### QUICK HITTERS

- Both **Jaylen Minnett** (4th - 85 total) and **Marcus Burk** (12th - 74 total) rank among the nation's elite in total 3s made. The duo is tops nationally for combined 3s made (159), one ahead of the UTSA tandem of Jhivvan Jackson and Keaton Wallace (158). Minnett owns the nation's second-longest active streak for games with a three made, having connected for at least one in 61 straight games, dating back to the end of his freshman year. Minnett tallied his 1,000th career point against Green Bay on Feb. 6 as part of a career-high 32 point effort, becoming the 24th member in school history and 16th to do so in three seasons or less.
- Junior **Elyjah Goss** has emerged as a monster on the glass, including grabbing a school record 21 rebounds against IU South Bend on Dec. 10, surpassing the previous mark by a single board. Goss ranks No. 5 nationally at 11.5 rebounds per game and is No. 1 nationally in total rebounds (291). He has led IUPUI in rebounding in 22 of 25 games, including 18-in-a-row entering today's contest. In league play, he's averaging a league best 14.1 per game.
- Junior **Marcus Burk** tallied his 1,000th collegiate point in the first half of the Jaguars' win over Purdue Fort Wayne. Burk tallied 776 in his two seasons at Campbell and has 516 this season, giving him 1,292 career points. Burk was recently named the Horizon League Nike Player of the Week after averaging 32.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game, including a career-high 39 points (12-24 FG, 8-15 3's, 7-10 FT) in the overtime win at Oakland on Saturday (Jan. 25).
- IUPUI is coming off a 16-17 campaign, having made the program's third postseason berth during the Division I era by earning a spot in the 2019 College Insider Tournament. The Jaguars' 16 wins were the program's most since going 19-14 in the 2010-11 in head coach Ron Hunter's final season at IUPUI.
- Head Coach **Byron Rimm II** took over on an interim basis earlier this year, replacing Jason Gardner, who spent five years at the helm of the program. Rimm boasts 14 years of head coaching experience, including 10 years at Prairie View A&M from 2006-2016 as he racked up 115 victories and is the program's all-time winningest head coach. He originally joined the Jaguars' staff just prior to last season as IUPUI's Associate Head Coach.
- IUPUI has players from nine different states/provinces this season, with five hailing from the Hoosier State. All total, IUPUI has players this year from Indiana, Illinois, Minnesota, New Jersey, North Carolina, Ohio, Ontario, Texas and Utah.

## NEWS, NOTES & STORYLINES

### LOTS O' KIDS

IUPUI packed in more than 2,000 third-graders at Thursday's 3rd annual NCAA 'Readers Are Leaders' game to celebrate a yearlong partnership and commitment to reading. IUPUI is now 2-1 in the 'Readers Are Leaders' games and have upped the attendance number in each of the three years. Below are the results from the three events.

### NATIONAL LEADERS

Entering this week, IUPUI boasts some big time numbers on a national scale, including the nation's top three-point shooting backcourt and rebounder.

-The backcourt duo of Jaylen Minnett (85) and Marcus Burk (74) have combined to make more threes than any other tandem in the country at 159, one ahead of the UTSA duo of Jhivvan Jackson (92) and Keaton Wallace (66).

-Junior Elyjah Goss is tops in the nation, having collected 291 rebounds this season, two ahead of Drexel's James Butler's 289. He ranks No. 5 nationally (tops in the HL) with 11.5 rebounds per game.

-In addition, Minnett owns the nation's 2nd longest active streak (Horizon League record and t-6th all-time longest in NCAA D1 history) of games with at least one three made at 61 straight games.

### SEEING 30-30

The IUPUI duo of Marcus Burk and Jaylen Minnett have hit some rare air on two different occasions this season, each scoring 30 points in a single-game twice this season. The feat has been accomplished just three times all year, and twice by IUPUI's top scorers.

Jan. 23 - Austin Peay vs. Tennessee St. - Terry Taylor (37 pts) & Jordyn Adams (37 pts)

Jan. 25 - IUPUI at Oakland - Marcus Burk (39 pts) & Jaylen Minnett (30 pts)

Feb. 6 - IUPUI vs. Green Bay - Marcus Burk (33 pts) & Jaylen Minnett (32 pts)

It marked the first time in the program's Division I era (1998-present) that two IUPUI players tallied 30 or better in the same game.

