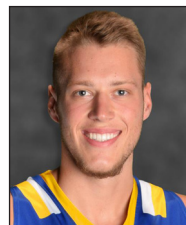

JACKRABBIT MEDIA INFORMATION

Credentials

All media credential requests for SDSU men's basketball home games should be directed to Assistant Sports Information Director Andrew Sogn at least 24 hours before the event.

The Sports Information Office may choose to mail credentials if they receive the request a week or more in advance. If not mailed, credentials may be picked up at the Jackrabbit ticket office inside the Stanley J. Marshall Center on weekdays from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., or at the Frost Arena will call window 60 minutes prior to the start of the event.

SDSU allows courtside access in Frost Arena only to working media. Media requiring access to phone lines and/or wired Internet should contact the SDSU Sports Information Office in advance of the game to assist in seating assignments, etc. SDSU does provide a free wireless Internet signal.

SDSU permits live blogging with descriptions of the event, but does not permit live video streaming of either game action or postgame press conferences. Video may be archived and posted to web sites following the conclusion of the event.

The South Dakota State Athletic Department asks that photographers (live and still) do not interfere with the sight lines of spectators. Video may be shot from the upper-level track on the east, west and south sides of Frost Arena. At court level, photographers must remain outside the team areas and in a position as to not interfere with the game.

Postgame Press Conference

A post game press conference may be held after home games in room 104 on the lower level of the Stanley J. Marshall HPER Center, just off the northeast side of the playing court. The visiting team goes first, followed by SDSU players and coaches.

Interview Policies

The South Dakota State Sports Information Office strives to comply with all legitimate interview requests for Jackrabbit coaches, student-athletes and administrators in a timely fashion.

Interview times can be arranged through the Sports Information Office or through the coach of the sport involved, preferably arranged 24 hours in advance Monday through Thursday.

Media members may not contact student-athletes directly without approval.

The SDSU Sports Information Office does not release the phone numbers of student-athletes to the media, and return calls must be made collect, or via a toll free number, unless the student-athlete does the interview from the Sports Information or Coaches Office. The media may not interview student-athletes prior to a contest on the day of the game, but may do so 10 minutes after the conclusion of contests by contacting a member of the Sports Information staff or coaching staff.

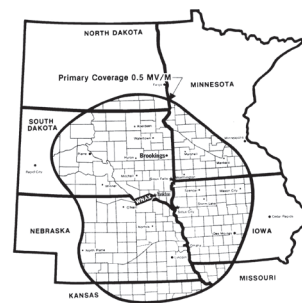
TRACKING THE JACKRABBITS

JACKRABBIT NOTES

The Setup

South Dakota State closes a two-game road swing this Wednesday, Jan. 18 as it head for Indianapolis, Ind., to take on IUPUI. Tipoff from the Indiana Farmer's Coliseum is set for 7 p.m.

This will be the 21st meeting all-time between the schools as SDSU holds a 13-7 advantage in the series, which dates back to 2007 when the Jackrabbits joined the Summit League. At IUPUI, the Jaguars hold a 5-4 lead in the series while SDSU has won seven of nine home games. Last year, the teams split home contests after SDSU had 11 straight prior.

Scouting the Jaguars

- IUPUI enters the week sitting seventh in the conference standings with a 2-3 Summit League mark while going 8-11 overall. The Jags are currently one game ahead of SDSU in the conference standings.
- IUPUI is coming off a road win over Oral Roberts, ending a stretch of three straight conference losses to begin the New Year.
- The Jaguars are led in scoring by Darell Combs' 17.3 points per game and Matt O'Leary's 14.7 scoring average. Combs has reached double figures in 16 games this season and has six 20-plus scoring efforts.
- O'Leary's 6.5 rebounds per game is a team-high as well with Evan Hall pulling down 5.9 rebounds per contest to sit second in that category.
- Combs, O'Leary and Kellon Thomas all have more than 50 assists on the year as Thomas' 3.1 assists per game paces the squad.
- Combs is 23rd nationally with 277 total field goal attempts this season and 63rd with 116 made field goals.
- As a team, IUPUI is scoring at a rate of 78.9 points per game while allowing 77.3 points on average.
- From the field, IUPUI is firing at 45.1 percent as a team with 165 made 3-pointers (out of 427 attempts). Opponents are shooting 45.0 percent against the Jaguars from the field and have shot 35.6 percent beyond the arc (133 of 374).
- At the charity stripe, the Jags are shooting 68.6 percent as a team, making 275 of 401 attempts.
- IUPUI averages 8.7 3-pointers per game, sitting 77th nationally while the team's 38.6 percent mark from long range is 45th in NCAA Division I. As well, IUPUI is 42nd in total 3-pointers made.

