OPENING TIP

LAST TIME OUT

Wright State split a pair of Horizon League contests last week-end against Cleveland State, falling 66-64 on Friday night before bouncing back with a 85-49 win on Saturday. Friday saw four players finish in double figures, led by Grant Basile's 15 points. Loudon Love finished with 14 points of his own, followed by Holden with 11 points. Basile, Love and Holden all finished with eight rebounds, as Love added four blocks, Basile had three blocks and Holden passed out three assists.

Saturday saw Holden finished with a game-high 23 points, one point shy of his season best, hitting 6-of-8 shots from the floor and connecting on 11-of-16 at the free throw stripe, both of which were new career highs. Finke finished with 15 points, one shy of his career high, while he was 6-of-8 from the free throw stripe – also career highs. Holden and Finke each finished with nine rebounds as well.

A SERIES CALLED JAG(S)

IUPUI comes into the weekend 4-3 overall and 2-3 in HL play, coming off of a pair of road wins at Northern Kentucky. Wright State and IUPUI have previously met 18 times entering this weekend's action, with the Raiders leading the series 15-3, including winning the last five matchups, and 8 of the last 9 meetings overall.

IUPUI won the first game of the series back on Nov. 29, 1976 (89-84) but the Raiders have had almost all the success in the series. The Jaguars other wins in the series came Feb. 23, 2018 and Jan. 8, 1986. Wright State and IUPUI met in 11 consecutive seasons from the 1976-77 through 1986-87 before the series went dormant for over 30 years.

WRIGHT STATE 2020-21 COVID-19 MEDIA PROTOCOLS

WORKING CREDENTIALS: To request credentials, please contact Nick Phillips, Assistant Athletics Director for Communications (nick.phillips@wright.edu). All requests should be made as early as possible and should be limited to working press only. Face coverings will be required at all times for everyone, as will temperature and symptom screenings at the point of entry. Media seating will be in the same general location as years past, on the deck off the northern baseline, but will be limited in capacity this season. To the extent possible with severe space limitations, priority will be given to media outlets based upon those which have regularly participated in Wright State media availability, with additional consideration to reach of the entity and the history of coverage. Requests for credentials will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. The Athletic Communications office has the final authority on whether any individuals from any organization will be issued media credentials.

The media room will be closed this year to be used only by team personnel for postgame press conferences. *ALL POSTGAME MEDIA INTERVIEWS WILL BE HELD VIRTUALLY*, along with all midweek media availability.

MEDIA ENTRANCE: There will be two ways working media will gain access to the Nutter Center this season, depending on time of their arrival. Entering via the loading dock (as in previous years) will only be available beginning an hour and a half prior to a game's start time and open through 30 minutes prior to tip. (Ex. - For a 7 p.m. tipoff, loading dock access begins at 5:30 p.m. and ends at 6:30 p.m.). Working media may also access the Nutter Center at any time, from pregame through the entirety of the contest, via Gate 9. Media will enter the arena and head directly to their seat. As a result of this new protocol, no pregame meal will be provided. Drinks will be available near media seating.

PHOTOGRAPHERS: There are several adjustments for still and video photographers this season. COVID-19 guidelines require appropriate distancing around the playing floor, and no access to shooting locations under the baskets or on the baselines. Wright State Athletics is providing two specified and raised shooting locations, one beyond each baseline, for photographers this season. Photographers will also have access to the horseshoe walkway at the base of the seating bowl, from the bottom of Sections 212-224. This is the opposite side of the

arena from the team benches - at no time will media members be allowed beyond Section 212. Please note, there is no access to the seating bowl from floor level this season. Those media members looking to access the bowl area for content must exit the main arena floor and use the stairs/elevator by media check-in/Gate 9 to gain access upstairs (Level 4/Concourse). A working area for photographers will be set up on the main arena floor area behind the print media deck. Ample power and wireless internet information will be available upon arrival to the Nutter Center.

