OPENING TIP

LAST TIME OUT

Playing shorthanded for the second-straight contest, the Wright State men's basketball team came up just short at Youngstown State, falling 90-87 on Saturday night. Wright State plaued without four individuals within the program's tier one personnel due to COVID-19 protocols, but saw three Raiders finish in double digits as three players played all 40 minutes of game action.

Tanner Holden tied a career-best with 27 points, including 20 in the second half, while finishing with 11 rebounds for his second double-double of the season as he added four assists while playing all 40 minutes. Grant Basile poured in 17 first half points on the way to a double-double of his own with 26 points and 10 rebounds as he played 39 minutes. Tim Finke tallied 15 first half points and finished with 18 points as the final Raider in double digits.

A SERIES CALLED JAG(S)

IUPUI is 1-15 overall this season with an 0-6 Horizon League mark. The Jaguars are 1-5 at home, but have lost their last 10 overall, including a Tuesday night contest at Ohio State.

This is the second meeting this season, with Wright State winning 72-58 inside the Nutter Center back on January 8.

Wright State and IUPUI have previously met 21 times entering Thursday's action, with the Raiders leading the series 18-3, including winning the last eight matchups, and 11 of the last 12 meetings overall. IUPUI won the first game of the series back on Nov. 29, 1976 (89-84) but the Raiders have had almost all the success in the series. The Jaguars other wins in the series came Feb. 23, 2018 and Jan. 8, 1986. Wright State and IUPUI met in 11 consecutive seasons from the 1976-77 through 1986-87 before the series went dormant for over 30 years.

WRIGHT STATE 2021-22 MEDIA PROTOCOLS

WORKING CREDENTIALS: To request credentials, please contact Nick Phillips, Assistant Athletics Director for Communications (nick.phillips@wright.edu). All requests should be made as early as possible and should be limited to working press only. Face coverings will be required at all times for everyone. Requests for credentials will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. The Athletic Communications office has the final authority on whether any individuals from any organization will be issued media credentials.

MEDIA ENTRANCE: Working media will gain access to the Nutter Center via the loading dock (as in previous years). The Media Room for working media will again be available pre-, post- and in-game, along with a pregame meal and beverages.

PHOTOGRAPHERS: COVID-19 guidelines require appropriate distancing around the playing floor - still and video photographers must remain at least 6 feet back from the playing court (denoted by a black marked line on each baseline) and also be aware of ticketed fans around them. Contact Nick Phillips with any questions.

RADIO COVERAGE: Radio broadcast permission must be obtained in advance from Nick Phillips. Official radio partners of visiting teams should work with their SID to communicate with Wright State in advance of the game(s). Wright State provides a courtesu ethernet line for the official radio partners of visiting teams. ISDN lines will not be readily available at the Nutter Center this season due to temporary relocation of radio areas due to COVID-19, but may be made available upon request. Inquiries about any accommodations should be made well in advance with Nick Phillips.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS: All postgame press conferences with head coach Scott Nagy and select players, will be conducted as a hybrid, both in person and electronically on Zoom this season. The link to join the press conference will be sent out at the conclusion of each game, along with any other relevant info. Wright State Athletic Communications representatives will be available to assist in postgame interviews. Interviews with the visiting team can be coordinated with the visiting SID and/or Nick Phillips.

WEEKLY MEDIA AVAILABILITY: Men's Basketball head coach Scott Nagy will hold his weekly media availability with the media in person this season when the team schedule allows, usually on a weekly basis. Select players may also be available at the weekly media availability. Contact Nick Phillips for any inquiries about the weekly media availability schedule.

-IUPUI has lost its last 10 games overall and is winnless in six Horizon League contests entering Thursday night. The Jaguars Ione win came at home on Nov. 23 against NCAA Division III member Spalding University (Ky.).
-IUPUI's win over Spalding on Nov. 23 was the first of three straight home games for the

-IUPUI's win over Spalding on Nov. 23 was the first of three straight home games for the Jaguars in what turned out to be their longest homestand of the season. IUPUI was slated for five straight home games from mid-December through January I, but saw the final three games of that stretch canceled due to COVID issues.

-IUPUI is coming off of an 83-37 road loss at Ohio State on Tuesday night, where the Jaguars were held to 13 points in the second half as Ohio State forced them into 21 turnovers.

40 MINUTE MEN

The Raiders, down to seven total players and five scholarship players in a pair of road contests on Jan. 13 and 15, saw Tim Finke and Keaton Norris play 40 minutes in back-to-back contests, while Grant Basile turned in 40- and 39-minute efforts. Tanner Holden logged 40 minutes in the Jan. 15 game after playing 27 minutes - including the entire second half with three fouls - in the Jan. 13 contest.

