### QUICK HITTERS

- IUPUI has started league play at 0-2 for a third straight season following Monday's home loss to Cleveland State. Last year's bunch began 0-2 with losses at NKU and Wright State before winning at UIC. Similarly, the Jaguars' first season in the Horizon League opened with back-to-back losses at NKU and Wright State before the Jags went on the road to defeat Green Bay. IUPUI has never begun Horizon League play 0-3.
- Junior **Marcus Burk** tallied his 1,000th collegiate point in the first half of the Jaguars' win over Purdue Fort Wayne. The Indy-native tallied 776 in his two seasons at Campbell and has 277 this season, giving him 1,053 career points.
- Junior **Elijah Goss** grabbed a school record 21 rebounds against IU South Bend on Dec. 10, surpassing the previous mark by a single board. Goss' 21 rebounds is the third highest single game total in NCAA Division I basketball this season and he now owns three of the top four single game efforts in the Horizon League this year with 21 against IUSB (Dec. 10), 18 against Youngstown State (Dec. 28) and 17 at Morehead State (Dec. 4).
- IUPUI is coming off a 16-17 campaign, having made the program's third postseason berth during the Division I era by earning a spot in the 2019 College Insider Tournament. The Jaguars' 16 wins were the program's most since going 19-14 in the 2010-11 in head coach Ron Hunter's final season at IUPUI.
- Head Coach **Byron Rimm II** took over on an interim basis earlier this year, replacing Jason Gardner, who spent five years at the helm of the program. Rimm boasts 14 years of head coaching experience, including 10 years at Prairie View A&M from 2006-2016 as he racked up 115 victories and is the program's all-time winningest head coach. He originally joined the Jaguars' staff just prior to last season as IUPUI's Associate Head Coach.
- IUPUI returns just five letterwinners and two starters (**Grant Weatherford** & **Elijah Goss**) from last year's squad. 2019 Horizon League Sixth Man of the Year **Jaylen Minnett** (12.0 ppg, 78.3's) headlines the group of returners and has slid into this year's starting five. Weatherford (6.2 ppg, 3.0 rpg) started all 33 games last season and Goss (6.8 ppg, 6.3 rpg) started 25 times last season before being slowed late in the season due to injury.
- IUPUI has players from nine different states/provinces this season, with five hailing from the Hoosier State. All total, IUPUI has players this year from Indiana, Illinois, Minnesota, New Jersey, North Carolina, Ohio, Ontario, Texas and Utah.
- IUPUI swept the Horizon League's weekly awards on Nov. 18 as junior guard **Marcus Burk** was named Player of the Week and **Mike DePersia** was named Freshman of the Week after leading the Jags to wins over Anderson and at South Florida. Burk averaged 25.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 2.0 assists per game while shooting 61 percent from the floor and 57.1 percent (8-of-14) from three. DePersia, who made his first two career starts during the week, averaged 4.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game while shooting 57 percent from the field.

## NEWS, NOTES & STORYLINES

### COLD FRONTS

IUPUI is trying to avoid a first-ever 0-3 start in Horizon League play today. Last year's group dropped road games at Northern Kentucky and Wright State before winning at UIC behind 30 points from Camron Justice.

In year one of Horizon League play, the Jags were also swept on the opening trip at Northern Kentucky and Wright State before firing back with a win at Green Bay.

This year's schedule marks the first time IUPUI has opened Horizon League play at home.

### CLOSING REMARKS

IUPUI led both of its last two games with five minutes remaining, before dropping home contests to Youngstown State (83-73) and Cleveland State (82-80). YSU closed the game with a 16-6 run to outlast the Jaguars while CSU scored on a tip-in as the final horn sounded to defeat the Jags on Monday night.

Following the loss to CSU on Monday, IUPUI is now 0-5 this season in games decided by two possessions (6 points) or less.

### SEASON HIGHS

The offensive was clicking against Cleveland State on Monday as the Jags matched their season-high with 80 points and set new season-highs in field goal percentage (51.9%) and assists (21). The Jags also hit 15-of-18 (83.3%) at the free throw line, marking their second best effort of the season.

