QUICK HITS

- Mo Evans could soon become the program leader in 3-pointers. Evans owns 241 treys. He is nearing the all-time leader in 3-pointers at Fort Wayne. The top spot is held by Nick Wise (1999-02) who made 246 in his career.
- Brent Calhoun moved into fourth place all-time in program history in blocks on Saturday at South Dakota State. He owns 95 career rejections. Next up on the list is third place Doug Reincke. He recorded 113 blocks from 1989-93.
- Xzavier Taylor scored 10 points off the bench against South Dakota State last Saturday on 5-of-7 shooting. He has scored seven or more points in three of the Mastodons' last four games.
- Following the Mastodons' game on Saturday at Oral Roberts, they will have played a game vs. each team in the league this year.
- Mo Evans has scored in double-digits in 20 games this year. The only game he came up short was a nine-point effort vs. Indiana.

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SCOUTING THE JAGUARS

IUPUI (9-12, 3-4 Summit) comes to the Gates Center with an identical 3-4 league record as the Mastodons. The Jaguars are led offensively by Darrell Combs' 17.0 points per game. However he has been held to single digit scoring in two of his last three games. His jumper in overtime gave the Jaguars a win over South Dakota State last Wednesday.

SCOUTING THE MASTODONS

The Mastodons (14-7, 3-4 Summit) are shooting 42.8 percent on the season. Four 'Dons are averaging in double-digits. Mo Evans is averaging 3.6 3-pointers per game and Kason Harrell is averaging 2.3 3-pointers per game.

THE SERIES

IUPUI leads the all-time series with Fort Wayne 25-13. The two clubs have been playing since 1975. As Summit League members they have met 15 times, that includes a meeting in 2014 in the Summit League Tournament in Sioux Falls, S.D. which the 'Dons won 85-47. IUPUI won both meetings with Fort Wayne last season. Both came down to the wire, with Fort Wayne falling 84-82 in Fort Wayne and 80-77 in the Circle City.

LAST TIME OUT

Fort Wayne fell 77-67 on Saturday at South Dakota State. The 'Dons didn't have an answer for Mike Daum who went off for 42 points with 10 3-pointers against the 'Dons. The sophomore passed the 1,000 career points in the game.

UP NEXT

Fort Wayne travels to Oral Roberts on Saturday (Jan. 28) in a 4 p.m. ET start in Tulsa, Okla.

LIFE IN THE SUMMIT

The 'Dons are 3-4 in conference play this year but their record doesn't indicate how close the contests have been. In the seven games they have scored 573 points and surrendered 577. In each of their four losses, they have held a lead in the second half.

RANKING THE 'DONS

Fort Wayne is No. 24 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll. They reached a program-best No. 6 on two occasions earlier in the year. In addition, earlier this season the 'Dons received a vote in two USA Today Coaches Polls and an Associated Press Top 25 Poll. It was the first time in program history the 'Dons have received a vote in the USA Today and AP Polls.

IN NATIONAL RANKINGS...

Fort Wayne ranks third in 3-point field goal percentage (42.8 percent), ninth in scoring (87.7), fourth in 3-pointers per game (11.1), 13th in total assists (355), 13th in field goal percentage (49.7 percent) and 17th in total steals (174).

NEARLY BOTTS-LIKE NUMBERS

Mo Evans picked up his 1,000th career point this year. He is the 13th player in program history to reach the plateau. He now owns 1,344 career points and ranks sixth all-time in scoring at Fort Wayne. To reach the fifth spot he will need to pass Ben Botts' 1,400 points. Botts played for Fort Wayne from 2007-11 and is a current assistant coach for the 'Dons.

MO RANKINGS, NO PROBLEMS

Mo Evans is third in 3-point field goal percentage (50.7), fifth in the nation in made 3-pointers (75) and 10th in 3-point field goals per game (3.57).

IT IS RAINING THREES

Mo Evans has made a 3-pointer in every game this year. Dating back to last season, he has made a trey in 37 straight games.

20-21 VISION

Fort Wayne made 20 3-pointers vs. Oral Roberts on Dec. 31. It tied a league record for most 3-pointers in a Summit League contest. The total tied the school record set last season when the 'Dons made 20 in a win at South Dakota on Feb. 4, 2016. Then on Jan. 9 the Mastodons made 21 3-pointers in a win over NCAA Division III Olivet to break the school record.

