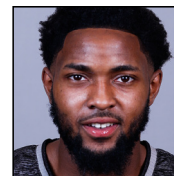
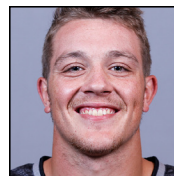
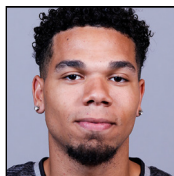

QUICK HITTERS

- IUPUI is coming off a season-best offensive performance in the 93-78 win at Green Bay last Sunday (Jan. 5). The Jags scored a season-high 53 points before halftime and led by as many as 25 points en route to a 15-point win. IUPUI finished with a season-high 93 points, 14 threes made, 17 free throws made and 22 assists on 31 field goals.
- Junior **Jaylen Minnett** has climbed to fifth in the country and tops in the Horizon League in total threes made, having connected on 57 treys this season. In league play, Minnett is leading the Horizon League in scoring (22.0 ppg) and threes made (4.75/game) and ranks third in assists (5.3 apg) and free throw percentage (92.9%).
- Junior **Elyjah Goss** grabbed a school record 21 rebounds against IU South Bend on Dec. 10, surpassing the previous mark by a single board. Goss ranks 11th nationally at 10.8 rebounds per game and has led IUPUI in rebounding in 14 of 17 games, including 10-in-a-row entering tonight's contest. In league play, he's averaging a league best 15.5 per game.
- Junior **Marcus Burk** tallied his 1,000th collegiate point in the first half of the Jaguars' win over Purdue Fort Wayne. The Indy-native tallied 776 in his two seasons at Campbell and has 319 this season, giving him 1,095 career points.
- IUPUI is coming off a 16-17 campaign, having made the program's third postseason berth during the Division I era by earning a spot in the 2019 College Insider Tournament. The Jaguars' 16 wins were the program's most since going 19-14 in the 2010-11 in head coach Ron Hunter's final season at IUPUI.
- Head Coach **Byron Rimm II** took over on an interim basis earlier this year, replacing Jason Gardner, who spent five years at the helm of the program. Rimm boasts 14 years of head coaching experience, including 10 years at Prairie View A&M from 2006-2016 as he racked up 115 victories and is the program's all-time winningest head coach. He originally joined the Jaguars' staff just prior to last season as IUPUI's Associate Head Coach.
- IUPUI returns just five letterwinners and two starters (**Grant Weatherford** & **Elyjah Goss**) from last year's squad. 2019 Horizon League Sixth Man of the Year **Jaylen Minnett** (12.0 ppg, 78 3's) headlines the group of returners and has slid into this year's starting five. Weatherford (6.2 ppg, 3.0 rpg) started all 33 games last season and Goss (6.8 ppg, 6.3 rpg) started 25 times last season before being slowed late in the season due to injury.
- IUPUI has players from nine different states/provinces this season, with five hailing from the Hoosier State. All total, IUPUI has players this year from Indiana, Illinois, Minnesota, New Jersey, North Carolina, Ohio, Ontario, Texas and Utah.
- IUPUI swept the Horizon League's weekly awards on Nov. 18 as junior guard **Marcus Burk** was named Player of the Week and **Mike DePersia** was named Freshman of the Week after leading the Jags to wins over Anderson and at South Florida. Burk averaged 25.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 2.0 assists per game while shooting 61 percent from the floor and 57.1 percent (8-of-14) from three. DePersia, who made his first two career starts during the week, averaged 4.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game while shooting 57 percent from the field.

BUCKETS IN THE BAY

IUPUI is coming off a season-best offensive performance in the Jaguars' 93-78 win at Green Bay last Sunday (Jan. 10). The Jaguars posted a number of season-high efforts, fueled by Jaylen Minnett's career-high 31 points (8-15 FG, 6-10 3's, 9-9 FT) and a 27-point (10-21 FG, 4-9 3's, 3-3 FT) from Marcus Burk.

Collectively, IUPUI scored a season-high 93 points, including a season-high 53 in the first half. The Jags also hit a season-high 31 field goals, 14 treys and 17 free throws and delivered a season-high 22 assists. The Jags built an 18-point first half lead and led by as many as 25 in the second half before settling for a 15-point victory.