ON THE VERGE

Tanner Holden is on the verge of reaching 500 career rebounds, entering Thursday's contest with 492 career rebounds. Holden is averaging 8.9 rebounds per game this season and has is averaging 6.7 rebounds/game for his career. He will become the 21st Raider to reach 500 career rebounds.

HOLDEN IT DOWN

Tanner Holden has scored 20-plus points in five of the last six overall entering Thursday's contest, including tying his career-high with 27 points at Youngstown State on Jan. 15. This season, Holden has scored in double-digits in 17 of 18 games, with 11 games of 20-plus points.

NATIONAL ATTENTION

Tanner Holden (82% FT) has made 109 free throws on 133 total attempts, which both lead the country through Tuesday's games. Holden's 345 total points scored is No. 16 in the country, while his 20.3 points per game average is No. 18 nationally.

Grant Basile's rebound work is also among the best in the nation: ranking 26th nationally with 152 total rebounds, No. 28 in the country with his 6.65 defensive rebounds/game average and No. 34 nationally in total rebounds/game average with his 8.9 boards per contest.

NUMBER 1,000 FOR NUMBER 2

Tanner Holden became the 35th member of the Wright State 1,000 point club on January 1 with a free throw in the first half against Green Bay. Currently in his third season, Holden is averaging over 14 points per game for his career and 20 points a contest this season. Holden is the second Raider from Wheelersburg, Ohio to find the record book, joining fellow Wheelersburg native Drew Burleson (2003-07) in the 1,000 point club. Burleson finished his career with 1,176 career points and is also a member of the 500 rebound club with 576 in his Raider career. Entering this week's games, Holden is at 492 rebounds and counting.

GREAT GRANT

Grant Basile was named the Horizon League's Player of the Week on Dec. 27 after his 23 points led four Raiders in double-digits scoring in the Dec. 21 victory over NC State, while his 16 rebounds were a game-high on the way to the night's lone double-double. He finished the night shooting 9-of-16 from the floor as he filled his stat line with a pair of three-pointers, four assists, a block and a steal over 35 minutes of action.

WELCOME TO THE NUTT HOUSE

Ever since its inaugural game - an 88-86 win over Tennessee State on December 1, 1990 - the Nutter Center has been a welcoming home for the Raiders over the years. In 2019-20, Wright State turned in a 14-2 mark at home in front of the Raider faithful, and since the Nutter Center's opening for the 1990-91 campaign, the Raiders have won over 300 games at home - a winning percentage above 70 percent.

AJ AWARDS

AJ Braun earned his first Horizon League Freshman of the Week honor on Dec. 27 after turning in 13 points and had seven rebounds in the Dec. 21 victory over NC State. His six points scored over the first five minutes of the second half helped the Raiders cement control of the night, while he added a pair of blocks and passed out a pair of assists.

ACC STATE-MENT

Wright State's 84-70 road victory over North Carolina State on December 21 was one day shy of the last Raider road win over an ACC opponent - an 85-81 victory at Georgia Tech Dec. 22, 2017. The Radier win over NC State was just the second win over the Wolfpack ever by a Horizon League school, while Wright State has now won two of its last three contests overall against ACC foes, with the lone loss coming against Clemson and former head coach Brad Brownell in the opening round of the 2019 NIT (75-69 loss).

(WRIGHT) STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA

Wright State is now 11-4 in program history against teams from the state of North Carolina following its win over North Carolina State on December 21. The Raiders have now won their last three contests inside Tar Heel State - the 84-70 victory over NC State, a 69-56 victory at Western Carolina on Dec. 18, 2014. and a 73-59 win at East Carolina in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament on March 18, 2014, which is currently the last Raider postseason victory.

CAREER CALVIN

Trey Calvin reset his career scoring mark for the second time this season with a 28-point effort in Wright State's loss at Cleveland State on Dec. 4. In addition, his 10-for-18 shooting mark and perfect 5-for-5 connection at the free throw stripe were also all new career bests. Calvin has scored in double-digits in five of nine games overall this season.

WELCOME TO COLLEGE

Freshman AJ Braun saw his first collegiate action during the Naples Invitational, and has made an immediate impact for the Raiders. He earned his first collegiate start on Dec. 2 at Fort Wayne and turned in his first double-digit scoring game, finishing with 17 points in the win.

WELL DONE WELAGE

Andrew Welage turned in a career-best 11 points - all in the first half - on Nov. 24 against Long Beach State with a 4-for-8 shooting line with a trio of three-point baskets. His 24 minutes played against The Beach was also a new career-high. Through six games, Welage is averaging 13.5 minutes per night, up from his 7.4 minutes/game mark in 11 contests played last season as a freshman.

BIG TEN TREY

Trey Calvin had a then-career night in Wright State's loss at Purdue on Nov. 16, finishing with a game-high 21 points, surpassing his former career-best 19 points from December 2020. Calvin finished the night 9-of-17 shooting, including hitting three of his nine three-point attempts, as his nine made baskets was also a career-best.

