


## QUICK HITTERS

- This marks IUPUI's first road trip of the season, albeit unexpected. The Jaguars were originally slated to host Robert Morris this week, but found out on Wednesday that they would be shipped to Milwaukee for a two-game set after RMU was forced to cancel due to COVID. IUPUI's first two Horizon League road trips of the season (at Purdue Fort Wayne and at Detroit Mercy) were canceled after a positive COVID test within the Jaguars' program.
- IUPUI leads the Horizon League and ranks 40th in the country in scoring defense, allowing just 63.3 points per game. No IUPUI opponent has topped 65 points in a game this season. The Jags rank second in the Horizon League in three-point defense (.235) and third in field goal defense (.423).
- IUPUI's offense has been problematic through the season's first three games as the Jaguars rank 12th in the Horizon League in scoring (60.0), three-point percentage (.246) and free throw percentage (.640) and 11th in field goal percentage (.384) and turnovers (18.7/game).
- After leading the Horizon League in rebounding last season, senior **Elyjah Goss** is seemingly up for an encore as he leads the league and ranks second in the country in the category this year at 12.67/game. Goss has grabbed double-digit boards in all three of the Jaguars' contests, including a season-high 16 in the opener against Tennessee State. For his career, Goss has moved to No. 2 on IUPUI's all-time list, having grabbed 709 career boards. Goss already owns IUPUI's single-game (21) and single-season (369) rebounding records.
- IUPUI's one constant on offense this season has been senior guard **Marcus Burk**, who leads the team and ranks fourth in the Horizon League in scoring at 17.0 ppg. Burk is the only IUPUI player to have scored in double-digits in all three games and is shooting 45.2 percent from the floor this season.
- Burk and **Jaylen Minnett** combine to be one of just four duos to have teamed to average at least 35 points per game last season. The pair averaged a combined 37.9 points per game last year and trail only UTSA's Jhivan Jackson & Keaton Wallace (45.6 ppg), Austin Peay's Terry Taylor & Jordyn Adams (39.2 ppg) and Iowa's Luka Garza & Joe Wieskamp (38.0 ppg).
- Minnett had the fifth-longest streak of consecutive games with at least one three in NCAA Division I history snapped, going scoreless against Cleveland State on Jan. 2. Minnett had made at least one three in every game of his career dating back to late in his freshman campaign before going without a triple at home against CSU last week.



## NEWS, NOTES & STORYLINES

### STIFLING

IUPUI has been strong defensively to start the 2020-2021 campaign, leading the Horizon League and ranking No. 40 in the country in scoring defense (63.3 ppg). The Jags rank second in the Horizon League in three-point defense (.235) and third in field goal defense (.423).

Last season, IUPUI held foes to 65 points or fewer just five times in 32 games, but has already done so in three games to start the year.

Per HoopPower Analytics, IUPUI was the nation's second-highest trending defense for the week of Dec. 27-Jan. 4, trailing only Colorado's defense.

### FIRST OF FOUR

IUPUI and Milwaukee are now scheduled to square off four times during the regular season with this week's series added to the schedule. The Jags will host Milwaukee on Jan. 29-30 inside Indiana Farmers Coliseum.

### NEW TEAM, NEW DREAM

IUPUI needed just 69 points to defeat Tennessee State in the opener, marking the Jags' fewest in a win since beating Milwaukee 67-60 on Feb. 22, 2019.

The Jags were outshot from the field as TSU shot 39 percent and IUPUI was held to just 37 percent. Last season, IUPUI was 1-23 overall in games in which it was outshot by its opponent.

Last season's squad averaged just 10.0 points per game off the bench, but this year's club tallied 22 bench points in the opener with five different players contributing to that total.

### TAP INTO THE RESERVES

After averaging just 10 points per game off the bench last season, this year's Jaguars has shown more depth and options off the bench. Through three games, IUPUI reserves are scoring 21.3 points per game and have topped 20 points in every game thus far.

Two of IUPUI's top four scorers - Azariah Seay (9.7 ppg) and Bakari LaStrap (7.4 ppg) - have come off the bench in all three games thus far.

Seay scored a career-high 14 (6-9 FG, 2-4 3's) against Cleveland State on Saturday (Jan. 2), which was the most by an IUPUI reserve this season.