Jaylen Minnett had a season-high 23 points (8-16 FG, 7-13 3's) and a career-high seven treys, including a game-tying hit with 8.8 seconds left. Freshman Mike DePersia had a career-high 11 points (3-3 FG, 1-1 3's, 4-4 FT) in 24 minutes and grad transfer Zo Tyson scored a career-high 10 points (4-4 FG, 2-2 FT) off the bench.

### BETTER THAN ALL THE REST

IUPUI's early season win at South Florida (70-53 on Nov. 13) was widely considered the best non-conference victory by a Horizon League team this season. The Jags entered play as a 17-point underdog before defeating the AAC foe by 17 points. In addition, it was IUPUI's first-ever victory over an AAC opponent in program history.

### MR. 1,000

Junior Marcus Burk netted his **1,000 collegiate point** in the Dec. 14 win over Purdue Fort Wayne with a three-point play at the 12:57 mark of the first half. Burk, an Indianapolis-native, tallied 776 in two seasons at Campbell and now has 277 this season, giving him 1,053 in his collegiate career.

Here are some more tidbits on Burk from the first half of the season:

-Burk has undoubtedly been IUPUI's top offensive player all season, ranking No. 2 in the Horizon League in scoring (18.5 ppg) and third in the league in threes made (2.93/gm).

-Burk tallied a season-high 32 points (12-of-21 FG, 7-of-10 3's) against Loyola (Md.), falling one shy of his career-high 33 from his sophomore year at Campbell. Burk's 32 was the most by an IUPUI player since Darell Combs hit the same number against South Dakota on Feb. 25, 2016.

-While Burk is averaging nearly 20 points per game, no IUPUI player has averaged 20 points per game for an entire season since Alex Young averaged 20.4 points per game in 2011-12. Only three players - Odell Bradley (23.1, 2003-04), George Hill (21.5, 2007-08) and Young (20.4, 2011-12) - have averaged better than 20 points per game during the Jaguars' Division I era.

-Burk is currently second in the Horizon League with seven 20-point scoring games, trailing only Detroit Mercy's Antoine Davis, who has 10 20+ scoring games.

### MR. WINDEX

Junior Elyjah Goss currently **leads the Horizon League** and ranks 21st nationally in rebounding at 10.1 per contest, more than a full rebound ahead of second place Naz Bohannon (YSU). He owns the three of the four highest single-game totals in the Horizon League this season, grabbing a school record 21 against IUSB (Dec. 10), 18 against Youngstown State (Dec. 28) and 17 at Morehead State (Dec. 4). His 21 boards against IUSB is the third-highest single-game total in NCAA Division I this season.

All total, Goss has led the Jaguars in rebounds in 13 of the team's 15 games.

Since returning to the starting lineup 10 games ago, Goss is averaging 9.8 points and 12.1 rebounds per game.

Goss is second in the league in offensive rebounds (3.60 rpg) and tops in defensive (6.47). He's also second in the league in blocked shots (1.00 bpg) and tied for the top in double-doubles (4) and double-digit rebound games (7).

### E'S RECORD BREAKING NIGHT

Junior Elyjah Goss had a record breaking night against IU South Bend on Dec. 10, posting a school record 21 rebounds to go along with a career-high 17 points and four blocked shots in the Jaguars' 80-60 victory. Goss grabbed seven offensive boards and 14 defensive boards and hit 7-of-10 field goal attempts.

The prior record was 20 on two different occasions, the most recent coming by Michael Boles in 1993. Goss became the first player in IUPUI history to grab at least 20 boards in the Jaguars' Division I era.

### HEALTH CHECK

The Dec. 7 game at Ball State was the first time all season that head coach Byron Rimm had his full roster as his disposal. Junior Jakoby Kemp missed the season's initial eight games due to injury and upon his return at Morehead State (Dec. 4), classmate

Jamil Jackson was sidelined due to injury. Jackson missed two games before returning at Ball State.

The Jags have played just five games at full strength as Isaiah Williams missed the most recent game with Cleveland State.

### SPLASH BROTHERS

IUPUI's version of the Splash Brothers - Marcus Burk and Jaylen Minnett - has been impressive, both ranking among the Horizon League's top three in threes made and three-point percentage.

