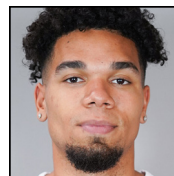
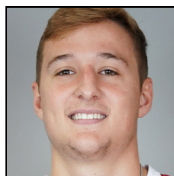

QUICK HITTERS

- With an early season 69-66 win over Tennessee St., IUPUI is seeking the program's first 2-0 start since 2009.
- IUPUI won the opener short-handed as senior guard **Jaylen Minnett** watched from the sidelines. The Jaguars expect to be at full strength entering this weekend. In Minnett's absence, the Jags got a typical effort from **Marcus Burk** (18 pts, 4 reb) and a strong showing from **Mike DePersia** (10 pts, 8 ast, 4 reb).
- Eight different Jaguars made their IUPUI debuts last against TSU with juniors **Bobby Harvey** (7 pts) and **Dimitar Pandev** (5 pts, 3 reb) each earning a starting nod. Freshman **Bakari LaStrap** (9 pts) and **Azariah Seay** (7 pts, 3 reb) keyed the reserves in the debuts as IUPUI reserves combined to score 22 points.
- The Jaguars 69 points were the fewest in a win since IUPUI defeated Milwaukee 67-60 on Feb. 22, 2019.
- The Jags enter the turn of the calendar having played just one game due to COVID concerns. The one game is among the nation's fewest - other teams to have played one game or less include Cal State Fullerton (1), Fordham (1), Alabama State (0), Merrimack (0), Siena (0), UMS (0) and the entire Patriot League (all have played 0).
- Be it just a one-game sample size, but senior forward **Elyjah Goss** leads the country in rebounding, having grabbed 16 in the opener. Goss averaged a Horizon League best 11.5 rebounds per game last season.
- IUPUI's core of returners is keyed by Burk, a preseason 1st team All-Horizon League pick, and Minnett, the program's all-time leader in threes made. Goss, who grabbed a school record 369 rebounds last season, was also named to the league's All-Defensive Team. Burk tested the NBA waters during the offseason before ultimately opting to return for his senior season. The two other returners are DePersia and **Sawyer Stoltz**.
- Burk and Minnett combine to be one of just four duos to have teamed to average at least 35 points per game last season. The pair averaged a combined 37.9 points per game last year and trail only UTSA's Jhivan Jackson & Keaton Wallace (45.6 ppg), Austin Peay's Terry Taylor & Jordyn Adams (39.2 ppg) and Iowa's Luka Garza & Joe Wieskamp (38.0 ppg).
- Minnett owns the fifth-longest streak of consecutive games with at least one three in NCAA Division I history, having made one in 68 straight games dating back to his freshman campaign. His streak is the second-longest active streak in Division I, trailing Eastern Illinois' Mack Smith, who sits at 88 and counting.

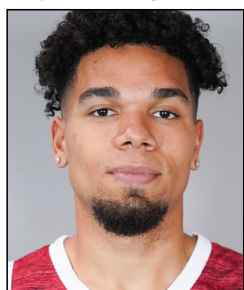

NEWS, NOTES & STORYLINES

FOR OPENERS

IUPUI opened the season with a win for the first time since 2015 and is vying for the program's first 2-0 start since 2009 today. IUPUI has opened 2-0 just nine times in the program's 49-year history and just twice (2003 & 2009) in the program's Division I era (1998-present).

NEW TEAM, NEW DREAM

-IUPUI needed just 69 points to defeat Tennessee State in the opener, marking the Jags' fewest in a win since beating Milwaukee 67-60 on Feb. 22, 2019.

-The Jags were outshot from the field as TSU shot 39 percent and IUPUI was held to just 37 percent. Last season, IUPUI was 1-23 overall in games in which it was outshot by its opponent.

-Last season's squad averaged just 10.0 points per game off the bench, but this year's club tallied 22 bench points in the opener with five different players contributing to that total.

THE NATION'S BEST

IUPUI may have only played one game thus far, so given the small sample size, they can say they lead *the nation* in blocked shots (7.0 bpg) and three-point percentage defense (17.6%).

Elyjah Goss leads the country in rebounding (16.0 rpg) and defensive rebounding (13.0 rpg) and ranks eighth nationally in blocked shots (3.0 bpg). Sophomore Mike DePersia is currently sixth in the country in assists (8.0 apg).