Grant Weatherford (13 pts, 6 reb, 3-5 3') and Elijah Goss (13 pts, 17 reb) also finished in double-digits as the Jaguars' starting five accounted for 86 of the team's 93 points.

COULDA, SHOULDA, WOULD...A

While IUPUI is 1-3 at this juncture of Horizon League play, the Jags could just as easily be sitting at 4-0 at this point.

The Jags dropped their Horizon League opener to Youngstown State, 83-73, on a night in which they led with five minutes to play and went 12-of-28 (42.9 percent) from the foul line. Two days later, IUPUI lost at a tip-in at the buzzer to Cleveland State, 82-80.

At Milwaukee last Friday, the Jags had a potential game-tying layup on their final possession go long, ultimately resulting in a 78-74 defeat.

IUPUI is now 0-6 this season in games decided by two possessions (six points) or less.

BETTER THAN ALL THE REST

IUPUI's early season win at South Florida (70-53 on Nov. 13) was widely considered the best non-conference victory by a Horizon League team this season. The Jags entered play as a 17-point underdog before defeating the AAC foe by 17 points. In addition, it was IUPUI's first-ever victory over an AAC opponent in program history.

MR. 1,000

Junior Marcus Burk netted his **1,000 collegiate point** in the Dec. 14 win over Purdue Fort Wayne with a three-point play at the 12:57 mark of the first half. Burk, an Indianapolis-native, tallied 776 in two seasons at Campbell and now has 317 this season, giving him 1,095 in his collegiate career.

Here are some more tidbits on Burk from the first half of the season:

- Burk has undoubtedly been IUPUI's top offensive player all season, ranking No. 2 in the Horizon League in scoring (18.8 ppg) and third in the league in threes made (2.82/gm).

- Burk tallied a season-high 32 points (12-of-21 FG, 7-of-10 3's) against Loyola (Md.), falling one shy of his career-high 33 from his sophomore year at Campbell. Burk's 32 was the most by an IUPUI player since Darell Combs hit the same number against South Dakota on Feb. 25, 2016.

- While Burk is averaging nearly 20 points per game, no IUPUI player has averaged 20 points per game for an entire season since Alex Young averaged 20.4 points per game in 2011-12. Only three players - Odell Bradley (23.1, 2003-04), George Hill (21.5, 2007-08) and Young (20.4, 2011-12) - have averaged better than 20 points per game during the Jaguars' Division I era.

- Burk is currently second in the Horizon League with eight 20-point scoring games, trailing only Detroit Mercy's Antoine Davis.

MR. WINDEX

Junior Elijah Goss currently **leads the Horizon League** and ranks No. 11 nationally in rebounding at 10.8 per contest, more than a full rebound ahead of second place Naz Bohannon (YSU). He owns the two of the four highest single-game totals in the Horizon League this season, grabbing a school record 21 against IUSB (Dec. 10), 18 against Youngstown State (Dec. 28) and 17 at Morehead State (Dec. 4). His 21 boards against IUSB is the third-highest single-game total in NCAA Division I this season.

All total, Goss has led the Jaguars in rebounds in 14 of the team's 17 games.

Since returning to the starting lineup 12 games ago, Goss is averaging 11.2 points and 12.9 rebounds per game.

In four league games, Goss leads the league in rebounding (13.3 rpg), offensive boards (6.25 rpg), defensive rebounds (9.25 rpg) and has three double-doubles in four contests.

Goss now has nine career double-doubles and has led the Jags in rebounding in each of the past 10 games.

HEALTH CHECK

The Dec. 7 game at Ball State was the first time all season that head coach Byron Rimm had his full roster as his disposal. Junior Jakoby Kemp missed the season's initial eight games due to injury and upon his return at Morehead State (Dec. 4), classmate Jamil Jackson was sidelined due to injury. The Jags have played just six games at full strength as Isaiah Williams missed the game with Cleveland State and Jackson missed the game at Milwaukee.

SPLASH BROTHERS

IUPUI's version of the Splash Brothers - Marcus Burk and Jaylen Minnett - has been impressive, both ranking among the nation's top 20 in threes made.

Burk leads the league in percentage (40%) and is third in threes made at 2.82/game. Minnett is second in threes made (3.35/game) and three-point percentage (38.8%). By hitting a combined 6.2 threes/game, the duo is tops in the league for a tandem as Northern Kentucky's Dante Walton and Tyler Sharpe are next in line.