### CLASS ACTS

IUPUI is coming off a banner semester in the classroom, achieving a 3.20 grade point average during the fall. Ten Jags (Carrasco, DePersia, Dhaliwal, Harvey, LaStrap, McClure, Pandev, Seay, Shirley and Stoltz) all posted a GPA of 3.0 or better, paced by McClure (3.93), Stoltz (3.75) and DePersia (3.66).

### BURK BALLIN'

Marcus Burk was one of five players voted to the Horizon League Preseason First Team before the season by the league's coaches, media and sports information personnel. Burk averaged 21.3 points per game last year and drained 93 3's in his first year with the program. He was a two-time Horizon League Player of the Week and entered his name into the NBA Draft during the offseason before ultimately returning to Indy for the 2020-2021 season.

Burk scored in double-digits in 29 of his 32 games last season, including hitting for 20-or-more 19 times. He topped 30 points on four different occasions, highlighted by a career-high 39 points in an overtime win at Oakland last season.

With Burk returning, it marks the first time IUPUI's top scorer from a season ago returned since Darell Combs returned in 2016-17 after leading the Jags in scoring at 16.3 points per game in 2015-16. Combs upped his output to 16.8 points per game as a senior in 2016-17.

Including his two years at Campbell before coming to IUPUI, Burk has totaled 1,476 points and 253 threes made in his collegiate career.

### NAME TWO BETTER... WE'LL WAIT...

While IUPUI's roster is predominantly new faces, some of the returners already boast impressive credentials. At the top of the list is the high scoring, Hoosier raised duo of Marcus Burk and Jaylen Minnett. The duo is one of four in the country that returns to school after averaging at least a combined 35 points per game or better last season.

Burk's 21.3 points per game were the most by an IUPUI player since George Hill averaged 21.5 per game in 2007-08. Minnett connected for a school record 115 3's during the season and became the 24th player in school history to surpass 1,000 career points in an IUPUI uniform.

### JAYL3N

Senior Jaylen Minnett became the 24th player in program history to achieve 1,000 career points in an IUPUI uniform against Green Bay on Feb. 6, 2020 as part of a career-high 32-point effort last season. He enters today's game with 1,150 career points, ranking No. 16 on the program's all-time list. He became the 16th player to hit for 1,000 points in three seasons or less in IUPUI history. Given his track record, he should move into the top 10 in career points midway through this unusual season. Below is a snippet of the program's all-time leading scorers and where Minnett sits.

### BOOGIE BOARDS

Senior Elijah Goss, known as E-Boogie on Twitter, was a monster on the glass last season, grabbing a school record 369 rebounds. He was voted to the Horizon League All-Defensive Team and his 11.5 boards per game were easily tops in the Horizon League and ranked sixth nationally. He currently ranks second in the nation in rebounding (12.7 rpg) and is tops in the Horizon League.

He entered this season fifth on the program's career rebounding list and is just 60 shy of matching Hall of Famer Don Carlisle's 769 career boards. His 709 rebounds are tops in the program's Division I history as he surpassed Brandon Cole for that mark against Cleveland State on Jan. 2.

Goss owns six career games of 17 boards or more, including having grabbed a school record 21 in a game last year. He has 33 career double-digit rebound games and 16 career double-doubles. Last year he tied IUPUI's D1 record with 12 double-doubles in a season.

### JERSEY MIKE DELIVERS

Sophomore Mike DePersia showed last year that he's a bona fide playmaker from the point guard spot. The New Jersey-native delivered an IUPUI Division I freshman record 85 assists in his 32 appearances and was a two-time Horizon League Freshman of the Week honoree. In Horizon League play, he averaged 3.2 assists per game and had a 3.05 assist-to-turnover ratio with 58 assists and just 19 turnovers.

In three games this season, DePersia is averaging 5.0 assists per game and ranks second in the Horizon League in assist-to-turnover ratio at 2.50 (15 ast/6 to).

### DEBUTS

Of the 12 players who saw time in the Jaguars' opener, eight were making their IUPUI debuts, including juniors Bobby Harvey and Dimitar Pandev earning starts.

