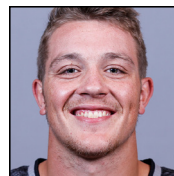
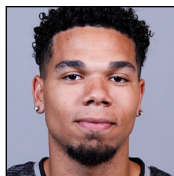

QUICK HITTERS

- IUPUI is coming off a 16-17 campaign, having made the program's third postseason berth during the Division I era by earning a spot in the 2019 College Insider Tournament. The Jaguars' 16 wins were the program's most since going 19-14 in the 2010-11 in head coach Ron Hunter's final season at IUPUI.
- Head Coach **Byron Rimm II** took over on an interim basis earlier this year, replacing Jason Gardner, who spent five years at the helm of the program. Rimm boasts 14 years of head coaching experience, including 10 years at Prairie View A&M from 2006-2016 as he racked up 115 victories and is the program's all-time winningest head coach. He originally joined the Jaguars' staff just prior to last season as IUPUI's Associate Head Coach.
- IUPUI returns just five letterwinners and two starters (**Grant Weatherford** & **Elyjah Goss**) from last year's squad. 2019 Horizon League Sixth Man of the Year **Jaylen Minnett** (12.0 ppg, 78 3's) headlines the group of returners and likely slides into this year's starting five. Weatherford (6.2 ppg, 3.0 rpg) started all 33 games last season and Goss (6.8 ppg, 6.3 rpg) started 25 times last season before being slowed late in the season due to injury.
- IUPUI has players from 10 different states/provinces this season, with six hailing from the Hoosier State. All total, IUPUI has players this year from Indiana, Illinois, Minnesota, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Ontario, Texas and Utah.
- Among this year's group of newcomers is Campbell-transfer **Marcus Burk**, who is expected to immediately step into a starting role. Burk, a 6-foot-3 guard from Indianapolis, averaged 14.8 points per game and knocked down 91 3's as a sophomore at Campbell in 2017-18. He scored in double-digits 23 times and had three games of 30 points or better.
- Burk led the Jaguars with 31 points (9-18 FG, 4-6 3's, 9-11 FT), seven boards and six steals in the 81-77 exhibition win over Tiffin two weeks ago. Minnett was the only other IUPUI player to finish in double-digits with 18 points (6-12 FG, 4-9 3's, 2-3 FT) while **Jamil Jackson Jr.** added nine points and three boards off the bench.
- Graduate-transfer **Zo Tyson**, who is expected to play a major role on the interior for the Jaguars this season, missed the exhibition game due to injury. The 6-foot-9 Colorado State-transfer returned to practice last week and is expected to dress for the opener.

NEW LOOK JAGS

This year's IUPUI team has a decidedly new look - a new head coach, only five returners and a largely new coaching staff.

Head coach Byron Rimm II took over on an interim basis this past fall, taking over for Indianapolis-native Jason Gardner. Rimm, who is the winningest head coach in Prairie View A&M history with 115 career wins, became the ninth head coach in IUPUI history after taking over for Gardner.

He has 10+ years of Division I head coaching experience and helped PVAMU to winning records in 2008-09 and 2009-10.

Beside him, Rimm boasts two new assistants on the sidelines as well as Brian Burton joined the program from UTEP in November and Aaron Evans joined the program as Director of Operations from nearby Marian University over the summer. Evans took the spot of Isaac Loechle, who was promoted from Director of Operations to Assistant Coach last summer.

Rimm has already vowed to speed up the team's tempo from a season ago.

ROSTER ASSEMBLY

IUPUI brings back five letterwinners from a season ago, including two starters (Elyjah Goss & Grant Weatherford), the league's Sixth Man of the Year (Jaylen Minnett) and two reserves (Jakoby Kemp & Brandon Kenyon).

Two other transfers sat out last season and are now eligible (Marcus Burk & Jamil Jackson Jr.) and a third (Zo Tyson), joined the program as a graduate transfer.

The remaining members of the roster are all new faces in two JC-transfers (Zaire Swaby & Isaiah Williams), a redshirt freshman transfer who's immediately eligible (Marlon Taylor) and four true freshmen (Mike DePersia, Ty Kessinger, Sawyer Stoltz & Taveion White). Swaby will sit out the season, giving the Jaguars 14 in uniform on game days.

