QUICK HITS

- Over the last three games (since the Feb. 11 game vs. Omaha), John Konchar is shooting 10-of-13 (76.9 percent) from three and 22-of-28 (78.6 percent) overall from the floor.
- 11 Mastodons have played in 20 or more games this season. Denver also has 11 student-athletes who have played in 20 games this year, tying Fort Wayne for the most in the league.
- Of the 570 Summit League minutes the Mastodons have played this year, John Konchar has played in 515 of them. That means Konchar has been on the court for 90.4 percent of conference play.
- John Konchar leads the Summit League in field goal percentage (64.9) and rebounds per game (9.2). Josh Jackson of Kansas is the only other guard in the nation to lead their respective league in both categories.
- Mo Evans ranks third all-time in career assists in program history with 431. He needs three more to pass Randy Spicer's 433 from 1996-00. The all-time leader in assists in Fort Wayne history is Lawrence Jordan (1985-86, 87-90). Jordan recorded 913.

SCOUTING THE JAGUARS

IUPUI (12-16, 6-8 Summit) has won home league games against Western Illinois, South Dakota State and North Dakota State. They are coming off a road win at Denver last week, 83-72. Leading the way for the Jaguars is senior Darell Combs 16.6 points per game. Senior Matt O'Leary leads the Jaguars with an average of 6.3 rebounds per game.

SCOUTING THE MASTODONS

The Mastodons (18-10, 7-7 Summit) are 5-7 on the road this season. John Konchar has recorded six double-doubles in the past eight games.

THE SERIES

IUPUI leads the all-time series 25-14. The Jaguars have won two of the last three meetings. Fort Wayne won 103-73 in Fort Wayne earlier this year. During the game, Konchar led with 19 points, 13 rebounds, and eight assists. The Mastodons led for more than 37 minutes in the contest.

LAST TIME OUT

Bryson Scott and John Konchar led Fort Wayne with 22 points each as the 'Dons fell to South Dakota State 97-89 on Feb. 18.

UP NEXT

Fort Wayne travels to Macomb, Illinois to play Western Illinois on Saturday (Feb. 25) at 8 p.m. EST for their last game of the regular season.

LIFE IN THE SUMMIT

The 'Dons are 7-7 in conference play this year but that doesn't tell the story of how close the competition has been. In each of their league losses, the 'Dons have held a lead in the second half. Play has been tight as Fort Wayne has scored 1,192 points while giving up 1,161 points in league play.

IN NATIONAL RANKINGS...

Fort Wayne ranks fourth in 3-pointers per game (10.8), fifth in total 3-pointers (303), fifth in scoring (87.9), seventh in field goal percentage (49.8 percent), ninth in 3-point field goal percentage (40.8 percent) and 11th in assists per game (17.4).

FIFTH IS BLISS

Mo Evans picked up his 1,000th career point this year. He is the 13th player in program history to reach the plateau. He now owns 1,460 career points and ranks fourth all-time in scoring at Fort Wayne. He recently passed Nick Wise's 1,450 points to take fourth. Next on the all-time scoring list is third place Bruce Roland (1986-89). Roland scored 1,477 career points.

MO IN NATIONAL RANKINGS...

Mo Evans is 10th in the nation in total assists (170), 13th in assists per game (6.1), 14th 3-point field goal percentage (44.8), 21st in made 3-pointers (87) and 21st in 3-point field goals per game (3.11).

SENSATIONAL SENIOR

Senior Brent Calhoun is making his senior year his best. He is averaging 8.6 points, 6.1 rebounds and 1.6 blocks per game. Each are on pace to be career bests.

JOHNNY ON THE SPOT

John Konchar is shooting 64.9 percent on the season, sixth best in the nation. He is 159-of-245 on the season.

3-POINT CHALLENGE

The Mastodons are participating in the Coaches vs. Cancer 3-Point Challenge. The Mastodons are asking fans to make a pledge for each 3-pointer the 'Dons make from February 1 - March 5. Fans can make a donation at: pledgeit.org/cvc-fort-wayne with all proceeds benefiting the American Cancer Society.

KASON. KEEPIN' ON

Kason Harrell is averaging 10.4 points per game this season for the 'Dons after playing only 73 minutes last season. He had 21 points at Austin Peay on Nov. 30. He scored 11 consecutive points late in the game against North Dakota State (Feb. 15) to help clinch the win.

