QUICK HITTERS

- IUPUI is coming off a 16-17 campaign, having made the program's third postseason berth during the Division I era by earning a spot in the 2019 College Insider Tournament. The Jaguars' 16 wins were the program's most since going 19-14 in the 2010-11 in head coach Ron Hunter's final season at IUPUI.
- Junior **Marcus Burk** enters play ranked No. 7 nationally in scoring (23.6 ppg) and No. 3 in the country in threes made (4.14/game). Burk has scored 20-or-more in the Jags last five games.
- Head Coach **Byron Rimm II** took over on an interim basis earlier this year, replacing Jason Gardner, who spent five years at the helm of the program. Rimm boasts 14 years of head coaching experience, including 10 years at Prairie View A&M from 2006-2016 as he racked up 115 victories and is the program's all-time winningest head coach. He originally joined the Jaguars' staff just prior to last season as IUPUI's Associate Head Coach.
- IUPUI returns just five letterwinners and two starters (**Grant Weatherford** & **Elyjah Goss**) from last year's squad. 2019 Horizon League Sixth Man of the Year **Jaylen Minnett** (12.0 ppg, 78 3's) headlines the group of returners and has slid into this year's starting five. Weatherford (6.2 ppg, 3.0 rpg) started all 33 games last season and Goss (6.8 ppg, 6.3 rpg) started 25 times last season before being slowed late in the season due to injury.
- IUPUI has players from 10 different states/provinces this season, with five hailing from the Hoosier State. All total, IUPUI has players this year from Indiana, Illinois, Minnesota, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Ontario, Texas and Utah.
- IUPUI swept the Horizon League's weekly awards on Nov. 18 as junior guard **Marcus Burk** was named Player of the Week and **Mike DePersia** was named Freshman of the Week after leading the Jags to wins over Anderson and at South Florida. Burk averaged 25.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 2.0 assists per game while shooting 61 percent from the floor and 57.1 percent (8-of-14) from three. DePersia, who made his first two career starts during the week, averaged 4.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game while shooting 57 percent from the field.

SIGHTS & SOUNDS

- Tonight's game kicks off a home-and-home series between IUPUI and Evansville. The Jaguars are slated to return the trip to the Pocket City next season.

BURK'S BEEN BALLIN'

Junior Marcus Burk has been on a tear all season long, ranking No. 7 nationally in scoring (23.6 ppg) and No. 3 in the country in threes made per game (4.14/game). His current streak of five straight games of scoring 20-or-more is the longest by an IUPUI player since Robert Glenn did the same from Feb. 6-20, 2010.

Here are some more notes on Burk to start the season:

- Burk tallied a season-high 32 points (12-of-21 FG, 7-of-10 3's) against Loyola (Md.) on Monday night, falling one shy of his career-high 33 from his sophomore year at Campbell. Burk's 32 was the most by an IUPUI player since Darell Combs hit the same number against South Dakota on Feb. 25, 2016.

- Burk is averaging 13.4 points per game in the first half of games this season, while shooting 54 percent (19-of-35) from three-point range. He scored 23 points before halftime in the win over Anderson and also has first half totals of 17 at Loyola (Ill.) and 16 vs. Loyola (Md.) on Monday night (Nov. 25).

- While Burk is off to a hot start and averaging better than 20 points per game to start the year, no IUPUI player has averaged 20 points per game for an entire season since Alex Young averaged 20.4 points per game in 2011-12. Only three players - Odell Bradley (23.1, 2003-04), George Hill (21.5, 2007-08) and Young (20.4, 2011-12) - have averaged better than 20 points per game during the Jaguars' Division I era.

- Burk enters tonight with 941 points in his collegiate career - 776 in two seasons at Campbell and 165 in an IUPUI uniform.

SPLASH BROTHERS

IUPUI's version of the Splash Brothers - Marcus Burk and Jaylen Minnett - has been impressive to start the season, both ranking among the Horizon League's top five in both threes made and three-point percentage.

Burk leads the league in three per game (4.1) while Minnett is third in the league in the category (2.7). Burk leads in three-point percentage (46.8%) and Minnett is also among the top five at 34.5 percent. By hitting a combined 6.8 three/game, the duo is easily tops in the league for a tandem.