### BURK HONORED

Not unexpectedly, Burk earned his second Nike #HLMBB Player of the Week award on Jan. 27 after averaging 32 points, 6.5 rebounds and 3 assists per game and connecting on 13 threes in two contests last week. Burk's 39 points at Oakland were the most by a Horizon League player this season and it came on the heels of his first career double-double at Detroit Mercy on Thursday, when he totaled 25 points and 10 boards.

### DUELING DOUBLE-DUBS

Both Marcus Burk (25 pts, 10 reb) and Elyjah Goss (15 pts, 12 reb), had double-doubles in the Jan. 23 loss at Detroit Mercy. It marked the 1st time two IUPUI players had a double-double in the same game since Jan. 2, 2014 when Donovan Gibbs (32 pts, 11 reb) and Khufu Najee (11 pts, 11 reb) both had double-doubles in a win over Judson.

### BETTER THAN ALL THE REST

IUPUI's early season win at South Florida (70-53 on Nov. 13) was widely considered the best non-conference victory by a Horizon League team this season. The Jags entered play as a 17-point underdog before defeating the AAC foe by 17 points. In addition, it was IUPUI's first-ever victory over an AAC opponent in program history.

### IN LEAGUE PLAY

Through 12 Horizon League games, here are some numbers that jump out.

-Offensively, IUPUI is ranked fourth in the league in scoring at 75.3 points per game, but yielding a league-worst 82.6 points per game. Foes are shooting 45.1 percent against the Jags and a league-best 39.9 percent from three-point range and averaging 9.6 made threes per game.

-Burk leads the league in scoring at 22.8 points per game while Minnett is third at 19.4 points per game. Minnett leads the league in threes made (3.9/game) and three-point percentage (37.9%) while Burk is second in percentage (34.4%) and third in makes (2.8/game). Goss leads the league in rebounding at 14.1 rebounds per game and with six double-doubles.

-Freshman Mike DePersia has 42 assists against just 14 turnovers in league games and is second in the league with a 3.00 assist-to-turnover ratio. As a team, IUPUI has 187 assists against 154 turnovers for a 1.21 a/to ratio, ranking fourth best in the league. However, IUPUI opponents have a robust 1.46 a/to ratio in league games.

-Four IUPUI players - Burk (3rd - 37.3), Weatherford (4th - 36.8), Minnett (5th - 36.3) and Goss (7th - 35.3) - rank among the league's top 10 in minutes played in league play.

### THE BEST ABILITY...

...is availability. IUPUI players have struggled to stay healthy and available this season as only five players - Burk, Minnett, DePersia, Goss and Weatherford - have played all 25 games. Redshirt freshman Marlon Taylor is the only other IUPUI player who has been available for all 25 games.

### MR. 1,000

Junior Marcus Burk netted his **1,000 collegiate point** in the Dec. 14 win over Purdue Fort Wayne with a three-point play at the 12:57 mark of the first half. Burk, an Indianapolis-native, tallied 776 in two seasons at Campbell and now has 516 this

### BASKETBALL CENTRAL

IUPUI will be a big part of the center of the college basketball universe this March as the 2020 Horizon League Championships will be played at the Indiana Farmers Coliseum on Mar. 9-10 and the department will later serve as institutional co-host of an NCAA Men's Basketball Regional at Lucas Oil Stadium on Mar. 26-28, alongside the Horizon League and Indiana Sports Corporation.

Both the men's and women's Horizon League Semifinals (Mar. 9) and Championship games (Mar. 10) will be played at Indiana Farmers Coliseum as 2020 marks the first of a three-year rotation.



season, giving him 1,292 in his collegiate career.

Here are some more tidbits on Burk:

-Burk has been IUPUI's top offensive player all season, ranking No. 2 in the Horizon League in scoring (20.6 ppg) and third in the league in threes made (3.00/gm). He also ranks tops in the league in three-point percentage at 38.7 percent.

-Burk has three 30-point games this season, including a career-high 39 at Oakland (12-24 FG, 8-15 3's, 7-10 FT) on Jan. 25.

