## SCENE SETTER

#### ■ THE GAME:

Illinois State plays its second contest of a three-game home stand by hosting Summit League foe IUPUI Wednesday at 6 p.m. on Doug Collins Court at Redbird Arena. The Redbirds aim to remain undefeated at home and against members of the Summit League this season after opening their home schedule with a victory over Summit League-favorite Fort Wayne (Nov. 16). ISU is coming off an 81-67 victory over Ferris State (Nov. 27).

#### ■ THE SERIES:

Wednesday's game marks the second overall meeting between Illinois State and IUPUI, with the Redbirds holding a 1-0 advantage in the all-time series. The two teams last squared off Dec. 23, 2000, with ISU winning, 82-63, in Normal, Illinois. ISU is 77-51 versus current Summit League members, and **Dan Muller** is 2-1 against the Summit.

#### ■ THE COACHES:

**Illinois State: Dan Muller (Illinois State, 1998)** is in his fifth season as the head coach at Illinois State. Muller is the first-ever ISU coach to beat four Top-25 teams in his first four years. He led ISU to the 2015 NIT.  
**IUPUI: Jason Gardner (Arizona, 2011)** is in his third season as the head coach at IUPUI. As a first-year coach in 2014-15, Gardner helped IUPUI more than triple its win total of the previous season.

#### ■ ILLINOIS STATE:

Was picked to finish second (out of 10 teams) in the Missouri Valley Conference ... Was the only team to feature two players (out of five) on the Preseason All-MVC First Team (**Paris Lee** and **MiKYLE McIntosh**) ... Returns four of five starters and seven of 11 letterwinners from last year's team, which tied for second place in the MVC with a 12-6 record, signifying ISU's highest league finish and most conference wins since the 2007-08 season.

#### ■ IUPUI:

Was picked to finish fifth (out of nine teams) in the Summit League ... Returns two starters and eight letterwinners from last year's 13-19 team which finished fourth with a 9-7 record in the Summit League regular-season standings ... Included among the returners is Darell Combs (16.3 ppg last season) who was voted a 2016 All-Summit League Second Team selection and was a Preseason All-Summit League First Team selection this year.

## COACHING STAFF

**DAN MULLER | HEAD COACH | FIFTH SEASON**

Dan Muller knows what it takes to lead the Illinois State men's basketball team to the NCAA Tournament. He was the leader on the floor when the Redbirds qualified for the Big Dance in 1998, and he is striving to repeat that accomplishment, this time from the sidelines, as ISU's head coach. Muller was named the 19th men's basketball coach in school history May 8, 2012. Throughout his first four seasons, Muller led the Redbirds to a 76-58 record, including four triumphs over Top-25 programs. Before becoming ISU's leader, Muller spent 12 years as an assistant coach at Vanderbilt. As a player, Muller guided ISU to two regular-season and MVC Tournament championships.

**LUKE YAKLICH | ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH | FOURTH SEASON**

An Illinois State alum with invaluable Illinois high school and AAU ties, along with more than a decade of head coaching experience, Luke Yaklich (pronounced YOCK-litch) has served as an assistant coach for the ISU men's basketball team since the 2013-14 season. He was promoted to associate head coach ahead of the 2016-17 campaign. Yaklich was previously the head boy's basketball coach at Joliet Township High School in Joliet, Illinois, for six seasons, and also as a coach for the Joliet Pride and Illinois Wolves AAU teams. In total, Yaklich worked as a high school head coach and teacher for 14 years. Yaklich served as the ISU men's basketball team's manager/student assistant from 1996-98.

**DEAN OLIVER | ASSISTANT COACH | THIRD SEASON**

Dean Oliver has continuously proven his leadership ability as an NBA player and an NCAA Division I assistant coach and student-athlete. He is now sharing his vast experience with the Illinois State men's basketball program since joining ISU as an assistant coach prior to the 2014-15 season. A Mason City, Iowa, native who was born in Quincy, Illinois, Oliver spent three seasons as an assistant coach at North Dakota (2011-14), in Grand Forks, North Dakota, before coming to ISU. Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Oliver prospered as a professional basketball player for nearly a decade, including a two-year stint in the NBA with the Golden State Warriors following a college career at Iowa.