WHERE'D THEY GO?

IUPUI graduated the Horizon League's Defensive Player of the Year D.J. McCall, who's currently in Fort Wayne Mad Ants camp, vying for a spot in the G-League as a rookie. In addition, three-year starter Evan Hall also graduated on the inside, as did 7-foot-1 big man Ahmed Ismail.

The other key departure was second team All-Horizon League selection Camron Justice, who pursued a graduate transfer, and is now playing at Western Kentucky. The Jags also suffered two other defections at the start of the school year as local product Jack Hansen decided not to continue his college basketball career after appearing in 31 games last season.

The other came when highly touted freshman Calvin Temple opted to transfer to Louisiana at the start of the school year. Temple, a 6-foot-1 guard who was one of the top prep players from the state of Mississippi, practiced with the Jaguars during the summer before opting to transfer.

DEBUT OF 'ZO

While the numbers from the Butler game weren't pretty for the most part, Colorado State-transfer Zo Tyson had a solid debut off the Jaguars' bench.

The 6-foot-9 Tyson, who played just 49 total minutes and totaled 11 points in 13 games at Colorado State, had new career-highs in points (8), rebounds (5), minutes (27) and steals (3) at Butler. Tyson hit on 4-of-5 shots and also delivered two assists in his IUPUI debut.

SHORT BENCH

While Butler's short rotation was well documented in the season opener, Coach Rimm was also dealing with a less than healthy bunch as both Jamil Jackson Jr. and Jakoby Kemp missed the game due to injury/illness.

Down two healthy bodies, Rimm used just seven players with Marcus Burk, Mike DePersia, Zo Tyson and Isaiah Williams all making their IUPUI debuts, alongside returners Elyjah Goss, Jaylen Minnett and Grant Weatherford.

FAMILY TIES

-DePersia comes from a notable basketball family in the state of New Jersey and he and his brothers - twins Rob and Nick - are one of just four sets of siblings in NJ high school basketball history to have all scored 1,000 points in their high school careers. DePersia led his Haddonfield squad to back-to-back state titles his junior and senior seasons. His two brothers went on to play collegiately at Rowan University and were named the Albert Carino Boys Basketball Club of South Jersey Small College Players of the Year last April while playing for former Penn State standout

Joe Crispin. Rob recently joined the Villanova program as a graduate assistant.

-Kemp's older brother is a WR with the Kansas City Chiefs, Marcus Kemp. Kemp played at the University of Hawaii and is now in his second season with the Chiefs, having joined the team as an undrafted free agent in 2017.

MINNETT NOTES

Junior Jaylen Minnett, the 2019 Horizon League Sixth Man of the Year, is unlikely to be a repeat winner of the award as he'll almost assuredly assume a starting job this season. The 6-foot-1 Terre Haute-native, averaged 12.0 points per game and drilled 78 3's last season, while coming off the bench in all but the season finale.

Some other tidbits on Minnett include:

-He currently owns the nation's fourth-longest streak of consecutive games with at least one made three at 37 games... Minnett made at least one trey in all 33 games last season and the final three games of the 2017-18 season... the last time Minnett went without a three in a game was against Oakland on Feb. 19, 2018 when he was held without a triple in 14 minutes.

-Minnett enters play ranked ninth on IUPUI's all-time list with 130 made 3's in his career... his 78 3's made last season was the 7th-highest single-season total in IUPUI history.

-He could climb to No. 8 on IUPUI's all-time list in threes made tonight with a pair of makes... next in line ahead of him is Sean Esposito (132)... after that, he has some work to do to move up both Leroy Nobles and Akeem Clark are tied for the No. 6 spot with 186 makes each.

-His 7.1 ppg scoring average as a freshman in 2017-18 was the highest by an IUPUI rookie since Alex Young average 10.8 points per game in 2008-09.

-His 51 made 3's in 2017-18 were the most by an IUPUI freshman in the program's Division I era (1998-present).

BURK NOTES

The most anticipated new face on the Jaguars' roster this season is that of Indianapolis-native Marcus Burk, who sat out last season after transferring in from Campbell. The 6-foot-3 guard is an elite scorer, who averaged 15 points per game as a sophomore at Campbell while playing alongside current NBAer Chris Clemons.

