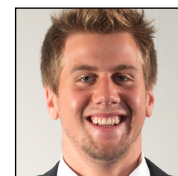
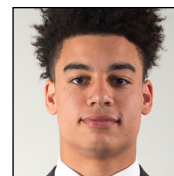
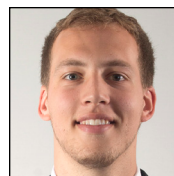

QUICK HITTERS

- IUPUI became the first No. 7 seed to pull a first round upset in The Summit League Tournament since 2009 with a decisive 76-57 win over North Dakota State on Saturday night.
- Senior **Matt O'Leary** was recently voted 3rd Team CoSIDA Academic All-America, becoming the first in program history to earn the award. O'Leary maintains a 3.81 GPA while studying in the prestigious Kelley School of Business.
- Seniors **Darel Combs** and **Matt O'Leary** collected postseason honors, both being voted honorable mention All-Summit League. Combs finished the regular season ranked eighth in the league in scoring and tenth in assists. O'Leary ranked among the league leaders in eight different categories, including scoring, rebounding and assists.
- IUPUI had five different players score 20 points or more since the start of Summit League play. That group includes **Darel Combs**, **Kellon Thomas**, **Matt O'Leary**, **D.J. McCall** and **Evan Hall**. Two others - **Aaron Brennan** and **Ron Patterson** - have each had games of at least 18 points in league play.
- IUPUI capped the non-conference slate at 6-8 overall - the six wins were the most in non-conference play since the 2011-12 squad went 7-7 to start the year. That team closed the non-conference schedule with four straight wins including over Western Kentucky, Ball State and Valparaiso.
- Before Christmas, IUPUI posted back-to-back 100-point games for the first time since January 1995. They are the first 100-point games in Head Coach **Jason Gardner**'s three years with the program.
- IUPUI won the Indianapolis Subregional of the 2K Classic, capturing home wins over Howard (77-55) and Eastern Michigan (83-71). Junior **Ron Patterson** was named Subregional MVP (16.0 ppg, 9-of-17 3's).
- This marks the 45th season of IUPUI basketball and the 19th the Jaguars have competed at the NCAA Division I level. IUPUI won the program's 250th game at the D1 level against Urbana on Dec. 12.
- Head Coach **Jason Gardner** is the 8th head coach in program history and is in his 3rd year at the helm. The former Indiana Mr. Basketball and Arizona-star enters today with an 36-57 career record (22-26 in the Summit).
- Determined to rebuild the program with Indiana kids, Gardner has stayed true to his word as 13 of the team's 17 players hail from the Hoosier State. Five (**T.J. Henderson**, **Anthony Jones**, **Ron Patterson**, **Nick Rogers** and **Kellon Thomas**) are from Indianapolis.
- IUPUI will continue to rely heavily on the transfer market this year as the team's top four scorers (Combs, Patterson, K. Thomas & **Matt O'Leary**) came to IUPUI via transfer.

Three Jags recently surpassed the 1,000 point mark for their collegiate careers, including **Darell Combs**, who became the 23rd member of IUPUI's 1,000 Point Club.

DO THE SPLITS

IUPUI closed the Summit League schedule having split the regular season series with seven of eight foes. The only team to sweep the Jaguars this season was league champion South Dakota.

BUILDING UP

For the third straight year since taking over, Head Coach **Jason Gardner** has increased his single-season win total. After taking over a program that had won 12 games in the two years combined prior, Gardner won 10 games in his first year and upped that to 13 last season. With Saturday's victory, he and the Jags have 14 this season.

LOOK NO FURTHER

The one statistical category that is the easiest tell for IUPUI outcomes is shooting percentage. IUPUI is 13-2 this year and 6-0 in Summit League play when outshooting the opposition. On the flip side, the Jags are 1-15 and 1-9 in Summit League play when being outshot from the field.

Under Gardner, IUPUI is 34-7 when outshooting its opponent and just 3-50 when being outshot.

NEW FIVE

Out of necessity, Head Coach **Jason Gardner** altered his starting five prior to the Feb. 1 North Dakota State game and has gone 5-3 since then. Junior **Aaron Brennan** replaced the injured **Evan Hall** and has averaged 11 points in his seven starts.

Seniors **Darell Combs**, **Matt O'Leary** and **Kellon Thomas** are the lone Jags to have started every game this season as Gardner has utilized just three different starting units all season.