RADIO COVERAGE: Radio broadcast permission must be obtained in advance from Nick Phillips. Official radio partners of visiting teams should work with their SID to communicate with Wright State in advance of the game(s). Wright State provides a courtesy ethernet line for the official radio partners of visiting teams. ISDN lines will not be readily available at the Nutter Center this season due to temporary relocation of radio areas due to COVID-19, but may be made available upon request. Inquiries about any accommodations should be made well in advance with Nick Phillips.

--Visiting radio broadcast position this season will be located at the top of Section 208, which is located behind the visiting bench. Ample power, ethernet line and wireless internet information, along with socially-distanced seating for two people, will be available upon arrival to the Nutter Center.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS: All postgame press conferences with head coaches Scott Nagy and Katrina Merriweather, along with select players, will be conducted electronically on Zoom this season. The link to join the press conference will be sent out before each game, along with any other relevant info. Wright State Athletic Communications representatives will be available to assist in postgame interviews. Interviews with the visiting team can be coordinated with the visiting SID and/or Nick Phillips.

WEEKLY MEDIA AVAILABILITY: Men's Basketball head coach Scott Nagy will hold his weekly media availability with the media virtually this season when the team schedule allows, usually on a weekly basis. Select players may also be available at the weekly media availability. Contact Nick Phillips for any inquiries about the weekly media availability schedule.

EYING IUPUI

IUPUI is coming off of its first-ever road wins at Northern Kentucky last weekend, led largely by Marcus Burk and Jaylen Minnett. Burk turned in games of 27 and 23 points, while Minnett finished with a pair of 18 point games in the victories.

The Jaguars opened the season on December 12 at home against Tennessee State with a three-point win, but were unable to play another game until the new year due to COVID issues. IUPUI had Horizon League series canceled against Fort Wayne and Detroit Mercy before returning to action on Jan. 1 and 2 against Cleveland State.

The series against Wright State will be IUPUI's first home contests since January 2, but will be the first home games in their regular venue – Indiana Farmers Coliseum – since the season opener on December 12. IUPUI's games against Cleveland State were moved on-campus due to delays in clearances with the Jaguars' COVID related pauses, and were the first games inside the on-campus facility for the Jaguars since Dec. 22, 2017.

KEEPING IT 100

Head coach Scott Nagy won his 100th career game at Wright State on January 16 against Cleveland State, becoming the third head coach in program history to record 100 career wins with the Raiders, joining the legendary Ralph Underhill (356 Wright State wins in 18 years) and Billy Donlon (109 career Wright State wins in six years). Ironically, Nagy won his 500th career game overall in February 2020 at Cleveland State.

Nagy became just the second current Horizon League head coach to reach 100 wins at the League school, joining Oakland's Greg Kampe. Kampe is the only other current Horizon League head coach with 500-plus career wins overall.

SHARING THE SCORING

Through 13 games, Wright State is averaging 79.2 points/game and has four players with double digit scoring averages and a fifth at 9.8/ppg.

Loudon Love has tallied 13 double figure scoring games, while Tanner Holden has 12 double figure scoring games. Grant Basile has 10 double figure scoring games. Tim Finke has nine such games, Trey Calvin has six and Jaylon Hall has five, while Alex Huibregtse (2x) and James Manns (1x) have also been in double figures this season.

SHARING THE BOARDS

Wright State leads the Horizon League and is 14th nationally in rebounding margin at +9.4 and is second in the HL in total rebounds with 565 (Oakland has 583 total rebounds in 4 additional games). The Raiders lead the HL in total defensive rebounds (409) and defensive rebounds per game average (31.5).

It's been a team effort on the glass, with Loudon Love leading the way with a Horizon League-best 10.4 rebounds per game, while Tanner Holden averages 7.9/per, Grant Basile 6.8 /per and Tim Finke 6.5/per.

THE FACTS OF (LOUDON) LOVE

LOVE YOUR NEW REBOUND KING

Loudon Love became Wright State's all-time leading rebounder when he grabbed an offensive rebound with 11:55 remaining in the first half on Dec. 13, 2020 at Bowling Green. Love entered the contest four rebounds shy of eclipsing Bill Edwards' (1989-93) 907 rebounds, and shattered the mark with 16 total boards in the win over Bowling Green.