Burk is fifth among active juniors (46th among all players) in college basketball with 206 career treys and Minnett is 12th on that list (74th overall) with 186 makes.

Minnett's 57 threes this season are tops in the Horizon League and third in the country while Burk's 48 is third in the league and 18th nationally.

TOP GUNS

Burk and Minnett are accounting for the bulk of the Jaguars' offense, having taken 50 percent of the team's field goal attempts (502 of 1001) and 73 percent of the team's three-point attempts (267 of 365). In addition, the duo has accounted for 49 percent (572 of 1168) of the team's total points.

Burk (18.8 ppg) and Minnett (15.5 ppg) easily lead the team in scoring while Elijah Goss is third at 9.2 ppg.

MINNETT NOTES

Junior Jaylen Minnett, the 2019 Horizon League Sixth Man of the Year, is unlikely to be a repeat winner of the award as he's assumed a starting job this season. The 6-foot-1 Terre Haute-native, averaged 12.0 points per game and drilled 78 3's last season, while coming off the bench in all but the season finale.

Some other tidbits on Minnett include:

- He's currently amidst a career-best 10 straight games in double-figures, averaging nearly 18.4 points per game during that span.

- He currently owns the nation's **third-longest streak** of consecutive games with at least one made three at 53 games... Minnett made at least one trey in all 33 games last season and the final three games of the 2017-18 season... the last time Minnett went without a three in a game was against Oakland on Feb. 19, 2018 when he was held without a triple in 14 minutes.

- Minnett enters play tied for sixth on IUPUI's all-time list with 186 made 3's in his career... he's tied with both Leroy Nobles and Akeem Clark with 186 makes.

- His 78 3's made last season was the 7th-highest single-season total in IUPUI history.

- His 7.1 ppg scoring average as a freshman in 2017-18 was the highest by an IUPUI rookie since Alex Young average 10.8 points per game in 2008-09.

- His 51 made 3's in 2017-18 were the most by an IUPUI freshman in the program's Division I era (1998-present).

WARM WEATHERFORD

Junior Grant Weatherford is making a claim to join Burk and Minnett as an elite three-point shooter. After starting the season 0-of-6 from deep in the season's first eight games, Weatherford is 12-of-23 (52.2%) from beyond the arc in the Jaguars' last nine games, coinciding with his return to the starting lineup.

Since rejoining the starting unit, Weatherford has tallied in double-digits six times. During the nine games, Weatherford is averaging 10.8 points, 4.8 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 2.0 steals per game while shooting 52.2 percent (35-of-67) from the field and three.

STORY TELLER

In IUPUI's five wins this season, the Jags have held opponents to 37.5 percent shooting overall and 26.1 percent from three-point range.

In the Jaguars' 12 losses, foes have shot 50 percent overall and 38.9 percent from beyond the arc.

Seven of the 12 opponents to have beaten the Jags have shot 50 percent or better from the floor.

FREEBIES

IUPUI enters play ranked 303rd of 350 teams in free throw percentage at 62.5 percent, which is well on pace to be the lowest mark in the program's Division I era. The current low mark was a 65.4 percentage for the 2008-09 season. The lowest single-season mark on record in program history was a 62.7 percentage in the 1976-77 campaign.

...HOWEVER

Since the Youngstown State loss in which IUPUI made just 12-of-28 (42.9 percent) at the foul line, IUPUI has been efficient in the three most recent games. Since then, IUPUI is a combined 46-of-57 (80.7 percent) in the last three games.

ZO DON'T MISS

Graduate transfer Zo Tyson hasn't missed a field goal attempt since the Dec. 10 against IU South Bend, going 8-of-8 from the floor since then (including five dunks). For the season, Tyson is making 66.7 percent of his field goal attempts with nine of his 24 made field goals being dunks.

FULL 40

Junior Jaylen Minnett's 40-minute effort at Green Bay on Jan. 5 was the first full 40 posted by an IUPUI player in a non-overtime game since Marcellus Barksdale played all 40 minutes at Western Illinois on Mar. 1, 2014.

