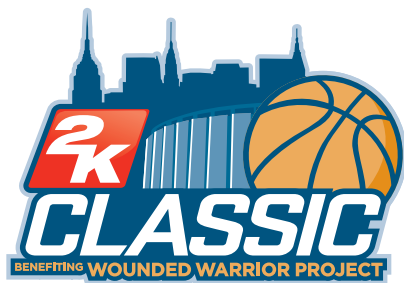




Game 5 | Nov. 22 | Marquette (2-2, 0-0 BIG EAST) vs. IUPUI (2-2, 0-0 Summit)

The Marquette University men's basketball team (2-2, 0-0 BIG EAST) concludes play in the 2K Classic Tuesday night at 6:30 p.m. CT when the squad hosts IUPUI (2-2, 0-0 Summit) at the BMO Harris Bradley Center. FS1 will feature Marquette's third national television broadcast of the season, with Jeff Levering (play-by-play) and Stephen Bardo (analyst) calling the action.



MU Has Claimed Trio Of Meetings With IUPUI

Marquette is 3-0 all-time against IUPUI, with the most recent matchup coming during the 2015-16 campaign.

MU needed overtime to down the Jaguars last season, pulling out a 75-71 victory at home on Nov. 16, 2015 as part of the Legends Classic. Forward Henry Ellenson led the way with 18 points and center Luke Fischer finished with a double-double (17 points, 10 rebounds). Guard Duane Wilson chipped in 16 points and matched a personal best with seven rebounds.

The Golden Eagles posted an 86-50 victory at home on Dec. 14, 2013 thanks in large part to 20 points and 11 rebounds off the bench from Davante Gardner. Five players finished with double figures in points and MU shot 65 percent from the floor as a team.

MU also claimed a 76-68 win on Nov. 10, 2007. Marquette is 24-4 all-time against teams currently in the Summit League, with the most recent matchup coming against Omaha in 2014-15.

Rowsey Provides Scoring Boost At 2K Classic

Entering Marquette's 2K Classic matchup with Pittsburgh last Friday, junior guard Andrew Rowsey had contributed just two points over the course of the team's first three outings.

In 28 minutes off the bench against the Panthers, Rowsey chipped in a team-high 20 points and also had two rebounds and a pair of assists. The Lexington, Va., native knocked down 3-of-7 shots from behind the 3-point line and 7-of-8 from the charity stripe. Only starters Haanif Cheatham and Jajuan Johnson saw more playing time (32 minutes).

Rowsey redshirted in 2015-16 after transferring from UNC Asheville, where he was a two-time all-league honoree. He averaged 19.2 points per game as a sophomore in 2014-15 and finished third in the nation in free throw percentage (.921).

Cheatham Chipping In All-Around Game

Sophomore guard Haanif Cheatham has picked up where he left off last season, when he was voted one of the league's top freshman by the head coaches.

Through games of Nov. 20, he is ranked among the league leaders in six different categories. The Fort Lauderdale, Florida, native is 22nd in scoring (12.3 ppg.), 19th in rebounding (5.0 rpg.), seventh in assists (3.8 apg.), 11th in free throw percentage (.857), fifth in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.8) and sixth in defensive rebounds (4.8 drpg.).

As a result of his solid all-around efforts, Cheatham is tops on the roster in assists and second in both scoring and rebounding.

Marquette Concludes Play In 2K Classic

Marquette is hoping to continue a trend of recent success in regular-season tournaments when the team continues play in the 2016 2K Classic.

MU has claimed five titles since 2004-05 and advanced to the final game in four other events. Two of the wins have come in overtime and at one point the Golden Eagles had claimed 12-straight victories in the annual tournaments.

The Golden Eagles are 32-10 overall since 2004-05 in multi-team events, including championships at the BCA Classic (2005), Great Alaska Shootout (2006), CBE Classic (2007), U.S. Virgin Island Paradise Jam (2011) and Legends Classic (2015).

MU appeared in the championship contest of the EA SPORTS Maui Invitational (2007), Chicago Invitational (2009), Old Spice Classic (2010) and DIRECTV Wooden Legacy (2013).

Golden Eagles Pull Away For Veterans Classic Win

Trailing by one point at the intermission, Marquette took control moments into the second half and was able to pull away for an impressive 95-71 win over Vanderbilt Friday night in the Veterans Classic.