TOP-30 NATIONALLY

IUPUI is 23rd nationally in three-point percentage (39.5%) and 38th in threes made (9.1/game). The Jaguars 282 treys are a new school record, eclipsing the mark of 246, set in 2007-08.

The Jaguars' current 39.3% clip is on pace to be the program's best since 2007-08 when IUPUI shot 42.3% from deep as a team.

40+

IUPUI has four regulars all hitting better than 40 percent from deep - **Aaron Brennan** (26 3's, 46.4%), **Matt O'Leary** (67 3's, 45.6%), **T.J. Henderson** (30 3's, 42.3%) and **Ron Patterson** (62 3's, 41.1%).

50-50-50 CLUB

The trio of **Darell Combs** (60), **Matt O'Leary** (67) and **Ron Patterson** (62) have all made at least 50 treys this season. It marks the first time in school history IUPUI has had three players make 50 treys in a season.

In 2007-08, IUPUI had three players make at least 40 treys that year as Gary Patterson (93), Austin Montgomery (72) and George Hill (49) all hit that mark.

THOMAS ON THE LINE

Senior **Kellon Thomas** capped the regular season ranked 11th in the country and tops in the Summit in free throw shooting at 90.4%.

He had a streak of 33 consecutive makes snapped at South Dakota earlier this season.

The Indianapolis-native enters tonight chasing the school record mark of 91.4%, set by Gary Patterson in 2007-08. Only two players, Patterson and Nick David, have single-season marks of 90 percent or better.

COMBS AT THE HORN

Senior **Darell Combs** capped an 18-point performance against SDSU by knocking in the game-winner with 1.5 seconds left in overtime. The Chicago-native hit a pull-up 18-footer from the right wing to send the Jaguars to an 85-83 win.

Ironically, Combs had two other 'buzzer beaters' during the game, hitting a 25-footer from the right wing at the end of the first half and then hit a 30-footer from the top of the key as the shot clock was expiring with 3:25 to play.

FOUR GAME-WINNERS

Combs became the fourth Jaguar to connect for a game-winner since Gardner's hire three years ago. Here are the others:

IN LEAGUE PLAY...

...IUPUI had five different players score 20 or more in a game; **Darell Combs**, **Matt O'Leary**, **Kellon Thomas**, **D.J. McCall** and **Evan Hall** all hit for 20-or-more in a Summit League game. Two others were close as **Ron Patterson** had a 19-point game and **Aaron Brennan** had an 18-point game.

SUMMIT LEAGUE OPENERS

Following the win over Western Illinois, Head Coach **Jason Gardner** is now 3-0 in Summit League openers. He previously won at Fort Wayne (63-58) on Jan. 4, 2014 and at South Dakota (77-66) last season.

INSIDE THE COLISEUM

IUPUI is 17-6 (.739) at home the past two seasons and 22-14 (.611) since Gardner took over the program.

10 TREYS

IUPUI has made at least 10 threes in a game 13 times this season, seven of which occurred in league play.

HOT AT HOME

IUPUI shot 43.1% from three-point range at home this season and averaged 9.9 makes per game.

COMBS NOTES (@KidRe11)

NEWS, NOTES & STORYLINES (CONT.)

-Senior **Darell Combs** leads the Jags in scoring (16.6 ppg) and was voted honorable mention All-Summit this season. He was a 2nd Team selection last season.

-The Chicago-native has scored in double-digits 52 times in 62 career games and 26 of 31 this season. He's hit for 20-or-more nine times this season and 18 times in his career.

-He became the 23rd member of IUPUI's 1,000 Point Club on Feb. 25 against South Dakota and is currently 22nd on the program's all-time scoring list.

-Combs scored his 1,000th collegiate point in a 23-point effort in the win over Marian on Dec. 28.

Including his 271 points scored at Eastern Michigan, Combs has 1,280 career points (1,009 at IUPUI) entering tonight's game.

-Combs hit his 100th career three against Denver on Jan. 21. He handed out his 100th career assist in the loss at Illinois.

-Combs capped his junior year with back-to-back 30+ scoring games, becoming the first IUPUI player to do so since **George Hill** achieved the feat in 2008.

O'LEARY NOTES (@OLeary_15)

-Senior **Matt O'Leary** had a streak of 19 straight games in double-digits snapped with a 9-point, 9-rebound effort against Denver on Jan. 21. He's scored in double-digits in 26 of 31 games this season.