STARTERS DOING IT ALL

Head coach Byron Rimm has shown a reluctance to delve too deeply into his bench as IUPUI reserves accounted for just 11.7 points per game this season. IUPUI is getting just 10 percent of its points from reserves and has had seven games in which the bench has provided fewer than 10 points. The Jags' bench has scored a season-high 19 points on three different occasions.

GRADE CHECKS

Six different Jaguars posted a grade point average of 3.0 or better during the fall - Mike DePersia, Elijah Goss, Brandon Kenyon, Sawyer Stoltz, Grant Weatherford and Taveion

BASKETBALL CENTRAL

IUPUI will be a big part of the center of the college basketball universe this March as the 2020 Horizon League Championships will be played at the Indiana Farmers Coliseum on Mar. 9-10 and the department will later serve as institutional co-host of an NCAA Men's Basketball Regional at Lucas Oil Stadium on Mar. 26-28, alongside the Horizon League and Indiana Sports Corporation.

Both the men's and women's Horizon League Semifinals (Mar. 9) and Championship games (Mar. 10) will be played at Indiana Farmers Coliseum as 2020 marks the first of a three-year rotation.

White. Weatherford, who is pursuing his Master's degree in Organizational Leadership, had the team's top GPA for the fall at 3.67.

GRADS

Two members of the IUPUI team have already completed their undergraduate work and are now pursuing Master's degrees. Grant Weatherford completed his undergraduate work last spring and is now pursuing a Master's degree and still has two years of eligibility ahead.

Colorado State-transfer Zo Tyson earned his degree this past summer and is now pursuing his Master's degree in Sports Journalism on the IUPUI campus.

WHERE'D THEY GO?

IUPUI graduated the Horizon League's Defensive Player of the Year D.J. McCall, who's currently playing in the G-League for the Fort Wayne Mad Antz. In addition, three-year starter Evan Hall also graduated on the inside, as did 7-foot-1 big man Ahmed Ismail.

The other key departure was second team All-Horizon League selection Camron Justice, who pursued a graduate transfer, and is now playing at Western Kentucky. The Jags also suffered two other defections at the start of the school year as local product Jack Hansen decided not to continue his college basketball career after appearing in 31 games last season.

The other came when highly touted freshman Calvin Temple opted to transfer to Louisiana at the start of the school year. Temple, a 6-foot-1 guard who was one of the top prep players from the state of Mississippi, practiced with the Jaguars during the summer before opting to transfer.

LARGE CLASS

IUPUI entered the season with an eight-man junior class eligibility wise, tying for the eighth largest class in all of college basketball. Below are the lists of largest classes.

FAMILY TIES

-DePersia comes from a notable basketball family in the state of New Jersey and he and his brothers - twins Rob and Nick - are one of just four sets of siblings in NJ high school basketball history to have all scored 1,000 points in their high school careers. DePersia led his Haddonfield squad to back-to-back state titles his junior and senior seasons. His two brothers went on to play collegiately at Rowan University and were named the Albert Carino Boys Basketball Club of South Jersey Small College Players of the Year last April while playing for former Penn State standout Joe Crispin. Rob recently joined the Villanova program as a graduate assistant.

-Kemp's older brother is a WR with the Kansas City Chiefs, Marcus Kemp. Kemp played at the University of Hawaii and is now in his second season with the Chiefs, having joined the team as an undrafted free agent in 2017.

PRO NOTES

In addition to the success that former IUPUI Jaguar George Hill is continuing to have in his 12th NBA season, IUPUI presently has seven former players playing professionally all over the world.

21 UP

Last February, Hall of Famer Matt Crenshaw became just the 3rd player in school history to have his jersey retired, joining #34 Carlos Knox and #3 George Hill, in the rafters.

Crenshaw finished as the program's all-time leader in assists and hit the game-winning shot in the 2003 Mid-Continent Conference Tournament to send IUPUI to the NCAA Tournament. He later played overseas and returned to IUPUI as a longtime member of the coaching staff before joining the Ball State coaching staff just prior to the start of last season.

Hill was among those to attend the festivities.



HUNTER TO THE HALL

Longtime IUPUI head coach Ron Hunter was inducted as part of the Jaguars' Hall of Fame Class of 2019 this past February.

