Quick Hits

- A 6-point loss earlier in the season snapped ORU's 10-game winning streak in the series against IUPUI. ORU still owns a 27-13 record all-time against the jaguars and is 9-7 on the road. In the first meeting on January 14, Martin led a cast of four Golden Eagles in double figures with 25 points.
- Albert Owens** has been virtually unstoppable in Summit League play averaging 20.1 points and 5.8 rebounds per game in Summit League games. He has topped the 20 point mark eight times, including back-to-back career high 28-point performances against Omaha and North Dakota State.
- Last season, ORU had just one player (Obi Emegano) average in double figures scoring. This season, ORU has three above that mark; **Albert Owens** 17.0 ppg, **Jalen Bradley** 14.1 ppg and **Kris Martin** 14.0 ppg. All three have upped their scoring in league play; Owens 20.1 ppg, Bradley 14.5 ppg and Martin 14.3 ppg.
- Five times this season ORU has held an opponent to less than 30 points in a half; 21 (2nd) at Creighton, 21 (1st) and 27 (2nd) vs. Little Rock, 23 (1st) at South Dakota State and 29 (1st) vs. Western Illinois.

TULSA, Okla. – The Oral Roberts men's basketball team mounted a 13-1 run to get within a point with six seconds to go, but Western Illinois hit a pair of free throws and a long 3-pointer at the buzzer was off the mark as the Leathernecks held on to beat ORU 63-60 Wednesday night at the Mabee Center.

Aaron Anderson, Albert Owens and Kris Martin all scored 14 points to lead the offensive attack for ORU. Anderson also led the rebounding effort with nine boards, while Jalen Bradley dished out a team-high four assists.

Garret Covington finished with 20 points to lead the Leathernecks, while Jeremiah Usiosefe tallied a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds.

Quote of the Game

"Our defense finally stepped up and played decent and allowed us to stay in the game while we couldn't get anything going offensively. It just didn't seem like we had the energy until five and a half minutes left and the guys started playing desperate. I've pleaded with the guys that that is how we've had to play the last five or six games. We did it the last five or six minutes and gave ourselves a chance but dug ourselves too big of a hole." – Head Coach Scott Sutton

Turning Point

ORU used an 11-0 run to make it a two point game, and after a WIU free throw a wild sequence of events ended in a jumper from Bradley to make it a one point game with a few seconds to go. Usiosefe hit two free throws with less than a second to play and ORU was left with a desperation heave that would not fall.

Oral Roberts: Anderson, Martin and Owens each scored 14 points for ORU, while Anderson grabbed a team-high nine rebounds.

Western Illinois: Covington scored 20 points while Usiosefe had 10 rebounds.

Inside the Box Score

- ORU shot just 35 percent (23-65) from the field and 27 percent (7-26) from 3-point range. The Golden Eagles were 7-10 from the free throw line.

- WIU hit 44 percent (24-55) from the field and 32 percent (7-22) from 3-point range. The Leathernecks hit 8-12 from the free throw line.

- The Leathernecks out-rebounded ORU 42-37, although ORU held a 10-6 advantage in second chance points.

News and Notes

- After posting at least one 20-point scorer in 11 straight games, ORU has now gone two straight without a player reaching 20 points.

- The 63 points give up to Western Illinois were the fewest since only allowing 48 to Little Rock December 19.

- ORU gave up just 29 points in the first half, the fifth half this season in which ORU has held a team below 30 points, but the second game in a row after giving up 23 in the first half to South Dakota State.

- The three point loss was the narrowest final margin since falling by one to No. 10 Creighton December 17.

Founded in 1963 by evangelist Oral Roberts, ORU is a 400-acre campus located in South Tulsa. ORU boasts a total enrollment of over 5,000 students from all 50 states and more than 30 foreign countries. Some famous ORU alums include entertainer Kathy Lee Gifford, Pulitzer-prize nominated author Clifton Taulbert and two-time NCAA track & field national champion and 2008 Olympic silver medalist Andretti Bain, 2012 NCAA outdoor national champion Jack Whitt and 2012 Olympians Prince Mumba (Track) and Dominique Allen (Women's Basketball).