In 69 games at Campbell, he averaged 11.2 points per game while connecting on 158 3's. He was named Big South Player of the Week on Nov. 27, 2017 after averaging 24.3 points per game during a four-game stretch. He and Clemons pulled a rare feat on Jan. 22, 2018 as each hit 10 3's in a win over Liberty, becoming the first duo to both hit 10 treys in a game.

Burk starred as a high schooler at nearby Franklin Central, where he averaged 25.3 points, 5.7 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game as a senior, earning a spot on The Indianapolis Star's Super Team.

GRADS

Two members of the IUPUI team have already completed their undergraduate work and are now pursuing Master's degrees. Grant Weatherford completed his undergraduate work last spring and is now pursuing a Master's degree and still has two years of eligibility ahead.

Colorado State-transfer Zo Tyson earned his degree this past summer and is now pursuing his Master's degree in Sports Journalism on the IUPUI campus.

LONG LAYOFFS

IUPUI's three key transfers are all coming off long layoffs, led by the break that Jamil Jackson Jr. has experienced.

Jackson's most recent game action was on Nov. 25, 2017 - nearly two years ago.

The Nov. 6 opener was Marcus Burk's first appearance since Mar. 22, 2018 while Zo Tyson's most recent game prior to the opener came on Feb. 20, 2019.

EXHIBITION NOTES

IUPUI squeaked past Tiffin University in the Jaguars' lone exhibition game, defeating the NCAA Division 2 squad, 81-77 on Oct. 23.

Burk led the way with 33 points while Minnett tossed in 18 in the victory. Elyjah Goss finished with eight points, 11 rebounds and four blocked shots and Jamil Jackson Jr. came off the bench with nine points in just 17 minutes. Four IUPUI starters - Burk, Minnett, Goss and Grant Weatherford - all played at least 33 minutes as the Jaguars limited to an eight-man rotation without Zo Tyson in uniform.

While Rimm was pleased with the win, some ugly numbers jumped off the stat sheet as well.

BASKETBALL CENTRAL

IUPUI will be a big part of the center of the college basketball universe this March as the 2020 Horizon League Championships will be played at the Indiana Farmers Coliseum on Mar. 9-10 and the department will later serve as institutional co-host of an NCAA Men's Basketball Regional at Lucas Oil Stadium on Mar. 26-28, alongside the Horizon League and Indiana Sports Corporation.

Both the men's and women's Horizon League Semifinals (Mar. 9) and Championship games (Mar. 10) will be played at Indiana Farmers Coliseum as 2020 marks the first of a three-year rotation.



NEWS, NOTES & STORYLINES (CONT.)

IUPUI committed 27 turnovers (20 from the starting five), leading to 32 Tiffin points off turnovers. The Jags also yielded 11 offensive boards and were outscored 10-2 on second chance points. The 27 turnovers and loss on the offensive glass allowed Tiffin to get nine more field goal attempts than the Jags.

The game included 12 ties and 12 lead changes.

OPENERS

IUPUI has dropped its last four season openers, all on the road, since winning a road opener at Indiana State (72-70 on Nov. 13, 2015).

Since then, IUPUI has dropped four straight season openers:

-Nov. 11, 2016 - Eastern Kentucky 97, IUPUI 87 (Richmond, Ky.)

-Nov. 11, 2017 - Bradley 68, IUPUI 53 (Peoria, Ill.)

-Nov. 6, 2018 - Xavier 82, IUPUI 69 (Cincinnati, Ohio)

-Nov. 6, 2019 - Butler 80, IUPUI 47 (Indianapolis, Ind.)

Since moving to the Division I level in 1998, IUPUI is 10-12 overall in season openers.

21 UP

Last February, Hall of Famer Matt Crenshaw became just the 3rd player in school history to have his jersey retired, joining #34 Carlos Knox and #3 George Hill, in the rafters.

Crenshaw finished as the program's all-time leader in assists and hit the game-winning shot in the 2003 Mid-Continent Conference Tournament to send IUPUI to the NCAA Tournament. He later played overseas and returned to IUPUI as a longtime member of the coaching staff before joining the Ball State coaching staff just prior to the start of last season.

Hill was among those to attend the festivities.



HUNTER TO THE HALL

Longtime IUPUI head coach Ron Hunter was inducted as part of the Jaguars' Hall of Fame Class of 2019 this past February.