SENSATIONAL SENIOR

Senior Brent Calhoun is making his senior year his best. He is averaging 7.4 points, 5.9 rebounds and 1.8 blocks per game. Each are on pace to be career bests.

John Konchar is shooting 64.0 percent on the season, fifth best in the nation. He is 114-of-178 on the season.

KASON. KEEPIN' ON

Kason Harrell is averaging 10.6 points per game this season for the ‘Dons after playing only 73 minutes last season. The sophomore has made a 3-pointer in all but one game this year. He had 21 points at Austin Peay on Nov. 30.

GRANTS AND BENJAMINS

The ‘Dons have scored 50 or more points in a half 11 times this season. They’ve scored 100 points in a game on five occasions, the most during the NCAA Division I era for the program. The last time the ‘Dons scored 100 points five times in a season was 1992-93.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

John Konchar has nine double-doubles this season, the most in the Summit League. After last year’s 14 he now owns 23 in his career, a total which ranks 15th among active NCAA Division I players.

GETTING DIGITS

Fort Wayne has had 10 games with five or more ‘Dons in double-digits this year.

40-MINUTE MAN

John Konchar has played in every minute of a game five times in his career. This season he has done it twice. He played 45 minutes in an overtime effort against Indiana and 40 minutes at Notre Dame.

DIMES FOR DAYS

Mo Evans recorded 11 assists against Austin Peay (Nov. 30) and 10 against Miami (Ohio) (Dec. 3). The last Mastodon to reach 10 or more assists in back-to-back games was Demetrius Johnson who had 10 against both North Dakota State and South Dakota State in 2008.

YOU GET AN ASSIST, AND YOU GET AN ASSIST!

The Mastodons have recorded 24 assists three times in a game this season. First at Austin Peay (Nov. 30), then at Stetson (Dec. 18) and one more time in a home contest vs. Oral Roberts (Dec. 31). They then set an NCAA Division I era program record with 35 assists vs. Olivet (Jan. 9).

POTW X3

Fort Wayne has earned three Summit League Player of the Week honors this season. Mo Evans (Nov. 21), Bryson Scott (Nov. 28) and John Konchar (Dec. 26) have each earned the honor.

KONCHAR ON THE BOARDS

John Konchar’s career rebound average of 8.9 per game ranks 13th among all active NCAA Division I players. His career 62.1 percent field goal percentage is ninth in Division I.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Fort Wayne has attained an overall home record of 112-38 (.741) in Fort Wayne over the past 11 seasons since 2006-07. The Mastodons are 73-25 (.740) in home games played at the Allen County War Memorial Coliseum, and 39-13 (.735) in home games played on campus at the Hilliard Gates Sports Center. Fort Wayne went 12-1 in games in Fort Wayne last season.

FROM ALL OVER

The 2016-17 roster features student-athletes from seven different states as well as Racine Talla who calls Dakar, Senegal home.

THE TEAM 3-POINT STAT

Fort Wayne has made at least one three-point field goal in 411 consecutive games, dating back to a road game at Miami (Ohio) (12/21/03, 0-9). UNLV has the current Division I record at 989 straight games, dating back to Nov. 26, 1986, when the 3-point basket was added to the NCAA game.

Jon Coffman is entering his sixth season at Fort Wayne, and third as head coach of the Mastodons in 2016-17. In 2015-16 he was named the Summit League Coach of the Year.

Coffman has taken the Mastodons to the postseason in each of his first two seasons as head coach. In 2015-16 the 'Dons won the Summit League regular season title and earned berth to the NIT. The 'Dons finished 24-10 and saw Max Landis and John Konchar earn All-Summit League First Team accolades.

In his first season as head coach, Coffman led the Mastodons to the program's second straight postseason basketball appearance, advancing to the CollegeInsider.com post-season tournament before falling to eventual tournament champion Evansville. His team went 16-15 during the season, earning the fourth seed for the 2015 Summit League Tournament.

