QUICK HITTERS

- This marks the 45th season of IUPUI basketball and the 19th the Jaguars have competed at the NCAA Division I level. IUPUI enters the season needing just four wins to move to 250 during its D1 era.
- Head Coach Jason Gardner is the eighth head coach in the history of the program and is in his third year at the helm. The former Indiana Mr. Basketball and Arizona-star enters today with an 23-42 career record (15-17 in the Summit).
- IUPUI was picked to finish fifth in The Summit League according to the preseason polls, including one of the 32 first-place votes. The Jags trailed fourth-place Omaha by just 21 points, but easily cleared sixth-place Oral Roberts by 132 points.
- Senior guard **Darell Combs** was voted preseason First Team All-Summit League by the league's coaches after being picked to the league's All-Newcomer Team and Second Team All-League last season. Combs averaged a team-high 16.3 points and made 58 threes last year after sitting the previous season as a transfer. He closed his junior year with back-to-back 30+ scoring games (32 against USD on 2/25 and 31 against Fort Wayne on 2/27), becoming the first IUPUI player to do so since George Hill in January 2008.
- Determined to rebuild the program with Indiana kids, Gardner has stayed true to his word as 13 of the team's 17 players hail from the Hoosier State this season. Five (T.J. Henderson, Anthony Jones, Ron Patterson, Nick Rogers and Kellon Thomas) are from Indianapolis.
- IUPUI will continue to rely heavily on the transfer market this year as the Jags' top two returners (Combs & Matt O'Leary) and transfers and two others (Patterson & K. Thomas) will log heavy minutes. Another (Rogers) will be waiting in the wings after transferring in from Toledo.
- Today's game is the second game of IUPUI's appearance in the 2K Classic. The Jags lost the opener at Michigan and will face Howard and either Eastern Michigan or Gardner-Webb this week.



NEWS, NOTES & STORYLINES

2K CLASSIC

Today's game is the second of four the Jaguars will play as part of this year's 2K Classic. IUPUI will now host the four-team, two-day Indianapolis Subregional, featuring Eastern Michigan, Gardner-Webb and Howard.

Regardless of today's outcomes, IUPUI will play the second game tomorrow at 1:00 p.m. and face either EMU or Gardner-Webb.

IUPUI's participation in the event will conclude at Marquette next Tuesday (Nov. 22).

VERSUS THE BISON

IUPUI faced Howard two years ago and dropped a 57-47 slugfest.

Amazingly, only three players on the current Jaguars' roster appeared in that game.

Aaron Brennan (6 pts, 5 reb, 29) was among the starting five and **Josh James** (4 pts, 6 reb, 13 min) and **D.J. McCall** (5 pts, 22 min) made appearances off the bench.

IUPUI shot just 28.3 percent from the floor in that loss, hitting just 4-of-26 (15.4%) from three.

HOT COMBS

Senior guard **Darell Combs** has stayed hot to open the 2016-17 season, tallying 28 in the opener at Eastern Kentucky and 22 at Michigan. Dating back to last season, Combs is averaging 25.8 points per game in his past four games.

He closed last season on a high note, earning the Summit League's final Player of the Week honor. He had a career night in a loss to South Dakota, pumping in 32 points (11-20 FG, 6-11 3's, 4-4 FT) in 35 minutes against the Coyotes.

In doing so, he became the first IUPUI player to hit for at least 30 points in a game since Donovan Gibbs scored 32 against Judson in January 2014.

Two days after, he tossed in 31 points and a career-high eight assists in the Jaguars' 80-77 upset of Fort Wayne, including hitting 6-of-7 from beyond the arc.

He became the first IUPUI player to net backto-back 30+ scoring games since current NBAer **George Hill** did so in January 2008.

JAGS SIGN TWO

IUPUI inked two during the early signing period, signing 6-foot-8 forward **Brandon Hau (Mukwanago, Wisc./Mukwanago)** and 6-foot guard **Jaylen Minnett (Terre Haute, Ind./Terre Haute South)** to National Letters of Intent.