True freshman Bakari LaStrap (9 points) was incredibly impressive in his collegiate debut, including scoring his first career bucket with a steal and two-handed dunk in transition. LaStrap was on the floor down the stretch of the one-possession win over Tennessee State, sharing the ball-handling duties with DePersia. Here are some other numbers from some IUPUI players' debuts:

Harvey (7 pts), Pandev (5 pts, 3 reb), Nathan McClure (2 pts, 2 reb), Dimitri Georgiadis (2 pts, 2 reb), Azariah Seay (7 pts, 3 reb, 2-3 3's), Jonah Carrasco (2 pts, 1 reb) and Acton Shirley (3 min).

### CAPTAINS

Head Coach Byron Rimm named four players captains for the 2020-2021 season - Marcus Burk, Mike DePersia, Elijah Goss and Jaylen Minnett.

### MOVIN' ON

Two of IUPUI's most noticeable departures from last season both opted to go the grad transfer route. After two seasons at IUPUI, guard Grant Weatherford opted to complete his eligibility at Georgia Southern this season. The other, Isaiah Williams, practiced with the team all summer and fall before announcing via social media on Dec. 6 that he

## BASKETBALL CENTRAL

IUPUI will be the epicenter of the college basketball universe this year as the 2021 NCAA Tournament (including the Final Four) and 2021 Horizon League Championships are already planned for the Circle City. This year's NCAA Tournament will be spread across six sites in the state of Indiana, including IUPUI's home venue of the Indiana Farmers Coliseum.

Last year marked the first of a three-year agreement to bring the Horizon League Tournament to Indiana Farmers Coliseum, which completed just prior to the COVID-19 outbreak.

would graduate this winter and pursue opportunities elsewhere.

### JUCO CENTRAL - TRANSFER NOTES

IUPUI is one of 21 Division I teams to welcome nine-or-more newcomers this season while the Jaguars are tops in the country with eight junior college transfers. It's likely that two of the JC-transfers will start their Division I debuts this weekend and seven are expected to see action.

Junior wings Bobby Harvey, Azariah Seay and Nathan McClure are expected to immediately contribute while Coach Rimm added an impressive haul of frontcourt size in Acton Shirley (7-foot), Dimitar Pandev (6-foot-10), Dimitri Georgiadis (6-foot-9) and Jonah Carrasco (6-foot-9).

An eighth, Amrit Dhaliwal, is expected to rejoin the program at the turn of the semester and begin play in January. He originally came to Indianapolis this summer, but opted to return to California to study remotely for the fall with the expectation of returning to Indy for the spring semester.

Five of the eight have spent time in the Division I ranks as Seay (Alabama State), McClure (Texas State), Shirley (Gardner-Webb), Georgiadis (The Citadel) and Dhaliwal (Fresno State) all began their careers at the Division I level.

Georgiadis and McClure were teammates last season at State Fair (Mo.) C.C. where they helped their team to a 16-14 record and an appearance in the Region 16 Tournament Semifinals.

Georgiadis is currently listed as a junior on the roster, but is hopeful to be granted a hardship waiver for the 2018-2019 season at The Citadel where he appeared in just six games before missing the remainder of the year to injury. He also had a medical procedure performed on Oct. 9 of this year, causing him to miss approximately 5-6 weeks of on-court action.

### THE ROOKIE

IUPUI has just one freshman on this year's roster in Texas-native Bakari LaStrap. He was the final signee for this season and joins the Jaguars from The Woodlands Christian Academy where he helped his high school squad to TAPPS Class 4A state championships in 2018 and 2020 and a runner-up finish in 2019. He was the All-Greater Houston Private School Player of the Year by the Houston Chronicle in 2020 after he averaged 16 points, five rebounds, five assists and two steals per game and shot 52 percent from the floor. He capped a 21-point performance in the 2020 state title game win over Colleyville Covenant by catching a lob from a teammate and throwing down a one-handed dunk as video of the play drew more than 12,000 views on the Overtime on Twitter

### WE BACK

The IUPUI staff remained largely intact from last season as the only defection was of assistant coach Brian Burton. Coach Rimm opted to promote Aaron Evans to an assistant coaching role for the 2020-2021 campaign. The rest of the staff - Matt Dunn and Isaac Loechle - are back on the bench for their third seasons.