CLASS ACTS

IUPUI is coming off a banner semester in the classroom, achieving a 3.20 grade point average during the fall. Ten Jags (Carrasco, DePersia, Dhaliwal, Harvey, LaStrap, McClure, Pandev, Seay, Shirley and Stoltz) all posted a GPA of 3.0 or better, paced by McClure (3.93), Stoltz (3.75) and DePersia (3.66).

NO PLACE LIKE HOME...

...and no, we're not talking about the old '227' sitcom theme song or Glen Campbell classic. This marks the Jaguars seventh season at Indiana Farmers Coliseum since the facility's renovation and reopening and IUPUI boasts a 46-31 (.597) mark at the Fairgrounds since then. IUPUI went 9-2 at the Coliseum in 2015-16 and 11-4 in 2018-19.

More impressive is IUPUI's 21-6 (.778) home record in non-league games during that span with the losses coming to Indiana State (2014), Georgia State (2014), Eastern Kentucky (2014), SIUE (2017), Ball State (2018) and Evansville (2019).

BURK BALLIN'

Marcus Burk was one of five players voted to the Horizon League Preseason First Team before the season by the league's coaches, media and sports information personnel. Burk averaged 21.3 points per game last year and drained 93 3's in his first year with the program. He was a two-time Horizon League Player of the Week and entered his name into the NBA Draft during the offseason before ultimately returning to Indy for the 2020-2021 season.

Burk scored in double-digits in 29 of his 32 games last season, including hitting for 20-or-more 19 times. He topped 30 points on four different occasions, highlighted by a career-high 39 points in an overtime win at Oakland last season.

With Burk returning, it marks the first time IUPUI's top scorer from a season ago returned since Darel Combs returned in 2016-17 after leading the Jags in scoring at 16.3 points per game in 2015-16. Combs upped his output to 16.8 points per game as a senior in 2016-17.

Including his two years at Campbell before coming to IUPUI, Burk has totaled 1,476 points and 253 threes made in his collegiate career.

NAME TWO BETTER... WE'LL WAIT...

While IUPUI's roster is predominantly new faces, some of the returners already boast impressive credentials. At the top of the list is the high scoring, Hoosier raised duo of Marcus Burk and Jaylen Minnett. The duo is one of four in the country that returns to school after averaging at least a combined 35 points per game or better last season.

UTSA – Jhivan Jackson (26.8) & Keaton Wallace (18.8) = 45.6

Austin Peay – Terry Taylor (21.8) & Jordyn Adams (17.4) = 39.2

Iowa – Luka Garza (23.7) & Joe Wieskamp (14.0) = 38.0

IUPUI – Marcus Burk (21.3) & Jaylen Minnett (16.6) = 37.9

Burk's 21.3 points per game were the most by an IUPUI player since George Hill averaged 21.5 per game in 2007-08. Minnett connected for a school record 115 3's during the season and became the 24th player in school history to surpass 1,000 career points in an IUPUI uniform.

JAYL3N

Senior Jaylen Minnett became the 24th player in program history to achieve 1,000

career points in an IUPUI uniform against Green Bay on Feb. 6, 2020 as part of a career-high 32-point effort last season. He enters today's game with 1,140 career points, ranking No. 16 on the program's all-time list. He became the 16th player to hit for 1,000 points in three seasons or less in IUPUI history. Given his track record, he should move into the top 10 in career points midway through this unusual season. Below is a snippet of the program's all-time leading scorers and where Minnett sits.

Finally, Minnett owns the nation's **second-longest streak** of consecutive games with at least one made three at 68 games, **which is the fifth-longest in NCAA history**... Minnett made at least one trey in all 32 games last season and all 33 games of his sophomore campaign. He also hit threes in the final three games of the 2017-18 season... the last time Minnett went without a three in a game was against Oakland on Feb. 19, 2018 when he was held without a triple in 14 minutes.

BOOGIE BOARDS

Senior Elyjah Goss, known as E-Boogie on Twitter, was a monster on the glass last season, grabbing a school record 369 rebounds. He was voted to the Horizon League All-Defensive Team and his 11.5 boards per game were easily tops in the Horizon League and ranked sixth nationally. He entered this season fifth on the program's career rebounding list and is just 82 shy of matching Hall of Famer Don Carlisle's 769 career boards.