TOP GUNS

Burk and Minnett are accounting for the bulk of the Jaguars' offense through the season's first seven games, having taken 53 percent of the team's field goal attempts (210 of 400) and 76 percent of the team's three-point attempts (117-of-154). In addition, the duo has accounted for 54 percent (247 of 461) of the team's total points.

Burk (23.6 ppg) and Minnett (11.7 ppg) easily lead the team in scoring while Isaiah Williams is third at 8.1 ppg.

FINDING DUBS

While Burk has scored in double-digits in all seven games to start the season, the remainder of the IUPUI roster has just *eight double-digit scoring games combined*. Minnett has scored in double-figures four times, Elijah Goss has done so three times and Isaiah Williams has hit double-figures once.

MINNETT NOTES

Junior Jaylen Minnett, the 2019 Horizon League Sixth Man of the Year, is unlikely to be a repeat winner of the award as he's assumed a starting job this season. The 6-foot-1 Terre Haute-native, averaged 12.0 points per game and drilled 78 3's last season, while coming off the bench in all but the season finale.

Some other tidbits on Minnett include:

- He currently owns the nation's fourth-longest streak of consecutive games with at least one made three at 43 games... Minnett made at least one trey in all 33 games last season and the final three games of the 2017-18 season... the last time Minnett went without a three in a game was against Oakland on Feb. 19, 2018 when he was held without a triple in 14 minutes.

- Minnett enters play ranked eighth on IUPUI's all-time list with 148 made 3's in his career...he has some work to do to move up on the list as both Leroy Nobles and Akeem Clark are tied for the No. 6 spot with 186 makes each.

- His 78 3's made last season was the 7th-highest single-season total in IUPUI history.

- His 7.1 ppg scoring average as a freshman in 2017-18 was the highest by an IUPUI rookie since Alex Young average 10.8 points per game in 2008-09.

- His 51 made 3's in 2017-18 were the most by an IUPUI freshman in the program's Division I era (1998-present).

MR. DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Junior Elijah Goss notched his second double-double of the season on Monday night, notching a season-high 14 points (5-of-9 FG, 4-6 FT) and matching his career-high with 13 boards (6 offensive) against Loyola (Md.). Goss logged his fifth

career double-double and is the only active IUPUI player to own a collegiate double-double.

Goss has quietly upped his scoring (6.8 ppg to 7.1 ppg) and rebounding (6.3 rpg to 6.9 rpg), despite his minutes per game being slightly lower this season (22.9 mpg to 21.4 mpg).

SOUTHERN TIDBITS

Isaiah Williams scored 12 of his season-high 13 points (4-7 FG, 5-8 FT) in the first half of Tuesday's loss to Southern, to go along with six rebounds... senior Zo Tyson matched his season-high of eight points, while also posting new career-highs in rebounds (6) and blocked shots (3)... freshman Mike DePersia had a season-high seven points (2-4 FG, 3-5 FT) in 26 minutes... IUPUI led by as many as 10 in the first half and had a four-point halftime lead, but was outscored 45-35 in the second half... junior Jaylen Minnett made a three for a 43rd straight game, extending the nation's fourth-longest active streak.

STORY TELLER

In IUPUI's two wins this season, the Jags have held opponents to 34 percent shooting overall and 19 percent from three-point range.

In the Jaguars' four losses, foes have shot 54.9 percent overall and 43 percent from beyond the arc.

Four of the five opponents to have beaten the Jags have shot 50 percent or better from the floor and the fifth, Bradley, shot 47.8 percent in the win.

In the Jags' two wins - IUPUI held Anderson to just 32.4 percent shooting and South Florida to 37 percent.

NEW LOOK JAGS

This year's team has a decidedly new look - a new head coach, only five returners and a largely new coaching staff.

Head coach Byron Rimm II took over on an interim basis this past fall, taking over for Indianapolis-native Jason Gardner. Rimm, who is the winningest head coach in Prairie View A&M history with 115 career wins, became the ninth head coach in IUPUI history after taking over for Gardner.

He has 10+ years of Division I head coaching experience and helped PVAMU to winning records in 2008-09 and 2009-10.

Beside him, Rimm boasts two new assistants on the sidelines as well as Brian Burton joined the program from UTEP in November and Aaron Evans joined the program as Director of Operations from nearby Marian University over the summer. Evans took the spot of Isaac Loechle, who was promoted from Director of Operations to Assistant Coach last summer.