Hunter, now the head coach at Tulane University, guided the IUPUI basketball program from 1994-2011 and is the program's all-time leader in wins (275), winning percentage (.557), games coached (494), winning seasons (11) and 20-win seasons (4). He guided IUPUI to its only ever NCAA Division I NCAA Tournament appearance in 2003. Led by future NBAer George Hill, his 2007-08 team won a school record 26 games and two years later, his team went 25-11 and collected the program's first-ever Division I postseason win. He was a two-time league Coach of the Year and clearly elevated the program during his tenure.

He earned national acclaim for his work with Samaritan's Feet as the first in the country to coach a game in his bare feet in January 2008 to raise awareness for those in need. He later personally delivered shoes to individuals in Peru and Costa Rica. He collected numerous honors for his philanthropic work including being named a 2008 ABC News Person of the Year, the 2010 Indiana Pathfinder Award recipient and an NABC Guardians of the Game Pillar Award for Service.

UNIVERSITY NOTES

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

IUPUI is a public research university located in downtown Indianapolis that is the result of a merger of the Purdue Indianapolis Extension Center (1946) and Indiana University Indianapolis (1916). The merger was completed in 1969 and athletics began in 1972.

The university offers more than 200 degree programs and boasts an enrollment over 30,000 (22,000 undergrad and 8,000 postgrad). The university also boasts an endowment of more than \$850 million.

The university is ranked among the Top 200 "National Universities" and ranked 7th for "Up and Coming Schools." U.S. News has ranked IUPUI among the nation's elite for 13 straight years.

All total, the campus covers 509 acres and is located along Indy's Cultural Trail. IUPUI includes the nation's largest nursing school, the second largest medical school in the country, the only dental school in the state, and the country's oldest school of physical education. IUPUI is among the top 20 campuses in the nation for graduate professional degrees conferred

ATHLETIC PROWESS

IUPUI was a primary beneficiary of the 1987 Pan-American Games in Indianapolis and continues to boast some world renowned facilities.

The IU Natatorium is located on the IUPUI campus and is among the best swimming & diving facilities in the world. It has hosted the U.S. Olympic Team Trials four different times and 12 NCAA National Championship meets. In addition, the 2017 World Juniors were held at IUPUI and 16 world records have been set in the Natatorium water.

Adjacent west is the Michael A. Carroll Track & Soccer Stadium which has hosted several USA Outdoor Track & Field Championships and NCAA Championships, along with the 1988 US Olympic Trials. Florence Griffith-Joyner set the 100m world record of 10.49 on the track.

In basketball circles, IUPUI is best known as the long-time host of the Nike All-American Camp, which was held on campus for two decades. The nation's top prep players and coaches from every level converged on campus for two weeks each summer in what was considered the elite college recruiting event of the year. Alum included LeBron James, Chris Webber, Allen Iverson, Kevin Garnett, Jason Kidd and Paul Pierce, among many others.

GEORGE HILL

IUPUI's best known basketball alum is current NBAer George Hill, who is in his 12th year in the league this season. Hill was originally drafted by the San Antonio Spurs (1st rd., 26th overall) in 2008.

He's played for the Spurs (2008-11), Indiana Pacers (2011-16), Utah Jazz (2016-17), Sacramento Kings (2017-18), Cleveland Cavaliers (2018) and Milwaukee Bucks (2018-pres.). He's played in more than 700 regular season games, making nearly 450 career starts and averaging 11.2 points per game in his NBA career.

Entering this season, he's played in 117 career playoff games, starting 90 times and averaging 12.3 points per game.

JAGS ROLL OVER BRADLEY, 85-73

INDIANAPOLIS (Nov. 28, 2018) - Junior Camron Justice scored 15 of his game-high 27 points at the foul line and Ahmed Ismail chipped in 13 points and five boards off the Jaguars' bench as IUPUI roared past Bradley, 85-73 inside Indiana Farmers Coliseum on Wednesday night (Nov. 28). IUPUI (5-2) extended the program's best start since the 2009 season by launching out to a 13-2 lead to start the game and staving off the Braves (6-2) every time they crept back in the game.