-While Burk is averaging just over 20 points per game, no IUPUI player has averaged 20 points per game for an entire season since Alex Young averaged 20.4 points per game in 2011-12. Only three players - Odell Bradley (23.1, 2003-04), George Hill (21.5, 2007-08) and Young (20.4, 2011-12) - have averaged better than 20 points per game during the Jaguars' Division I era.

### NO. 0 HITS 1,000

Junior Jaylen Minnett became the 24th player in program history to achieve 1,000 career points in an IUPUI uniform on Feb. 6 as part of a career-high 32-point effort. Minnett enters today's game with 1,016 career points and would be the 16th player to achieve the mark in three seasons or less.

He's also recently moved into third on the program's all-time list in threes made:

Minnett made at least one trey in all 33 games last season and the final three games of the 2017-18 season... the last time Minnett went without a three in a game was against Oakland on Feb. 19, 2018 when he was held without a triple in 14 minutes.

-Minnett's 78 3's made last season was the 7th-highest single-season total in IUPUI history and his 85 this season is the fifth-most in school history.

-His 7.1 ppg scoring average as a freshman in 2017-18 was the highest by an IUPUI rookie since Alex Young average 10.8 points per game in 2008-09.

-His 51 made 3's in 2017-18 were the most by an IUPUI freshman in the program's Division I era (1998-present).

### MR. WINDEX

Junior Elyjah Goss currently **leads the Horizon League** and ranks No. 6 nationally in rebounding at 11.5 per contest. He owns five of the seven highest single-game totals in the Horizon League this season, including grabbing a school record 21 against IUSB (Dec. 10), 18 against Youngstown State (Dec. 28) and at Oakland (Jan. 25) and 17 rebounds twice. His 21 boards against IUSB is tied for the fourth-highest single-game total in NCAA Division I this season.

All total, Goss has led the Jaguars in rebounds in 22 of the team's 25 games and 18-in-a-row.

Five games into this season, he was averaging 6.0 rebounds per game, but has since grabbed at least 10 boards in 16 of the Jaguars' 20 games.

In league play, Goss leads the league in rebounding (14.1 rpg) and has seven double-doubles in 12 games and grabbed double-digit boards in every league contest.

Goss now has 13 career double-doubles, including 10 this season.

### SPLASH BROTHERS

IUPUI's version of the Splash Brothers - Marcus Burk and Jaylen Minnett - is on pace to reach unpreceded heights.

Burk leads the league in percentage (38.7%) and is third in threes made at 3.0/game. Minnett is second in threes made (3.4/game) and three-point percentage (36.6%). By hitting a combined 6.4 threes/game, the duo is tops in the league and **leads the country with 159 combined makes**.

Burk is fifth among active juniors (36th among all players) in college basketball with 232 career treys and Minnett is seventh on that list (55th overall) with 214 makes.

### TOP GUNS

Burk and Minnett are accounting for the bulk of the Jaguars' offense, having taken 52 percent of the team's field goal attempts (778 of 1503) and 74 percent of the team's three-point attempts (423 of 574). In addition, the duo has accounted for 53 percent (924 of 1751) of the team's total points.

### STORY TELLER

In IUPUI's six wins this season, the Jags have held opponents to 37 percent shooting overall and 28 percent from three-point range while making 7.7 threes per game.

In the Jaguars' 19 losses, foes have shot 48 percent overall and 39 percent from beyond the arc while making 9.3 threes per game. Nine of the 19 opponents to have beaten the Jags have shot 50 percent or better from the floor.

### FREEBIES

IUPUI enters play ranked 326th of 350 teams in free throw percentage at 64.4 percent, which is on pace to be the lowest mark in the program's Division I era. The current low mark was a 65.4 percentage for the 2008-09 season. The lowest single-season

mark on record in program history was a 62.7 percentage in the 1976-77 campaign.

### ...HOWEVER

Since the Dec. 28 Youngstown State loss in which IUPUI made just 12-of-28 (42.9 percent) at the foul line, IUPUI has been efficient at the stripe. Since then, IUPUI is a combined 167-of-235 (71 percent) in the last 11 games.

### FULL 40

Junior Jaylen Minnett's 40-minute effort at Green Bay on Jan. 5 was the first full 40 posted by an IUPUI player in a non-overtime game since Marcellus Barksdale played all 40 minutes at Western Illinois on Mar. 1, 2014.