ROSTER ASSEMBLY

IUPUI brings back five letterwinners from a season ago, including two starters (Elijah Goss & Grant Weatherford), the league's Sixth Man of the Year (Jaylen Minnett) and two reserves (Jakoby Kemp & Brandon Kenyon).

Two other transfers sat out last season and are now eligible (Marcus Burk & Jamil Jackson Jr.) and a third (Zo Tyson), joined the program as a graduate transfer.

The remaining members of the roster are all new faces in two JC-transfers (Zaire Swaby & Isaiah Williams), a redshirt freshman transfer who's immediately eligible (Marlon Taylor) and three true freshmen (Mike DePersia, Sawyer Stoltz & Taveion White). Swaby will sit out the season, giving the Jaguars 13 in uniform on game days.

WHERE'D THEY GO?

IUPUI graduated the Horizon League's Defensive Player of the Year D.J. McCall, who's currently in Fort Wayne Mad Ants camp, vying for a spot in the G-League as a rookie. In addition, three-year starter Evan Hall also graduated on the inside, as did 7-foot-1 big man Ahmed Ismail.

The other key departure was second team All-Horizon League selection Camron Justice, who pursued a graduate transfer, and is now playing at Western Kentucky. The Jags also suffered two other defections at the start of the school year as local product Jack Hansen decided not to continue his college basketball career after appearing in 31 games last season.

The other came when highly touted freshman Calvin Temple opted to transfer to Louisiana at the start of the school year. Temple, a 6-foot-1 guard who was one of the top prep players from the state of Mississippi, practiced with the Jaguars during the summer before opting to transfer.

LARGE CLASS

IUPUI boasts an eight-man junior class eligibility wise, tying for the eighth largest class in all of college basketball. Below are the lists of largest classes.

BASKETBALL CENTRAL

IUPUI will be a big part of the center of the college basketball universe this March as the 2020 Horizon League Championships will be played at the Indiana Farmers Coliseum on Mar. 9-10 and the department will later serve as institutional co-host of an NCAA Men's Basketball Regional at Lucas Oil Stadium on Mar. 26-28, alongside the Horizon League and Indiana Sports Corporation.

Both the men's and women's Horizon League Semifinals (Mar. 9) and Championship games (Mar. 10) will be played at Indiana Farmers Coliseum as 2020 marks the first of a three-year rotation.

FAMILY TIES

-DePersia comes from a notable basketball family in the state of New Jersey and he and his brothers - twins Rob and Nick - are one of just four sets of siblings in NJ high school basketball history to have all scored 1,000 points in their high school careers. DePersia led his Haddonfield squad to back-to-back state titles his junior and senior seasons. His two brothers went on to play collegiately at Rowan University and were named the Albert Carino Boys Basketball Club of South Jersey Small College Players of the Year last April while playing for former Penn State standout Joe Crispin. Rob recently joined the Villanova program as a graduate assistant.

-Kemp's older brother is a WR with the Kansas City Chiefs, Marcus Kemp. Kemp played at the University of Hawaii and is now in his second season with the Chiefs, having joined the team as an undrafted free agent in 2017.

GRADS

Two members of the IUPUI team have already completed their undergraduate work and are now pursuing Master's degrees. Grant Weatherford completed his undergraduate work last spring and is now pursuing a Master's degree and still has two years of eligibility ahead.

Colorado State-transfer Zo Tyson earned his degree this past summer and is now pursuing his Master's degree in Sports Journalism on the IUPUI campus.

OPENERS

IUPUI has dropped its last four season openers, all on the road, since winning a road opener at Indiana State (72-70 on Nov. 13, 2015).

21 UP

Last February, Hall of Famer Matt Crenshaw became just the 3rd player in school history to have his jersey retired, joining #34 Carlos Knox and #3 George Hill, in the rafters.

Crenshaw finished as the program's all-time leader in assists and hit the game-winning shot in the 2003 Mid-Continent Conference Tournament to send IUPUI to the NCAA Tournament. He later played overseas and returned to IUPUI as a longtime member of the coaching staff before joining the Ball State coaching staff just prior to the start of last season.

