SETTING THE SCENE

The Cleveland State men's basketball team enters this weekend's pair of Horizon League games in search of going 6-0 in the Horizon League for the first time since the 2007-08 season. Tre Gomillion is coming off of a career day, pouring in a career-best 23 points on 11-12 shooting from the field in a come-from-behind victory against Youngstown State on Sunday, Dec. 27 at the Wolstein Center. Torrey Patton scored 19 points that game, all in the second half, while D'Moi Hodge chipped in 14 points, in addition to a game-high four steals.

A WIN ON FRIDAY WOULD...

Mark the first time since the 2007-08 season the Vikings begin #HLMBB play 5-0. It would also mark the program's longest winning streak since winning seven games during the 2013-14 season.

THE CLEVELAND STATE/IUPUI SERIES

Saturday's contest is the ninth all-time meeting between these two programs, with the series being evenly split 4-4. The Vikings come into this weekend's set of games on a three-game winning streak, having not lost to IUPUI since Jan. 10, 2019 at IUPUI. In the latest outing, Cleveland State won, 72-62, behind four Vikings scoring in double figures, led by Craig Beaudion and Torrey Patton's game-high tying 18 points.

SCOUTING THE JAGUARS

IUPUI comes into Friday's matinee match against the Vikings having only played one game this season, a 69-66 win over Tennessee State on Dec. 12 at Indiana Coliseum. Marcus Burke led the Jags in scoring, pouring in 18 points, in addition to four rebounds, two assists, one block and two steals in 36 minutes of action. Elyjah Goss pulled down a team-high 16 rebounds that contest, to go along with seven points and three blocks. Mike DePersia dished out a team-high eight assists, in addition to 10 points on 3-6 (.500) shooting from the field, four rebounds and two steals in 36 minutes of action.

RISE IN THE HORIZON (AS A TEAM)

Through four #HLMBB contest this season, the Vikings are ranked fourth in points per game (80.0), fourth in points allowed (71.0), third in margin of victory (9.0), second in field goal percentage (.534), fifth in defensive field goal percentage (.420), fifth in three-point field goal percentage (.373) and first in steals per game (9.25)

RISE IN THE HORIZON (INDIVIDUALLY)

Through four #HLMBB contests, **D'Moi Hodge** is ranked fifth in scoring per game (19.8), sixth in three-point field goal percentage (.481), first in steals per game (3.3) and ninth in blocked shots (1.3). **Tre Gomillion** is ranked fifth in field goal percentage (.657), sixth in assist/turnover ratio (2.2) and 13th in assists per game (3.3). **Torrey Patton** ranks 14th in scoring (15.5), while **Deante Johnson** stands 14th in rebounds (6.3) and eighth in blocks (1.3).

OVERALL RANKINGS

In total, both league games and non-conference games, **D'Moi Hodge** is seventh in scoring (16.5), seventh in field goal percentage (.467) and first in steals (2.5). **Torrey Patton** and **Deante Johnson** are tied for 11th in rebounds (6.6), while **Johnson** is ranked seventh in blocked shots (1.6).

COME-FROM-BEHIND-DUB

Against Youngstown State on Sunday, Dec. 27, the Vikings overcame a double-digit deficit to defeat the Penguins, 81-74. Down by 10 at the half, the Vikings poured in 51 points on a 21-31 (.677) clip in the final 20 minutes, behind 19 second half points from senior Torrey Patton to secure the #HLMBB win. Tre Gomillion notched a career-high 23 points, while D'Moi Hodge chipped in 14 points and four steals and Deante Johnson pulled down 10 rebounds.

TRE GOMILLION AKA MR. RELIABLE

Gomillion has started in every game of his Cleveland State career (39 starts). The junior has had a career season thus far, pouring in a career-high 23 points on a near-perfect 11-12 (.917) shooting from the floor on Dec. 27, 2020. His .917 shooting percentage puts the Augusta, Georgia, native in the record book, tying him with Jamal Jackson's .917 clip on 12/5/94 (also 11-12 from the field). Against Purdue Fort Wayne on Dec. 19, Gomillion contributed 16 points on a then-career-high 8-13 (.615) shooting from the floor.