THE NAGY ERA - AN ERA OF SUCCESS

Since being hired in April 2016 as the ninth head coach in program history, Scott Nagy has led the Wright State program to unprecedented success. A three-time Horizon League Coach of the Year (when there had been previously been only three in program history prior to his arrival), Nagy and the Raiders have qualified for a postseason tournament in three of his five seasons (2018 NCAA Tournament, 2019 and 2020 NITs).

Entering the 2021-22 season, Nagy has won 109 of his 158 games at Wright State in five seasons, having won 69 percent of his games. That clip is just behind the winning percentage of the top coach in Wright State program history, Ralph Underhill, who won 120 games in his first five seasons from 1978-79 to 1982-83 when the Raiders competed at the NCAA Division II level.

Nagy's 69 Horizon League victories over the last five seasons are 26 more than Wright State won in the five years immediately preceding his hiring (2011-2016), while the Raiders' 28 All-Conference accolades (6 first team, 4 second team, 1 third team, 4 Newcomer team, 5 All-Defensive, 3 All-Tournament, 3 Coach of the Year) are more than nine times the amount of honors from 2013-2016 (1 second team, 1 Newcomer team, 1 All-Defensive).

Additionally, Nagy's Raider teams have produced in the classroom as well, with six student-athletes earning Horizon League All-Academic Team recognition, including two Raider student-athletes earning spots on the five-member team in two different seasons, while Nagy's teams have each had a cumulative GPA of over 3.0 since taking over in April 2016. In the three years immediately preceding his hiring, the program did not reach a 3.0 GPA in any season.

Nagy became the 61st active NCAA head coach (28th at the Division I level) to reach the 500-win mark when he did so Feb. 22, 2020 against Cleveland State. He went on to win his 100th career game at Wright State on January 16, 2021 against Cleveland State, becoming the third head coach in program history to record 100 career wins with the Raiders.

Along with leading Wright State to the postseason three times in his five seasons, the Raider head man has made 16 total postseason appearances in his 26-year head coaching career.

Away from the court, Scott Nagy and the Raider program have been heavily involved with Samaritan's Feet, an international humanitarian organization whose mission is to put new shoes and socks on the feet of those in need.

Since beginning his tenure at Wright State, Nagy and the Raiders have served at three shoe distributions in the Dayton area, providing nearly 600 pairs of shoes to children and adults. The Raiders also served on an international level in 2018 in the Dominican Republic. Nagy and his staff have coached a game in their bare feet for the 12 consecutive years to draw awareness to this cause.

BIG TIME BASILE

Grant Basile has reset his career-high scoring total in Wright State's loss at Marshall on Nov.12. Basile ended last season with a then-best 35 points in the Raiders' Horizon League tournament loss against Milwaukee last March, going 11-of-18 from the floor with a 12-of-15 mark from the free throw stripe. Basile turned in 37 points on the road against Marshall, including 22 points in the second half, as he went 12-of-21 from the floor while hitting 12-of-14 from the stripe.

MOVING UP

Raider head coach Scott Nagy tallied his 110th victory at Wright State with the season-opening win over Lake Erie, moving into second-place all-time for career victories at Wright State behind only Ralph Underhill, who finished his career with 356 Raider wins over 18 seasons.

STARTING STRONG

Wright State has always opened seasons strong at home. The Raiders have won 14 season openers over the last 21 years, dating back to 2000-01. This season was the 10th time the Raiders have opened the season inside the Nutter Center in the last 21 years, with eight wins in those games. Wright State is a combined 44-8 all-time in season openers in its two home venues. The Raiders were an astounding 19-1 in home openers inside the Physical Education Building from 1970-71 through 1989-90 (lone loss was 1976-77) and have been just as impressive since opening the Nutter Center on December 1, 1990, where Wright State is 25-7 in home openers, including winning the first home contest of the season nine of the last 11 years.

HOLDEN ON HENSON WATCH LIST

Tanner Holden was named to the Lou Henson Award Preseason Watch List on November 4. The award is presented annually to the nation's top Division I mid-major player. Holden's selection follows the Henson recognition from former Raider Loudon Love, named to Lou Henson All-America Team the last three consecutive seasons.

PRESEASON HONORS

A pair of Raiders earned Horizon League preseason honors ahead of the season, with redshirt junior Grant Basile named a first team preseason selection and junior Tanner Holden earning second team preseason honors. Basile scored at a 15.0 points per game clip with 19 double digit scoring games, including a career-high 35 points in the Horizon League tournament last March against Milwaukee. Holden averaged a team-high 34 minutes per game last season and tallied 15.8 points per game, second-most on the roster. He recorded 21 double digit scoring games, including 18 games with 15 or more points. Basile and Holden both began their Raider careers as all-freshman honorees in 2019-20.