### STARTERS DOING IT ALL

Head coach Byron Rimm has shown a reluctance to delve too deeply into his bench as IUPUI reserves accounted for just 10.2 points per game this season. IUPUI is getting less than 15 percent of its points from reserves and has had 12 games in which the bench has provided fewer than 10 points. The IUPUI bench has outscored the opposition's just twice this season.

The Jags' bench has scored a season-high 19 points on three different occasions.

### GRADE CHECKS

Six different Jaguars posted a grade point average of 3.0 or better during the fall - Mike DePersia, Elijah Goss, Brandon Kenyon, Sawyer Stoltz, Grant Weatherford and Taveion White. Weatherford, who is pursuing his Master's degree in Organizational Leadership, had the team's top GPA for the fall at 3.67. Kenyon and Weatherford were recently named to the Horizon League's Academic Honor Roll for the fall semester.

### LARGE CLASS

IUPUI entered the season with an eight-man junior class eligibility wise, tying for the eighth largest class in all of college basketball. Below are the lists of largest classes.

### FAMILY TIES

-DePersia comes from a notable basketball family in the state of New Jersey and he and his brothers - twins Rob and Nick - are one of just four sets of siblings in NJ high school basketball history to have all scored 1,000 points in their high school careers. DePersia led his Haddonfield squad to back-to-back state titles his junior and senior seasons. His two brothers went on to play collegiately at Rowan University and were named the Albert Carino Boys Basketball Club of South Jersey Small College Players of the Year last April while playing for former Penn State standout Joe Crispin. Rob recently joined the Villanova program as a graduate assistant.

-Kemp's older brother is a WR with the Kansas City Chiefs, Marcus Kemp. Kemp played at the University of Hawaii and is now in his second season with the Chiefs, having joined the team as an undrafted free agent in 2017.

### PRO NOTES

In addition to the success that former IUPUI Jaguar George Hill is continuing to have in his 12th NBA season, IUPUI presently has seven former players playing professionally all over the world.

### AT THE HORN

### 21 UP

Last February, Hall of Famer Matt Crenshaw became just the 3rd player in school history to have his jersey retired, joining #34 Carlos Knox and #3 George Hill, in the rafters.

Crenshaw finished as the program's all-time leader in assists and hit the game-winning shot in the 2003 Mid-Continent Conference Tournament to send IUPUI to the NCAA Tournament. He later played overseas and returned to IUPUI as a longtime member of the coaching staff before joining the Ball State coaching staff just prior to the start of last season.

Hill was among those to attend the festivities.



### HUNTER TO THE HALL

Longtime IUPUI head coach Ron Hunter was inducted as part of the Jaguars' Hall of Fame Class of 2019 last February.

Hunter, now the head coach at Tulane University, guided the IUPUI basketball program from 1994-2011 and is the program's all-time leader in wins (275), winning percentage (.557), games coached (494), winning seasons (11) and 20-win seasons (4). He guided IUPUI to its only ever NCAA Division I NCAA Tournament appearance in 2003. Led by future NBAer George Hill, his 2007-08 team won a school record 26 games and two years later, his team went 25-11 and collected the program's first-ever Division I postseason win. He was a two-time league Coach of the Year and clearly elevated the program during his tenure.

He earned national acclaim for his work with Samaritan's Feet as the first in the country to coach a game in his bare feet in January 2008 to raise awareness for those in need. He later personally delivered shoes to individuals in Peru and Costa Rica. He collected numerous honors for his philanthropic work including being named a 2008 ABC News Person of the Year, the 2010 Indiana Pathfinder Award recipient and an NABC Guardians of the Game Pillar Award for Service.

## UNIVERSITY NOTES

### ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

IUPUI is a public research university located in downtown Indianapolis that is the result of a merger of the Purdue Indianapolis Extension Center (1946) and Indiana University Indianapolis (1916). The merger was completed in 1969 and athletics began in 1972.

The university offers more than 200 degree programs and boasts an enrollment over 30,000 (22,000 undergrad and 8,000 postgrad). The university also boasts an endowment of more than \$850 million.