-Owning a 3.61 GPA, O'Leary became the program's first-ever CoSIDA Academic All-American in 2017, collecting third team plaudits.

-Tallied his 1,000th collegiate point on Feb. 25 against South Dakota. He has 1,011 collegiate points - 245 in his two years at Loyola and 766 at IUPUI.

-O'Leary ranks among The Summit League leaders in eight different categories: field goal percentage, defensive rebounding, three-point percentage, rebounding, blocked shots, assists, three-point field goals and scoring.

-After scoring just 20-or-more once last season, O'Leary has done it seven times this year, including a career-high 25 at Illinois.

-O'Leary led the Jags in scoring just three times last season, but has done so seven times this year.

-O'Leary has started all 62 games of his IUPUI career.

-Achieved a 4.0 GPA during the fall semester. He was voted Academic All-District for the second straight year this year.

K. THOMAS NOTES (@KellonCash5)

-Thomas averaged 11.6 points per game in Summit League play and had 39 assists against just 18 turnovers.

-After scoring in double-digits just four times in non-conference play, he hit for dubs in 10 Summit League games.

-Has 1,034 points in his collegiate career - 738 at Kent State and 296 this season. He scored his 1,000th collegiate point at Denver on Feb. 19.

PATTERSON NOTES (@Buss34)

-Not known as a three-point threat upon transferring from Syracuse, junior **Ron Patterson** has been lethal from deep this season. The Indianapolis-native made just 15-of-71 (21.1 percent) attempts in his two years with the Orange, but is 62-of-151 (41.1 percent) this year.

-Patterson has hit at least three threes 11 times, including a career-high five on two different occasions.

-Patterson leads the Jaguars with 42 steals and is second on the squad with 62 threes made.

-His stat line in a 15-point effort at Marquette earlier this season was three 3's and three dunks.

SMARTY CATS

The Jaguars posted an all-time best semester GPA of 3.09 during the fall. All total, 13 Jaguars posted a GPA of 3.0 or above, led by **Matt O'Leary's** 4.0 mark.

MAJOR CONFERENCE FOES

IUPUI finished this season 0-4 against major conference foes with losses coming at Michigan, Marquette, Illinois and Northwestern. The Jags dropped those four games by an average margin of 16.8 points per game - the slimmest margin being an eight-point loss at Illinois.

CENTURY MARKS

Just before Christmas, the IUPUI offense exploded, scoring 100-or-more points in back-to-back games for the first time since January 1995. The 100 points games in the wins over Urbana and Southern Utah are the first 100-point games since Gardner took over three seasons ago and was the first 100-point game since scoring 112 against Judson on Jan. 2, 2014.

During that span, IUPUI hit 75-of-121 (62 percent) from the floor and 30-of-57 (52.6 percent) from beyond the arc. In addition, the Jags had 49 assists on 75 buckets.

SHOOTING 50

IUPUI is 17-1 (.944) when shooting 50 percent or better under Gardner and 34-7 (.829) when outshooting foes.

DOWN 21

IUPUI was down 21 (59-38) with 14 minutes left at Miami before coming all the way back to tie the game in the final minute. Senior **Kellon Thomas** tied the score with a three with 29 seconds left before Miami scored the game's final three points to get the win.

UPSET BID THWARTED

IUPUI just missed picking off Illinois on Dec. 6 before falling in Champaign, 85-77. IUPUI led for nearly half the game and was tied in the final minutes before fading late.

Senior **Matt O'Leary** led three Jags in double-digits with a career-high 25 points and **Darell Combs** added 18. Illinois needed a 32-point effort from All-Big Ten performer Malcolm Hill to stave off the Jaguars.

2K CLASSIC

IUPUI capped the four-game 2K Classic with a 2-2 record, losing road games at Michigan and Marquette and winning the Indianapolis Subregional of the event. IUPUI captured home wins over Howard (77-55) and Eastern Michigan (83-71). **Ron Patterson** was named Subregional MVP after averaging 16 points and making 9-of-17 threes.

He was joined on the All-Tournament Team by senior forward **Matt O'Leary**, who averaged 10.5 points, 9.5 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.5 steals over two games.

JAGS GET DEFENSIVE

The most important stat in the Jags' wins over Howard and Eastern Michigan was how stingy the Jaguars' defense was - specifically on the perimeter. Howard and Eastern Michigan combined to hit just 36.3 percent from the field and 3-of-26 (11.5 percent) from three-point range.