Hau averaged 16.3 points and 7.5 boards per game as a junior and chose IUPUI over Air Force, Drake, Elon, Iowa, Navy, North Dakota State and South Dakota.

Three players made their IUPUI debuts last Friday night as transfers **Ron Patterson** and **Kellon Thomas** were in the starting lineup and true freshman **Giovanni Fraser** came off the bench.

MICHIGAN TIDBITS

Redshirt sophomore **D.J. McCall** grabbed a career-high seven boards at Michigan on Sunday... two days after being whistled for a Division I record 37 fouls in the season opener, IUPUI was called for just 17 fouls at Michigan on Sunday... IUPUI dropped to 0-3 all-time against Michigan and 2-4 in games played inside Michigan's Crisler Center... IUPUI has used the same starting five in both games so far this season - **Kellon Thomas, Darell Combs** and **Ron Patterson** in the backcourt and **Evan Hall** and **Matt O'Leary** in the frontcourt.

HOME COOKING

IUPUI went 9-2 at home last season at home and hasn't lost a non-conference home game since a 73-64 loss to Eastern Kentucky on Dec. 13, 2014.

EXHIBIT A

IUPUI cruised to an 87-74 win over St. Joseph's College in its lone exhibition game of the season, paced by 14 apiece from **Darell Combs** (2-7 FG, 8-8 FT) and **Ron Patterson** (5-7 FG, 3-4 3's). The Jaguars led by as many as 25 late in the game before yielding a large SJC run to close the game with the reserves on the floor.

Six others finished with eight points each as the starting frontcourt of **Matt O'Leary** and **Evan Hall** combined on 16 points (7-8 FG) and 14 rebounds in just 35 combined minutes.

IUPUI shot 51 percent from the floor and held St. Joseph's to just 31 percent shooting.

The major bugaboo on the scoresheet was the

number of times IUPUI turned it over. The Jags committed 26 miscues leading to 26 St. Joe's points. Every IUPUI player that saw action except **D.J. McCall** (18 minutes) and **Noah Thomas** (5 minutes) had at least one turnover.

Gardner was able to play 15 different players with **Kellon Thomas** (8 pts, 3 ast) playing a team-high 24 minutes as the starting point guard.

YEAR THREE

Year three looks to be a big year for Head Coach Jason Gardner and the IUPUI men's program. Gardner's team finished fourth in The Summit League a year ago and returns a core that includes the top two scorers from a year ago in Darell Combs (16.3 ppg) and Matt O'Leary (10.3 ppg, 6.0 rpg)

Combs was voted Second Team All-Summit League a year ago and was a preseason First Team All-Summit League selection this year. Meanwhile O'Leary, who owns a 3.79 and is majoring in Management, was an Academic All-District 5 selection.

In addition, Gardner's squad welcomes a pair of impact transfers in Kent State-graduate **Kellon Thomas** and Syracuse-transfer **Ron "Buss" Patterson**. Thomas started every game for the Flashes a year ago and led KSU in assists and threes made, while Patterson is a former top-150 recruit before originally committing to Indiana.

FAMILIAR FACES

All total, IUPUI boasts eight guys with at least one season under their belts.

Junior **Aaron Brennan** has played in 60 career games and made 33 starts at IUPUI while **Josh James** returns to the program after a season away from basketball. The 6-foot-9 James has appeared in 52 games and made 13 starts from 2013-15 before taking last year off.

Six others - Combs, O'Leary, **Evan Hall, T.J. Henderson, D.J. McCall** and **Grant Sinn** - have one year of IUPUI experience.

O'Leary started all 32 games last season while Combs started 29 times. Hall made 11 starts and McCall made 15 starts as a true freshman in 2015-16 before redshirting last season.

HOMECOMINGS

IUPUI was an easy choice for a pair of transfers, expected to play major roles this season. Both Ron "Buss" Patterson and Kellon Thomas are Indianapolis-natives and wanted to return to the

Circle City to complete their college careers. In addition, the duo played AAU basketball together alongside Matt O'Leary for Indiana Elite.