The university is ranked among the Top 200 "National Universities" and ranked 7th for "Up and Coming Schools." U.S. News has ranked IUPUI among the nation's elite for 13 straight years.

All total, the campus covers 509 acres and is located along Indy's Cultural Trail.

IUPUI includes the nation's largest nursing school, the second largest medical school in the country, the only dental school in the state, and the country's oldest school of physical education. IUPUI is among the top 20 campuses in the nation for graduate professional degrees conferred

### ATHLETIC PROWESS

IUPUI was a primary beneficiary of the 1987 Pan-American Games in Indianapolis and continues to boast some world renowned facilities.

The IU Natatorium is located on the IUPUI campus and is among the best swimming & diving facilities in the world. It has hosted the U.S. Olympic Team Trials four different times and 12 NCAA National Championship meets. In addition, the 2017 World Juniors were held at IUPUI and 16 world records have been set in the Natatorium water.

Adjacent west is the Michael A. Carroll Track & Soccer Stadium which has hosted several USA Outdoor Track & Field Championships and NCAA Championships, along with the 1988 US Olympic Trials. Florence Griffith-Joyner set the 100m world record of 10.49 on the track.

In basketball circles, IUPUI is best known as the long-time host of the Nike All-American Camp, which was held on campus for two decades. The nation's top prep players and coaches from every level converged on campus for two weeks each summer in what was considered the elite college recruiting event of the year. Alum included Lebron James, Chris Webber, Allen Iverson, Kevin Garnett, Jason Kidd and Paul Pierce, among many others.

### GEORGE HILL

IUPUI's best known basketball alum is current NBAer George Hill, who is in his 12th year in the league this season. Hill was originally drafted by the San Antonio Spurs (1st rd., 26th overall) in 2008.

He's played for the Spurs (2008-11), Indiana Pacers (2011-16), Utah Jazz (2016-17), Sacramento Kings (2017-18), Cleveland Cavaliers (2018) and Milwaukee Bucks (2018-pres.). He's played in more than 700 regular season games, making nearly 450 career starts and averaging 11.2 points per game in his NBA career.

Entering this season, he's played in 117 career playoff games, starting 90 times and averaging 12.3 points per game.

### JAGUARS FALL AT MILWAUKEE DESPITE GOSS' MONSTER NIGHT

**MILWAUKEE, Wisc. (Jan. 3, 2020)** - Host Milwaukee closed with a 7-0 run, including a pair of go-ahead free throws from C.J. Wilbourne with 1:08 to play as the Panthers outlasted IUPUI, 78-74 inside Panther Arena on Friday night (Jan. 3). Milwaukee connected on 12-of-29 (41.4 percent) three-point attempts, six in each half, to fuel their attack.

Junior Elijah Goss finished with a career-high 19 points, 16 rebounds and six blocked shots for his fifth double-double of the season and Jaylen Minnett added 18 points in the loss. IUPUI (4-12, 0-3 HL) misfired on its final five field goal attempts of the contest, including Minnett's potential game tying layup on the Jaguars' final possession of the game.

"We're right there," head coach Byron Rimm II said. "It's just where it comes down to one bad shot or one missed assignment and that's been the margin so far. We could just as easily be 3-0 at this point."

Goss helped give the Jaguars one final opportunity, drawing a charge from MKE's Te'jon Lucas with 23 seconds left to negate a bucket. Trailing 76-74 with 21 seconds left, the Jaguars ultimately turned to Minnett on their final offensive possession. The Jaguars' second-leading scorer beat his opponent off the dribble, but was unsuccessful as his attempt went long. Isaiah Williams was called for a foul going for the offensive rebound, allowing MKE's Darius Roy to set the final margin at the free throw line.

"From every single game, it's been simple, small pieces that we can take - one game it was free throws and tonight it was transition defense," Goss said. "We're pretty much there. It's early in conference play. It's hard because they've been such tough, close losses, but we're going to figure this out and go on a little run (of wins)."

Josh Thomas staked MKE to a 71-70 lead with a trey with 3:09 remaining, only to see Marcus Burk retaliate with a jumper just inside the arc. Minnett extended the Jaguars' lead to 74-71 at the foul line with 2:32 left, but it would be IUPUI's final counters of the night.