### FROM ALL OVER

One thing Coach Rimm has instituted is a broader recruiting base, plucking newcomers from Alabama (Seay), California (Dhaliwal), Georgia (Shirley), Kansas (Carrasco), Texas (LaStrap & McClure), Virginia (Georgiadis) and even Macedonia (Pandev).

Seay is IUPUI's first player from Alabama and Carrasco is IUPUI's first player from Kansas. LaStrap and McClure are just the second and third IUPUI players to hail from Texas (Taveion White was the first) and Georgiadis is just the Jaguars' second player from Virginia (Matt Crenshaw was the first).

Shirley is IUPUI's third-ever player from Georgia (Mike Lunday & D.A. Harvey) and Pandev is IUPUI's third-ever European-born player (Petar Macura & Michal Vavrek). Dhaliwal is just the sixth IUPUI player to come from California, joining Fred Alexander, Barry Gowdy, Dean Hadley, Bart Lennehan and Khufu Najee.

### ACTON UP

7-foot junior Acton Shirley is just the third 7-footer in program history, joining Bill Van Senu and Ahmed Ismail. Shirley is on his fourth stop during his college basketball career, having trekked to Gardner-Webb (2017-2018), North Georgia (2018-2019) and Saddleback College (2019-2020).

### SCHEDULE QUIRKS

Because of the pandemic, the Horizon League schedule went away from the traditional home-and-home format and each school will play 10 of 11 league foes this season. Having swept last year's regular season series, IUPUI will not face Oakland during the regular season this year.

IUPUI's home opponents will be Cleveland State (Jan. 1-2), Robert Morris (Jan. 8-9), Wright State (Jan. 22-23), Milwaukee (Jan. 29-30) and UIC (Feb. 12-13).

The road trips will send IUPUI to Purdue Fort Wayne (Dec. 19-20), Detroit Mercy (Dec. 26-27), Northern Kentucky (Jan. 15-16), Green Bay (Feb. 5-6) and Youngstown State (Feb. 19-20).

Fans will not be allowed into any Horizon League venues through the end of the calendar year and a determination on January and February games will be made at a later date.

### WORLDWIDE LEADER

Every single game on the Jaguars' slate this year will be broadcast on ESPN platforms - primarily on ESPN3 or ESPN+. Friday games in the Horizon League this season could be flexed to ESPN, as predicated by ESPN.

Greg Rakestraw (xpx) and IUPUI Hall of Famer Bob Lovell (analyst) will continue to call the action while Indianapolis-based Tupelo Honey will produce the broadcasts.

## UNIVERSITY NOTES

### ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

IUPUI is a public research university located in downtown Indianapolis that is the result of a merger of the Purdue Indianapolis Extension Center (1946) and Indiana University Indianapolis (1916). The merger was completed in 1969 and athletics began in 1972.

The university offers more than 200 degree programs and boasts an enrollment over 30,000 (22,000 undergrad and 8,000 postgrad). The university also boasts an endowment of more than \$850 million.

The university is ranked among the Top 200 "National Universities" and ranked 7th for "Up and Coming Schools." U.S. News has ranked IUPUI among the nation's elite for 13 straight years.

All total, the campus covers 509 acres and is located along Indy's Cultural Trail.

IUPUI includes the nation's largest nursing school, the second largest medical school in the country, the only dental school in the state, and the country's oldest school of physical education. IUPUI is among the top 20 campuses in the nation for graduate professional degrees conferred

### ATHLETIC PROWESS

IUPUI was a primary beneficiary of the 1987 Pan-American Games in Indianapolis and continues to boast some world renowned facilities.

The IU Natatorium is located on the IUPUI campus and is among the best swimming & diving facilities in the world. It has hosted the U.S. Olympic Team Trials four different times and 12 NCAA National Championship meets. In addition, the 2017 World Juniors were held at IUPUI and 16 world records have been set in the Natatorium water.

Adjacent west is the Michael A. Carroll Track & Soccer Stadium which has hosted several USA Outdoor Track & Field Championships and NCAA Championships, along with the 1988 US Olympic Trials. Florence Griffith-Joyner set the 100m world record of 10.49 on the track.

In basketball circles, IUPUI is best known as the long-time host of the Nike All-American Camp, which was held on campus for two decades. The nation's top prep players and coaches from every level converged on campus for two weeks each summer in what was considered the elite college recruiting event of the year. Alum included LeBron James, Chris Webber, Allen Iverson, Kevin Garnett, Jason Kidd and Paul Pierce, among many others.