Howard was 0-for-9 from three on Friday, marking the first time in IUPUI's Division I era (1998-present) that a foe hasn't hit at least one trey.

NON-CONFERENCE HOME COOKING

IUPUI went 9-2 at home last season at home and hasn't lost a non-conference home game since a 73-64 loss to Eastern Kentucky on Dec. 13, 2014.

FAMILIAR FACES

All total, IUPUI entered the season with eight guys with at least one season under their belts.

Junior **Aaron Brennan** entered the year having played in 60 career games and made 33 starts at IUPUI while **Josh James** returned to the program after a season away from basketball. The 6-foot-9 James appeared in 52 games and made 13 starts from 2013-15 before taking last year off.

Six others - Combs, O'Leary, **Evan Hall**, **T.J. Henderson**, **D.J. McCall** and **Grant Sinn** - have one year of IUPUI experience.

O'Leary started all 32 games last season while Combs started 29 times. Hall made 11 starts and McCall made 15 starts as a true freshman in 2015-16 before redshirting last season.

HOMEcomings

IUPUI was an easy choice for a pair of transfers, expected to play major roles this season. Both **Ron "Buss" Patterson** and **Kellon Thomas** are Indianapolis-natives and wanted to return to the Circle City to complete their college careers.

In addition, the duo played AAU basketball together alongside **Matt O'Leary** for Indiana Elite.

Another reason Patterson chose IUPUI was to honor his Broad Ripple High School teammate, the late **Steven Jamison**, who died of cancer in July 2010 who was committed to play at IUPUI and wore No. 25 (hence why Patterson wears 25). Patterson has a large "Steven" tattoo across his chest, honoring his deceased friend.

Patterson chose IUPUI over a group that included Kent State, Ball State, Georgia State, Illinois State, Houston and Eastern Michigan. Thomas picked IUPUI over a group that included Purdue, Minnesota, Northwestern, Seton Hall, Ball State, Duquesne, Georgia State, UIC and Jacksonville.

PRESEASON PICKS

IUPUI was picked fourth or fifth by nearly every major publication this season and was voted fifth in The Summit League's preseason polls. Here's a breakdown of where IUPUI sat in the preseason publications:

SCOURING THE HOOSIER STATE

The bulk of IUPUI's roster is made up of Indiana natives as 13 of the 17 listed are from the Hoosier State. The only out-of-state players on the Jaguars' roster are Combs and true freshman **Elyjah Goss** (both from Illinois), sophomore **Evan Hall** (Kentucky) and true freshman **Giovanni Fraser** (Florida).

Of the 13 from the Hoosier State, five are from Indianapolis and Brennan is from a northern suburb of the city.

Of the current 17 players, Gardner has brought 14 to IUPUI. Only **Aaron Brennan**, **D.J. McCall** and **Josh James** were recruited by the previous staff.

TRUE NEWBIES

IUPUI's collection of freshmen this season consists of signees **Anthony Jones**, **Elyjah Goss** and **Giovanni Fraser** and non-scholarship additions **Evan Borgman** and **Chad Hudson**.

Jones, a 6-foot-5 swingman, attended FCI Prep in Sebring, Fla., last season where he averaged better than 20 points, five boards and four assists per game.

Goss, a bouncy 6-foot-7 forward, earned honorable mention All-State honors in Illinois a year ago and finished as Plainfield (Ill.) East's career leader in rebounds.

Fraser, a 6-foot-8 post player, averaged 15 points, 11 rebounds and two blocked shots per game as a senior, earning Third Team All-Broward County honors for 4A-2A schools.

Borgman, a skilled 6-foot-9 forward, averaged better than 18 points, eight rebounds and three blocked shots per game at Jac-Cen-Del High School.

Hudson, a 5-foot-11 guard, posted 11 points, four assists and 1.5 steals per game at Don Bosco Prep after a four-year career at Jeffersonville High School.

SEEING RED

True freshmen **Evan Borgman**, **Elyjah Goss** and **Anthony Jones** are expected to redshirt the season, leaving Gardner with 13 players at his disposal when the team is fully healthy.

MEDIA DEALS

Virtually every IUPUI game will be heard on 97.5 FM Fox Sports Radio and 1260 WNDE in Central Indiana this year. Morgan Adcock (xpx) returns to the mic as the Voice of the Jaguars again this season.