Burk is third in the league in threes per game (2.93) while Minnett is second in the league in the category (3.27). Burk is second in three-point percentage (41.1%) and Minnett is third at 37.7%. By hitting a combined 6.2 threes/game, the duo is tops in the league for a tandem as Northern Kentucky's Dantez Walton and Tyler Sharpe are next in line at 5.37 threes/game.

Burk is fifth among active juniors (48th among all players) in college basketball with 202 career treys and Minnett is 12th on that list (84th overall) with 178 makes.

Minnett's 49 threes this season are tops in the Horizon League and third in the country while Burk's 44 is second in the league and 14th nationally.

### WARM WEATHERFORD

Junior Grant Weatherford is making a claim to join Burk and Minnett as an elite three-point shooter. After starting the season 0-of-6 from deep in the season's first eight games, Weatherford is 9-of-17 (53%) from beyond the arc in the Jaguars' last seven games, coinciding with his return to the starting lineup.

Since rejoining the starting unit, Weatherford has tallied in double-digits four times. During the seven games, Weatherford is averaging 10.6 points, 4.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 2.1 steals per game while shooting 50 percent (26-of-52) from the field and 9-of-17 (53 percent) from three-point range.

### TOP GUNS

Burk and Minnett are accounting for the bulk of the Jaguars' offense, having taken 50 percent of the team's field goal attempts (435 of 875) and 73 percent of the team's three-point attempts (237 of 324). In addition, the duo has accounted for 49 percent (491 of 1001) of the team's total points.

Burk (18.5 ppg) and Minnett (14.5 ppg) easily lead the team in scoring while Isaiah Williams is third at 8.6 ppg.

### MINNETT NOTES

Junior Jaylen Minnett, the 2019 Horizon League Sixth Man of the Year, is unlikely to be a repeat winner of the award as he's assumed a starting job this season. The 6-foot-1 Terre Haute-native, averaged 12.0 points per game and drilled 78 3's last season, while coming off the bench in all but the season finale.

Some other tidbits on Minnett include:

-He currently owns the nation's **third-longest streak** of consecutive games with at least one made three at 51 games... Minnett made at least one trey in all 33 games last season and the final three games of the 2017-18 season... the last time Minnett went without a three in a game was against Oakland on Feb. 19, 2018 when he was held without a triple in 14 minutes.

-Minnett enters play ranked eighth on IUPUI's all-time list with 178 made 3's in his career... both Leroy Nobles and Akeem Clark are tied for the No. 6 spot with 186 makes each.

-His 78 3's made last season was the 7th-highest single-season total in IUPUI history.

-His 7.1 ppg scoring average as a freshman in 2017-18 was the highest by an IUPUI rookie since Alex Young average 10.8 points per game in 2008-09.

-His 51 made 3's in 2017-18 were the most by an IUPUI freshman in the program's Division I era (1998-present).

### STORY TELLER

In IUPUI's four wins this season, the Jags have held opponents to 37 percent shooting overall and 23.4 percent from three-point range.

In the Jaguars' 11 losses, foes have shot 50.3 percent overall and 38.7 percent from beyond the arc.

Seven of the 11 opponents to have beaten the Jags have shot 50 percent or better from the floor.

### FREEBIES

IUPUI enters play ranked 343rd of 350 teams in free throw percentage at 60.0 percent, which is well on pace to be the lowest mark in the program's Division I era. The current low mark was a 65.4 percentage for the 2008-09 season. The lowest single-season mark on record in program history was a 62.7 percentage in the 1976-77 campaign.

### NEW LOOK JAGS

This year's team has a decidedly new look - a new head coach, only five returners and a largely new coaching staff.

Head coach Byron Rimm II took over on an interim basis this past fall, taking over for Indianapolis-native Jason Gardner. Rimm, who is the winningest head coach in Prairie View A&M history with 115 career wins, became the ninth head coach in IUPUI history after taking over for Gardner.

He has 10+ years of Division I head coaching experience and helped PVAMU to winning records in 2008-09 and 2009-10.

Beside him, Rimm boasts two new assistants on the sidelines as well as Brian Burton

## BASKETBALL CENTRAL

IUPUI will be a big part of the center of the college basketball universe this March as the 2020 Horizon League Championships will be played at the Indiana Farmers Coliseum on Mar. 9-10 and the department will later serve as institutional co-host of an NCAA Men's Basketball Regional at Lucas Oil Stadium on Mar. 26-28, alongside the Horizon League and Indiana Sports Corporation.