Another reason Patterson chose IUPUI was to honor his Broad Ripple High School teammate, the late Steven Jamison, who died of cancer in July 2010 who was committed to play at IUPUI and wore No. 25 (hence why Patterson wears 25). Patterson has a large 'Steven' tattoo across his chest, honoring his deceased friend.

Patterson chose IUPUI over a group that included Kent State, Ball State, Georgia State, Illinois State, Houston and Eastern Michigan. Thomas picked IUPUI over a group that included Purdue, Minnesota, Northwestern, Seton Hall, Ball State, Duquesne, Georgia State, UIC and Jacksonville.

IUPUI was picked fourth or fifth by nearly every major publication this season and was voted fifth in The Summit League's preseason polls. Here's a breakdown of where IUPUI sat in the preseason publications:

SIMPLE MATH

The key to winning games in Head Coach Jason Gardner's first two seasons on the job has been pretty simple - make shots.

Gardner's team is 11-1 (.917) in games in which it's made 50 percent from the floor or better and 21-6 (.778) when shooting a higher percentage than its opponents.

SCOURING THE HOOSIER STATE

The bulk of IUPUI's roster is made up of Indiananatives as 13 of the 17 listed are from the Hoosier State. The only out-of-state players on the Jaguars' roster are Combs and true freshman Elviah Goss (both from Illinois), sophomore Evan Hall (Kentucky) and true freshman Giovanni Fraser (Florida)

Of the 13 from the Hoosier State, five are from Indianapolis and Brennan is from a northern suburb of the city.

Of the current 17 players, Gardner has brought 14 to IUPUI. Only Aaron Brennan, D.J. McCall and **Josh James** were recruited by the previous staff.

Goss, a bouncy 6-foot-7 forward, earned honorable mention All-State honors in Illinois a year ago and finished as Plainfield (III.) East's career leader in rebounds

Fraser, a 6-foot-8 post player, averaged 15 points, 11 rebounds and two blocked shots per game as a senior, earning Third Team All-Broward County honors for 4A-2A schools.

IUPUI's two-man senior class of Marcellus Barksdale and Mason Archie are both considered key losses, particularly at the defensive end.

The 6-foot-5 Barksdale finished his career ranked second all-time in games played (134) and made 95 starts in an IUPUI unform. He was a two-time honorable mention All-Summit League

selection, averaging 8.5 points and 5.1 rebounds per game his final season. He also finished his IUPUI career ranked among the program's top-10 all-time in rebounds, steals and blocked shots.

Archie, a two-year letterwinner, started 44 times in 62 appearances in an IUPUI uniform. He averaged 6.2 points per game and hit 51 treys and was considered the Jags' top perimeter defender last

Both inked professional deals this past summer with Barksdale signing to play with TG s.Oliver Wuerzburg in Germany's Pro B League and Archie signing with Barreteros de Zacatecas in the top league in Mexico (LNBP).

7,054 POINTS

Few coaching staffs can match the production of the IUPUI coaching quartet during their respective playing days. All total, IUPUI's four coaches combined to score 7,054 points in their four-year careers, led by Gardner's 1,984 points at Arizona. Gardner later had his No. 22 jersey retired at Arizona

Scott Gillespie scored 1,871 points in his four years at Ripon (Wisc.) College while Associate Head Coach Matt Crenshaw tallied 938 points in four seasons with the Jaguars.

The newest addition to the IUPUI coaching staff, former Purdue standout Roy Hairston, scored 574 points in two years with the Boilermakers from . 1995-97. He scored 1,687 points in two seasons at Hutchinson (Kan.) Community College, finishing as the program's all-time leading scorer and earning a spot in the NJCAA Hall of Fame.

ANOTHER NEW FACE

IUPUI added another new face to the bench in the offseason as longtime Cathedral High School head coach Andy Fagan joined the Jaguars' staff as a Senior Advisor.