**BRIAN REESE | ASSISTANT COACH | FIRST SEASON**

Brian Reese, who won a national championship as a player with North Carolina and was the head coach at Division II Georgian Court University last season, was hired as an assistant coach at Illinois State ahead of the 2016-17 season. Prior to his head coaching stint, Reese served as a collegiate assistant for six years. Before coaching at Georgian Court, Reese was an assistant at Monmouth University for four seasons (2011-15). Prior to joining Monmouth, Reese served as an assistant coach at High Point (2010-11) after a two-year stint with Wingate (2008-10). As a player, Reese helped North Carolina win the 1992-93 national championship by averaging 11.4 points and 3.6 rebounds per game.

**DJ IS A HIT**

Junior transfer guard **DJ Clayton** has played well in his first four games as a Redbird. After scoring six points in the season opener at Murray State (Nov. 11), Clayton has reached double figures in three-straight contests, netting 11 points with nine rebounds against Fort Wayne (Nov. 16), an ISU career-best 13 points with five rebounds at TCU (Nov. 21), and once again, 11 points in the win over Ferris State (Nov. 27).

**MIKYLE STYLE**

Junior forward **MiKYLE McIntosh** – a Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference selection – picked up where he left off by recording season highs in points (20) and rebounds (nine) at TCU (Nov. 21).

**CAREER NIGHT**

Senior forward **Deontae Hawkins** netted a career-high 24 points in Illinois State's home-opening victory over Fort Wayne (Nov. 16). Hawkins surpassed his previous high of 18 points versus Youngstown State (Nov. 29, 2014). The Dayton, Ohio, native, made a career-best nine field goals (on 15 attempts), topping his previous mark of seven-made field goals against Southern Illinois Feb. 24, 2016.

**BALANCED ATTACK**

In Illinois State's wire-to-wire home-opening victory over Fort Wayne (Nov. 16), the Redbirds featured five players who reached double-figure scoring for the first time since achieving the same feat Jan. 12, 2016 at Southern Illinois. **Deontae Hawkins**, **MiKYLE McIntosh** and **Paris Lee** were three of the five both times.

**HAWK SKIES FOR BOARDS**

In Illinois State's season opener at Murray State (Nov. 11), senior forward **Deontae Hawkins** matched a career best with 15 rebounds. Hawkins recorded 15 boards for the third time in his career. And, with 14 points, Hawkins earned his third-career double-double.

**IT'S A STEAL**

Senior guard **Paris Lee** enters the 2016-17 season ranked No. 2 among active NCAA players for career steals. He needs five to crack into the MVC all-time Top 10 for steals.

**RECORDS IN REACH**

As the Missouri Valley Conference's active career leader in steals and assists, senior guard **Paris Lee** will undoubtedly leave his mark in the Illinois State record book. Lee ranks second in career steals (192) behind **Ron Jones** (222 from 1976-80). Lee also ranks 11th in career assists (341). Additionally, Lee began the 2016-17 season with 813 points, just 187 away from becoming the 42nd member of the 1,000-point club. Lee scored 355 points last season and has never scored fewer than 227.

**HIGH EXPECTATIONS**

Illinois State is picked to finish second in the league, according to the 2016-17 MVC Preseason Poll, as compiled from votes by MVC sports information directors, media and coaches. Illinois State's predicted second-place finish marks ISU's highest pick since also being tabbed second in the 2012-13 preseason poll. The Redbirds have now been selected to finish second or higher six times in program history (1993-94: first; 1996-97: first; 1997-98: first; 2001-02: first; 2012-13: second; 2016-17: second). ISU received 356 total points and four first-place votes. Wichita State is the favorite to win the MVC men's basketball title.