Goss owns six career games of 17 boards or more, including having grabbed a school record 21 in a game last year. He has 31 career double-digit rebound games and 15 career double-doubles. Last year he tied IUPUI's D1 record with 12 double-doubles in a season.

JERSEY MIKE DELIVERS

Sophomore Mike DePersia showed last year that he's a bona fide playmaker from the point guard spot. The New Jersey-native delivered an IUPUI Division I freshman record 85 assists in his 32 appearances and was a two-time Horizon League Freshman of the Week honoree. In Horizon League play, he averaged 3.2 assists per game and had a 3.05 assist-to-turnover ratio with 58 assists and just 19 turnovers.

In this year's opener, DePersia was pressed into a starting role and responded with 10 points, eight assists and four rebounds in 36 minutes of work.

DEBUTS

Of the 12 players who saw time in the Jaguars' opener, eight were making their IUPUI debuts, including juniors Bobby Harvey and Dimitri Pandev earning starts.

True freshman Bakari LaStrap (9 points) was incredibly impressive in his collegiate debut, including scoring his first career bucket with a steal and two-handed dunk in transition. LaStrap was on the floor down the stretch of the one-possession win over Tennessee State, sharing the ball-handling duties with DePersia. Here are some other numbers from some IUPUI players' debuts:

Harvey (7 pts), Pandev (5 pts, 3 reb), Nathan McClure (2 pts, 2 reb), Dimitri Georgiadis (2 pts, 2 reb), Azariah Seay (7 pts, 3 reb, 2-3 3's), Jonah Carrasco (2 pts, 1 reb) and Acton Shirley (3 min).

CAPTAINS

Head Coach Byron Rimm named four players captains for the 2020-2021 season - Marcus Burk, Mike DePersia, Elyjah Goss and Jaylen Minnett.

MOVIN' ON

Two of IUPUI's most noticable departures from last season both opted to go the grad transfer route. After two seasons at IUPUI, guard Grant Weatherford opted to complete his eligibility at Georgia Southern this season. The other, Isaiah Williams, practiced with the team all summer and fall before announcing via social media on Dec. 6 that he would graduate this winter and pursue opportunities elsewhere.

BASKETBALL CENTRAL

IUPUI will be the epicenter of the college basketball universe this year as the 2021 Final Four and 2021 Horizon League Championships are already planned for the Circle City. Indianapolis is widely rumored to be the lone site of the 2021 NCAA Tournament at a number of sites, which would ultimately culminate in the Final Four at Lucas Oil Stadium.

Last year marked the first of a three-year agreement to bring the Horizon League Tournament to Indiana Farmers Coliseum, which completed just prior to the COVID-19 outbreak.



JUCO CENTRAL - TRANSFER NOTES

IUPUI is one of 21 Division I teams to welcome nine-or-more newcomers this season while the Jaguars are tops in the country with eight junior college transfers. It's likely that two of the JC-transfers will start their Division I debuts this weekend and seven are expected to see action.

Junior wings Bobby Harvey, Azariah Seay and Nathan McClure are expected to immediately contribute while Coach Rimm added an impressive haul of frontcourt size in Acton Shirley (7-foot), Dimitar Pandev (6-foot-10), Dimitri Georgiadis (6-foot-9) and Jonah Carrasco (6-foot-9).

An eighth, Amrit Dhaliwal, is expected to rejoin the program at the turn of the semester and begin play in January. He originally came to Indianapolis this summer, but opted to return to California to study remotely for the fall with the expectation of returning to Indy for the spring semester.

Five of the eight have spent time in the Division I ranks as Seay (Alabama State), McClure (Texas State), Shirley (Gardner-Webb), Georgiadis (The Citadel) and Dhaliwal (Fresno State) all began their careers at the Division I level.

Georgiadis and McClure were teammates last season at State Fair (Mo.) C.C. where they helped their team to a 16-14 record and an appearance in the Region 16 Tournament Semifinals.

Georgiadis is currently listed as a junior on the roster, but is hopeful to be granted a hardship waiver for the 2018-2019 season at The Citadel where he appeared in just six games before missing the remainder of the year to injury. He also had a medical procedure performed on Oct. 9 of this year, causing him to miss approximately 5-6 weeks of on-court action.