"I liked how we fired back at them every time they made it close," head coach Jason Gardner said. "That's what I was most proud of. We never backed down. We knew they were going to get some [defensive] stops and make their runs, but we answered every time. I think that shows a little bit of toughness on our part."

"It helps when you're playing at home, but you still have to go out and make plays. That's what it came down to and I liked how our guys did a good job of making plays."

Luuk van Bree had 18 points off the Bradley bench and Darrell Brown finished with 15 points and three assists.

IUPUI got the start it wanted, pounding the ball inside to Elyjah Goss and Evan Hall to start the game. The duo scored the team's first nine points before Grant Weatherford got on the board with a steal near midcourt that he turned into a three-point play in transition. The Jags added a bonus point when Justice swished a free throw after Bradley was called for an administrative technical when a player wearing a number other than what was in the scorebook. The Jaguars extended out to a 24-10 lead when Nick Rogers splashed a three, but Bradley fired back with a 15-0 run to take a 25-24 lead with 6:30 to play before halftime.

The Jags rebuilt a double-digit lead, largely behind Justice's hot shooting, before settling for a 44-38 lead at the break.

IUPUI pitched a shutout for nearly six minutes to start the second half, but only scored seven points of its own during that stretch to make it 51-38. The Braves closed within four with 8:55 to play after Elijah Childs split a pair of free throws, but the Jags stayed cool and received contributions from numerous sources down the stretch.

There was a Goss baseline layup off a brilliant D.J. McCall drive and dish. Grant Weatherford scored on a tough drive to the hole on which he thought he drew a foul as well.

Ismail and Justice combined on a five-point possession that all but sealed the deal with just under six minutes to play. Ismail dropped in a layup, drawing a foul on van Bree on the play. As the teams lined up for the ensuing free throw, BU's Childs was whistled for a technical for barking at an official. Justice stepped up and swished both freebies before Ismail capped the three-point play with a make of his own. The lead remained in double-figures for the rest of the night.

IUPUI shot 51 percent against a typically stingy Bradley defense, while holding the Braves to just 45 percent overall. IUPUI won the glass 32-30 and outscored the Braves 36-26 in the paint.

Ismail made 5-of-7 shots in close while Goss was 6-of-7 as part of a career-high 12 point scoring night. Hall closed with nine points on 4-of-6 shooting and Weatherford closed with eight points.



Byron Rimm II was named the program's interim head coach for the 2019-2020 season on Aug. 27, 2019, becoming the ninth head coach in program history. He originally joined the IUPUI program in October 2018 as the Jaguars' associate head coach.

In his first season on the Jaguars' sidelines, IUPUI's 16 wins were the program's most since a 19-win campaign in 2010-

11. Included in the wins was a benchmark road win at ACC foe Boston College and a win of the Niagara Regional of the Fort Myers Tip-Off Classic during non-conference play. The Jaguars were later selected to play in the 2019 CIT, earning the program's third postseason appearance in the Division I era.

Rimm has an extensive background in college basketball including having served as head coach at Prairie View A&M from 2006-15. During his time with the Panthers, the program ascended to new heights, including back-to-back appearances in the SWAC tournament championship game in 2013 and 2014. Before Prairie View, the Pensacola, Fla.-native gained valuable experience on the West Coast, which included assistant coaching stops at Pasadena City College and Chaffey Community College from 1997-2000.

He directed Cal State San Bernardino to a No. 3 national ranking in NCAA Division II during the 2000 campaign and then took over the reins as the head women's basketball coach at Texas College in Tyler, Texas, guiding the team to a 20-12 mark in his lone season. At the time, the 20-12 mark was the most successful season in program history. He then had a four-year run as the head men's coach with Jarvis Christian College before joining Prairie View A&M as an assistant for the 2005-06 season. He was promoted to the head coaching spot the following season at age 32.

He coached Prairie View A&M to winning seasons in 2008-09 and 2009-10 and won 115 games during his time as head coach. His 2014 squad boasted the highest APR ranking among SWAC teams and also registered the best score in program history.

Since then, Rimm has served as the director of basketball operations at Texas A&M Corpus Christi in 2016-17 and as an assistant at UC Riverside in 2017-18.

Rimm played at Ventura College and California State University Los Angeles before earning his degree from Cal State, Los Angeles in 1999. He earned his master's degree in education from American InterContinental University in 2005.