Both the men's and women's Horizon League Semifinals (Mar. 9) and Championship games (Mar. 10) will be played at Indiana Farmers Coliseum as 2020 marks the first of a three-year rotation.

joined the program from UTEP in November and Aaron Evans joined the program as Director of Operations from nearby Marian University over the summer. Evans took the spot of Isaac Loechle, who was promoted from Director of Operations to Assistant Coach last summer.

### WHERE'D THEY GO?

IUPUI graduated the Horizon League's Defensive Player of the Year D.J. McCall, who's currently in Fort Wayne Mad Ants camp, vying for a spot in the G-League as a rookie. In addition, three-year starter Evan Hall also graduated on the inside, as did 7-foot-1 big man Ahmed Ismail.

The other key departure was second team All-Horizon League selection Camron Justice, who pursued a graduate transfer, and is now playing at Western Kentucky. The Jags also suffered two other defections at the start of the school year as local product Jack Hansen decided not to continue his college basketball career after appearing in 31 games last season.

The other came when highly touted freshman Calvin Temple opted to transfer to Louisiana at the start of the school year. Temple, a 6-foot-1 guard who was one of the top prep players from the state of Mississippi, practiced with the Jaguars during the summer before opting to transfer.

### LARGE CLASS

IUPUI entered the season with an eight-man junior class eligibility wise, tying for the eighth largest class in all of college basketball. Below are the lists of largest classes.

### FAMILY TIES

-DePersia comes from a notable basketball family in the state of New Jersey and he and his brothers - twins Rob and Nick - are one of just four sets of siblings in NJ high school basketball history to have all scored 1,000 points in their high school careers. DePersia led his Haddonfield squad to back-to-back state titles his junior and senior seasons. His two brothers went on to play collegiately at Rowan University and were named the Albert Carino Boys Basketball Club of South Jersey Small College Players of the Year last April while playing for former Penn State standout Joe Crispin. Rob recently joined the Villanova program as a graduate assistant.

-Kemp's older brother is a WR with the Kansas City Chiefs, Marcus Kemp. Kemp played at the University of Hawaii and is now in his second season with the Chiefs, having joined the team as an undrafted free agent in 2017.

### GRADS

Two members of the IUPUI team have already completed their undergraduate work and are now pursuing Master's degrees. Grant Weatherford completed his undergraduate work last spring and is now pursuing a Master's degree and still has two years of eligibility ahead.

Colorado State-transfer Zo Tyson earned his degree this past summer and is now pursuing his Master's degree in Sports Journalism on the IUPUI campus.

### PRO NOTES

In addition to the success that former IUPUI Jaguar George Hill is continuing to have in his 12th NBA season, IUPUI presently has seven former players playing professionally all over the world.

### 21 UP

Last February, Hall of Famer Matt Crenshaw became just the 3rd player in school history to have his jersey retired, joining #34 Carlos Knox and #3 George Hill, in the rafters.

Crenshaw finished as the program's all-time leader in assists and hit the game-winning shot in the 2003 Mid-Continent Conference Tournament to send IUPUI to the NCAA Tournament. He later played overseas and returned to IUPUI as a longtime member of the coaching staff before joining the Ball State coaching staff just prior to the start of last season.

Hill was among those to attend the festivities.



### HUNTER TO THE HALL

Longtime IUPUI head coach Ron Hunter was inducted as part of the Jaguars' Hall of Fame Class of 2019 this past February.

Hunter, now the head coach at Tulane University, guided the IUPUI basketball program from 1994-2011 and is the program's all-time leader in wins (275), winning percentage (.557), games coached (494), winning seasons (11) and 20-win seasons (4). He guided IUPUI to its only ever NCAA Division I NCAA Tournament appearance in 2003. Led by future NBAer George Hill, his 2007-08 team won a school record 26 games and two years later, his team went 25-11 and collected the program's first-ever Division I postseason win. He was a two-time league Coach of the Year and clearly elevated the program during his tenure.