The Golden Eagles knocked down a total of 13 treys, the most since making the same number against Grambling State on Dec. 2, 2015. Six different players (most since Dec. 5, 2015 vs. Maine) drained at least one 3-pointer on Friday, led by three each from freshman Sam Hauser and sophomore Haanif Cheatham.

MU shot 59.0 percent in the second half, but the defense was just as impressive. Vanderbilt turned the ball over 19 times, thanks in part to 13 Marquette steals, and shot just 39.7 percent from the field.

Johnson Collects Tremendous All-Around Performance

Senior guard Jajuan Johnson collected one of his best all-around games as a Golden Eagle in the win over Vanderbilt Friday night in the Veterans Classic.

In just 29 minutes of action, Johnson chipped in 21 points, six steals, four rebounds and three assists. He shot 9-of-13 from the floor, including a 3-of-5 effort from behind the 3-point line. The thefts total matched his career high.

2017 Recruiting Class Adds Size To Front Line

The Golden Eagles announced the addition of three players to the roster for the 2017-18 campaign on Nov. 9, the first day of the early signing period.

The trio, which features three players who measure at least 6-7, includes Jamal Cain (Pontiac, MI/Cornerstone Health & Technology HS), Ike Eke (Detroit, MI/Univ. of Detroit Jesuit HS) and Theo John (Minneapolis, MN/Champlin Park HS).

Cain (6-7, 180), rated as high as 77th in the nation by Rivals.com, has spent each of the last two seasons at Cornerstone Health & Technology in Detroit, Michigan. He has combined to average 24.8 points, 15.5 rebounds, 3.6 assists and 3.0 blocks per game since joining the program and helped the team to a 27-14 overall record.

Eke (6-9, 220) helped University of Detroit Jesuit High School to the state title as a junior under head coach Patrick Donnelly, chipping in 9.8 points, 8.7 rebounds and 2.1 blocks per game while shooting 65.0 percent from the field. The Cubs were the fifth team in state history to finish the season undefeated and the championship was the first in program history.

A three-year letterwinner at Champlin Park High School, John (6-9, 230) has helped the Rebels to a 77-11 record during his tenure and three conference championships. He averaged 14.0 points, 8.6 rebounds and 3.3 blocks per game as a junior and claimed all-conference accolades for the second-straight year.

Marquette Dials Long Distance In Exhibition Win

Seven different players hit at least one 3-pointer in the team's 106-53 victory over Rockhurst in exhibition action Nov. 5 at the BMO Harris Bradley Center.

Six Marquette players finished with double figures in points, led by freshman guard Markus Howard's 17 points. The Golden Eagles shot 59.2 percent (42-of-71) from the field overall and collected 29 assists on the 42 made field goals. Junior guard Andrew Rowsey chipped in 13 points in his Marquette debut and freshman Sam Hauser collected 12 points and six rebounds in 21 minutes off the bench.

Marquette's defense was just as impressive, holding the Hawks to 29.8 percent from the floor and creating 17 turnovers, which turned into 30 points.

Fischer Claims Preseason All-League Accolades

Senior center Luke Fischer was selected to the Preseason All-BIG EAST Second Team at the league's annual media day, the lone Marquette player to earn a spot.

The Germantown, Wisconsin, native finished 19th in the league in scoring (12.1 ppg.) and 14th in rebounding (6.2 rpg.) as a junior and was also third in the conference in field goal percentage (.608). His field goal efficiency was the second-best season mark in program history.

For his career, Fischer has started 56 of the 61 career games in which he has played for Marquette and contributed 11.7 points and 5.6 boards per outing. He spent the first semester of his freshman season at Indiana before transferring to MU.

Marquette Celebrating 100 Years Of Hoops In 2016-17

Marquette, which owns a wealth of tradition and success in men's basketball, will be celebrating its 100th year of basketball all season long in 2016-17.

The three major events scheduled include a 40th celebration of the 1977 national championship (Dec. 9-10), an all-player and staff reunion (Feb. 17-18, 2017) and The Centennial Hoopla dinner at the BMO Harris Bradley Center on June 23, 2017.

Marquette is ranked in the top-50 all-time in overall victories and is top-40 in winning percentage. The program is one of 18 schools to claim an NCAA (1977) and NIT (1970) championship and has made 47 total postseason appearances, a top-10 mark among NCAA Division I programs. Over the years, MU players have earned 29 All-America selections and 57 individuals have been selected in the NBA Draft.