Coffman spent the previous three seasons as an assistant coach with the Mastodons. The 2013-14 squad ended the season with the eighth-best field goal percentage in NCAA Division I, while ranking 16th in three-point field goal percentage, 20th in total three-point field goals, and 27th in total assists.

Previously he spent two years on staff at Colgate University, where he was an assistant under Emmett Davis who ranks as the all-time winningest coach in school history. At Colgate, Coffman held the top assistant position and oversaw the Raiders' player development, opponent scouting, scheduling and recruiting coordination of Colgate's national recruiting effort. During the two years in Hamilton, N.Y., Coffman helped to coach and recruit two all-rookie league selections, a first team all-league selection and Coffman's fourteenth player to sign a professional contract.

Coffman's coaching career is marked by working with outstanding head coaches that have combined for 1141 wins between them, including two Hall of Fame college coaches whose courts are named in their honor (John Kresse/College of Charleston & Bob Johnson/Emory & Henry College), three coaches that hold their schools' all-time win mark (Emmett Davis/Colgate, John Kresse/College of Charleston & Bob Johnson/Emory & Henry). In addition, he played for Hall of Fame high school coach, Ron Bell, at the Marist School in Atlanta, Ga., who amassed 636 wins and won three State Championships during his high school coaching tenure.

Prior to Colgate, Coffman spent eight seasons on the staff at Stetson University, where he was an assistant under Derek Waugh. Coffman, a high school classmate of Waugh, joined the Stetson staff in 2001 after Waugh was named the youngest Division I coach in the country. Coffman's duties at Stetson included working with the guards, opponent scouting, fund raising, coordinating camps, scheduling and coordinating recruiting. Coffman acted as the recruiting coordinator during his last 5 years at Stetson, and during this period, the Hatters won 33 of their last 44 home games (.750), had their highest conference finish in program history, and set three school records for wins in the Division I era (overall, road and home winning streaks).

While a member of the Stetson University coaching staff, Stetson signed three A-Sun All-Freshman team members, six All-Conference selections, the leading scoring duo in Stetson history (EJ Gordon & Anthony Register), three players that rank in the top 10 all-time scorers in school history (EJ Gordon-1691/Garfield Blair-1583/Anthony Register-1414), 15 All-State players in Florida, Georgia and Alabama, a junior college All-American, the 2009 conference Defensive Player of the Year, the 2003 NCAA steals leader and eight players that have gone on to play professionally. Before leaving Stetson in the summer of 2009, Coffman helped to recruit and lay the groundwork for Stetson to secure the top 2009 & 2010 recruiting classes in the Atlantic Sun Conference according to ESPN.com.

Coffman's tenure also included an upset over the University of Georgia in 2004, which marked the Hatters' first win over an SEC opponent in 21 years. In addition, the 2005-2006 campaign marked one of the greatest single-season turnarounds in NCAA history. While faltering during Stetson's pre-conference season and at one point owning the nations longest losing streak, the Hatters rebounded to win 12 of their last 14 games and actually held the nation's longest winning streak during February.

At Stetson, Coffman started one of the largest team camps in the state of Florida. In addition, he helped to facilitate the largest Elite Camp in the state, which played a significant role in upgrading Stetson's recruiting efforts in Florida.

Prior to Stetson, Coffman coached under John Kresse at the College of Charleston in 2000-01. While on staff, the Cougars recorded a 22-7 record and the Southern Conference regular season title and a 13-0 record at home. During the 2000-01 season, the Cougars were ranked the top mid-major team in the country for a large part of the year and rose as high as 33rd in the country in the AP Poll.

Coffman began his coaching career in 1997 at Emory & Henry College in Emory, Va. as the top assistant under coach Bob Johnson. While at Emory & Henry, Coffman helped to recruit Justin Call, who earned the Jostens Trophy (Division III National Player of the Year Award) while playing for the Wasps.

Coffman graduated from Washington & Lee University in 1996, earning a bachelor's degree in both economics and geology. He was also a three-year starter for the Generals basketball team and captain of the 1995-96 squad. He still holds three school records, including the mark for most three-pointers in a game (7) and free throws made in a game (18).

After graduation, Coffman worked in finance for two years in San Francisco, Calif. before joining the coaching ranks in 1997.