Hill was among those to attend the festivities.



HUNTER TO THE HALL

Longtime IUPUI head coach Ron Hunter was inducted as part of the Jaguars' Hall of Fame Class of 2019 this past February.

Hunter, now the head coach at Tulane University, guided the IUPUI basketball program from 1994-2011 and is the program's all-time leader in wins (275), winning percentage (.557), games coached (494), winning seasons (11) and 20-win seasons (4). He guided IUPUI to its only ever NCAA Division I NCAA Tournament appearance in 2003. Led by future NBAer George Hill, his 2007-08 team won a school record 26 games and two years later, his team went 25-11 and collected the program's first-ever Division I postseason win. He was a two-time league Coach of the Year and clearly elevated the program during his tenure.

He earned national acclaim for his work with Samaritan's Feet as the first in the country to coach a game in his bare feet in January 2008 to raise awareness for those in need. He later personally delivered shoes to individuals in Peru and Costa Rica. He collected numerous honors for his philanthropic work including being named a 2008 ABC News Person of the Year, the 2010 Indiana Pathfinder Award recipient and an NABC Guardians of the Game Pillar Award for Service.

UNIVERSITY NOTES

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

IUPUI is a public research university located in downtown Indianapolis that is the result of a merger of the Purdue Indianapolis Extension Center (1946) and Indiana University Indianapolis (1916). The merger was completed in 1969 and athletics began in 1972.

The university offers more than 200 degree programs and boasts an enrollment over 30,000 (22,000 undergrad and 8,000 postgrad). The university also boasts an endowment of more than \$850 million.

The university is ranked among the Top 200 "National Universities" and ranked 7th for "Up and Coming Schools." U.S. News has ranked IUPUI among the nation's elite for 13 straight years.

All total, the campus covers 509 acres and is located along Indy's Cultural Trail.

IUPUI includes the nation's largest nursing school, the second largest medical school in the country, the only dental school in the state, and the country's oldest school of physical education. IUPUI is among the top 20 campuses in the nation for graduate professional degrees conferred

ATHLETIC PROWESS

IUPUI was a primary beneficiary of the 1987 Pan-American Games in Indianapolis and continues to boast some world renowned facilities.

The IU Natatorium is located on the IUPUI campus and is among the best swimming & diving facilities in the world. It has hosted the U.S. Olympic Team Trials four different times and 12 NCAA National Championship meets. In addition, the 2017 World Juniors were held at IUPUI and 16 world records have been set in the Natatorium water.

Adjacent west is the Michael A. Carroll Track & Soccer Stadium which has hosted several USA Outdoor Track & Field Championships and NCAA Championships, along with the 1988 US Olympic Trials. Florence Griffith-Joyner set the 100m world record of 10.49 on the track.

In basketball circles, IUPUI is best known as the long-time host of the Nike All-American Camp, which was held on campus for two decades. The nation's top prep players and coaches from every level converged on campus for two weeks each summer in what was considered the elite college recruiting event of the year. Alum included LeBron James, Chris Webber, Allen Iverson, Kevin Garnett, Jason Kidd and Paul Pierce, among many others.

GEORGE HILL

IUPUI's best known basketball alum is current NBAer George Hill, who is in his 12th year in the league this season. Hill was originally drafted by the San Antonio Spurs (1st rd., 26th overall) in 2008.

He's played for the Spurs (2008-11), Indiana Pacers (2011-16), Utah Jazz (2016-17), Sacramento Kings (2017-18), Cleveland Cavaliers (2018) and Milwaukee Bucks (2018-pres.). He's played in more than 700 regular season games, making nearly 450 career starts and averaging 11.2 points per game in his NBA career.

Entering this season, he's played in 117 career playoff games, starting 90 times and averaging 12.3 points per game.

EVANSVILLE RUNS AWAY FROM JAGUARS, 89-62

EVANSVILLE, Ind. (Dec. 6, 2014) - Host Evansville got 22 points from First Team All-Valley guard D.J. Balentine and shot 57 percent from the floor collectively as the Purple Aces coasted to an 89-62 win over IUPUI inside Ford Center on Saturday night (Dec. 6). Redshirt freshman Leo Svete finished with a team-high 17 points on 5-of-12 shooting in the loss and junior Mason Archie, II added 11 in the defeat.