Love is on pace to break the Wright State career rebounds per game average record, currently held by Rondey Robinson (1987-89) who had an 8.7 rebounds per game career average. Love's 341 rebounds in his initial campaign in 2017-18 is the most in a single season in Wright State history. Love began the 2019-20 season in sixth place on the Wright State career rebounding list, moving up from there over the last season-plus.

ONE MORE RING TO CLIMB

Loudon Love recorded his 1,000th career rebound in Wright State's Jan. 9 win over Youngstown State, making him the second Raider to reach the mark all-time, joining former Wright State women's basketball standout Symone Simmons and her 1,050 career rebounds.

ALL IN THE NAME OF LOVE...

Entering the Cleveland State games, Loudon Love has 1,559 career points and is now tied for No. 8 all-time in Wright State program history with former Raider Mark Vest (1984-86). He is 141 points away from cracking the top five list all-time. Through 11 games, Love is averaging 15.1 points per game, and is adding a 10.8 rebounds/game average.

Love averaged 15.9 points and 9.7 rebounds last season, turning in double digit scoring performances in 21 of his 27 games played, including 17 in Horizon League play. He finished with 11 double-double performances last season, including eight in league action.

LOVE FROM KAREEM & LUTE

Loudon Love has been named to the watch list for the 2021 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award and to the 2020-21 Lute Olson Award preseason watch list. The Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award annually honors the top center in men's college basketball, with the 20-player watch list announced by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. The Lute Olson Award is presented annually to the nation's top Division I player, with Love one of 30 players nationally to appear on the initial watch list.

A two-time member of the Lou Henson All-America Team honoring the nation's best mid-major players, Love was also named the Horizon League's Preseason Player of the Year and was the HL Player of the Year last March in addition to being a two-time All-Horizon first team selection and beginning his collegiate career as the League's Freshman of the Year following the 2017-18 campaign.

LEAGUE LOVE

Loudon Love was named the Horizon League's Co-Player of the Week on Dec. 14 after becoming the Raiders' all-time rebounds leader in an 85-67 road win over Bowling Green. The weekly honor was the fourth Player of the Week award in Love's career, while the big man also tallied seven weekly Freshman of the Week honors during the 2017-18 campaign on the way to being named Horizon League Freshman of the Year.

AIMING FOR HISTORY

Loudon Love entered the 2020-21 season with a chance to join some elite Horizon League company by earning his second Horizon League Player of the Year honor. Love has the opportunity to become just the sixth player in HL history to win multiple Player of the Year award, and the first in Wright State history.

Four of the other five instances saw players win in back-to-back seasons, most recently with Green Bay's Keifer Sykes in 2014 and 2015. Other multiple-time winners include: Loyola's Alfredrick Hughes, the only three-time HL Player of the Year (1983, 1984, 1985), Byron Larkin (1986 and 1988) and Brian Grant (1993, 1994) from Xavier, and Detroit Mercy's Rashad Phillips (2000, 2001).

Love would become the third Horizon League player to win multiple Player of the Year honors and also have been named the League's Newcomer of the Year, joining Larkin and Phillips.

WEEKEND WARRIORS

In their 51st season of basketball, the Raiders have played two consecutive games against the same opponent five times in their history, but have never faced the same opponent on consecutive days prior to 2020-21 Horizon League play.

Four of the previous instances have been a meeting in the final game of the regular season followed by a first-round tournament matchup, while the lone regular season instance came during the program's Division II era. During the 1984-85 campaign, the Raiders faced SIU Edwardsville in consecutive games on the schedule – one and home and one away – on consecutive Saturdays in February.

Last season, Wright State was 14-4 in weekend contests (11-3 on all other days) with only one weekend loss per month (Nov.-Feb.) in 2019-20. The Raiders were a perfect 6-0 on Fridays, had a 6-2 mark in Saturday action and were 2-2 in Sunday games last season.