Charity Stripe Success

South Dakota State has gotten to the free throw line more than its opponents in 16 of 20 games this season and have trailed in free throw attempts just twice this season. The Jackrabbits are shooting just under 80 percent (78.8) on free throws this season, have four players at or above the 80 percent mark and nine active players shooting above 70 percent on free throws.

- From Dec. 7 to Dec. 22, Mike Daum hit a school record 43 consecutive free throws, breaking the previous record of 35, set by Garrett Callahan in 2008-09. Over the final seven non-conference games Daum hit 60 of 63 at the charity stripe (95.2 percent).
- Mike Daum set a school record with 16 made free throws (out of 16 attempts) against Murray State after tying the previous school record with 13 made free throws (out of 13 attempts) against Idaho (Dec. 10).
- As of Jan. 16, South Dakota State ranks 23rd in free throw attempts (462), sixth nationally in free throws made (364) and fifth in NCAA Division I in free throw percentage (.788).
- As of Jan. 16, Mike Daum is the national leader in free throw makes (144) and attempts (164) and is 37th in free throw percentage (87.8).

Daum-inating

Mike Daum has stepped into a new role as the go-to scorer for the Jackrabbits in 2016-17, but has picked up where he left off after his redshirt freshman season ended with All-Summit League First Team, All-Newcomer and Newcomer of the Year honors. Daum was picked as the 2016-17 Summit League Preseason Player of the Year, and is living up to the hype with 22.6 points and 7.7 rebounds per contest so far this year.

- Named The Summit League's December Male Athlete of the Month after averaging 25.4 points and 7.5 rebounds over eight contests last month. Daum shot 53.6 percent from the field, 40 percent beyond the arc and 92.4 percent at the charity stripe for the month while reaching 20 points or more in seven of eight games (with over 30 points in two games).
- Named The Summit League's Athlete of the Week on Dec. 19 after a monster performance against Murray State that earned him a spot on ESPN's *SportsCenter*.
- Daum has hit double figures in 18 of 20 games this season and 48 times over 54 career games.
- Has scored 20 or more in 14 games this season and 21 for his career.
- Has scored over 30 points in five contests this season.
- Has recorded five double-doubles this season and seven in his career.
- Set a career high with 14 field goals made and 25 field goals attempted on Jan. 12 at Oral Roberts. The 14 made field goals is tied for second most in school history with the FG attempts tied for fifth all-time at SDSU.
- Hit a school record 43 consecutive free throws from Dec. 7 to 22, breaking the previous record of 35, set by Garrett Callahan in 2008-09. Over the final seven non-conference games Daum hit 60 of 63 at the charity stripe (95.2 percent).
- Set new or matched career-highs for points (32), field goals (10), free throws made-attempted (11 of 13), assists (six) and minutes (36) on Nov. 27 against Milwaukee.
- Reset new career highs in points (33) and free throws made (13 of 13) against Idaho on Dec. 10.
- Moved into a seven-way tie for fourth in single game field goals made (11) and five-way tie for seventh in field goal attempts (22) in a single game against Murray State.
- Put together the program's seventh highest scoring game against Murray State when he finished with 39 to go alongside a 16 of 16 effort from the charity stripe that set a new school record for free throws made.
- Daum recorded back-to-back double-doubles against UC Irvine and East Tennessee State at the Sanford Pentagon Showcase, March 25-26. The last time a Jackrabbit had recorded back-to-back double-doubles in a game was Nov. 14 and 17, 2014 when Cody Larson achieved the feat in the opening two games of the 2014-15 season.
- Daum was named to the Sanford Pentagon Showcase All-Tournament Team after posting averages of 24.0 points, 11.0 rebounds and 3.6 assists per game in three contests over the weekend event in Sioux Falls, S.D.
- Daum saw his streak of 22 consecutive games in double figures come to an end Nov. 14 at UC Irvine when he finished with nine points and eight rebounds, but has only missed scoring 10 or more twice this season and six times in 54 career games

