- ORU leads the all-time series with IUPUI 27-12 and the Golden Eagles have won 10 in a row in the series. ORU is 13-3 all-time in the Mabee Center against the Jaguars. Seven of the 39 contests have gone to overtime, including a 20T and a 30T game, both during the 2003-04 season.
- ORU has faced one of the toughest schedules in the nation to start 2016-17. Eight of its nonconference opponents played in the 2016 postseason, including five NCAA Tournament teams. ORU's nonconference strength of schedule is currently 5th according to the NCAA RPI and the overall SOS is currently 30.
- Albert Owens has been virtually unstoppable in Summit League play averaging 20.8 points and 7.0 rebounds per game over the first four games. He has topped the 20 point mark in three of the four contests, including a career high 26 points against Fort Wayne.


TULSA, Okla. – The Oral Roberts men's basketball team went 11-12 from the free throw line in the final 1:26 of the game to earn a 94-88 victory over South Dakota State Thursday night at the Mabee Center. A tie game at 83-83 with less than two minutes to go, ORU out-scored SDSU 11-2 until a desperation 3-pointer with three seconds remaining once the Golden Eagles had the game in hand.

ORU had a pair of 20-point scorers in Albert Owens (24 points) and Kris Martin (20 points). The duo combined to go 15-25 from the field and 11-11 from the free throw line. All five ORU starters finished the game in double figures for the first time since doing so against Tabor November 25, 2015. The Golden Eagles out-rebounded SDSU 33-32 with 12 offensive rebounds. Aaron Anderson had seven assists, Jalen Bradley added six assists and Martin had five helpers as the Golden Eagles had a season high 23 assists.

Mike Daum led SDSU with 32 points on a 14-25 shooting effort, while the Jackrabbits had four players in double figures.

It was important to come back after a tough road stretch and protect our home court, especially with what we have coming up. South Dakota State: Daum led the scoring with 32 points while Chris Howell had a team-high seven boards for the Jackrabbits. Howell and Michael Orris each had five assists.

Inside the Box Score

- ORU shot 50 percent (32-64) from the field but just 32 percent (7-22) from 3-point range. The Golden Eagles connected on 96 percent (23-24) from the free throw line.
- SDSU shot 64 percent in the first half but cooled in the second to shoot 52 percent (34-65) for the game and 38 percent (12-32). The Jackrabbits hit 66 percent (8-12) from the free throw line.
- ORU held a 33-32 advantage in rebounds and a 14-13 edge in second chance points.
- The Golden Eagles led for 28:23 of the game including 19 minutes in the second half.

News and Notes

- ORU scored 50 points in the first half to take a 50-49 lead into the locker room. It was ORU's first 50 point first half since dropping 53 against Tabor November 25, 2015.
- The Golden Eagles are now 5-0 this season when leading at halftime.

Home Sweet Home

Since the start of the 2004-05 season, ORU is 129-30 (.811) at home and an amazing 87-16 (.844) in conference play in that time. During that stretch, the Golden Eagles have at least 10 wins in eight of the 11 years, including a 15-0 regular season mark in 2011-12.

Founded in 1963 by evangelist Oral Roberts, ORU is a 400-acre campus located in South Tulsa. ORU boasts a total enrollment of over 5,000 students from all 50 states and more than 30 foreign countries.