THE BLOCK BROTHERS

Loudon Love and Grant Basile are Nos. 1 and 2 atop the Horizon League block leaderboard, with Love having swatted 22 attempts and Basile with 21 blocks entering the weekend's action. Love and Basile are two of only four players in the HL with double-digit blocks, with Love (1.7 blocks per) and Basile (1.6 blocks/per) as two of the four players averaging more than a block per contest.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE

The Jan. 9 loss to Youngstown State marked the first time Wright State has lost back-to-back Horizon League games since the 2016-17 season, when it happened twice (Jan. 7 vs. Youngstown St., Jan. 12 at Green Bay / Feb. 21 at NKU, Feb. 24 vs. Valpo). The Raiders did not lose back-to-back games at any point during the 2019-20 season.

In 2018-19, it happened three times, most recently in the Horizon League Championship (March 12, NKU) and NIT (March 19, Clemson), and the last time Wright State had back-to-back regular season losses was against then-No. 22 Mississippi State (Dec. 22, 2018) and vs. UIC (Dec. 28, 2018).

Wright State's last three-game losing streak was also during the 2018-19 season: Dec. 1, 2018 at Indiana State, Dec. 5, 2018 vs. Miami (OH) and Dec. 8, 2018 at Kent State.

NATIONAL ATTENTION

As of Wednesday, Loudon Love enters this weekend's contests ranked 15th in the nation with his 10.4 rebounds/game average, while he is also ranked No. 11 nationally in total rebounds with 135 total boards through 13 games. Love also has recorded five double-doubles so far this season, a mark that is the 18th-most in the country.

As of Wednesday, Wright State is No. 4 nationally in total rebounds per game, averaging 43.46, and is also No. 4 nationally in team defensive rebounds/game at 31.46 per.

FIRST FIVE...AGAIN

With their weekend sweeps over Detroit Mercy and Green Bay, as well as a weekend-opening win at Oakland, the Raiders opened Horizon League play with a 5-0 record for the second straight season and the third time overall under head coach Scott Nagy (also 2017-18). The streak ended at five consecutive League wins for the second year in a row (lost sixth HL game at UIC last year - Jan. 12, 2020). Wright State went on to win 15 of 18 HL contests a year ago, including its first four, and in 2017-18 won its first seven HL contests on the way to a 14-4 league record.

MID-MAJOR POLL

Wright State dropped one spot to No. 18 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll, released Jan. 18. Horizon League foe Cleveland State (21 votes) also received votes this week.

The Raiders opened the 2020-21 season at No. 20 in the listing's preseason poll on November 23 and were No. 25 in the Nov. 30 before playing a game. Wright State climbed as high as 10th overall in the poll on three occasions last year and was in every weekly ranking during the 2019-20 campaign.

LOCKDOWN DEFENSE

After allowing 51 second half points in the season opener to Marshall, Wright State has held opponents to 35 points or less in 13 of the 20 halves since the opener, stretched across 10 games.

Since Scott Nagy's arrival the Raiders have only allowed 50-plus points in a half 10 total times in his five seasons – and only four times since the 2017-18 season (Feb. 2018 at UIC, Feb. 2020 at Green Bay, Feb. 2020 vs. Detroit Mercy, Dec. 2020 vs. Marshall). The other six instances all came during Nagy's first year at Wright State (2016-17). Conversely, the Raiders have limited opponents to 55 points or fewer in a game 19 times in the Nagy Era, including against Miami (OH) on Dec. 5.

THE NAGY ERA - AN ERA OF SUCCESS

Since being hired in April 2016 as the ninth head coach in program history, Scott Nagy has led the Wright State program to unprecedented success. Coming off of his third consecutive Horizon League Coach of the Year honors (when there had been previously been only three in program history prior to his arrival), Nagy and the Raiders have qualified for a postseason tournament in three consecutive seasons (2018 NCAA Tournament, 2019 and 2020 NITs).

Entering the 2020-21 season, Nagy had won 91 of his 134 games at Wright State in four seasons, having won 67.9 percent of his games. That clip is just behind the winning percentage of the top coach in Wright State program history, Ralph Underhill, who won 68.7 percent of his games in his first four seasons (92 wins, 114 total games) from 1978-79 to 1981-82 when the Raiders competed at the NCAA Division II level.