Senior guard **Paris Lee** and junior forward **MiKYLE McIntosh** are both 2016-17 MVC Preseason First Team selections. The Redbirds landed two on the five-player preseason roster for the first time since **Rico Hill** and current head coach **Dan Muller** represented ISU as preseason first-team selections in 1997-98. Hill and Muller led Illinois State to the NCAA Tournament that year after winning MVC regular-season and tournament titles. The 2016-17 Redbirds were the only team to earn two first-team honors.

## REDBIRDS TO PLAY IN 2017 PUERTO RICO TIP-OFF

"Another year and another terrific high-level tournament for Illinois State basketball," head coach Dan Muller said. "I want to thank ESPN for giving us a great opportunity to play in the Puerto Rico Tip-Off with an outstanding field of teams. I am looking forward to our team getting a chance to experience a new culture and play in a great tournament next year."

Other schools competing in the 2017 Puerto Rico Tip-Off will be Boise State of the Mountain West Conference, South Carolina of the Southeastern Conference and UTEP of Conference USA.

Boise State (20-12), Florida State (20-14), Iowa State (23-12), South Carolina (25-9) and Tulsa (20-12) won more than 20 games last season, with Illinois State (18-14) and UTEP (19-14) also posting winning records during the 2015-16 campaign. Overall, the eight schools scheduled to compete in the 2017 Puerto Rico Tip-Off posted a 59.8 winning percentage (158-106). Both Florida State and South Carolina competed in the 2016 NIT.

Senior guards **Paris Lee** and **Tony Wills** are two of four starters and seven letterwinners returning for the 2016-17 Redbirds. Illinois State's top returning scorer is Lee, who averaged 11.1 points per game to rank 20th in the league and account for 16.5 percent of the team's total scoring in 2015-16. He begins the 2016-17 season ranked fifth in league scoring (813 points). Additionally, Lee is the league's top returner in assists after averaging 3.7 per contest in 2015-16 to account for 29.1 percent of ISU's total assists. Returning senior forward **Deontae Hawkins** led the Redbirds and ranked ninth in the MVC by averaging 5.8 rebounds per game to account for 18 percent of Illinois State's total rebounds last season. He also averaged 10.3 points per contest.

The 2016-17 Redbirds return 57.2 percent of their scoring (a 6.6 percent increase from last year) and 50 percent of their rebounding. ISU also returns: 67.4 percent of assists, 64.9 percent of steals, 60 percent of blocks and 54.6 percent of minutes. Joining Illinois State's seven returning letterwinners are eight newcomers, including three true freshmen, one redshirt freshman, two junior college transfers and two Division I transfers who will be eligible to play in 2017-18.

Illinois State men's basketball great **Doug Collins** was inducted into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame during an enshrinement ceremony Nov. 18, at the Arvest Bank Theatre at the Midland in Kansas City, Missouri. A tape-delayed telecast of the ceremony will air Dec. 15 at 5 p.m. CT on ESPNU. In his three-year varsity career at ISU (1970-73), Collins averaged 29.1 points per game and totaled 2,240 career points while being named both an All-American and Academic All-American each season.

# DAN MULLER

## HEAD COACH • FIFTH SEASON • 78-60 ISU AND CAREER RECORD

Dan Muller knows what it takes to lead the Illinois State men's basketball team to the NCAA Tournament. He was the leader on the floor when the Redbirds qualified for the Big Dance in 1998, and he is striving to repeat that accomplishment, this time from the sidelines, as ISU's head coach. Muller was named the 19th men's basketball coach in school history May 8, 2012.

Throughout his first four seasons, Muller led the Redbirds to a 76-58 record, including four triumphs over Top-25 programs, two postseason appearances (2015 National Invitation Tournament and 2014 College Basketball Invitational), three postseason wins, and victories against the Big Ten, the BIG EAST and the Southeastern Conference (SEC). Muller is the first coach in Illinois State basketball history to beat four Top-25 teams in his first four seasons, and his four Top-25 victories are also tied for the most ever recorded by a Redbird head coach.