He earned national acclaim for his work with Samaritan's Feet as the first in the country to coach a game in his bare feet in January 2008 to raise awareness for those in need. He later personally delivered shoes to individuals in Peru and Costa Rica. He collected numerous honors for his philanthropic work including being named a 2008 ABC News Person of the Year, the 2010 Indiana Pathfinder Award recipient and an NABC Guardians of the Game Pillar Award for Service.

## UNIVERSITY NOTES

### ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

IUPUI is a public research university located in downtown Indianapolis that is the result of a merger of the Purdue Indianapolis Extension Center (1946) and Indiana University Indianapolis (1916). The merger was completed in 1969 and athletics began in 1972.

The university offers more than 200 degree programs and boasts an enrollment over 30,000 (22,000 undergrad and 8,000 postgrad). The university also boasts an endowment of more than \$850 million.

The university is ranked among the Top 200 "National Universities" and ranked 7th for "Up and Coming Schools." U.S. News has ranked IUPUI among the nation's elite for 13 straight years.

All total, the campus covers 509 acres and is located along Indy's Cultural Trail.

IUPUI includes the nation's largest nursing school, the second largest medical school in the country, the only dental school in the state, and the country's oldest school of physical education. IUPUI is among the top 20 campuses in the nation for graduate professional degrees conferred

### ATHLETIC PROWESS

IUPUI was a primary beneficiary of the 1987 Pan-American Games in Indianapolis and continues to boast some world renowned facilities.

The IU Natatorium is located on the IUPUI campus and is among the best swimming & diving facilities in the world. It has hosted the U.S. Olympic Team Trials four different times and 12 NCAA National Championship meets. In addition, the 2017 World Juniors were held at IUPUI and 16 world records have been set in the Natatorium water.

Adjacent west is the Michael A. Carroll Track & Soccer Stadium which has hosted several USA Outdoor Track & Field Championships and NCAA Championships, along with the 1988 US Olympic Trials. Florence Griffith-Joyner set the 100m world record of 10.49 on the track.

In basketball circles, IUPUI is best known as the long-time host of the Nike All-American Camp, which was held on campus for two decades. The nation's top prep players and coaches from every level converged on campus for two weeks each summer in what was considered the elite college recruiting event of the year. Alum included Lebron James, Chris Webber, Allen Iverson, Kevin Garnett, Jason Kidd and Paul Pierce, among many others.

### GEORGE HILL

IUPUI's best known basketball alum is current NBAer George Hill, who is in his 12th year in the league this season. Hill was originally drafted by the San Antonio Spurs (1st rd., 26th overall) in 2008.

He's played for the Spurs (2008-11), Indiana Pacers (2011-16), Utah Jazz (2016-17), Sacramento Kings (2017-18), Cleveland Cavaliers (2018) and Milwaukee Bucks (2018-pres.). He's played in more than 700 regular season games, making nearly 450 career starts and averaging 11.2 points per game in his NBA career.

Entering this season, he's played in 117 career playoff games, starting 90 times and averaging 12.3 points per game.

## THE LAST MEETING - IUPUI 67, MILWAUKEE 60 (FEB. 22, 2019 - INDIANAPOLIS)

### JAGUARS GET PAST MILWAUKEE LATE IN 67-60 VICTORY

**INDIANAPOLIS (Feb 22, 2019)** - The IUPUI basketball team found itself mixed in another close affair on Friday night (Feb. 22), but finished strong and came away victorious as the Jags outlasted Milwaukee, 67-60. Sophomore Jaylen Minnett scored a game-high 22 points off the Jaguars' bench and junior Camron Justice chimed in with 15 as IUPUI snapped a four-game skid and gave the program its most victories since the 2010-11 campaign.

DeAndre Abram led Milwaukee (9-19, 4-11 HL) with 19 points and seven rebounds and Darius Roy pumped in 18 in the loss.

IUPUI (15-13, 7-8 HL) came up with timely baskets and even more timely defensive stops late after the game was tied at 54 all with 5:48 to play. The game featured 15 lead changes, the final coming when Minnett combined a stop and a bucket by collecting a steal near midcourt and racing to the other end for an uncontested layup, which sparked a pivotal 6-0 run. Senior center Ahmed Ismail contributed the final four points of the run as part of his 13-point, 8-rebound effort. The 7-foot-1 veteran scored on a pair of free throws and then dropped in an easy layup off a Justice assist with 2:43 left to make it 60-54.