The loss was IUPUI's (2-5) third straight while Evansville (6-1), ranked No. 15 in the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25, won for the sixth time in seven games to start the year and improved to 3-0 all-time against the Jaguars.

IUPUI led 9-8 in the early going when P.J. Boutte dropped in a tough layup, but the Jaguars' offense dried up from there, largely due to turnovers. The Purple Aces ripped off a 19-0 run over the game's next five-plus minutes before Archie snapped the spurt with a transition basket. Evansville started the run with two Jaylon Brown layups sandwiched around a Jaylon Moore layup, forcing Head Coach Jason Gardner to call timeout.

After the timeout, three more IUPUI miscues led to six more Evansville points before Balentine capped a wild possession with an open wing three after an initial shot was swatted by Justus Stanback. Evansville closed the half with a 40-16 lead, capped by back-to-back Adam Wing baskets before the break.

"Turnovers really cost us tonight. It took possessions away from us and led to their easy baskets," IUPUI Head Coach Jason Gardner said. "It wasn't just one or two guys either. They defended us well on the perimeter, but we still should've been able to do a better job of getting into our offense and getting looks. I thought we played tentative instead of attacking them."

"They're a good offensive team, but we gave them far too many easy shots with our turnovers."

Down 24 at the half, IUPUI never really challenged after intermission.

The Jaguars closed within 58-39 on a DavRon Williams layup with 10:38 to play, but Balentine answered back with an easy left-handed layup that became a three-point play. IUPUI shot 54 percent from the field in the second half, but never closed the gap as Evansville shot 59 percent after halftime.

Little used sub David Howard came off the UE bench to score a career-high 16 second half points, including hitting 8-of-11 free throws. Mislav Brzozja added 10 points, three boards and three assists and Egidijus Mockevicius just missed a double-double with nine points, 10 boards and four blocked shots.

Svete went 4-of-8 from downtown for his career-high 17 while Archie finished 5-of-8 from the floor for his third career double-digit scoring game. Boutte and Williams both finished with eight points and Elijah Ray grabbed six boards before fouling out. IUPUI finished with 19 turnovers, 15 of which came in the sloppy first half. Evansville ultimately turned the 19 IUPUI turnovers into 23 points.



Byron Rimm II was named the program's interim head coach for the 2019-2020 season on Aug. 27, 2019, becoming the ninth head coach in program history. He originally joined the IUPUI program in October 2018 as the Jaguars' associate head coach.

In his first season on the Jaguars' sidelines, IUPUI's 16 wins were the program's most since a 19-win campaign in 2010-

11. Included in the wins was a benchmark road win at ACC foe Boston College and a win of the Niagara Regional of the Fort Myers Tip-Off Classic during non-conference play. The Jaguars were later selected to play in the 2019 CIT, earning the program's third postseason appearance in the Division I era.

Rimm has an extensive background in college basketball including having served as head coach at Prairie View A&M from 2006-15. During his time with the Panthers, the program ascended to new heights, including back-to-back appearances in the SWAC tournament championship game in 2013 and 2014. Before Prairie View, the Pensacola, Fla.-native gained valuable experience on the West Coast, which included assistant coaching stops at Pasadena City College and Chaffey Community College from 1997-2000.

He directed Cal State San Bernardino to a No. 3 national ranking in NCAA Division II during the 2000 campaign and then took over the reins as the head women's basketball coach at Texas College in Tyler, Texas, guiding the team to a 20-12 mark in his lone season. At the time, the 20-12 mark was the most successful season in program history. He then had a four-year run as the head men's coach with Jarvis Christian College before joining Prairie View A&M as an assistant for the 2005-06 season. He was promoted to the head coaching spot the following season at age 32.

He coached Prairie View A&M to winning seasons in 2008-09 and 2009-10 and won 115 games during his time as head coach. His 2014 squad boasted the highest APR ranking among SWAC teams and also registered the best score in program history.

Since then, Rimm has served as the director of basketball operations at Texas A&M Corpus Christi in 2016-17 and as an assistant at UC Riverside in 2017-18.

Rimm played at Ventura College and California State University Los Angeles before earning his degree from Cal State, Los Angeles in 1999. He earned his master's degree in education from American InterContinental University in 2005.