### GEORGE HILL

IUPUI's best known basketball alum is current NBAer George Hill, who is in his 13th year in the league this season. Hill was originally drafted by the San Antonio Spurs (1st rd., 26th overall) in 2008.

He's played for the Spurs (2008-11), Indiana Pacers (2011-16), Utah Jazz (2016-17), Sacramento Kings (2017-18), Cleveland Cavaliers (2018), Milwaukee Bucks (2018-20) and was traded to the Oklahoma City Thunder this offseason. He's played in 785 regular season games, making nearly 450 career starts and averaging 11.1 points and 3.2 assists per game in his NBA career. He led the league in three-point percentage last season at 46 percent and is a career 38 percent shooter.

Entering this season, he's played in 127 career playoff games, starting 91 times and averaging 12.1 points per game.

**Byron Rimm II** is in his second season as head coach of the Jaguars after originally being named the program's interim head coach for the 2019-2020 season on Aug. 27, 2019. The ninth head coach in program history, Rimm originally joined the IUPUI program in October 2018 as the Jaguars' associate head coach.

In his first season as head coach, he piloted the team to a 7-25 mark, which included a resounding early season road win over

AAC foe South Florida. Under his leadership, guard Marcus Burk earned All-Horizon League honors and later entered his name in the NBA Draft, while forward Elyjah Goss was an All-Defensive Team selection and set a program record for single-season rebounds.

Rimm originally came to Indianapolis to serve as associate head coach during the 2018-2019 campaign, helping IUPUI to 16 wins - the program's most since a 19-win campaign in 2010-11. Included in the wins was a benchmark road win at ACC foe Boston College and a win of the Niagara Regional of the Fort Myers Tip-Off Classic during non-conference play. The Jaguars were later selected to play in the 2019 CIT, earning the program's third postseason appearance in the Division I era.

Rimm has an extensive background in college basketball including having served as head coach at Prairie View A&M from 2006-15, where he remains the program's all-time winningest coach with 115 victories. Under Rimm's direction, the program ascended to new heights, including back-to-back appearances in the SWAC tournament championship game in 2013 and 2014. Before Prairie View, the Pensacola, Fla.-native gained valuable experience on the West Coast, which included assistant coaching stops at Pasadena City College and Chaffey Community College from 1997-2000.

He directed Cal State San Bernardino to a No. 3 national ranking in NCAA Division II during the 2000 campaign and then took over the reins as the head women's basketball coach at Texas College in Tyler, Texas, guiding the team to a 20-12 mark in his lone season. At the time, the 20-12 mark was the most successful season in program history. He then had a four-year run as the head men's coach with Jarvis Christian College before joining Prairie View A&M as an assistant for the 2005-06 season. He was promoted to the head coaching spot the following season at age 32.

He coached Prairie View A&M to winning seasons in 2008-09 and 2009-10 and won 115 games during his time as head coach. His 2014 squad boasted the highest APR ranking among SWAC teams and also registered the best score in program history.

Since then, Rimm has served as the director of basketball operations at Texas A&M Corpus Christi in 2016-17 and as an assistant at UC Riverside in 2017-18.

Rimm played at Ventura College and California State University Los Angeles before earning his degree from Cal State, Los Angeles in 1999. He earned his master's degree in education from American InterContinental University in 2005.

## THE LAST MEETING - MILWAUKEE 80, IUPUI 79 (OT) (FEB. 8, 2020 - INDIANAPOLIS)

### JAGUARS FALL IN OVERTIME TO MILWAUKEE, 80-79

**INDIANAPOLIS (Feb. 8, 2020)** - In a meeting of the Jaguars and Panthers on Saturday afternoon, both felines expunged more than their shares of nine lives before the visiting Milwaukee squad escaped victorious, 80-79 in overtime. Milwaukee's Te'Jon Lucas banked in a short jumper with 7.0 seconds left in overtime to provide the game-winner as IUPUI missed an opportunity in the final second to send the game to a second overtime. Junior **Marcus Burk**, who was fouled while receiving a pass in the final second, swished the first free throw before missing the second to end the contest.