Hunter, now the head coach at Tulane University, guided the IUPUI basketball program from 1994-2011 and is the program's all-time leader in wins (275), winning percentage (.557), games coached (494), winning seasons (11) and 20-win seasons (4). He guided IUPUI to its only ever NCAA Division I NCAA Tournament appearance in 2003. Led by future NBAer George Hill, his 2007-08 team won a school record 26 games and two years later, his team went 25-11 and collected the program's first-ever Division I postseason win. He was a two-time league Coach of the Year and clearly elevated the program during his tenure.

He earned national acclaim for his work with Samaritan's Feet as the first in the country to coach a game in his bare feet in January 2008 to raise awareness for those in need. He later personally delivered shoes to individuals in Peru and Costa Rica. He collected numerous honors for his philanthropic work including being named a 2008 ABC News Person of the Year, the 2010 Indiana Pathfinder Award recipient and an NABC Guardians of the Game Pillar Award for Service.

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

IUPUI is a public research university located in downtown Indianapolis that is the result of a merger of the Purdue Indianapolis Extension Center (1946) and Indiana University Indianapolis (1916). The merger was completed in 1969 and athletics began in 1972.

The university offers more than 200 degree programs and boasts an enrollment over 30,000 (22,000 undergrad and 8,000 postgrad). The university also boasts an endowment of more than \$850 million.

The university is ranked among the Top 200 "National Universities" and ranked 7th for "Up and Coming Schools." U.S. News has ranked IUPUI among the nation's elite for 13 straight years.

All total, the campus covers 509 acres and is located along Indy's Cultural Trail.

IUPUI includes the nation's largest nursing school, the second largest medical school in the country, the only dental school in the state, and the country's oldest school of physical education. IUPUI is among the top 20 campuses in the nation for graduate professional degrees conferred

ATHLETIC PROWESS

IUPUI was a primary beneficiary of the 1987 Pan-American Games in Indianapolis and continues to boast some world renowned facilities.

The IU Natatorium is located on the IUPUI campus and is among the best swimming & diving facilities in the world. It has hosted the U.S. Olympic Team Trials four different times and 12 NCAA National Championship meets. In addition, the 2017 World Juniors were held at IUPUI and 16 world records have been set in the Natatorium water.

Adjacent west is the Michael A. Carroll Track & Soccer Stadium which has hosted several USA Outdoor Track & Field Championships and NCAA Championships, along with the 1988 US Olympic Trials. Florence Griffith-Joyner set the 100m world record of 10.49 on the track.

In basketball circles, IUPUI is best known as the long-time host of the Nike All-American Camp, which was held on campus for two decades. The nation's top prep players and coaches from every level converged on campus for two weeks each summer in what was considered the elite college recruiting event of the year. Alum included LeBron James, Chris Webber, Allen Iverson, Kevin Garnett, Jason Kidd and Paul Pierce, among many others.

GEORGE HILL

IUPUI's best known basketball alum is current NBAer George Hill, who is in his 12th year in the league this season. Hill was originally drafted by the San Antonio Spurs (1st rd., 26th overall) in 2008.

He's played for the Spurs (2008-11), Indiana Pacers (2011-16), Utah Jazz (2016-17), Sacramento Kings (2017-18), Cleveland Cavaliers (2018) and Milwaukee Bucks (2018-pres.). He's played in more than 700 regular season games, making nearly 450 career starts and averaging 11.2 points per game in his NBA career.

Entering this season, he's played in 117 career playoff games, starting 90 times and averaging 12.3 points per game.

THE LAST MEETING - WRIGHT STATE 71, IUPUI 56 (Mar. 5, 2019 - DAYTON, OHIO)

JAGS SPUTTER IN #MOTORCITYMAD-NESS OPENER AT WRIGHT STATE

DAYTON, Ohio (Mar. 5, 2019) - The IUPUI basketball team picked an inopportune time for its worst offensive showing of the year as the No. 8 seeded Jaguars put up little resistance in a lopsided 71-56 loss to top-seeded Wright State in the quarterfinals round of the Horizon League Tournament on Tuesday night (Mar. 5). IUPUI was listless from the outset and finished at just 36 percent overall and 4-of-21 (19 percent) from three-point range.