NEARING 20 WINS AGAIN

Fort Wayne needs two wins for their 20th of the season. It would be their third 20-win season in four years. It would also be their second consecutive 20-win season, which would be a first for the program as an NCAA Division I squad. Only once previously in program history, 1988-89 & 1989-90, have the 'Dons won 20 games in consecutive seasons.

BLOCK TIME

Brent Calhoun owns 103 career blocks, fourth most in program history.

Fort Wayne made 20 3-pointers vs. Oral Roberts on Dec. 31. It tied a league record for most 3-pointers in a Summit League contest. The total tied the school record set last season when the 'Dons made 20 in a win at South Dakota on Feb. 4, 2016. Then on Jan. 9 the Mastodons made 21 3-pointers in a win over NCAA Division III Olivet to break the school record.

GRANTS AND BENJAMINS

The 'Dons have scored 50 or more points in a half 13 times this season. They've scored 100 points in a game on seven occasions, the most during the NCAA Division I era for the program. The school record for 100 point games in a single season was the 1989-90 squad, which hit the century mark nine times.

100 FOR COFF

Since Jon Coffman became the Fort Wayne head coach in 2014-15, the 'Dons have scored 100 points in a game 10 times. Only Omaha among Summit League teams have hit 100 more during this time, doing so in 12 games.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

John Konchar has 15 double-doubles this season, the most in the Summit League and 13th most in the nation. Last year he recorded 14 double-doubles as a freshman.

GETTING DIGITS

Fort Wayne has had 13 games with five or more 'Dons in double-digits this year.

40-MINUTE MAN

John Konchar has played in every minute of a game five times in his career. This season he has done it twice. He played 45 minutes in an overtime effort against Indiana and 40 minutes at Notre Dame.

DIMES FOR DAYS

Twice this season Mo Evans has recorded double-digit assists in back-to-back games. Mo Evans recorded 11 assists against Austin Peay (Nov. 30) and 10 against Miami (Ohio) (Dec. 3). Later in the season he recorded 10 assists vs. South Dakota (Feb. 8) and then notched 12 assists vs. Omaha (Feb. 11). Before Evans, the last Mastodon to reach 10 or more assists in back-to-back games was Demetrius Johnson who had 10 against both North Dakota State and South Dakota State in 2008.

YOU GET AN ASSIST, AND YOU GET AN ASSIST!

The Mastodons have recorded 20 or more assists in a game seven times this year. They set an NCAA Division I era program single-game record with 35 assists vs. Olivet (Jan. 9). Their 29 assists against Omaha on Feb. 18 set a school record for a single game against an NCAA Division I opponent.

POTW X4

Fort Wayne has earned four Summit League Player of the Week honors this season. Mo Evans (Nov. 21), Bryson Scott (Nov. 28) and John Konchar (Dec. 26 and Jan. 30) have each earned the honor.

FILLIN' UP THE BOX SCORE

John Konchar recorded 19 points, 13 rebounds, eight assists and five steals on Jan. 25 vs. IUPUI. According to College Basketball Reference, he is the only player in the nation to record such a line or better since College Basketball Reference began tracking single game box scores in 2010. His game helped him win the Summit League Player of the Week honor.

KONCHAR ON THE BOARDS

John Konchar's career rebound average of 9.2 per game ranks 11th among all active NCAA Division I players. His career 61.5 percent field goal percentage is ninth in Division I among active players.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Fort Wayne has attained an overall home record of 115-40 (.742) in Fort Wayne over the past 11 seasons since 2006-07. The Mastodons are 74-27 (.740) in home games played at the Allen County War Memorial Coliseum, and 41-14 (.745) in home games played on campus at the Hilliard Gates Sports Center. Fort Wayne went 12-1 in games in Fort Wayne last season.

THE TEAM 3-POINT STAT

Fort Wayne has made at least one three-point field goal in 416 consecutive games, dating back to a road game at Miami (Ohio) (12/21/03, 0-9). UNLV has

Jon Coffman is entering his sixth season at Fort Wayne, and third as head coach of the Mastodons in 2016-17. In 2015-16 he was named the Summit League Coach of the Year.

Coffman has taken the Mastodons to the postseason in each of his first two seasons as head coach. In 2015-16 the 'Dons won the Summit League regular season title and earned berth to the NIT. The 'Dons finished 24-10 and saw Max Landis and John Konchar earn All-Summit League First Team accolades.