JACKRABBIT NOTES

- Daum set the school's freshman scoring record with 518 last season. The previous record was Matt Caldwell's 453 points from 2006. He was also the first-ever SDSU freshman (at both DI and DII levels) to earn all-league/all-conference honors.
- Daum has scored 451 points this season through 20 games, and with a minimum of 11 games remaining in the regular season he is on pace to break Nate Wolter's sophomore scoring record of 604 points.
- Daum's 33-point effort against Idaho on Dec. 10 moved him into first on the active career scoring list.
- Daum went over the 800-point mark in his career with 39 points against Murray State on Dec. 10 and hit the 900-point mark after scoring 30 against South Dakota Dec. 31. He is the program's active leading scorer and if he continues his pace of more than 22 points per game, Daum is projected to join the 1,000 points club in mid-January 2017.
- Daum ranks third nationally in total scoring with 451 points through 20 games. He is eighth nationally with 22.6 points per game currently.
- Daum ranks eighth nationally with 138 field goals made and 36th with 265 field goal attempts
- Daum ranks as the third highest scoring sophomore on the NCAA's active scoring list among all divisions and DI. He trails Marcus Evans of Rice (1,020 points) and Tyler Hall of Montana State (973 points) as the leading sophomore scorers.

#FearFrost

- The Jacks own a 69-5 record at Frost Arena over the last five seasons, which includes perfect home records in four of the last five years. That span includes two home winning streaks of 30 or more games.
- SDSU's 34-game winning streak, which ended Wednesday, Dec. 28, ranked as the nation's second longest active streak at the time it ended.
- SDSU won 30 consecutive home games from Jan. 29, 2011 to Nov. 14, 2013.
- SDSU put together undefeated seasons inside Frost Arena the following years: 1984-85 (18-0), 2002-03 (17-0), 2011-12 (14-0), 2012-13 (13-0), 2014-15 (13-0), and 2015-16 (12-0).
- Since 2011-12, South Dakota State has won 93.2 percent of its home games, a mark that ranks fifth among all Division I programs. The list of top 10 home winning percentages since 2011-12 is available on page four of the game notes.

From Long Range

- SDSU has fired 524 3-pointers this season, up from 426 3-point attempts through 20 games last season. The school record for 3-point attempts in a season is 732. No. 10 on that record list is 527.
- Those 524 3-point attempts represent 48.8 percent of SDSU's 1,072 total field goal attempts.
- As of Jan. 16, the Jacks rank ninth in NCAA Division I in 3-point attempts (524), are 16th nationally in 3-pointers made (181), shooting at 34.5 percent beyond the arc.
- South Dakota State set a new school record for 3-point field goal attempts in a single game on Nov. 19, 2016 at Wyoming, firing 37 shots from beyond the arc. The previous record was 33, set twice, last at Oakland on Jan. 26, 2012.

- The Jacks tied the previously set record for 3-point attempts against Idaho, Nov. 21, and set a new record for made 3-pointers in that game, knocking down 16. The previous mark was 15, set at Oakland on Dec. 31, 2008.