THE ROOKIE

IUPUI has just one freshman on this year's roster in Texas-native Bakari LaStrap. He was the final signee for this season and joins the Jaguars from The Woodlands Christian Academy where he helped his high school squad to TAPPS Class 4A state championships in 2018 and 2020 and a runner-up finish in 2019. He was the All-Greater Houston Private School Player of the Year by the Houston Chronicle in 2020 after he averaged 16 points, five rebounds, five assists and two steals per game and shot 52 percent from the floor. He capped a 21-point performance in the 2020 state title game win over Colleyville Covenant by catching a lob from a teammate and throwing down a one-handed dunk as video of the play drew more than 12,000 views on the Overtime on Twitter

WE BACK

The IUPUI staff remained largely intact from last season as the only defection was of assistant coach Brian Burton. Coach Rimm opted to promote Aaron Evans to an assistant coaching role for the 2020-2021 campaign. The rest of the staff - Matt Dunn and Isaac Loehle - are back on the bench for their third seasons.

FROM ALL OVER

One thing Coach Rimm has instituted is a broader recruiting base, plucking newcomers from Alabama (Seay), California (Dhaliwal), Georgia (Shirley), Kansas (Carrasco), Texas (LaStrap & McClure), Virginia (Georgiadis) and even Macedonia (Pandev).

Seay is IUPUI's first player from Alabama and Carrasco is IUPUI's first player from Kansas.

LaStrap and McClure are just the second and third IUPUI players to hail from Texas (Taveion White was the first) and Georgiadis is just the Jaguars' second player from Virginia (Matt Crenshaw was the first).

Shirley is IUPUI's third-ever player from Georgia (Mike Lunday & D.A. Harvey) and Pandev is IUPUI's third-ever European-born player (Petar Macura & Michal Vavrek). Dhaliwal is just the sixth IUPUI player to come from California, joining Fred Alexander, Barry Gowdy, Dean Hadley, Bart Lennehan and Khufu Najee.

ACTION UP

7-foot junior Acton Shirley is just the third 7-footer in program history, joining Bill Van Senus and Ahmed Ismail. Shirley is on his fourth stop during his college basketball career, having trekked to Gardner-Webb (2017-2018), North Georgia (2018-2019) and Saddleback College (2019-2020).

SCHEDULE QUIRKS

Because of the pandemic, the Horizon League schedule went away from the traditional home-and-home format and each school will play 10 of 11 league foes this season. Having swept last year's regular season series, IUPUI will not face Oakland during the regular season this year.

IUPUI's home opponents will be Cleveland State (Jan. 1-2), Robert Morris (Jan. 8-9), Wright State (Jan. 22-23), Milwaukee (Jan. 29-30) and UIC (Feb. 12-13).

The road trips will send IUPUI to Purdue Fort Wayne (Dec. 19-20), Detroit Mercy (Dec. 26-27), Northern Kentucky (Jan. 15-16), Green Bay (Feb. 5-6) and Youngstown State (Feb. 19-20).

Fans will not be allowed into any Horizon League venues through the end of the calendar year and a determination on January and February games will be made at a later date.

WORLDWIDE LEADER

Every single game on the Jaguars' slate this year will be broadcast on ESPN platforms - primarily on ESPN3 or ESPN+. Friday games in the Horizon League this season could be flexed to ESPN, as predicated by ESPN.

Greg Rakestraw (ppx) and IUPUI Hall of Famer Bob Lovell (analyst) will continue to call the action while Indianapolis-based Tupelo Honey will produce the broadcasts.

UNIVERSITY NOTES

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

IUPUI is a public research university located in downtown Indianapolis that is the result of a merger of the Purdue Indianapolis Extension Center (1946) and Indiana University Indianapolis (1916). The merger was completed in 1969 and athletics began in 1972.

The university offers more than 200 degree programs and boasts an enrollment over 30,000 (22,000 undergrad and 8,000 postgrad). The university also boasts an endowment of more than \$850 million.

The university is ranked among the Top 200 "National Universities" and ranked 7th for "Up and Coming Schools." U.S. News has ranked IUPUI among the nation's elite for 13 straight years.

All total, the campus covers 509 acres and is located along Indy's Cultural Trail.

