# **QUICK NOTES**

- EKU leads the all-time series with IUPUI, 2-1. The Colonels won the last matchup, 73-64, on Dec. 13, 2014 in Indianapolis.
- In its lone exhibtion on Sunday, EKU beat Georgetown College - the No. 2 NAIA team in the country - 83-71. Freshman guard Asante Gist led the Colonels with 22 points and five assists.
- EKU has won four consecutive season openers, including a convincing 107-80 win over Coppin State last season.
- Sophomore forward Nick Mayo was voted Preseason All-OVC in late October. Mayo was the OVC Freshman of the Year and first team All-OVC in 2015-16. He is one of only two freshmen in the last five years to be named first team All-OVC, joining former Murray State guard and NBA first round draft pick Cameron Payne (2013-14).
- EKU was the only team in the OVC to rank in the top-three in the league in all three shooting categories in 2015-16: three-point field goal percentage (1st / 39.5%), field goal percentage (2nd / 49.1%) and free throw percentage (3rd / 73.0%).
- The Colonels broke the school record for field goal percentage (49.1%) in 2015-16.
- Senior Jaylen Babb-Harrison finished 2015-16 as the OVC leader in three-point field goal percentage (45.3%). The last Colonel to finish the season as the OVC's leader in three-point field goal percentage was Mike Rose in 2008-09 (48.1). Rose also led the NCAA that year.

# **COLONELS OUT-BOARD GAMECOCKS**

EKU out-rebounded JSU, 48-27, on Feb. 25. It was the Colonels' best rebounding margin of the year.

# **DEFENSE LEADS THE WAY VS. JSU**

EKU held Jacksonville State to 27 percent (15-of-55) shooting from the field in the 76-54 win over the Gamecocks on Feb. 25. It was the lowest point total and lowest field goal percentage allowed by the Colonels this season. It was the first time EKU had held an opponent below 30 percent from the field since the upset of No. 18 Miami (29 percent) on Dec. 18, 2014.

#### TOMMY STARTS ON SENIOR DAY

Senior walk-on Tommy Matthews made his first-career start on Senior Day vs. Belmont on Feb. 18. Matthews has been a part of 84 wins during his four-year Colonel career.

# **SEASON HIGH FOR POWELL**

Senior Ja'Mill Powell buried a career-high six three-pointers and scored a season-high 25 points in the Colonels' 79-78 loss to Tennessee State on Feb. 13. He missed his career high by one point.

# THREE-POINT PERCENTAGE LEADER

Junior Jaylen Babb-Harrison came off the bench to knock down three three-pointers at Morehead State on Feb. 11. As of Feb. 12, Babb-Harrison leads the OVC in three-point field goal percentage (46.4). The last Colonel to finish the season as the OVC's leader in three-pointer percentage was Mike Rose in 2008-09 (48.1). Rose also led the NCAA that year.

# **HISTORIC SWEEP**

Following EKU's Music City sweep, JaVontae Hawkins (Player of the Week), Jarelle Reischel (Newcomer of the Week) and Nick Mayo (Freshman of the Week) swept the OVC's weekly awards. It is the first time under the current format (1985-86) three individual players from the same school have swept the OVC weekly awards outright (no ties).

# **BELMONT'S HOME STREAK SNAPPED!**

EKU defeated Belmont, 88-78, on Feb. 6 at the Curb Event Center, handing the Bruins their first-ever OVC home loss since they joined the league in 2012-13. It was the nation's longest home conference win streak.

#### **POWELL THE KEY?**

Senior Ja'Mill Powell made his second straight start vs. TSU and responded with 10 points, six rebounds and three assists. The Colonels are 4-0 this season when Powell scores in double figures.

#### **COLONELS DIAL IN FROM LONG RANGE**

EKU shot a season-high 64 percent (14-of-22) from three-point range vs. the Tigers. The performance comes five days after the Colonels shot a season-low 5 percent (1-of-17) from long range vs. Morehead State on Jan. 30.

# FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK #8

Nick Mayo was voted the OVC Freshman of the Week for the eighth time on Feb. 1. He averaged 20.5 ppg and 5.5 rpg over the week before. The EKU record for OVC Freshman of the Week awards is 11, held by Matt Witt in 2002-03.

# MCGLONE'S TURNOVER(LESS) STREAK

Junior Isaac McGlone dished out a seasonhigh five assists vs. Morehead State on Jan. 30. McGlone has committed only one turnover in EKU's last 10 games. He has played 348 minutes during that span (34.8 mpg). He has a very-solid 25.0 assist-to-turnover ratio during that span.

# **BLOCK PARTY**

Freshman Nick Mayo's five blocks vs. Morehead State were the most by a Colonel since Eric Stutz had seven vs. Southeast Missouri on Feb. 2, 2013.