In his first season as head coach, Coffman led the Mastodons to the program's second straight postseason basketball appearance, advancing to the CollegeInsider.com post-season tournament before falling to eventual tournament champion Evansville. His team went 16-15 during the season, earning the fourth seed for the 2015 Summit League Tournament.

Coffman spent the previous three seasons as an assistant coach with the Mastodons. The 2013-14 squad ended the season with the eighth-best field goal percentage in NCAA Division I, while ranking 16th in three-point field goal percentage, 20th in total three-point field goals, and 27th in total assists.

Previously he spent two years on staff at Colgate University, where he was an assistant under Emmett Davis who ranks as the all-time winningest coach in school history. At Colgate, Coffman held the top assistant position and oversaw the Raiders' player development, opponent scouting, scheduling and recruiting coordination of Colgate's national recruiting effort. During the two years in Hamilton, N.Y., Coffman helped to coach and recruit two all-rookie league selections, a first team all-league selection and Coffman's fourteenth player to sign a professional contract.

Coffman's coaching career is marked by working with outstanding head coaches that have combined for 1141 wins between them, including two Hall of Fame college coaches whose courts are named in their honor (John Kresse/College of Charleston & Bob Johnson/Emory & Henry College), three coaches that hold their schools' all-time win mark (Emmett Davis/Colgate, John Kresse/College of Charleston & Bob Johnson/Emory & Henry). In addition, he played for Hall of Fame high school coach, Ron Bell, at the Marist School in Atlanta, Ga., who amassed 636 wins and won three State Championships during his high school coaching tenure.

Prior to Colgate, Coffman spent eight seasons on the staff at Stetson University, where he was an assistant under Derek Waugh. Coffman, a high school classmate of Waugh, joined the Stetson staff in 2001 after Waugh was named the youngest Division I coach in the country. Coffman's duties at Stetson included working with the guards, opponent scouting, fund raising, coordinating camps, scheduling and coordinating recruiting. Coffman acted as the recruiting coordinator during his last 5 years at Stetson, and during this period, the Hatters won 33 of their last 44 home games (.750), had their highest conference finish in program history, and set three school records for wins in the Division I era (overall, road and home winning streaks).

While a member of the Stetson University coaching staff, Stetson signed three A-Sun All-Freshman team members, six All-Conference selections, the leading scoring duo in Stetson history (EJ Gordon & Anthony Register), three players that rank in the top 10 all-time scorers in school history (EJ Gordon-1691/Garfield Blair-1583/Anthony Register-1414), 15 All-State players in Florida, Georgia and Alabama, a junior college All-American, the 2009 conference Defensive Player of the Year, the 2003 NCAA steals leader and eight players that have gone on to play professionally. Before leaving Stetson in the summer of 2009, Coffman helped to recruit and lay the groundwork for Stetson to secure the top 2009 & 2010 recruiting classes in the Atlantic Sun Conference according to ESPN.com.

Coffman's tenure also included an upset over the University of Georgia in 2004, which marked the Hatters' first win over an SEC opponent in 21 years. In addition, the 2005-2006 campaign marked one of the greatest single-season turnarounds in NCAA history. While faltering during Stetson's pre-conference season and at one point owning the nations longest losing streak, the Hatters rebounded to win 12 of their last 14 games and actually held the nation's longest winning streak during February.

At Stetson, Coffman started one of the largest team camps in the state of Florida. In addition, he helped to facilitate the largest Elite Camp in the state, which played a significant role in upgrading Stetson's recruiting efforts in Florida.

Prior to Stetson, Coffman coached under John Kresse at the College of Charleston in 2000-01. While on staff, the Cougars recorded a 22-7 record and the Southern Conference regular season title and a 13-0 record at home. During the 2000-01 season, the Cougars were ranked the top mid-major team in the country for a large part of the year and rose as high as 33rd in the country in the AP Poll.

Coffman began his coaching career in 1997 at Emory & Henry College in Emory, Va. as the top assistant under coach Bob Johnson. While at Emory & Henry, Coffman helped to recruit Justin Call, who earned the Jostens Trophy (Division III National Player of the Year Award) while playing for the Wasps.

Coffman graduated from Washington & Lee University in 1996, earning a bachelor's degree in both economics and geology. He was also a three-year starter for the Generals basketball team and captain of the 1995-96 squad. He still holds three school records, including the mark for most three-pointers in a game (7) and free throws made in a game (18).