Nagy's 53 Horizon League victories over the last four seasons are more than double the amount that Wright State won in the three years immediately preceding his hiring (26 HL wins, 2013-2016), while the Raiders' 22 All-Conference accolades (4 first team, 3 second team, 1 third team, 4 Newcomer team, 3 All-Defensive, 3 All-Tournament, 3 Coach of the Year) are more than seven times the amount of honors from 2013-2016 (1 second team, 1 Newcomer team, 1 All-Defensive).

Additionally, Nagy's Raider teams have produced in the classroom as well, with five student-athletes earning Horizon League All-Academic Team recognition, including two Raider student-athletes earning spots on the five-member team for the last two seasons, while Nagy's teams have each had a cumulative GPA of over 3.0 since taking over in April 2016. In the three years immediately preceding his hiring, the program did not reach a 3.0 GPA in any season.

Nagy became the 61st active NCAA head coach (28th at the Division I level) to reach the 500-win mark when he did so Feb. 22, 2020 against Cleveland State. Along with leading Wright State to the postseason three times in his four seasons, the Raider head man has made 16 total postseason appearances in his 25-year head coaching career. One reason is the continuity among his staff, with Wright State being one of only 11 programs in the nation to have five or more staff members in their fourth season or more together in 2019-20.

Away from the court, Scott Nagy and the Raider program have been heavily involved with Samaritan's Feet, an international humanitarian organization whose mission is to put new shoes and socks on the feet of those in need.

Since beginning his tenure at Wright State, Nagy and the Raiders have served at three shoe distributions in the Dayton area, providing nearly 600 pairs of shoes to children and adults. The Raiders also served on an international level in 2018 in the Dominican Republic. Nagy and his staff have coached a game in their bare feet for the 12 consecutive years to draw awareness to this cause.

WELCOME TO THE NUTT HOUSE

Ever since its inaugural game – an 88-86 win over Tennessee State on December 1, 1990 – the Nutter Center has been a welcoming home for the Raiders over the years. In 2019-20, Wright State turned in a 14-2 mark at home in front of the Raider faithful, and since the Nutter Center's opening for the 1990-91 campaign, the Raiders have won over 300 games at home – a winning percentage above 70 percent.

HOLDEN STEADY

Tanner Holden was named the Horizon League's Player of the Week on Dec. 28. Holden shot 67 percent for the weekend as he recorded games of 18 and 19 points in Wright State's two wins over Green Bay. He recorded his first double-double of the season with 18 points and 10 rebounds on Saturday before tying his season high with 19 points on Sunday, adding eight rebounds in the victory.

Holden followed up the honor with a season-best 24 points on Jan. 1 at Oakland and a double-double with 16 points and 11 rebounds on Jan. 2 against the Golden Grizzlies.

THAT'S...DIFFERENT

The Raiders' 16-point home loss against Marshall to open the season was a 180-degree turn from their few losses over the last several seasons. Last year, Wright State lost two home games by a combined seven points, and in 2018-19, its two home losses tallied up to a combined six-point margin. Wright State's last double-digit home loss prior to Marshall came against Murray State on November 18, 2017, a game that coincidentally was also the last time the Raiders lost their home opening game.

20-20, 20-20

Wright State has won 20-plus games in each of head coach Scott Nagy's four seasons on the bench. Nagy has guided his teams to 20 or more victories in 16 of his 25 seasons as a collegiate head coach.

The Raiders were the first team in the Horizon to reach 20 wins last season, while Wright State reached the mark in 25 total games – that's the fewest games the Raiders have needed to reach 20 victories since becoming a Division-I program in 1987-88. They previously needed 26 games to reach the mark in both 1989-90 and 2007-08.

STAYING HOME

According to VerbalCommits, there are over 1,000 Division I basketball players who have transferred in 2020 alone. Wright State is one of only seven programs nationally that did not have any players transfer out of its program following the 2019-20 season. Joining the Raiders were: Florida State, Louisiana Tech, Miami (Fla.), TCU, Texas and Winthrop.