HOLY HODGE!

The junior transfer had a historic, record-setting, performance against Purdue Fort Wayne on Sunday, Dec. 20. Hodge poured in a NCAA-high 46 points (as of 12/21) on 15-23 (.652) shooting from the floor, including a 10-15 (.667) clip from deep, a game-high seven rebounds, three assists and a game-high tying four steals in 32 minutes of action. Over his two games against the Mastodons, Hodge, who started in both games, averaged 25.5 points on 17-31 (.548) shooting from the field, in addition to an 11-19 (.579) mark from three-point territory, 5.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 4.5 steals in 20.5 minutes of play. His play earned him Horizon League Player of the Week honors (announced Dec. 21).

D'MOI WE KNOW, THE BETTER: HODGE IN THE HISTORY BOOKS

Hodge etched his name in the Cleveland State men's basketball history books with his outing at Purdue Fort Wayne (12/20/20). The junior from the British Virgin Islands set new school records for most made three-pointers in a game (10), most made three-pointers in a half (8), most points scored by a junior (46) and most points scored in a first half (31). Hodge's 10 made three-pointers are the most in the NCAA this season (as of 12/21/20), while his 46 points were only three points shy of tying the program record (49-Franklin Edwards at Xavier, 2/25/81).

UNDEFEATED IN #HLMBB PLAY

For the first time in 10 years, the Vikings begin Horizon League play with a 4-0 record after taking down one of the newest members, Purdue Fort Wayne, of the #HLMBB in the first weekend of league play, and then completing a two-game sweep against in-state rival Youngstown State.

BATTLING AGAINST NO. 22 BUCKEYES

In a battle against the nationally-ranked Ohio State Buckeyes on Dec. 13, the Vikings held advantages in points in the paint (34-22), rebounds (36-34), bench scoring (29-19), second chance points (12-6), fast break points (10-7) and assists (11-0). In the second half, Cleveland State shot .519 (14-27) from the floor, including a 5-10 (.500) clip from the three-point line.

PATTON CLEANING UP THE GLASS

Torrey Patton grabbed a career-high tying 14 rebounds against the No. 22 Ohio State Buckeyes on Dec. 13. It marked the second time in his career the senior recorded 14 rebounds (2/29/20 at Green Bay) and the fourth time he notched 10-or-more rebounds in a single contest. Patton's averaging a team-leading 6.8 rebounds per game, which is tied for ninth-best in the Horizon League.

TRANSFERS SHINE AGAINST BUCKEYES

Junior transfers D'Moi Hodge and Chris Greene each recorded 10-plus points against the Buckeyes on Dec. 13. Hodge, a transfer from State College of Florida, finished with a team-high 14 points, while Greene, a transfer from CC of Beaver County, led the Vikes bench with 12 points. Combined, the two juniors shot 11-21 (.523) from the field, including a 4-10 (.400) mark from deep.

ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS

Junior forward Deante Johnson had a record-setting performance in the team's first contest of the season at Toledo (12/1/20). Johnson grabbed a career-high tying 10 rebounds (last done 1/5/20 at Green Bay) and set a new career-high in blocks, rejecting five shots. The junior's five blocks are tied for seventh-most in a single game in Cleveland State history. Johnson is the 24th Viking in CSU history to swat five shots (last done by Charlie Woods vs. Valpo, 2/3/11) and is one of only 18 players in NCAA Division I to record 10+ rebounds and 5+ blocks in a single game this season (as of 12/24/20).

FIRST GAME JITTERS? NEVER HEARD OF 'EM

Coach Gates played four freshman against the Rockets on Dec. 1, with freshman guard Alec Oglesby getting the start and leading the team in steals (two). Forward Jayson Woodrich made an impact off of the bench, leading all bench scoring, pouring in 11 points on a 4-8 (.500) clip from the floor, while Demetrius Terry saw 10 minutes of play going 2-3 (.667) from the field scoring two points and forward Mabor Majak saw two minutes of action.