He and his wife, Tracy, have a eight-year old son, Thomas, and five-year old daughter Lucy and reside in Fort Wayne. Tracy has coached softball collegiately for the past 15 years and is currently the head coach at the University of Northwest Ohio.

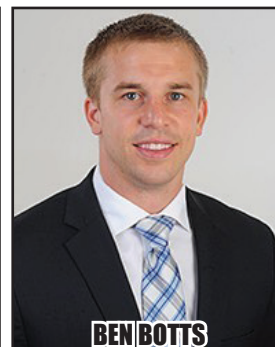

WHY MASTODONS?

It all started about 10,000 years ago ...

That's when mastodons roamed the southern Great Lakes region of North America. These stocky versions of modern elephants reached heights of about ten feet at the shoulder, with tusks that curved upward that were six feet or more in length. Mastodons were browsers who fed mostly on leaves and twigs from small trees and shrubs.

One such mastodon found its final resting place about two miles south of Angola, Indiana, on land that would eventually become part of Orsie Routsong's farm. In the fall of 1968, Routsong decided to expand a small pond on his property. An excavator was hired and instructed to pile the excavated material around the edge of the pond. Several days after the excavation was finished a heavy rain storm pounded the piles of dirt.

The next day, a young neighbor boy of Routsong's discovered a large bone in one of the dirt piles. Routsong knew it was something out of the ordinary, so he called Jack Sunderman, chair of the IPFW Geology Department, to identify the bone, and to ask for advice on what to do with it. Sunderman says his first question was, "How big is the bone," with Routsong's answer being "pretty big, maybe 3 or 4 feet long."

When Sunderman got to the farm, he identified the bone as a leg bone of a mastodon. He told Routsong a skeleton like this would have scientific and instructional value if a large portion of it could be located. Routsong agreed, and also agreed to have the IPFW Geology Department do the excavation. Sunderman got two more faculty members, Geoffrey Matthews and Bernd Erdtmann, and several geology students to help in the project.

After all the mastodon bones were collected, cleaned, and preserved, Routsong agreed to have the adult mastodon

skeleton placed on permanent display at IPFW; the skull of a nearby baby mastodon is now on loan to Science Central.

In the spring of 1970, The Communicator (IPFW's student newspaper) began a drive to come up with a mascot for IPFW. Some of the suggested choices included the Boiler-Hoosiers, Warhawks, Marauders, Frontiersmen, Pioneers, Elfs, and Hobbits. Those names and others came from student suggestions. Steve Pettyjohn, who served as the student body president in 1968-69, wrote a letter to the editor about the school mascot. In his letter, Pettyjohn extolled the virtues of choosing the mastodon as IPFW's mascot: "It sounds different, strange - that's exactly why. It's different and yes, even strange. For God's Sakes, let's have the courage to be a little different."

In the meantime, former Indiana Congressman Mark Souder, who served as student body president in 1969-70, recalls being lobbied by the Geology Club to choose the mastodon.

According to Nusbaumer, "Souder appointed a committee in student government to select a name although he was lobbying hard for the mastodon." After some discussion on the subject, Souder says a vote was taken by the committee and the mastodon came out the winner. Souder finished his recollection with these thoughts. "History shows that the advocacy of the geology club was correct. The fast, decisive action of the elected student government—though it did not please everyone and was not a precedent that the University desired to see—has also been upheld by history as IPFW regularly scores high in any list of unique university nicknames; even in this era when everybody strives to be different. We did it decades ago."

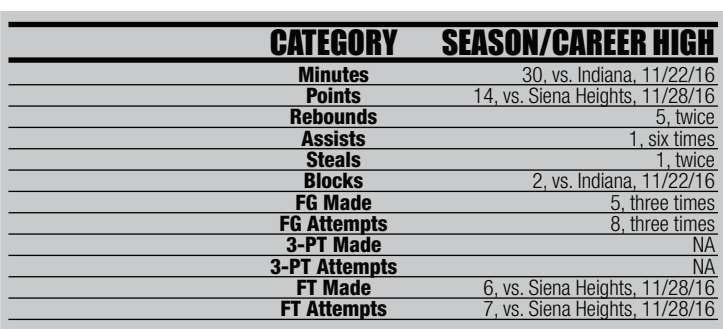