LIFE ON THE ROAD (TRIP)

With 2021-22 returning to a 'normal schedule' compared to last season, Wright State will face a pair of long road trips after seeing its longest road stretch be only three games in 2020-21.

After opening the season at home on Nov. 9, the Raiders did not return to the Nutter Center until Dec. 15, playing seven games on the road in four states during that stretch. Wright State traveled to Marshall (Nov. 12) and Purdue (Nov. 16) before three games at the Naples Invitational from Nov. 22-24. The Raiders capped the stretch with two Horizon League contests, at Purdue Fort Wayne (Dec. 2) and Cleveland State (Dec. 4).

Wright State also faces a five-game road trip during Horizon League play in January, traveling to Northern Kentucky (Jan. 10), Robert Morris (Jan. 13), Youngstown State (Jan. 15), IUPUI (Jan. 20) and UIC (Jan. 22).

IN CASE YOU'VE FORGOTTEN ABOUT US...

Wright State returns 10 players from last season's squad that finished 18-6 overall and recorded a 16-4 conference mark on the way to the third straight season of claiming at least a share of the Horizon League regular season title. Three returning Raiders earned Horizon League postseason honors, with Tanner Holden on the first team, Grant Basile on the second team and Tim Finke garnering All-Defen-

sive honors, while former Raider Loudon Love earned his second straight HL Player of the Year honor along with being a first team performer. In October, Wright State received 463 total votes and nine first-place votes as the Raiders were selected second in the Horizon League preseason poll ahead of the 2021-22 season.

THE BIG 5-0(0)

Wright State head coach Scott Nagy reached another milestone of his coaching career on Feb. 22, 2020 with an 81-74 overtime victory over Cleveland State for his 500th collegiate victory. With the victory, Nagy became the 61st active NCAA head coach (28th at the Division I level) to reach the 500-win mark. His career-high for victories in a season is 27, which he did twice at South Dakota State (2003-04: 27-7 and 2011-12: 27-8). He has won 25 games in a season twice in four years at Wright State (2017-18: 25-10 and 2019-20: 25-7).

KEEPING IT 100

Head coach Scott Nagy won his 100th career game at Wright State on Jan. 16, 2021 against Cleveland State, becoming the third head coach in program history to record 100 career wins with the Raiders, joining the legendary Ralph Underhill (356 Wright State wins in 18 years) and Billy Donlon (109 career Wright State wins in six years). Ironically, Nagy won his 500th career game overall in February 2020 at Cleveland State. Nagy became just the second current Horizon League head coach to reach 100 wins at the League school, joining Oakland's Greg Kampe. Kampe is the only other current Horizon League head coach with 500-plus career wins overall.

WHO'S THE NEW GUY?

The Wright State coaching staff has a new look this season after three new faces joined the Raider bench. Dan Beré, Travis Trice and Tae Gibbs are new to the staff, replacing former associate head coach Brian Cooley (Colorado State), assistant coach Sharif Chambliss (Wisconsin) and administrative assistant Nick Naqu.

WHERE'S THE LOVE?

Former Wright State standout Loudon Love announced during the summer that he was forgoing the additional season of eligibility he would have gained because of the COVID-19 pandemic, opting instead to begin his professional career. Love was selected 11th overall in the 2021 NBA G League Draft on Oct. 23 by the Texas Legends, affiliates of the Dallas Mavericks.

Love, the all-time leading rebounder in Wright State basketball history, played in 120 career games in a Raider uniform and departed Wright State as the winningest player in the Division I era, having been a part of 89 wins over his five seasons. He finished his career with 1,123 career rebounds, the most in Wright State basketball history (men and women), Love exited Wright State as the No. 3-leading scorer all-time in program history with 1,792 career points.

RAIDERS INK TWO

Head coach Scott Nagy y announced the signing of two players on November 10 to national letters-of-intent to attend Wright State and join the Raider program beginning next fall. The newest Raiders are Drey Carter from Columbus, OH (Westerville South) and Logan Woods from Cincinnati, OH (Fairfield).

Carter, a 6'8" guard, averaged 15.1 points per game last season as a junior while connecting on 45 percent of his three-point attempts. He added 4.7 rebounds per game and 2.5 assists per contest on the way to being named a first team All-League player and earning Division I All-Ohio honorable mention honors.

Woods, a 6'4" guard, averaged 16.1 points per game as a junior, shooting 46.5 percent overall from the floor with a 36.5 percent average from three-point range last season. He added 3.3 rebounds per game and 1.7 assists per contest while averaging just under a seal per game as Fairfield won the conference championship and he was named a first team All-League player and earning Division I All-Ohio honorable mention honors.