BUILDING MOMENTUM

The 2020-21 Cleveland State men's basketball program looks to build off of last season's momentum, as the Vikes finished with seven league wins, the most since the 2014-15 season, won three consecutive league games for the first time since 2014-15 and three straight non-conference games for the first time since 2011-12.

COACH OF THE YEAR HONORS

In his first season at Cleveland State, Horizon League head coaches, sports information directors and media members voted Dennis Gates as Horizon League Co-Coach of the year, along with Wright State's Coach Nagy. Gates is only the second head coach in Cleveland State history to be awarded the league's honor, joining Gary Waters (2007-08).

MEET THE CAPTAINS

The Cleveland State men's basketball captains for the 2020-21 season include: Algevon Eichelberger, Torrey Patton, Craig Beaudion and Deante Johnson. The team's bench captain is sophomore guard Jeremy Sanchez, while the freshman captain is three-star recruit Alec Oglesby.

RETURNING PRODUCTION

In Horizon League play, the Vikings are returning over 80% of their production from last season: 83% of total points, 84% of total rebounds, 82% of total assists, 86% total blocks and 83% of total steals.

FRESH FACES

The Vikes enter the 2020-21 season with the top-ranked recruiting class in the Horizon League, per Rivals.com. The class includes transfers Chris Greene, D'Moi Hodge, Yahel Hill, and freshmen Mabor Majak, Alec Oglesby and Jayson Woodrich. The Vikings, ranked 86th in the nation and tied for the fourth-best class in the state of Ohio, tied with the University of Dayton. Nine of 17 Vikings are returning from last season.

DENNIS GATES

HEAD COACH | SECOND SEASON

- Landed the top recruiting class of 2020 in the Horizon League, according to Rivals.com
- This recruiting class was ranked 86th-best in the nation and tied for fourth-best in the state of Ohio
- Coming into the 2020-21 season, was selected to finish seventh in the Horizon League, as voted upon by league head coaches, sports information directors and media members
- Named the 2019-20 Horizon League Coach of the Year
- Only the second head coach in Cleveland State history to be awarded COY by the Horizon League (Gary Waters, 2007-08)
- Notched seven league wins in his first season at the Helm of the Vikings... the most since the 2014-15 season
- Also won three consecutive league games for the first time since 2014-15 and three straight non-conference games for the first time since 2011-12
- Coached Algevon Eichelberger to a All-Horizon League Third Team spot, while Torrey Patton was named Horizon League Player of the Week (1/6/20) and Hugo Ferreira Horizon League Freshman of the Week (2/24/20)
- Prior to Cleveland State, spent nine years on Leonard Hamilton's staff at Florida State
- Helped lead the Seminoles to a 29-8 record in 2018-19, including a 13-5 mark in the ACC and a spot in the Sweet 16
- In 2017-18, Florida State had a 23-12 overall record and advanced to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 25 years
- In his first year back at Florida State in 2011-12 the Seminoles captured the ACC title for the first time in school history
- During his tenure in Tallahassee, Gates has helped recruit top-100 players including 2017 NBA Lottery pick Jonathan Isaac (No. 9), 2017 NBA Draft choice Dwayne Bacon, (No. 22), NBA free-agent signee Xavier Rathan-Mayes (No. 24), sophomore M.J. Walker (No. 24), junior Trent Forrest (No. 45), senior Phil Cofer (No. 56) and 2019 NBA Draft choice Terance Mann (No. 94)
- Has also worked at Marquette, Cal, Northern Illinois and Nevada
- Began his coaching career as a coaching assistant with the Los Angeles Clippers during the 2002-03 season

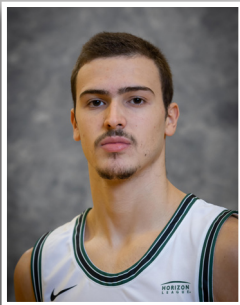

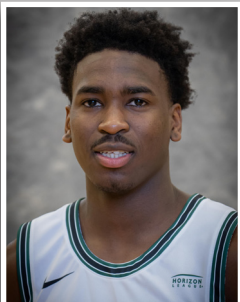