Consistent postseason success has resulted in 31 NCAA tournament trips, 16 visits to the Sweet 16 and a trio of Final Four appearances.

Marquette Making Strides Off The Court

Under Director of Sports Performance Todd Smith, the Golden Eagles have been making tremendous strides in the weight room across-the-board.

While each player on the roster features improvements in multiple measurement areas, highlights include the following individuals. Sophomore guards Haanif Cheatham and Traci Carter were the two most improved players over the course of summer workouts and classmate Sacar Anim claimed the team competition points award. Cheatham posted the top 25-yard dash time (2.93 seconds) and senior Luke Fischer is tops on the roster in bench press (280 pounds) and 185-pound reps (19).

Freshman Sam Hauser has added nearly 10 pounds of muscle (decreased body fat three percent) since arriving on campus in July. All of the individual improvements have led to team increases across-the-board. The average deadlift moved from 290 pounds to 372 pounds and chin-ups went from 13 to 22 reps.

Fischer, Johnson Highlight Group Of Veterans

The Golden Eagles featured one of the youngest rosters in the nation last season, but that isn't the case in 2016-17.

Center Luke Fischer and guard Jajuan Johnson are All-BIG EAST candidates entering their respective senior campaigns and finished among the conference leaders in multiple categories last year. Fischer is the squad's leading returning scorer (12.1 ppg.) and rebounder (6.2 rpg.) and Johnson managed to shoot an impressive 51.0 percent from the floor from his perimeter position.

Junior guard Duane Wilson was an all-league honoree as a freshman and owns a wealth of experience in the rotation. MU's talented sophomore class is led by guard Haanif Cheatham, who was named to the conference's all-rookie roster in 2015-16.

After competing last year with only one senior on the roster, walk-on Michael Mache, Marquette now has seven players who have seen at least 30 games of action.

While the roster lost just one primary rotation player from 2015-16, the coaching staff has its work cut out for it to replace the production of BIG EAST Freshman of the Year Henry Ellenson. The Rice Lake, Wisconsin native chipped in 17.0 points and 9.7 rebounds per game (led MU in both categories) in his lone season before entering the NBA Draft (18th overall selection, Detroit Pistons).

Newcomers Arrive With Playing Experience

The Marquette roster features four newcomers this season, but two of the players already own significant collegiate experience and another is an accomplished international performer.

Junior Andrew Rowsey redshirted in 2015-16 after transferring from UNC Asheville, where he was a two-time all-league honoree. He averaged 19.2 points per game as a sophomore in 2014-15 and finished third in the nation in free throw percentage (.921).

Senior Katin Reinhardt owns stops at UNLV and USC and will have one season with MU as a graduate transfer. He has made two NCAA tournament appearances and chipped in 11.4 points per contest for the Trojans in 2015-16.

Markus Howard arrives on campus in possession of two gold medals, most recently helping the USA Basketball U17 Team to the FIBA World Championship. He averaged 11.9 points per outing for Team USA and shot 48.6 percent from behind the 3-point line.

Freshman Sam Hauser was a consensus nationally ranked prep recruit and the Gatorade Wisconsin Boys Basketball Player of the Year as a senior. He helped Stevens Point Area High School to an undefeated campaign and second-straight state title.

Freshmen Learned On The Job In BIG EAST Play In 2015-16

According to KenPom.com, Marquette featured the eighth-youngest roster in all of collegiate basketball and the third youngest among the top-five RPI leagues in 2015-16.

The experience value is in terms of years of college experience where a player's eligibility class is assumed to determine this. The experience calculation weights the experience of each player on the roster based on minutes played.

In BIG EAST play, MU's first-year players accounted for a league-high 47.3 percent (1726-of-3650) of the team's total minutes. Forward Henry Ellenson led the way with 35.7 minutes per game and Haanif Cheatham (31.9 mpg.) and Traci Carter (23.8 mpg.) combined to collect a majority of the playing time. For the season overall, freshmen accounted for over 45.6 percent of the team's minutes, the 12th-highest percentage in the nation (Stats, Inc.).

While the 2016-17 roster features just one senior (Jajuan Johnson) in his fourth year with the program, the team is significantly more experienced. MU players own a total of 19 letters entering the campaign, one season after collecting just six as a group and having only one walk-on senior (Michael Mache).