In addition, every IUPUI home game will be broadcast on ESPN3 as Greg Rakestraw (xpx) and Hall of Famer Bob Lovell (analyst) will be the primary tandem on the call.

7,054 POINTS

Few coaching staffs can match the production of the IUPUI coaching quartet during their respective playing days. All total, IUPUI's four coaches combined to score 7,054 points in their four-year careers, led by Gardner's 1,984 points at Arizona. Gardner later had his No. 22 jersey retired at Arizona.

Scott Gillespie scored 1,871 points in his four years at Ripon (Wisc.) College while Associate Head Coach Matt Crenshaw tallied 938 points in four seasons with the Jaguars.

The newest addition to the IUPUI coaching staff, former Purdue standout Roy Hairston, scored 574 points in two years with the Boilermakers from 1995-97. He scored 1,687 points in two seasons at Hutchinson (Kan.) Community College, finishing as the program's all-time leading scorer and earning a spot in the NJCAA Hall of Fame.

AB ON DUBS

Junior **Aaron Brennan** picked an opportune time to notch his first career double-double, finishing with 18 points and a career-high 11 rebounds against North Dakota State on Saturday night.

Brennan came in averaging just 3.2 rebounds per game, but grabbed 11 defensive caroms, helping IUPUI outrebound the Bison 37-30. IUPUI had been outrebounded in the previous five games by an average of 5.4 rebounds per contest before cleaning up on Saturday.

Brennan's 18 points also matched his career-high as he hit 6-of-12 field goals and 4-of-5 foul shots. He set the tone early, hitting back-to-back threes to give the Jaguars a quick 13-7 lead in the opening five minutes.

Brennan's 11 defensive boards tied for the most by an IUPUI player in The Summit League Tournament, matching the 11 grabbed by **Matt O'Leary** against NDSU last season.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE NOTES

Brennan's double-double was just the fifth by an IUPUI player this year as both **Evan Hall** and **Matt O'Leary** had two each.

STREAKS SNAPPED

Saturday's win snapped the Jaguars' six-game Summit League Tournament losing streak, which dated back to the semifinals round of the 2010 event.

IUPUI had since lost five consecutive quarterfinals matchups before Saturday's victory.

MARGINS

IUPUI's 19-point winning margin (76-57) exceeded their winning margin in any of their seven Summit League regular season wins. The Jags defeated Western Illinois 89-71 to open league play, but then had just two other double-digit wins in league play.

BOMBS AWAY

IUPUI'S 25 three-point attempts on Saturday were the most-ever by an IUPUI squad in a Summit League Tournament game. The Jags connected on 9-of-25 attempts with six different Jags putting in at least one make.

COMBS DEBUTS

After missing last year's Summit League Tournament loss to North Dakota State, senior **Darell Combs** had a solid debut in this year's tournament, finishing with 11 points, three assists and two steals in 31 minutes of work. Combs fired the final dagger at the Bison, sinking a corner three with under two minutes to play to finally bury NDSU.

Combs missed last year's quarterfinals round game due to a violation of team rules.

7UP

It's been a rarity that No. 7 seeds have advanced in The Summit League Tournament. In fact, IUPUI's win was the first by a No. 7 seed since 2009 when South Dakota State tipped No. 2 Oral Roberts in overtime.

Prior to that, No. 7 seeds had won in 2005 and 1993.

No. 7 Oakland WON the 2005 event in Tulsa and was the third time a No. 7 seeded team advanced to the league championship game.

No. 7 Cleveland State lost the inaugural tournament to No. 5 Western Illinois in 1984 and No. 7 UIC fell to No. 1 Missouri State in the 1989 tournament.

SIoux BLUES

Sioux Falls is the lone Summit League Tournament site that IUPUI has an all-time losing record, going 4-8 in South Dakota's largest city. IUPUI went 3-2 in Fort Wayne, 5-1 in Kansas City (including a championship) and 5-4 in Tulsa.

The win was IUPUI's first inside the Denny Sanford PREMIER Center as the first three wins in Sioux Falls came at Sioux Falls Arena.

STACKING QUARTERS

IUPUI improved to 11-6 all-time in The Summit League quarterfinals with Saturday's win. The Jags won their first round game eight straight times from 2001-08 and 10 of 11 times from 2001-11.

