- The Bulldogs have won their home opener in 22 consecutive seasons; that dates back to 1998 when Southwest Missouri State (now referred to as Missouri State) won a 72-57 decision at Hinkle Fieldhouse.
- Butler is 59-1 over its last 60 non-conference home games.
- Butler was picked to finish sixth in the BIG EAST Preseason Poll by the conference's head coaches.
- Sophomore Chuck Harris was an honorable mention selection to the Preseason All-BIG EAST team by the conference's head coaches.
- Butler's 2021-22 roster includes six players who are entering their fifth or sixth season of college basketball.
- The Bulldogs return 10 of their 11 top scorers from a season ago.
- Butler's roster returns 97.2 percent of its scoring and 96.2 percent of its minutes played from last season.
- Butler adds graduate transfer Ty Groce to the roster; Groce led Eastern Michigan in both scoring and rebounding in 2020-21.
- Butler had nine players miss at least one game last season due to a non-COVID injury.
- Butler and Creighton were the only two BIG EAST teams to play all 20 conference games during the 2020-21 season.
- Butler overcame a 19-point deficit to beat Xavier in the BIG EAST Tournament, the largest comeback in a win for the Bulldogs since erasing a 20-point deficit at Georgetown Dec. 27, 2017.
- Five of Butler's 10 wins in 2020-21 included double-digit comebacks.
- Harris was the first freshman to lead Butler in scoring since 1979-80 season.
- Harris was a unanimous selection to the 2020-21 BIG EAST All-Freshman Team.
- Eight different Bulldogs led the team in scoring last season; six different Bulldogs posted 20-point games.
- Butler committed single-digit turnovers in nine games last season.
- Butler went 8-4 at Hinkle Fieldhouse during the 2020-21 season.
- Bryce Nze finished fourth in the BIG EAST in rebounding (7.7 per game)

The Bulldogs officially open the 2021-22 season Tuesday night when the Jaguars of IUPUI make the short trip to Hinkle Fieldhouse from downtown Indianapolis.

The game is part of the FOX Opening Night Tip-Off Show, which will have FS1 showcasing all of the BIG EAST teams who have opening-night contests. While FS1 will cut in and out of Butler's game throughout the night, fans who want to follow solely along with the Bulldogs' game are encouraged to watch the contest in its entirety on the FOX Sports App.

THE SERIES: Butler and IUPUI meet for the seventh time with Tuesday's match-up. The Bulldogs have won all six previous games, all of which have been played at Hinkle Fieldhouse. The two teams also opened the 2019-20 season at Hinkle Fieldhouse, which is coach LaVall Jordan's only meeting against the Jaguars as the head coach at Butler.

DRESS REHEARSAL #1: The Bulldogs opened the season with a 94-84 exhibition win over Tiffin Oct. 30 at Hinkle. Freshman Jayden Taylor led the Bulldogs with 25 points on 8-of-11 shooting. Both Bryce Nze (23 points, 10 rebounds) and Aaron Thompson (11 points, 10 assists) posted double-doubles. The Bulldogs shot 58 percent for the contest and held strong advantages in rebounding (37-23) and points in the paint (50-28). Tiffin stayed in the contest by shooting 15-of-29 from three-point range.

DRESS REHEARSAL #2: The Bulldogs closed the exhibition portion of their schedule with a Friday night win over the University of Indianapolis, 73-68. Chuck Harris led the Bulldogs with an efficient 20 points on 6-of-9 shooting. Bryce Nze posted 15 points and 11 rebounds for his second double-double of the preseason. Jayden Taylor added 12, his second straight double-figure scoring performance. The Bulldogs committed only five turnovers.

TOUGH SLATE: In addition to a true round-robin format that has Butler playing all 10 BIG EAST foes both on the road and at home, the Bulldogs will challenge themselves significantly with this season's non-conference schedule. Butler will host Michigan State Nov. 17 in the annual Gavitt Games. The Maui Invitational (now being played in Las Vegas) features an opening-round match-up with 2021 Final Four team Houston. The Bulldogs travel to Oklahoma Dec. 7 in the annual BIG EAST-Big 12 Battle. Butler and Purdue, which is No. 7 in the AP preseason poll, will meet Dec. 18 in the Crossroads Classic.

HAPPY RETURNS: Butler returns 10 of its top 11 scorers from last season. In all, Butler's roster returns 97.2 percent of its scoring and 96.2 percent of minutes played from the 2020-21 season. Butler returns five double-digit scorers from a season ago and adds Ty Groce, a graduate transfer from Eastern Michigan. Groce led the Eagles in scoring last season, the sixth player on the Butler roster to average double figures in 2020-21. Butler has six players who will play their fifth season of college basketball during the upcoming campaign -- Aaron Thompson, Bryce Nze, Jair Bolden, Christian David, Bo Hodges, and Ty Groce. Of that group, Nze, Bolden and Groce are in their sixth year of college after previously redshirting and now taking advantage of the additional season of eligibility due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

PRESEASON PICKS: The BIG EAST head coaches picked the Bulldogs to finish sixth in the league standings in the preseason poll that was announced as part of BIG EAST Media Day in New York City in October.

WHAT WILL HE DO FOR AN ENCORE?: Butler's Chuck Harris was recognized as an honorable mention selection to the 2021-22 All-BIG EAST preseason team. Harris was one of three unanimous picks on the 2020-21 All-BIG EAST Freshman Team, joining Posh Alexander of St. John's and Marquette's Dawson Garcia (Garcia has since transferred to North Carolina). Harris led the Bulldogs in scoring during the 2020-21 season, becoming the first freshman to lead the team in scoring since the 1979-80 season (Tony Warren). Harris led the team in scoring in 17 of his 24 games played, scoring 20 or more points six times.