IUPUI includes the nation's largest nursing school, the second largest medical school in the country, the only dental school in the state, and the country's oldest school of physical education. IUPUI is among the top 20 campuses in the nation for graduate professional degrees conferred

ATHLETIC PROWESS

IUPUI was a primary beneficiary of the 1987 Pan-American Games in Indianapolis and continues to boast some world renowned facilities.

The IU Natatorium is located on the IUPUI campus and is among the best swimming & diving facilities in the world. It has hosted the U.S. Olympic Team Trials four different times and 12 NCAA National Championship meets. In addition, the 2017 World Juniors were held at IUPUI and 16 world records have been set in the Natatorium water.

Adjacent west is the Michael A. Carroll Track & Soccer Stadium which has hosted several USA Outdoor Track & Field Championships and NCAA Championships, along with the 1988 US Olympic Trials. Florence Griffith-Joyner set the 100m world record of 10.49 on the track.

In basketball circles, IUPUI is best known as the long-time host of the Nike All-American Camp, which was held on campus for two decades. The nation's top prep players and coaches from every level converged on campus for two weeks each summer in what was considered the elite college recruiting event of the year. Alum included LeBron James, Chris Webber, Allen Iverson, Kevin Garnett, Jason Kidd and Paul Pierce, among many others.

GEORGE HILL

IUPUI's best known basketball alum is current NBAer George Hill, who is in his 13th year in the league this season. Hill was originally drafted by the San Antonio Spurs (1st rd., 26th overall) in 2008.

He's played for the Spurs (2008-11), Indiana Pacers (2011-16), Utah Jazz (2016-17), Sacramento Kings (2017-18), Cleveland Cavaliers (2018), Milwaukee Bucks (2018-20) and was traded to the Oklahoma City Thunder this offseason. He's played in 785 regular season games, making nearly 450 career starts and averaging 11.1 points and 3.2 assists per game in his NBA career. He led the league in three-point percentage last season at 46 percent and is a career 38 percent shooter.

Entering this season, he's played in 127 career playoff games, starting 91 times and averaging 12.1 points per game.

Byron Rimm II is in his second season as head coach of the Jaguars after originally being named the program's interim head coach for the 2019-2020 season on Aug. 27, 2019. The ninth head coach in program history, Rimm originally joined the IUPUI program in October 2018 as the Jaguars' associate head coach.

In his first season as head coach, he piloted the team to a 7-25 mark, which included a resounding early season road win over

AAC foe South Florida. Under his leadership, guard Marcus Burk earned All-Horizon League honors and later entered his name in the NBA Draft, while forward Elyjah Goss was an All-Defensive Team selection and set a program record for single-season rebounds.

Rimm originally came to Indianapolis to serve as associate head coach during the 2018-2019 campaign, helping IUPUI to 16 wins - the program's most since a 19-win campaign in 2010-11. Included in the wins was a benchmark road win at ACC foe Boston College and a win of the Niagara Regional of the Fort Myers Tip-Off Classic during non-conference play. The Jaguars were later selected to play in the 2019 CIT, earning the program's third postseason appearance in the Division I era.

Rimm has an extensive background in college basketball including having served as head coach at Prairie View A&M from 2006-15, where he remains the program's all-time winningest coach with 115 victories. Under Rimm's direction, the program ascended to new heights, including back-to-back appearances in the SWAC tournament championship game in 2013 and 2014. Before Prairie View, the Pensacola, Fla.-native gained valuable experience on the West Coast, which included assistant coaching stops at Pasadena City College and Chaffey Community College from 1997-2000.

He directed Cal State San Bernardino to a No. 3 national ranking in NCAA Division II during the 2000 campaign and then took over the reins as the head women's basketball coach at Texas College in Tyler, Texas, guiding the team to a 20-12 mark in his lone season. At the time, the 20-12 mark was the most successful season in program history. He then had a four-year run as the head men's coach with Jarvis Christian College before joining Prairie View A&M as an assistant for the 2005-06 season. He was promoted to the head coaching spot the following season at age 32.

He coached Prairie View A&M to winning seasons in 2008-09 and 2009-10 and won 115 games during his time as head coach. His 2014 squad boasted the highest APR ranking among SWAC teams and also registered the best score in program history.

Since then, Rimm has served as the director of basketball operations at Texas A&M Corpus Christi in 2016-17 and as an assistant at UC Riverside in 2017-18.