## POWELL GETS THE START

Senior Ja'Mill Powell made his first start since Nov. 16 vs. Morehead State (Jan. 30) and responded with eight points and a career-high seven rebounds.




# **Getting Personal With The Colonels**







#### **MAYO HONORED**

Nick Mayo was voted OVC Freshman of the Year and first team All-OVC following the season. Mayo is the fourth different Colonel player to be named OVC Freshman of the Year and first since Adam Leonard shared the award in 2006-07. He is one of only two freshmen in the last five years to be named first team All-OVC, joining former Murray State guard and NBA first round draft pick Cameron Payne (2013-14).

#### **HISTORIC SWEEP**

Following EKU's Music City sweep, JaVontae Hawkins (Player of the Week), Jarelle Reischel (Newcomer of the Week) and Nick Mayo (Freshman of the Week) swept the OVC's weekly awards. 

Dan McHale, a former University of Louisville assistant, was introduced as Eastern Kentucky's new head coach on April 9, 2015.

"We are ecstatic to welcome Coach Dan McHale and his family to the Colonel Family," Eastern Kentucky University President Michael Benson said. "Dan brings years of experience at some top-flight programs to EKU, along with ties to Kentucky and this region. He came to us with the highest recommendations from some of America's best coaches and we have every confidence he will take our basketball program to the next level."

Before being chosen as Eastern Kentucky's 20th head men's basketball coach, McHale completed his second season as an assistant coach at the University of Minnesota where he worked under head coach Richard Pitino. McHale got his coaching start under Hall of Fame coach Rick Pitino as a staff assistant at Louisville from 2001 to 2003.

"I'm extremely excited to be working at Eastern Kentucky University," McHale said. "I want to thank President Benson and Steve Lochmueller for this opportunity. With the leadership of these two, it's an honor to be a part of these exciting times at EKU. We are going to bring excitement to McBrayer Arena with a fast paced style of play. It's going to be fun for our players and our fans."

In his first season at Minnesota, McHale helped the Gophers to a NIT Championship and a 25-13 record that included wins over No. 9 Wisconsin and No. 11 Ohio State. The 25 victories are the second-most in program history. The 2014-15 squad won 18 games, including a victory at Michigan State, a team that would reach the Final Four.

"I am extremely excited and proud of Dan McHale," Richard Pitino said. "Eastern Kentucky is getting a tremendous coach and recruiter, but more importantly a great person. He will represent the Eastern Kentucky program in a first-class manner. There is no doubt in my mind that he will do great things there."

McHale served as a student manager for four seasons (1997-01) at Kentucky. He was part of one national championship team, four NCAA Tournament teams and three Southeastern Conference championships while working with Tubby Smith's Wildcats.

The Cardinals went 25-7, won the 2003 Conference USA Tournament title and reached the NCAA Tournament in McHale's second season as a staff assistant at Louisville. During his first stint he assisted with opponent scouting, game preparation and

on-campus recruiting. After one year as the director of operations at Manhattan College, McHale returned to UofL for two seasons as the director of video operations, overseeing advance scouting video and evaluation video of Cardinal players. In his second two-year stint at Louisville, the Cardinals won 45 games and played in two NCAA Tournaments.

"Dan is one of the hardest working coaches in our profession," Rick Pitino said. "I have great admiration for his dedication to our game. He is a great addition to our state."

In 2007, McHale joined Kevin Willard's first staff at lona College. As an assistant, McHale helped lead the Gaels from two wins the season before the duo arrived to 12 wins their first season and 21 wins in year three at lona. He recruited NBA draft pick and 2012 MAAC Player of the Year Scott Machado to lona.

McHale followed Willard to Seton Hall when he was named head coach in 2010. In their second season, the Pirates won 20 games. While at Seton Hall, McHale was responsible for the Pirates' defensive game planning and spearheaded opponent scouting and game preparation.

"Eastern Kentucky has hit a home run with the hiring of Dan McHale, who is a rising star within the coaching ranks," Willard said. "He is not only a terrific recruiter and mentor of student-athletes, but he also has a great mind for the game of basketball. Dan has earned the opportunity to lead a basketball program, and with his outstanding knowledge, personality and work ethic, he will make a positive impact at Eastern Kentucky."

McHale will look to add to the success of the Rick Pitino coaching tree that includes Billy Donovan (Florida), Tubby Smith (Texas Tech), Mick Cronin (Cincinnati), Richard Pitino (Minnesota) and former EKU head coach Travis Ford (Oklahoma State).

McHale has caught the eye of one of America's top young college basketball coaches – Memphis head coach Josh Pastner.

"Dan is going to do an outstanding job at Eastern Kentucky University," said Pastner. "He is a tireless worker and will do the job with great principle and great work ethic. Eastern Kentucky got a winner in Dan McHale."