Muller has guided ISU student-athletes to eight All-Missouri Valley Conference selections (one first team, four second team and three honorable mention), four MVC All-Defensive accolades, three MVC All-Newcomer honors and one MVC All-Freshman accolade. Additionally, three Redbirds have garnered All-MVC Scholar-Athlete recognition under Muller's tutelage.

As a fourth-year coach (2015-16), Muller and the Redbirds faced one of the toughest non-conference schedules in program history, ranked No. 7 nationally at the end of the regular season, according to the Collegiate Basketball News Report. The Redbirds finished the 2015-16 campaign with an 18-14 overall record and tied for second place with a 12-6 mark in the MVC, signifying ISU's highest league finish and most conference wins since 2007-08. Illinois State's upset victory over No. 21 Wichita State (Feb. 6) on Doug Collins Court at Redbird Arena marked Muller's fourth Top-25 win in as many seasons. In the classroom, Muller's Redbirds established a cumulative team grade-point (GPA) record by teaming up to earn a 2.82 GPA during the 2015-16 academic year.

In his third season (2014-15), Muller guided ISU to a 22-13 overall record, marking the Redbirds' most victories since

2009-10. Illinois State tied for third place in the league with an 11-7 mark. As the MVC Tournament's fourth seed, ISU upset No. 8 Wichita State in the semifinals. After falling to No. 11 Northern Iowa in the tournament championship game, the Redbirds earned an at-large bid to the NIT and advanced to the second round by beating Green Bay at home (March 18). The Redbirds also established a team grade-point average record in the fall of 2014 with a 2.99 GPA.

During his second season (2013-14), Muller was charged with leading the most inexperienced team in NCAA Division I basketball. With just two-and-a-half years of returning experience, Muller guided ISU to an 18-win season, including victories over a Top-25 program (vs. No. 25 Dayton, Dec. 7), a Big Ten team (at Northwestern, Nov. 17), a BIG EAST opponent (vs. DePaul, Dec. 22) and an SEC foe (vs. Texas A&M, March 24).

In his first year at Illinois State (2012-13), Muller led the Redbirds to an 18-win campaign, with at least one victory against eight of the MVC's nine opponents, including a win at No. 16 Creighton.

Before becoming Illinois State's leader, Muller spent 12 years as an assistant coach at Vanderbilt. Under former Illinois State head coach Kevin Stallings, Muller was regarded as one of the top assistant coaches in the country. As Vanderbilt's recruiting coordinator, Muller spearheaded the program's recruiting efforts beginning in 2006, which were the highest rated recruiting classes in the history of the program.

As a player, Muller guided Illinois State to two regular-season and MVC Tournament championships and four postseason appearances, including trips to the NCAA Tournament in his final two seasons (1997 and 1998).

Muller ranks 11th in career scoring with



1,445 points, while leading the Redbirds to a 91-37 overall record, and he still owns the school record with 128-consecutive starts (every game of his career). Muller was also a two-time MVC Defensive Player of the Year and was named the MVP of the MVC Tournament as a senior. In 2009, he was inducted into the Illinois State Athletics Percy Family Hall of Fame.

Off the court, Muller was a two-time GTE Academic All-American and a recipient of the NCAA's Post-Graduate Scholarship. He also was named a Bone Scholar, the highest academic honor at ISU, and he is the only men's basketball student-athlete to earn the award.

The Lafayette, Indiana, native spent two years playing professionally, including a stint with the NBA's Vancouver Grizzlies.

Muller is a 1998 graduate of Illinois State and graduated cum laude with a bachelor's degree in organizational leadership. He later earned his master's in business administration from Florida in 2003. He is married to Melissa Muller and has one stepson, Sib.