Rimm played at Ventura College and California State University Los Angeles before earning his degree from Cal State, Los Angeles in 1999. He earned his master's degree in education from American InterContinental University in 2005.

JAGUARS COMEBACK BID FALLS SHORT AT CLEVELAND STATE, 72-62 CLEVELAND, Ohio (Jan. 30, 2020)

- The IUPUI basketball team dug a double-digit hole early in the second half before trying to storm back on the road at Cleveland State on Thursday night (Jan. 30) before ultimately falling to the Vikings, 72-62 inside Wolstein Center. Junior **Marcus Burk** led four Jaguars in double-digits with 18 points, albeit on 5-of-16 shooting as both teams struggled to find an offensive rhythm. Junior **Jaylen Minnett** added 12 points on 4-of-13 shooting, before fouling out, and **Grant Weatherford** had 11 points, six assists, five boards and five steals in the loss. **Elyjah Goss** added his ninth double-double of the season with 10 points and 12 rebounds.

Torrey Patton and Craig Beaudion scored 18 each for Cleveland State (9-14, 5-5 HL) and Algevon Eichelberger contributed 14 points and eight rebounds. Franklyn Penn Jr. rounded out CSU's double-digit scorers with 11 points and eight rebounds.

IUPUI (6-17, 2-8 HL) shot just 36 percent overall and 7-of-24 (29.2 percent) from three-point range, while CSU fared only slightly better at 37.7 percent shooting. However, CSU bullied the under-

manned Jaguars on the interior, outscoring IUPUI 36-22 in the paint and outrebounding the Jaguars, 46-32. IUPUI was without **Isaiah Williams** for a fourth straight game and both **Zo Tyson** and **Jakoby Kemp** were unavailable as well. Things got even tougher when **Jamil Jackson Jr.** left the game in the first half with an injury, forcing little used freshman **Taveion White** into a season-high 15 minutes. The Texas-native who came in with zero points and six rebounds in his collegiate career, contributed seven points, two rebounds and a blocked shot.

IUPUI trailed 26-24 with 2:23 left before halftime when Burk swished a wing trey off a find from Weatherford, only to see Cleveland State score the final six points of the half on back-to-back treys. Patton drilled an open three, followed by a trey from Kasheem Thomas. The Vikings proceeded to score the first five points of the second half on an Eichelberger three-point play and a Patton layup to build a 13-point lead with 18:14 left. The lead later swelled to 15 on a Patton three with 10:56 remaining before the Jags clawed back in the game.

The Jaguars outscored CSU by a 10-1 count over a six-minute span as both teams struggled to score. Weatherford opened the run with a trey and Goss followed with a layup. However, both teams were held scoreless over the next four-plus minutes until Goss scored again with a pair of free throws with 5:43 to play. Penn fired back by splitting a pair of free throws with 5:18 left, but Burk scored on a three after Goss rebounded a Minnett miss and kicked out for a second three-point attempt.

Cleveland State quickly pushed the lead back to 11 before Minnett hit back-to-back jumpers to make it 62-56 with 2:58 remaining. However, the comeback attempt became even more difficult when Minnett fouled out on a reach in on CSU's ensuing possession with 2:32 remaining.

Minnett extended his personal streak of consecutive games with a three made to 59-in-a-row, tying for the eighth-longest in NCAA Division I history. He moved his career scoring total to 971 points and moved into fourth on IUPUI's all-time list with 203 career threes made. Goss, who recorded his 12th career double-double, moved up to a tie for 12th place on IUPUI's all-time list with 568 career rebounds.

The loss gave Cleveland State a season sweep of the head-to-head series and the all-time series moved to 4-4 all-time.

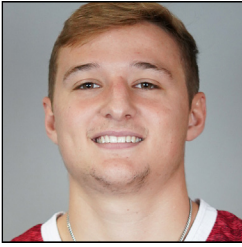

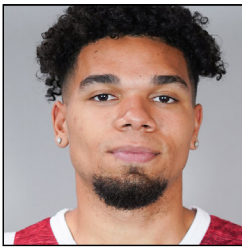

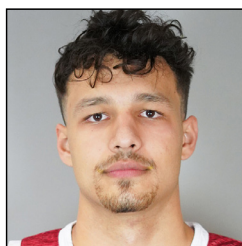