SEEKING A FIRST

Regardless of who IUPUI plays in the semis, the Jaguars will be seeking a first-ever postseason win against their foe.

IUPUI is 0-1 all-time against Fort Wayne, having lost to the Mastodons in the 2014 tournament. A meeting with Omaha would be the first-ever postseason game between the two schools.

PINE GUYS

Including a 23-13 margin on Saturday, IUPUI's bench has now outscored the opposition's subs in four of the past five games.

Ron Patterson, **Evan Hall** and **T.J. Henderson** continued to shoulder the bench scoring load, combining on all 23 of the Jaguars' bench points on Saturday. Hall led the charge with 10 points (4-5 FG, 2-2 FT) while Henderson had eight points, four rebounds and two assists in 24 minutes at the point. Patterson added five points, two steals and a team-high four assists in 22 minutes.

Jason Gardner was named the eighth head coach in IUPUI men's basketball program's history on April 2, 2014. Gardner, the 1999 winner of the Indiana Mr. Basketball Award, spent a year on the University of Memphis bench and two seasons at Loyola prior to that.

In his first season on the Jaguars' bench, he guided IUPUI to 10 wins, more than tripling the program's Division I win total from a year prior. His hiring paid immediate dividends on the recruiting trail, as he immediately inked five Division I transfers, four of whom were former in-state standouts.

In year two, Gardner led the Jags to a 13-win season against one of the nation's stiffest schedules, including a 9-7 mark in league play and a finish in the top half of the league standings.

Gardner has shown he's a proven recruiter, inking talent, both through high school signees, transfers and graduate transfers.

While at Memphis, Gardner helped the Tigers to a 24-10 record as Shaq Goodwin and Joe Jackson earned All-Conference accolades. In addition, Memphis forward Austin Nichols was a unanimous selection to the American Athletics Conference All-Rookie Team after averaging 9.1 points and 4.2 boards per game. Gardner was a college teammate of current Memphis Head Coach Josh Pastner at Arizona.

Prior to coming to Memphis, Gardner was an assistant under Porter Moser at Loyola, helping the Ramblers to an eight-game improvement from 2011-12 to 2012-13. He coached Ben Averkamp to All-Horizon League accolades for two straight seasons, while Loyola point guard Cully Payne was a Bob Cousy Award nominee. He also helped recruit one of the top signing classes in the Horizon League prior to the 2012-13 season. Gardner's coaching career began in 2010 when he served as an assistant at nearby Cathedral High School.

Gardner's racked up numerous accolades during his prestigious high school, college and professional playing careers. He was a 1999 McDonald's and Parade All-American while at North Central High School, finishing his prep career with a school record 1,669 points. He was a two-time Gatorade Circle of Champions Indiana Player of the Year and was named the 1998-99 Indianapolis County Player of the Year by The Indianapolis Star and Indianapolis News. His senior season, he helped NCHS to the IHSAA 4A state championship and Tournament of Champions title while averaging 22.6 points, 4.7 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 3.0 steals per game.

The 5-foot-10 point guard was recruited to the University of Arizona by legendary Head Coach Lute Olsen, where he was a four-year All-American for the Wildcats. He was the 2002-03 Naismith National Player of the Year and Lowe's Senior CLASS award recipient. He was the 2000 consensus National Freshman of the Year and closed his career as one of four players in Pac-12 history with 1,500 points, 500 assists and 200 steals for a career. He helped lead Arizona to two Pac-12 regular season titles (2000, 2003) and four consecutive NCAA Tournament berths. The Wildcats made three Sweet Sixteens (2001, 2002, 2003), two Elite Eights (2001, 2003) and were the NCAA national runner-up in 2001. All total, Arizona won 107 games during Gardner's four seasons and he still holds school records for games started (135) and minutes played (4,825), while ranking third in school history with 1,984 career points. He also finished second in threes made (318) and fourth in assists (622). He earned his degree from the university in 2011 in disciplinary studies.

Gardner later played professionally overseas for more than eight years, primarily in Germany. In 2009, he was named MVP of German Basketball Bundesliga after helping Oldenburg to the league crown, averaging 13.7 points, 4.0 assists and 3.0 boards per game. He was a two-time Basketball Bundesliga All-Star, including starting the 2007 game.

Gardner is married to the former Jacquelyn Maxberry and the couple has four children, Jasper, Jason Jr., Jacob and Jackson.