Fagan hired Gardner as an assistant at Cathedral prior to his taking a job on the Loyola staff. Fagan coached the Irish to a state runner-up finish in 2013 and city championships in 2012 and 2013.

He coached a number of Division I players, including Collin Hartman (Indiana), Matt Gregory (Notre Dame) and Mo Evans (Fort Wayne).

HEAD COACH JASON GARDNER



Jason Gardner was named the eighth head coach in IUPUI men's basketball program's history on April 2, 2014. Gardner, the 1999 winner of the Indiana Mr. Basketball Award, spent a year on the University of Memphis bench and two seasons at Loyola prior to that.

In his first season on the Jaguars' bench, he guided IUPUI to 10 wins, more than tripling the program's Division I win total from a year prior. His hiring paid immediate dividends on the recruiting trail, as he immediately inked five Division I transfers, four of whom were former in-state

standouts.

In year two, Gardner led the Jags to a 13-win season against one of the nation's stiffest schedules, including a 9-7 mark in league play and a finish in the top half of the league standings.

Gardner has shown he's a proven recruiter, inking talent, both through high school signees, transfers and graduate transfers.

While at Memphis, Gardner helped the Tigers to a 24-10 record as Shaq Goodwin and Joe Jackson earned All-Conference accolades. In addition, Memphis forward Austin Nichols was a unanimous selection to the American Athletics Conference All-Rookie Team after averaging 9.1 points and 4.2 boards per game. Gardner was a college teammate of current Memphis Head Coach Josh Pastner at Arizona.

Prior to coming to Memphis, Gardner was an assistant under Porter Moser at Loyola, helping the Ramblers to an eight-game improvement from 2011-12 to 2012-13. He coached Ben Averkamp to All-Horizon League accolades for two straight seasons, while Loyola point guard Cully Payne was a Bob Cousy Award nominee. He also helped recruit one of the top signing classes in the Horizon League prior to the 2012-13 season. Gardner's coaching career began in 2010 when he served as an assistant at nearby Cathedral High School.

Gardner's racked up numerous accolades during his prestigious high school, college and professional playing careers. He was a 1999 McDonald's and Parade All-American while at North Central High School, finishing his prep career with a school record 1,669 points. He was a two-time Gatorade Circle of Champions Indiana Player of the Year and was named the 1998-99 Indianapolis County Player of the Year by The Indianapolis Star and Indianapolis News. His senior season, he helped NCHS to the IHSAA 4A state championship and Tournament of Champions title while averaging 22.6 points, 4.7 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 3.0 steals per game.

The 5-foot-10 point guard was recruited to the University of Arizona by legendary Head Coach Lute Olsen, where he was a four-year All-American for the Wildcats. He was the 2002-03 Naismith National Player of the Year and Lowe's Senior CLASS award recipient. He was the 2000 consensus National Freshman of the Year and closed his career as one of four players in Pac-12 history with 1,500 points, 500 assists and 200

steals for a career. He helped lead Arizona to two Pac-12 regular season titles (2000, 2003) and four consecutive NCAA Tournament berths. The Wildcats made three Sweet Sixteens (2001, 2002, 2003), two Elite Eights (2001, 2003) and were the NCAA national runner-up in 2001. All total, Arizona won 107 games during Gardner's four seasons and he still holds school records for games started (135) and minutes played (4,825), while ranking third in school history with 1,984 career points. He also finished second in threes made (318) and fourth in assists (622). He earned his degree from the university in 2011 in disciplinary studies.

Gardner later played professionally overseas for more than eight years, primarily in Germany. In 2009, he was named MVP of German Basketball Bundesliga after helping Oldenburg to the league crown, averaging 13.7 points, 4.0 assists and 3.0 boards per game. He was a two-time Basketball Bundesliga All-Star, including starting the 2007 game.

Gardner is married to the former Jacquelyn Maxberry and the couple has four children, Jasper, Jason Jr., Jacob and Jackson.