LIFE ON THE ROAD (TRIP)

COVID-19 precautions have changed the way teams travel on the road this season, but Wright State just wrapped up its longest road stretch of the season at a whopping three games (Bowling Green and Detroit Mercy x2). With the Horizon League's back-to-back schedule, the Raiders are never away from home for longer than one week at a time the rest of the regular season, although they will play four straight home contests over two week-

ends in mid-January. Wright State played six road/neutral games before Horizon play even started last year.

PRESEASON PROJECTIONS

For the third consecutive season, Wright State was picked atop the Horizon League preseason poll, with the Raiders receiving 37 of the 44 total first place votes ahead of the 2020-21 season. Additionally, Loudon Love was chosen as the league's Preseason Player of the Year and a First Team preseason selection.

20 x FIVE

Wright State has won 20-plus games the previous five seasons, matching the longest stretch in program history of consecutive 20-plus win seasons, joining the 1978-79 through the 1982-83 Division II National Championship season.

The Raiders begin the first full season of the new decade after arguably their most successful decade in program history, winning 20-plus games in seven of the last decade's 10 seasons. Wright State also previously won 20-plus games seven times in one decade back from 1980-81 through 1989-90.

WHO'S THE NEW GUY?

The Horizon League welcomed two new institutions to the conference for 2020-21 – Robert Morris and Purdue Fort Wayne.

Wright State has squared off with Robert Morris twice, in back-to-back seasons in January 1977 and 1978, winning both games of the home and home series. The Raiders have a 9-3 lead in the short series against Purdue Fort Wayne, with the last meeting coming during the 2006-07 season. Seven of the 11 matchups came during the 1980's.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER

With the various delays to the begin the season, the 2020-21 season marked the first time this century that Wright State opened its schedule with a game in December (last: Dec. 2, 1992 at Kentucky). The Raiders have opened seasons in December now eight times and are 6-2 overall in those contests, six of which have come at home.

Interestingly enough, Wright State had opened a season on December 3 twice before in its history prior to this year – in 1988 and 1991, both also at home. The Raiders began the 1988-89 campaign with an 88-71 win over Middle Tennessee and started the 1991-92 campaign with an 82-76 victory over Bowling Green.

THE BIG 5-0(0)

Wright State head coach Scott Nagy reached another milestone of his coaching career on Feb. 22, 2020 with an 81-74 overtime victory over Cleveland State for his 500th collegiate victory. With the victory, Nagy became the 61st active NCAA head coach (28th at the Division I level) to reach the 500-win mark. His career-high for victories in a season is 27, which he did twice at South Dakota State (2003-04: 27-7 and 2011-12: 27-8). He has won 25 games in a season twice in four years at Wright State (2017-18: 25-10 and 2019-20: 25-7).

GONE STREAKING

Wright State won eight straight games from Dec. 12, 2019-Jan. 10, 2020, matching its longest winning streak under Scott Nagy (eight straight from Dec. 22, 2017-Jan. 18, 2018).

YOU LOVE TO SEE IT

Redshirt-senior Loudon Love was chosen as the Horizon League's Pre-season Player of the Year and a First Team preseason selection in early November.

Love finished the last year averaging just shy of a double-double for the season at 15.9 points per game and 9.7 rebounds per contest, with his 3.85 offensive rebounds per game average finishing 10th in the country. His 9.7 rebounds/game average was No. 38 nationally and his 261 total rebounds were the 86th-most in the country. Love recorded 21 double-digit scoring performances in 27 games played in 2019-20, including 17 such performances in Horizon League play. He tallied 11 double-doubles last season, eight of which came in League action.

BALANCED ATTACK

Wright State was the most balanced Horizon League team during 2019-20 non-conference play, ranking second in the HL in points per game and having had five different players total 20 points or more in a game. Wright State also leads the Horizon in rebounding and has had four separate players grab 10 or more boards in a game. As a team, Wright State shoots 45.5 percent from the floor, good for third in the HL, and is first in turnover margin.