DeAndre Abram tied the score at 74 all with a wing three and Minnett missed on a potential go-ahead drive with 1:24 left. The Jags nearly secured the offensive rebound as Mike DePersia came charging in to try and gather the loose ball, but lost his footing in front of the IUPUI bench to give the Panthers possession.

IUPUI (4-12, 0-3 HL) got an initial stop as Roy misfired on a contested jumper, but Wilbourne was fouled underneath as he was jostled for position for the offensive board, leading to the go-ahead free throws. Milwaukee was just 4-of-10 from the free throw line before hitting their final four of the night in the final 68 seconds to ice the win.

The Jaguars used a 13-0 run in the first half to build a 31-20 lead with 4:29 left before halftime. Minnett fueled the burst with a pair of triples, while Williams also scored three points during the run. The damage could have been deeper for the Jags as Burk got loose for a fast break, but lost the handle as he attempted a layup, leading to a Milwaukee transition opportunity. Roy cashed in at the other end, converting a three-point play to stop the Jaguars' run. Milwaukee ultimately outscored IUPUI 14-6 over the final four minutes of the half to cut the Jags' lead to 37-34 by intermission.

IUPUI finished at 44 percent from the floor, but just 2-of-13 (15.4 percent) from three-point range. Minnett finished at 2-of-7 with both makes coming during the first half run, while Burk was held 0-of-4 in a 15-point effort. Williams closed with six points and three boards and Mike DePersia added four points, five boards and a career-high five assists off the bench. The Jags were without Jamil Jackson Jr., who missed the game due to illness, limiting Rimm's rotation to seven players.

Goss continued to impress of late, giving him two double-doubles in the Jaguars' first three league games.

"This year, I've just come in with a new aggressive mindset," Goss said. "I can just grab every single rebound possible and just help my team with the small things, whether it's rebounding, scoring points in the paint, defending the basket or whatever the team needs, that's why I'm here."

IUPUI outscored Milwaukee 46-28 in the paint as the 46 points in the paint were easily a season-high.

Thomas led Milwaukee with 13 points and Arturro Bingham added 12, hitting 4-of-5 three-point attempts. Lucas closed with 11 points, six boards, six assists and six steals and Roy added 10 points. ## HEAD COACH BYRON RIMM II



**Byron Rimm II** was named the program's interim head coach for the 2019-2020 season on Aug. 27, 2019, becoming the ninth head coach in program history. He originally joined the IUPUI program in October 2018 as the Jaguars' associate head coach.

In his first season on the Jaguars' sidelines, IUPUI's 16 wins were the program's most since a 19-win campaign in 2010-

11. Included in the wins was a benchmark road win at ACC foe Boston College and a win of the Niagara Regional of the Fort Myers Tip-Off Classic during non-conference play. The Jaguars were later selected to play in the 2019 CIT, earning the program's third postseason appearance in the Division I era.

Rimm has an extensive background in college basketball including having served as head coach at Prairie View A&M from 2006-15. During his time with the Panthers, the program ascended to new heights, including back-to-back appearances in the SWAC tournament championship game in 2013 and 2014. Before Prairie View, the Pensacola, Fla.-native gained valuable experience on the West Coast, which included assistant coaching stops at Pasadena City College and Chaffey Community College from 1997-2000.

He directed Cal State San Bernardino to a No. 3 national ranking in NCAA Division II during the 2000 campaign and then took over the reins as the head women's basketball coach at Texas College in Tyler, Texas, guiding the team to a 20-12 mark in his lone season. At the time, the 20-12 mark was the most successful season in program history. He then had a four-year run as the head men's coach with Jarvis Christian College before joining Prairie View A&M as an assistant for the 2005-06 season. He was promoted to the head coaching spot the following season at age 32.

He coached Prairie View A&M to winning seasons in 2008-09 and 2009-10 and won 115 games during his time as head coach. His 2014 squad boasted the highest APR ranking among SWAC teams and also registered the best score in program history.

Since then, Rimm has served as the director of basketball operations at Texas A&M Corpus Christi in 2016-17 and as an assistant at UC Riverside in 2017-18.

Rimm played at Ventura College and California State University Los Angeles before earning his degree from Cal State, Los Angeles in 1999. He earned his master's degree in education from American InterContinental University in 2005.