After graduation, Coffman worked in finance for two years in San Francisco, Calif. before joining the coaching ranks in 1997.

He and his wife, Tracy, have a eight-year old son, Thomas, and five-year old daughter Lucy and reside in Fort Wayne. Tracy has coached softball collegiately for the past 15 years and is currently the head coach at the University of Northwest Ohio.

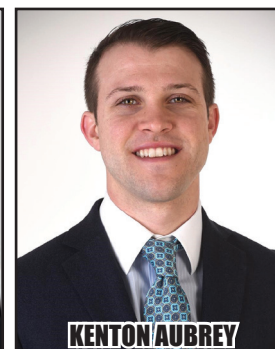

WHY MASTODONS?

It all started about 10,000 years ago ...

That's when mastodons roamed the southern Great Lakes region of North America. These stocky versions of modern elephants reached heights of about ten feet at the shoulder, with tusks that curved upward that were six feet or more in length. Mastodons were browsers who fed mostly on leaves and twigs from small trees and shrubs.

One such mastodon found its final resting place about two miles south of Angola, Indiana, on land that would eventually become part of Orsie Routsong's farm. In the fall of 1968, Routsong decided to expand a small pond on his property. An excavator was hired and instructed to pile the excavated material around the edge of the pond. Several days after the excavation was finished a heavy rain storm pounded the piles of dirt.

The next day, a young neighbor boy of Routsong's discovered a large bone in one of the dirt piles. Routsong knew it was something out of the ordinary, so he called Jack Sunderman, chair of the IPFW Geology Department, to identify the bone, and to ask for advice on what to do with it. Sunderman says his first question was, "How big is the bone," with Routsong's answer being "pretty big, maybe 3 or 4 feet long."

When Sunderman got to the farm, he identified the bone as a leg bone of a mastodon. He told Routsong a skeleton like this would have scientific and instructional value if a large portion of it could be located. Routsong agreed, and also agreed to have the IPFW Geology Department do the excavation. Sunderman got two more faculty members, Geoffrey Matthews and Bernd Erdtmann, and several geology students to help in the project.

After all the mastodon bones were collected, cleaned, and preserved, Routsong agreed to have the adult mastodon

skeleton placed on permanent display at IPFW; the skull of a nearby baby mastodon is now on loan to Science Central.

In the spring of 1970, The Communicator (IPFW's student newspaper) began a drive to come up with a mascot for IPFW. Some of the suggested choices included the Boiler-Hoosiers, Warhawks, Marauders, Frontiersmen, Pioneers, Elfs, and Hobbits. Those names and others came from student suggestions. Steve Pettyjohn, who served as the student body president in 1968-69, wrote a letter to the editor about the school mascot. In his letter, Pettyjohn extolled the virtues of choosing the mastodon as IPFW's mascot: "It sounds different, strange - that's exactly why. It's different and yes, even strange. For God's Sakes, let's have the courage to be a little different."

In the meantime, former Indiana Congressman Mark Souder, who served as student body president in 1969-70, recalls being lobbied by the Geology Club to choose the mastodon.

According to Nusbaumer, "Souder appointed a committee in student government to select a name although he was lobbying hard for the mastodon." After some discussion on the subject, Souder says a vote was taken by the committee and the mastodon came out the winner. Souder finished his recollection with these thoughts. "History shows that the advocacy of the geology club was correct. The fast, decisive action of the elected student government—though it did not please everyone and was not a precedent that the University desired to see—has also been upheld by history as IPFW regularly scores high in any list of unique university nicknames; even in this era when everybody strives to be different. We did it decades ago."

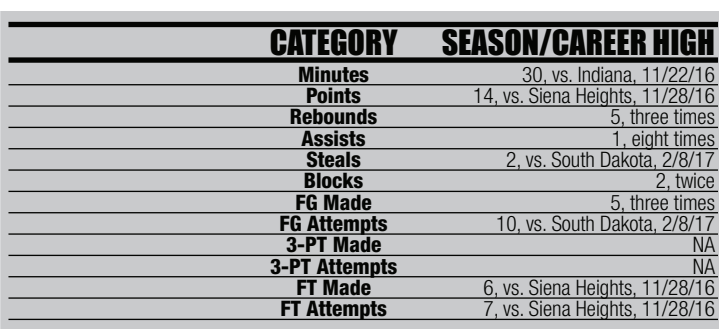