IN CASE YOU'VE FORGOTTEN ABOUT US...

Wright State claimed its first outright Horizon League regular season title in program history last season with a 15-3 mark in Horizon League play. The 15 League wins were a new program-best, while the Raiders' 25 wins in 2019-20 set the new program standard for most wins in a regular season in the Division I Era.

Additionally, the team's six road Horizon League victories were the most in program history and the Raiders were a perfect 9-0 at home in league play on the way to a 14-2 overall home mark at the Nutter Center. Wright State was the only team to have a member on the All-Horizon League first, second and third team, led by Player of the Year Loudon Love. The Raiders' seven Horizon League honors were also the most in Wright State program history, surpassing the six from 2018-19.

2019-20 AWARDS SEASON

Wright State received seven Horizon League honors in the league's post-season awards announced last March, headlined by Player of the Year selection Loudon Love and Co-Coach of the Year honors for Scott Nagy.

The honor was the third consecutive for Nagy, while Love's Player of the Year award made the Raider big man the first Wright State player to earn the Horizon League's top individual honor since DeShaun Wood following the 2006-2007 season. Love was also recognized on the HL first team, while Bill Wampler earned second team honors and Cole Gentry was named to the third team. Grant Basile and Tanner Holden were both named to the All-Freshman Team.

The seven honorees are the most in Wright State program history. Nagy's recognition was his third in four seasons at the helm of the Raiders and was the sixth time in program history a Wright State coach earned the league's top coaching honor.

ONE OF THE FEW

The Raiders were one of 23 teams in the country with 25 or more victories entering the 2020 Horizon League Championship last March. Prior to its loss at Youngstown State on Feb. 20, 2020, Wright State was one of the final seven teams in the country to have not lost a game by double-digits.

RAIDERS INK TWO

Head coach Scott Nagy announced the signing of two players on November 11 to national letters-of-intent to attend Wright State and join the Raider program beginning next fall.

A.J. Braun, a 6'9" big man from Dayton, OH (Bishop Fenwick), averaged 18.2 points per game and 11 rebounds per game last season as a junior, including 3.5 offensive rebounds per game. He averaged 2.9 blocks per game while shooting 54.5 percent from the floor and 41 percent from three-point range while tallying 16 double-doubles. A first team Grater Catholic League selection last season, Braun already holds the Bishop Fenwick school record with 175 career blocks entering his senior season.

Keaton Norris, a 5'11" guard from Hilliard, OH (Hilliard Bradley), averaged 11.5 points per game as a junior last season along with averaging four assists and four rebounds per game. He shot 48 percent from the floor and 40 percent from three-point range, while also connecting at an 84 percent rate from the free throw stripe, as he helped Hilliard Bradley to a 25-2 record and the Ohio Capital-Cardinal (OCC) League championship.

POSTSEASON SUCCESS

The Raiders, who won 25 games last year and their first outright Horizon League regular season title, were on their way to a second consecutive NIT appearance prior to the 2020-21 season's shutdown due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The NIT appearance would have marked Wright State's third straight postseason appearance (NCAA Tournament, 2018 & NIT, 2019).

Wright State has qualified for four different postseason tournaments in program history: NCAA Tournament (3x: 1993, 2007, 2018), NIT (2x: 2019, 2020), College Basketball Invitational (2013) and CollegeInsider.com Tournament (2014).

Among all NCAA Division I men's basketball programs, Wright State is one of 18 total programs nationally to have appeared in four or more NCAA postseason tournaments.

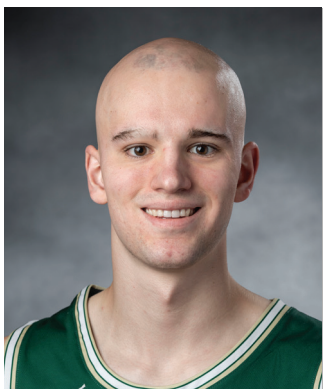

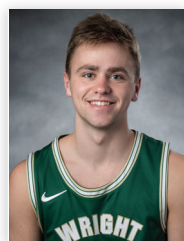