Player Quick Hits

- Cole Gentry, who started four games for the Jackrabbits earlier this season, has been granted his release from the program.
- A.J. Hess posted his first career double-double on Jan. 4 at Western Illinois, scoring 13 points to go alongside a career-high 14 rebounds.
- Hess pulled down 42 total rebounds over 15 non-conference games to open the year, but since conference play began Hess is the team's leading rebounder with 40 over five games. Hess set career-highs in rebounds against North Dakota State (10) and Western Illinois (14).
- A.J. Hess and Reed Tellinghuisen rank 31st and 47th among NCAA Division I players, respectively, in 3-point field goal attempts. Hess has hit 50 of 138 this season and Tellinghuisen has made 41 out of 130.
- Six times this season the Jacks have seen four players reach double figures. The Jacks last did it Jan. 12 when Mike Daum (32), Reed Tellinghuisen (14), A.J. Hess (12) and Chris Howell (11) all scored in double digits at Oral Roberts.
- Twice this season South Dakota State has had two players score over 20 points in the same game. A.J. Hess (31) and Mike Daum (23) score 20-plus in a loss for the first time since Feb. 10, 2016 at Omaha when Daum and Reed Tellinghuisen reached that mark. On Dec. 3 against Kansas City, Andre Wallace (21) and Daum (22) broke the 20-point mark in a win for the first time since Daum and George Marshall did it on Feb. 13, 2016 against South Dakota.
- SDSU has had five different players hit double figures in a game twice this season. The Jacks first did it in the win over Minnesota Crookston on Nov. 30, 2016. SDSU also did it Jan. 7 against Omaha.
- Entering the Nov. 30 game with Minnesota Crookston, the most assists an SDSU player had in a game was six this season. Sergio El Darwich matched that in the opening half against UMC and finished with eight for the night.
- Over a span of three games from Nov. 21 to Nov. 26, South Dakota State saw A.J. Hess, Reed Tellinghuisen and Mike Daum all reach double figures and score a majority of SDSU's points. Of the 200 points SDSU scored in those games, the three Jackrabbits had 161, or 80.5 percent of the points. Daum scored 63 points in that stretch (31.5 percent), Hess had 57 points (28.5 percent) and Tellinghuisen had 41 points (20.5 percent). Mike Daum posted his first-ever 30-point game against Milwaukee on Nov. 27, finishing with 32 points off of 10-for-13 shooting in the field and an 11-for-13 effort from the charity stripe. Daum also dished out a career-high six assists.
- A.J. Hess put together SDSU's first 30-point game at Idaho (scoring 31) since Nov. 26, 2013 when Jordan Dykstra had 32 against Lehigh.
- Reed Tellinghuisen has hit double figures in 14 of 20 games this season, pushing his career mark in that category to 46 games with double figures. Tellinghuisen is



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second on the active career scoring list.

- Reed Tellinghuisen ranks 11th nationally with 674 total minutes played this season.
- After a slow start to the season where A.J. Hess scored just 11 points total in the first four games, the graduate transfer has raised his average to 10.3 points per game with 12 double figure scoring games and a double-double.

Team Quick Hits

- The Jackrabbits were whistled for only 10 fouls on Nov. 30 against UMC and on Dec. 16 versus Murray State, and only eight on Nov. 27 against Milwaukee. The Jacks have been whistled for less than 15 personal fouls 10 times this season.
- The Jacks are 14th nationally with just 15.5 personal fouls per game (as of Jan. 16 stats release).
- At least one Jackrabbit has scored in double figures over the last 296 games dating back to Jan. 12, 2008 at IUPUI when Anthony Cordova has nine points to lead the Jacks.
- SDSU has made at least one 3-pointer in 324 consecutive games. The last time the Jackrabbits did not make a 3-point field goal was Jan. 25, 2007 at Utah State when the team went 0-for-13.
- From Jan. 31, 2009 through the 2013-14 season, SDSU put together a streak of 179 games with at least one 1,000 point scorer on the floor. SDSU has now gone 89 games without a 1,000 point scorer. Mike Daum is currently 31 points away from scoring 1,000 for his career.
- The last time SDSU went 0-2 to open the year was 2014-15 when the squad finished with a 24-11 overall record and was a Summit League regular season co-champion.
- SDSU is 91-18 all-time in home openers (where records available). Dating back to 2004-05, SDSU's first year of DI transition, SDSU is 11-2. Since joining the Summit League in 2007-08, SDSU is 9-2 in home openers.
- SDSU is now 72-39 in season-openers all-time. The Jacks are 5-8 in season-opening games at the Division I level.

Jackrabbits' Last Time Out -- Jan. 7, 2017

TULSA, Oklahoma -- South Dakota State men's basketball saw its comeback efforts fall short as the Jacks dropped a 94-88 contest at Oral Roberts Thursday evening despite a 32-point effort from Mike Daum.

SDSU (8-12, 1-4 Summit League) shot 52.3 percent from the field and hit 12 3-pointers on the night, but Oral Roberts used a 23 of 24 effort at the charity stripe alongside a 50 percent mark on field goals and seven 3-pointers to secure the win.

Daum led all scorers, attempting a career-high 25 field goals with a career-high 14 made. Reed Tellinghuisen (14 points), A.J. Hess (12 points) and Chris Howell (11 points) joined Daum in double figures as Howell snagged a team-high seven boards.