Bill Wampler led Wright State (20-12) with 18 points off the bench and first team all-league center Loudon Love closed with 13 points and nine boards on the inside. Skylear Potter and Malichi Smith combined on 23 points as well off the Wright State bench. Horizon League Sixth Man of the Year Jaylen Minnett was the lone IUPUI (16-16) player to finish in double-figures with 17 points. Senior D.J. McCall added nine points and six rebounds and Grant Weatherford grabbed nine boards in the loss.

"We just didn't come out and play the way we should or the way we're supposed to in the beginning. We didn't make shots and just kind of fell into a hole again against them. (Wright State) is a good team and they took advantage of it and really put pressure on us early," head coach Jason Gardner said. "I honestly think we're a better team than what we showed out there tonight, but that's part of it."

"We haven't played great down the stretch of the season and tonight was the same thing. We didn't make shots and we missed some assignments and you can't go on the road against a good team like Wright State and win when you don't play your best."

It took the Jaguars more than 30 minutes to make a trey and by the time Minnett rattled in a contested triple, the Jags were on the wrong side of a 26-point margin.

IUPUI was punchless offensively for much of the first half, trailing by as many as 19 late in the half after Wampler hit a contested wing three with 1:25 left before the break. The Jags showed a glimmer of life to close the half, scoring the final six points of the stanza, all on Justice free throws. IUPUI shot just 6-of-22 (27.3 percent) from the floor and was 0-of-8 from three-point range while turning the ball over nine times against just one assist. Wampler (14 points) and Love (nine points) combined to outscore the Jags before halftime, hitting a combined 9-of-14 from the floor. Wampler was deft from deep, connecting on 4-of-5 three-point attempts before intermission.

The knockout punch came right out of the gates in the second half as Wright State scored the first nine points after the break. IUPUI piled up defensive stops in the early going, but didn't get on the board until McCall went down the lane for a two-handed dunk with 14:54 to play.

Even when IUPUI had positive plays, they seemed to come with unfortunate results. Just before halftime, Evan Hall had a trademark turnaround result hit softly off the backboard and then inexplicably pop out, ultimately resulting in a run out the other direction. Junior Camron Justice had a tough spinning reverse do nearly the same thing early in the second half.

On one defensive trip, senior center Ahmed Ismail blocked a shot with such authority that it turned into an almost perfect kickout pass to a wide open Wampler in the corner. Fortunately for the Jags, Wampler missed his lone three-point attempt of the second half and was unable to add insult to injury.

Byron Rimm II was named the program's interim head coach for the 2019-2020 season on Aug. 27, 2019, becoming the ninth head coach in program history. He originally joined the IUPUI program in October 2018 as the Jaguars' associate head coach.

In his first season on the Jaguars' sidelines, IUPUI's 16 wins were the program's most since a 19-win campaign in 2010-

11. Included in the wins was a benchmark road win at ACC foe Boston College and a win of the Niagara Regional of the Fort Myers Tip-Off Classic during non-conference play. The Jaguars were later selected to play in the 2019 CIT, earning the program's third postseason appearance in the Division I era.

Rimm has an extensive background in college basketball including having served as head coach at Prairie View A&M from 2006-15. During his time with the Panthers, the program ascended to new heights, including back-to-back appearances in the SWAC tournament championship game in 2013 and 2014. Before Prairie View, the Pensacola, Fla.-native gained valuable experience on the West Coast, which included assistant coaching stops at Pasadena City College and Chaffey Community College from 1997-2000.

He directed Cal State San Bernardino to a No. 3 national ranking in NCAA Division II during the 2000 campaign and then took over the reins as the head women's basketball coach at Texas College in Tyler, Texas, guiding the team to a 20-12 mark in his lone season. At the time, the 20-12 mark was the most successful season in program history. He then had a four-year run as the head men's coach with Jarvis Christian College before joining Prairie View A&M as an assistant for the 2005-06 season. He was promoted to the head coaching spot the following season at age 32.

He coached Prairie View A&M to winning seasons in 2008-09 and 2009-10 and won 115 games during his time as head coach. His 2014 squad boasted the highest APR ranking among SWAC teams and also registered the best score in program history.

Since then, Rimm has served as the director of basketball operations at Texas A&M Corpus Christi in 2016-17 and as an assistant at UC Riverside in 2017-18.

Rimm played at Ventura College and California State University Los Angeles before earning his degree from Cal State, Los Angeles in 1999. He earned his master's degree in education from American InterContinental University in 2005.