"We're a lot better than what we've been playing and a lot better than our record," head coach **Byron Rimm II** said. "We've just got to do the little things - we've got to knock down these free throws and we've got to get some of these rebounds.

"Burk and Minnett, I almost take it for granted because on a bad day, they both go out and get 20. I thought Minnett's shot in regulation was going to be the game-winner - it rolled in and out and that's how the cookie crumbles."

Junior **Jaylen Minnett** had a team-high 26 points on an 8-of-30 shooting day and Burk closed with 23 on 5-of-20 shooting. **Grant Weatherford** supplied 13 points and five steals before fouling out and **Elyjah Goss** had seven points and 13 rebounds. Freshman **Taveion White** continued to provide a major spark off the bench, closing with four points and a season-high nine rebounds in 25 minutes.

Lucas led Milwaukee (12-13, 7-6 HL) with 31 points, 12 rebounds and five assists and Courtney Brown Jr. pumped in 11 points, DeAndre Abram also had a double-double off the Milwaukee bench with 10 points and 13 rebounds.

Such has been the case of late, IUPUI (6-20, 2-11 HL) was playing uphill from the outset after falling into a 20-11 hole midway through the opening half. Milwaukee extended the lead to 35-24 on an Abram three at the 4:24 mark and led 43-33 at intermission. In what would become a precursor of things to come, two officials reviews in the final seconds of the half resulted in three late made free throws for the Panthers that made it a double-digit margin.

IUPUI got contributions from unexpected sources in the first half as Burk specifically struggled to find the range. Goss tossed in his first trey of the season in the game's early going and **Mike DePersia** rattled home an open corner trey for his third make of the year. White continued to give a lift off the bench, grabbing six boards and a steal before intermission.

The Panthers extended the lead to 13 on a Josh Thomas layup early in the second half before IUPUI began chipping away. The Jags did the bulk of their damage at the foul line, working into the bonus early in the stanza and repeatedly earning free throw attempts. As the attempts piled up, so did the self inflicted wounds as IUPUI made just 13-of-25 (52 percent) attempts after halftime after making all eight of its first half tries.

The Jags pulled even at 60 all when Weatherford put back a Minnett miss, but Milwaukee immediately fired back with a Lucas four-point play from the top of the key. The Panthers lead grew to eight with 3:53 remaining before a 10-0 IUPUI run gave the hosts a 73-71 advantage with 1:44 left.

Lucas split a pair of free throws with 1:26 left and Minnett misfired on a three, giving the Panthers a chance to retake the lead. However, Lucas drew another foul and split a pair to tie the score. After an IUPUI turnover with 35.7 seconds left, Milwaukee returned the favor when DePersia picked off a Lucas pass and immediately shuffled the ball to Minnett. Minnett came up empty on a contested wing three, sending the game to overtime.

IUPUI went ahead 78-76 with 1:15 left after DePersia came up with a steal after Goss missed a three and kicked out to Burk for a wide open three. Lucas tied the game at 78 all with 41 seconds left and Minnett missed a potential go-ahead trey with 15 seconds left.

Milwaukee opted against a timeout and Lucas raced the other way, working to his left before banking in the winner. IUPUI similarly raced the other way, but Minnett had his shot blocked in traffic with 0.9 seconds left. On the ensuing inbounds, Thomas fouled Burk, who tried to get a three-point attempt to the rim from the corner. The foul was immediately called on the floor, giving the Jaguars' sharpshooter two free throw attempts. Burk, who drew eight fouls all total, missed the second to cap his day at 9-of-13 from the line.

"It's unfortunate," Minnett said of the loss. "We put it on ourselves, really. We just have to come out more locked in from the jump and I take responsibility for that.

"I need to be way better than what I was today. I knew I was going to take the shot (in regulation) and just wanted to shoot it with confidence. We fight. We fight to the very end and we've got to keep rallying to make a run."

Milwaukee shot 43.5 percent from the floor and held IUPUI to just 32.9 percent shooting and 12-of-38 (31.6 percent) from three. The Jags also lost the glass, 49-41, as Milwaukee outscored the Jags 28-20 in the paint.

The Jags did force 24 turnovers and outscored the Panthers 29-12 in points off turnovers, including 10 fast break points.