MKE's Jake Wright banked in a long three with 1:45 left, but IUPUI countered when Ismail put back a Minnett miss with 1:16 left to retain the two possession lead. From there, IUPUI made enough free throws and took advantage of some Panther misses to escape victorious.

"I'm really proud of my guys," head coach Jason Gardner said. "I thought defensively we were pretty good in the second half and that was the difference in the ballgame. We forced them into some tough shots and I thought we did a better job of limiting them to one shot with our work on the glass in the second half."

"Jaylen really gave us a spark offensively tonight with his ability to make shots. He kind of got us going in the first half and carried it over to the second half. He's a confident kid and has the ability to make some really tough shots. I think you saw that tonight."

Milwaukee was doing the shot making in the game's early going as the Panthers made their first six three-point attempts en route to building a 30-24 lead. IUPUI clawed back to take a 37-36 lead at the break, despite the Panthers canning eight triples before intermission. IUPUI built a six-point lead early in the second half before Milwaukee fired back to build a 50-45 lead.

Minnett stroked a wing three with 9:56 to play to spark a personal 9-0 run that saw him score from beyond the arc, on a contested drive and then at the free throw line. He then dropped in a short baseline jumper to close the burst and give the Jags a four-point lead. Milwaukee scored the game's next four points before IUPUI ran away late.

IUPUI shot 43 percent in the win while limiting the Panthers to just 31 percent after halftime and 39 percent for the game. Evan Hall finished with six points, six rebounds and three blocked shots while Elyjah Goss returned from a two-game absence with six points and six boards of his own off the bench.

Wright closed with 12 points for the Panthers on four treys and Amir Allen had four points and a game-high 11 boards before fouling out.

The win was icing on an already celebratory evening as IUPUI retired the No. 21 jersey of Hall of Famer Matt Crenshaw during halftime. Crenshaw was joined on the court by nearly 20 former teammates and players he coached while current NBAer George Hill addressed the crowd as part of the celebration.

## HEAD COACH BYRON RIMM II



**Byron Rimm II** was named the program's interim head coach for the 2019-2020 season on Aug. 27, 2019, becoming the ninth head coach in program history. He originally joined the IUPUI program in October 2018 as the Jaguars' associate head coach.

In his first season on the Jaguars' sidelines, IUPUI's 16 wins were the program's most since a 19-win campaign in 2010-

11. Included in the wins was a benchmark road win at ACC foe Boston College and a win of the Niagara Regional of the Fort Myers Tip-Off Classic during non-conference play. The Jaguars were later selected to play in the 2019 CIT, earning the program's third postseason appearance in the Division I era.

Rimm has an extensive background in college basketball including having served as head coach at Prairie View A&M from 2006-15. During his time with the Panthers, the program ascended to new heights, including back-to-back appearances in the SWAC tournament championship game in 2013 and 2014. Before Prairie View, the Pensacola, Fla.-native gained valuable experience on the West Coast, which included assistant coaching stops at Pasadena City College and Chaffey Community College from 1997-2000.

He directed Cal State San Bernardino to a No. 3 national ranking in NCAA Division II during the 2000 campaign and then took over the reins as the head women's basketball coach at Texas College in Tyler, Texas, guiding the team to a 20-12 mark in his lone season. At the time, the 20-12 mark was the most successful season in program history. He then had a four-year run as the head men's coach with Jarvis Christian College before joining Prairie View A&M as an assistant for the 2005-06 season. He was promoted to the head coaching spot the following season at age 32.

He coached Prairie View A&M to winning seasons in 2008-09 and 2009-10 and won 115 games during his time as head coach. His 2014 squad boasted the highest APR ranking among SWAC teams and also registered the best score in program history.

Since then, Rimm has served as the director of basketball operations at Texas A&M Corpus Christi in 2016-17 and as an assistant at UC Riverside in 2017-18.

Rimm played at Ventura College and California State University Los Angeles before earning his degree from Cal State, Los Angeles in 1999. He earned his master's degree in education from American InterContinental University in 2005.