All five starters for the Golden Eagles reached double figures in the scoring column, led by Albert Owens' 24 points.

An early 8-0 run for the Jacks with 3-pointers from Tellinghuisen and Hess carried SDSU to an 10-4 lead in the first three minutes, but ORU responded with seven consecutive points of their own to take an 11-10 lead at 16:08.

After a swing of five quick lead changes saw the Jacks take control, 17-16, off an Andre Wallace jumper, SDSU held the advantage for the next five minutes, but couldn't pull away as ORU found an answer for the Jacks hot shooting.

With 3:52 to go in the half, Hess sunk his third 3-pointer of the night to move the Jacks' edge to four once again, but the Eagles used a 7-2 run over the next 90 seconds to take back the lead before neither scored over the final two minutes of the half.

All told, 16 lead changes, six ties and 20 field goals for both teams over a fast-paced, high-efficiency first half sent the Jacks to the locker room down one, 50-49.

SDSU hit 64.5 percent of its field goals with nine 3-pointers in the opening 20 minutes while Oral Roberts was 20 of 37 (54.1 percent) on field goals in the first half with five 3s.

Daum paced the squad with 13 points and four rebounds in the half, matching Hess (nine points) with three 3-pointers. Ian Theisen had nine points as well for the Jacks in the first.

ORU picked up where it left off in the second, moving out to a 63-54 lead before the under-16 media before SDSU cut it to five (63-58) behind a Daum dunk and Howell 3-pointer. The Jackrabbits continued to rally and drew within one, 68-67, moments later, with another Daum slam off Howell's assist at 9:35 to close a run of seven straight for SDSU.

After Golden Eagles pulled away to lead by 11 (81-70) with less than six to play, and the Jacks started a climb back over the next four minutes that saw them cut the lead to two, 81-79, behind a pair of Tellinghuisen free throws with 3:01 on the clock.

The Jackrabbit run was ended on the next ORU possession, but SDSU continued to push and tied it, 83-all, with 1:04 to play on a second chance layup by Daum.

That was all for the Jacks, however, as ORU's free throw shooting prowess helped the Golden Eagles hold on down the stretch.

Jaguars' Last Time Out -- Jan. 12, 2017 (IUPUIjags.com)

TULSA, Okla. - Sophomore D.J. McCall scored a career-high 21 points to lead four Jaguars in double-digits as IUPUI picked off Oral Roberts, 91-85 inside the Mabee Center on Saturday night (Jan. 14). The win snapped the Jaguars' recent three-game skid and was IUPUI's first over ORU in Tulsa since February 2004. The win also broke IUPUI's 10-game losing streak to Oral Roberts.

Senior Matt O'Leary chipped in 17 points and Kellon Thomas added 15 points in the win. Junior Ron Patterson came off the bench to contribute 12 while Kris Martin paced ORU (5-14, 1-4 Summit) with 25 points, including 5-of-10 from three.

McCall staked the Jaguars to a fantastic start as IUPUI (8-11, 2-3 Summit) built an early 15-8 lead behind the sophomore guard's quick 10 in the opening three-plus minutes. IUPUI led the bulk of the first half before relinquishing the lead with 6:51 before the break. However, the Jacks capped the stanza with a 10-2 run which included an O'Leary layup at the final horn to take a 50-47 halftime advantage.

The Jacks never yielded the lead in the second half, but had to endure some tenuous moments to escape with the victory. After scoring 30 points in the paint in the first half, the Jacks used an aerial attack in the second to stay in front of the hosts.

Patterson sank back-to-back threes to put IUPUI ahead 73-65 with 9:25 left and McCall connected on his second of three threes to make it an 11-point lead with 6:14 to play. IUPUI was still up 10 with 4:10 left, but had to cling for dear life in the closing minutes.

ORU crept within 84-81 with 1:16 left when Martin grabbed a defensive board and raced the other way for an easy layup. IUPUI went empty on the next trip on a pair of missed free throws and Martin made it 84-83 when he connected on both foul shots with 32 seconds left.

Thomas responded with a pair of freebies and Evan Hall helped seal the win by blocking an ORU attempt with 24 seconds left. IUPUI proceeded to hit 5-of-6 foul shots down the stretch to stave off the Golden Eagles.