Harris became the third Bulldog to earn a spot on the BIG EAST All-Freshman Team since Butler joined the BIG EAST prior to the 2013-14 season. Kamar Baldwin was also a unanimous selection in 2016-17 and Andrew Chrabascz earned a spot on the 2013-14 team.

TOP 10 WINS: Butler defeated No. 8 Villanova, 73-61, Feb. 28 at Hinkle Fieldhouse in the Bulldogs' Senior Day. It was Butler's second Top 10 win of the season; the Bulldogs also defeated No. 8/6 Creighton on Jan. 16.

HOME SWEET HINKLE: Butler is 48-14 at Hinkle Fieldhouse in LaVall Jordan's four seasons as head coach of the Bulldogs.

CALL IT A COMEBACK: Five of Butler's 10 wins during the 2020-21 season included a double-digit comeback. The Bulldogs overcame a 19-point deficit in the BIG EAST

Tournament win over Xavier, which was Butler's biggest comeback since erasing a 20-point deficit at Georgetown Dec. 27, 2017, taking a 91-89 double-overtime win.

Other comebacks included a Feb. 9 16-point comeback against St. John's as well as 12 vs. DePaul, Feb. 6; 13 vs. Creighton, Jan. 16; and 11 vs. Georgetown, Jan. 6.

LaVall Jordan, who helped Butler to conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances as both a player and an assistant coach, returned to his alma mater as the 24th head coach in men's basketball program history. He was hired June 12, 2017 by Butler Vice President/Director of Athletics Barry Collier, who recruited Jordan to Butler as a student-athlete and coached him for three of Jordan's four seasons in a Bulldog uniform.

At Butler (as head coach)

- The 2019-20 Bulldogs finished the season 22-9 and ranked in the Top 25 of both national polls
- Butler climbed to No. 5 in both national polls earlier in the season, the highest in-season ranking in program history.
- Jordan's Bulldogs held opponents to only 62.1 points per game, the 11th-best mark nationally.
- For his leadership, Jordan was among 15 coaches on the late season watch list for the 2020 Werner Ladder Naismith Men's Coach of the Year Award.
- Led the Bulldogs to a 20-win season and an 2018 NCAA Tournament appearance in his first season as head coach of his alma mater; followed that with 2019 NIT berth
- The Bulldogs advanced to the Round of 32 in the 2018 NCAA Tournament with a win over Arkansas. Butler also posted its first BIG EAST Tournament victory in 2018.
- Mentored Kelan Martin to Associated Press honorable mention All-America honors as Martin became the second all-time scorer in Butler history. In doing so, he was voted as a unanimous All-BIG EAST selection among a long list of accolades.
- The 2017-18 season included a home win over No. 1 (and eventual national champion) Villanova and a thrilling overtime victory over Ohio State in the PK80 Invitational as Butler overcame a 15-point deficit with less than four minutes remaining in regulation.
- Joined Brad Stevens, Thad Matta and Chris Holtmann as first-year head coaches to lead the Bulldogs to the NCAA Tournament.

At Butler (as an assistant coach and player)

- His coaching career began on the Butler sidelines (2003-07), working as an assistant coach for three seasons (2004-07) and as the coordinator of basketball operations in 2003-04.
- Helped guide the Bulldogs to a 29-7 record in 2006-07, sharing the Horizon League regular season title in 2007. Butler advanced to the Sweet 16 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament before a loss to eventual national champion, Florida.
- Before embarking on his coaching career, Jordan was a starting guard at Butler (1998-2001), helping the Bulldogs win three conference tournament titles and two Midwestern Collegiate Conference regular-season championships. He participated in four consecutive postseason tournaments -- NCAA (1998, 2000, 2001) and NIT (1999) -- and helped record Butler's first NCAA tournament win in 39 years with a 79-63 win over Wake Forest in 2001.
- Won 91 games in four years, which (at the time) made him the winningest player in Butler history.
- A two-time All-Midwestern Collegiate Conference performer and was the league's tournament MVP in 2001. His Butler career included 977 points, 365 rebounds, 179 assists, and 151 3FGM.
- Earned his bachelor's degree in journalism from Butler in 2001

As a Head Coach (2016-17 at Milwaukee)

- In his first head coaching position, Jordan led the Panthers to the Horizon League Tournament championship game; Milwaukee entered the postseason as the tournament's No. 10 seed.
- Inheriting only four returning scholarship players when he took over the Panthers' program in April of 2016, finished 11-24 on the season.

As an Assistant Coach (at Michigan and Iowa, in addition to his time at Butler)

- Spent six seasons as an assistant coach at Michigan (2010-16) under head coach John Beilein
- Helped Michigan to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the 2013 national title game -- the first for the program in 20 years, followed by a return trip to the Elite Eight in 2014.
- With Jordan, U-M averaged 24 wins per season, including a U-M record-tying 31 during the 2012-13 season. Michigan claimed a share of the 2012 Big Ten regular-season title. The Wolverines won their first outright Big Ten title in 28 years in 2014.
- Specializing in guard development, Jordan coached eight Wolverine guards to All-Big Ten honors. In addition, during his stint with U-M, six Wolverines reached the NBA.
- Spent three years at Iowa (2007-10) under Todd Lickliter. Jordan also coached under Lickliter at Butler after playing for Barry Collier and Thad Matta.

As a Professional Player

- Following his Butler career, he went on to play professional basketball in Europe
- He was the first Butler player to participate in the National Basketball Developmental League, playing for the Huntsville Flight.

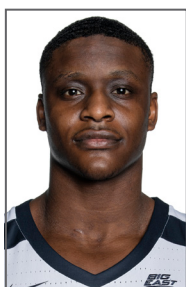