Coaching Staff Owns Impressive Playing Credentials

The playing credentials of the Marquette men's basketball staff, and competitive nature of their pickup games in Kasten Gym, are difficult to match and feature multiple examples of All-America recognition and postseason success.

Steve Wojciechowski (Duke), Chris Carrawell (Duke), Brett Nelson (Florida), Travis Diener (Marquette), Justin Gainey (N.C. State), Stan Johnson (Southern Utah) and Jake Presutti (Syracuse) all competed as players at the NCAA Division I level.

Along with a plethora of individual accolades and team accomplishments, the group combined for over 6,000 points, 2,000 assists and 800 steals in nearly 800 career games at the collegiate level.

Marquette Game Notes

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Steve Wojciechowski

Head Coach I Third Season
Duke, 1998

The 2016-17 campaign will mark the third at Marquette University for head coach Steve Wojciechowski, who has enjoyed a wealth of success in collegiate basketball as both a player and a coach.

Wojciechowski (pronounced woe-ju-HOW-skee) was introduced as the program's 17th head coach on April 1, 2014 by Marquette University President Dr. Michael R. Lovell.

From the moment he arrived on campus, Wojciechowski established his "Win Every Day" philosophy as the foundation for the Marquette program. That approach has been extremely successful on the recruiting trail, where the MU staff has been able to assemble a back-to-back nationally ranked recruiting classes in 2015 and 2016.

The Golden Eagles collected a 20-win campaign in 2015-16 under Wojciechowski and advanced to the quarterfinals of the BIG EAST Conference Tournament. The team's on-court success was led by Henry Ellenson, the league's freshman of the year and eventual NBA first-round pick by the Detroit Pistons. Ellenson was the program's first McDonald's All-America honoree in over 30 years and a top-10 rated prospect.

The Golden Eagles claimed their first win under Wojciechowski in the season opener in 2014-15. The 79-63 win over UT Martin at the BMO Harris Bradley Center was his first as a head coach at the NCAA Division I level. The season also produced wins over Georgia Tech, Tennessee and Arizona State.

Wojciechowski, 40, had previously served as an assistant coach at Duke since the 1999-2000 season and was promoted to associate head coach in the summer of 2008. As a player

and coach, he was a part of Duke's winning tradition, serving on the coaching staff for two NCAA tournament champions. During his tenure, the Blue Devils posted an incredible 441-92 record and competed in the NCAA tournament every year.

Wojciechowski also served as court coach and scout for the USA Basketball Men's National Team. He helped lead on-court duties as well as game preparation from 2006-12, including the program's gold-medal performance at the 2008 Beijing Olympics and 2012 London Olympics. The Olympic teams included NBA greats such as Marquette alumnus Dwyane Wade, Kobe Bryant and LeBron James.

Earning national titles

In 2001, in his second year as an assistant at Duke, Wojciechowski and the Blue Devils won the national championship. The team also captured the Atlantic Coast Conference regular season and tournament crowns and posted a 35-4 record.

Wojciechowski saw one of his former teammates and pupils, Shane Battier, earn the consensus National Player of the Year award in 2001 as well as National Defensive Player of the Year for the third consecutive season.

Wojciechowski achieved repeated success at the highest level with an NCAA title in the

2009-10 season as associate head coach. On the road to the championship, the Blue Devils also won the ACC Tournament, the ACC Regular Season and NIT Season Tip-Off titles. Defense and rebounding were key for the Blue Devils who had one of the nation's top defenses, holding opponents to 61.0 points per game, and ranked 14th out of 334 teams in rebounding margin.

As a player, Wojciechowski was named the top defensive player in the country his senior year, a two-time All-ACC choice and honorable mention Associated Press All-America. He appeared in 128 career games for the Blue Devils and earned 88 starting assignments.

Wojciechowski is a native of Severna Park, Md., and a first-generation college student, having earned a bachelor's degree in sociology from Duke in 1998.

He and his wife Lindsay have two sons, Jack and Charlie.

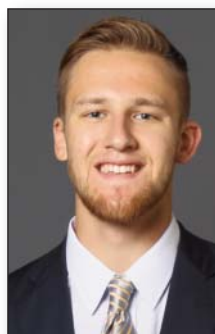