IUPUI shot 55 percent from the field and 11-of-22 from three-point range, while also outrebounding ORU 36-25. McCall, who had hit just one trey all season and six in his two-year career entering play, connected on 3-of-5 attempts including the two late makes. Thomas was a perfect 3-of-3 from deep and Patterson made 2-of-3 snipes off the bench.

Oral Roberts shot 50 percent from the floor and 9-of-17 (53 percent) from three-point range. The Golden Eagles also connected on 16-of-17 (94.1 percent) from the foul line with the lone miss coming in the final minute.

IUPUI earned 16 second chance points, thanks to 14 offensive boards. Hall led the swarm with eight boards and McCall grabbed six boards and delivered five assists. O'Leary finished with five boards and five assists while Darell Combs closed with eight points and four boards.

Albert Owens tallied 21 points and nine rebounds for ORU and Jalen Bradley added 17 points and four assists. Darian Harris added 11 points and five boards off the ORU bench before fouling out.

New Faces, Great Places

South Dakota State's hiring of first-year head coach T.J. Otzelberger was a nod to the state's motto, "Great Faces, Great Places." The new face of the program, announced April 14, 2016, is in his first-ever heading coaching role, but has been groomed for the position over several assistant stops, working with Lorenzo Romar (Washington), Fred Hoiberg (Iowa State), Greg McDermott (Iowa State) and Steve Prohm (Iowa State). Alongside Otzelberger, new members of the coaching staff include Ben Walker, a Creighton hall of fame member who last coached at Jackson State, Eric Henderson, a former Wayne State (Neb.) standout who spent last season with SDSU's rival, North Dakota State, and Tyler Glidden, the director of operations who has worked at Creighton and Iowa State. Rob Klinkefus was the lone holdover from former head coach Scott Nagy's staff, and enters his 11th season at SDSU.

20-Win Seasons

Reaching the 20-win mark has become a standard at South Dakota State University over the previous five seasons, as the Jackrabbits have done in four times in that span and 23 times in the program's history.

2015-16 Season Review

The 2015-16 Jackrabbit Men's Basketball season featured several highlights throughout the campaign, including a trip to the NCAA Tournament, a conference tournament title and earning a share of The Summit League's regular season championship. The Jackrabbits earned the No. 12 seed in last year's West Region, narrowly missing an upset over fifth-seeded Maryland in the first round, falling 79-74. Prior to that, SDSU earned the nickname "Cardiac Jacks" with a run through the conference tournament, pulling off three-point quarterfinal and one-point semifinal wins before earning the automatic bid with a 67-59 win over NDSU in the final. Mike Daum was named the tournament MVP and Deondre Parks was a member of the All-Tournament team. For the regular season, SDSU posted its second consecutive undefeated home record while three players garnered All-Conference honors in addition to other national awards. Mike Daum was named the Summit League Freshman and Sixth Man of the Year in addition to earning spots on the All-Conference First Team and the All-Newcomer Team. George Marshall was an All-Conference First Team selection and Deondre Parks claimed an honorable mention nod. On the national level, Marshall and Parks earned NABC Division I All-District 12 honors with First and Second Team nods, respectively, and Daum was named a Kyle Macy All-American. After the season, longtime head coach Scott Nagy resigned after completing his 21st season at the helm.

Nate Wolters – Crvena Zvezda MTS Beograd (Serbia)

At SDSU from 2009-13: The Jackrabbits all-time leader in points and assists, the Washington Wizards drafted Wolters with the 38th overall pick in the 2013 NBA Draft, then traded him to the Philadelphia 76ers, who traded him to the Milwaukee Bucks, all on the same night. Wolters played his rookie season with the Bucks before they waived him on Jan. 9, 2015. He signed the first of two 10 day contracts with the New Orleans Pelicans on Jan. 14, but they let him go on Feb. 3, making him a free agent again. The Grand Rapids Drive claimed Wolters from the player pool on March 6. He finished the season with the Drive, then played with the Los Angeles Clippers in the 2015 summer league, but suffered an injury late in the season, then chose to play the 2015-16 season in Turkey, signing with Besiktas Integral Forex Istanbul in the Turkish Basketball Super League. After spending the 2016 Summer Leagues with Indiana and Washington of the NBA, Wolters was in camp with the Denver Nuggets and just missed the cut, electing to sign with Crvena Zvezda MTS Beograd for the 2016-17 season.
