QUICK HITTERS

IUPUI will kickoff season No. 51 with Hall of Famer **Matt Crenshaw** beginning his first season as head coach. Crenshaw was a four-year letterwinner for the Jaguars (2000-2004) and finished his career as the program's all-time leader in assists (510). He also made the game-winning shot to send the Jaguars to their first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance in 2003, hitting the winning in the Mid-Continent Conference title game as IUPUI defeated Valparaiso, 66-64, at Kemper Arena in Kansas City. Crenshaw spent 12 seasons on the IUPUI bench before leaving for an assistant post at Ball State from 2018-2021.

Crenshaw faces the unenviable task of having to take over a program that lost its all-time leading rebounder (**Elyjah Goss**), all-time leader in threes made (**Jaylen Minnett**) and a two-time all-league guard that's now playing in the NBA G League (**Marcus Burk**). Burk averaged 21.7 points last season while Minnett poured in 16.4 points per game last season. Goss averaged 11.1 points and 11.6 rebounds per game and also led the team in blocked shots. All total, IUPUI returns just 32.5 percent of the team's scoring and 49.3 percent of the team's minutes from a season ago.

IUPUI's two returning starters are junior guard **Mike DePersia** (5.0 ppg, 3.74 a/to) and **Nathan McClure** (4.4 ppg, 13.3 s's). Two other key returners are **Azariah Seay** (5.7 ppg) and **Bobby Harvey** (5.6 ppg).

IUPUI will undoubtedly perform something in the season opener that has never occurred in the program's Division I history (and unlikely to have ever happened in program history). The Jaguars will most assuredly utilize a starting five with no players from the state of Indiana. That has never occurred in the program's D1 history (1998-present) and it's unlikely that it ever occurred prior to 1998 as well. In the history of the program, nearly 73 percent of the players to have played in at least one game for the program come from the state of Indiana. IUPUI has just three Indiana natives on this year's squad in **Zach Gunn** and non-scholarship student-athletes **Kaleb Edwards** and **Derek Petersen**. Of that three, Gunn is likely to miss the entire season due to an injury suffered in the preseason.

IUPUI flashed some serious defense in its season opener at Butler on Nov. 9, holding the Bulldogs to just .341 shooting, 15 made field goals and 56 total points. The .341 shooting percentage was the lowest by an IUPUI opponent since holding St. Francis Brooklyn to .340 back on Nov. 23, 2018. The 15 made buckets tied for the fourth-lowest total in a game by an IUPUI opponent and were the least since Western Illinois made just 14 against IUPUI back on Feb. 6, 2010. The 56 points allowed were the fewest by an IUPUI foe since IUPUI held South Florida to 53 back on Nov. 13, 2019.

PROTEGE

First year head coach Matt Crenshaw is quick to credit his college coach and mentor Ron Hunter (current Tulane HC) for helping guide his principles. IUPUI experienced a lot of success at the Division I level under Hunter with the success largely stemming from two traits - an aggressive matchup zone defense that held opponents down and ability to limit turnovers.

IUPUI did both in the season opener, holding Butler to just .341 percent shooting, 15 made field goals (only six after halftime) and just 56 points.

The .341 shooting percentage was the lowest by an IUPUI opponent since holding St. Francis Brooklyn to .340 back on Nov. 23, 2018. The 15 made buckets tied for the fourth-lowest total in a game by an IUPUI opponent and were the least since Western Illinois made just 14 against IUPUI back on Feb. 6, 2010. The 56 points allowed were the fewest by an IUPUI foe since IUPUI held South Florida to 53 back on Nov. 13, 2019.

In addition, IUPUI committed just nine turnovers and forced 14 miscues. The Jaguars cashed in to outscore Butler 11-7 in points off turnovers.

DEBUTS

Four IUPUI players made their Jaguar debuts at Butler on Tuesday night (Nov. 9) with three making their collegiate debuts.

Grad-transfer B.J. Maxwell made his IUPUI debut with a team-high 14 points, six boards and two blocked shots. He hit 4-of-11 field goal attempts and played a team-high 27 minutes.

The three true freshmen all made their collegiate debuts with KJ Pruitt and Boston Stanton III doing so as starters. 6-foot-11 forward Chuks Isitua made his debut off the IUPUI bench.

DEPARTED

IUPUI returns just 32.5 percent of its scoring from a season ago as the trio of Marcus Burk (21.7 ppg, 45 3's), Jaylen Minnett (16.4 ppg, 41 3's) and Elyjah Goss (11.1 ppg, 11.6 rpg) are all playing elsewhere this season.

Burk recently inked a deal with the G League Grand Rapids Gold (affiliate of the Denver Nuggets), Goss is playing professionally in Sweden and Minnett opted to play a graduate season at Missouri State.

Burk finished his two-year IUPUI career ranked No. 22 on the program's all-time scoring list with 1,072 points and Minnett finished No. 9 on the program's all-time scoring list with 1,403 career points and as the program's all-time leader in threes made (285). Goss closed his career as the program's all-time leader in rebounds (880) and a D1 record 25 double-doubles.

SEVEN BACK

IUPUI returns seven letterwinners and two starters - Mike DePersia (5.0 ppg, 3.9 apg) and Nathan McClure (4.4 ppg, 2.9 rpg). The other returning letterwinners are Azariah Seay (5.7 ppg), Bobby Harvey (5.6 rpg), Bakari LaStrap (2.8 ppg), Dimitar Pandev (1.6 ppg, 1.9 rpg) and Jonah Carrasco (0.3 ppg, 0.4 rpg).

JERSEY MIKE

Junior guard Mike DePersia ranked No. 3 in the country a year ago with a 3.74 assist-to-turnover ratio, delivering 71 assists against just 19 miscues. In league play, he upped that figure to 4.13. His 3.74 mark last season easily eclipsed the previous IUPUI single-season mark, which was 3.30 set by Taj Hawkins back in 2001-02.

DePersia tied IUPUI's single-game record with 14 assists in a game in a Feb. 12 win over UIC, doing so without committing a turnover. He had a six-game span where he didn't turn the ball over once, dishing out 31 assists during that span.

DePersia enters his third season with the program with a 2.56 career assist-to-turnover ratio, having distributed 156 assists against just 61 turnovers in an IUPUI uniform. The IUPUI career record in the category is 2.16 as Brady Adkins had 261 assists against just 121 turnovers from 1994-1996.

HOOSIER TIES

For the first time in program history, IUPUI will likely unveil a starting five that doesn't include an Indiana-native. In program history, 73 percent of the players have come from the state of Indiana and IUPUI has never started a game in the Division I era (1998-present) without having at least one Indiana-native included.

This year's team has three Hoosier State natives - graduate transfer Zach Gunn and non-scholarship freshmen Kaleb Edwards and Derek Petersen.

LONESTARS

IUPUI had never had a Texas-native in the program prior to 2019 when Taveion White joined the program. Fast forward to 2021-2022 and IUPUI has four Texas-natives (B.J. Maxwell, KJ Pruitt, Bakari LaStrap and Nathan McClure) on the team and a fifth who played high school in Texas in Chuks Isitua.

UNIVERSITY NOTES

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

IUPUI is a public research university located in downtown Indianapolis that is the result of a merger of the Purdue Indianapolis Extension Center (1946) and Indiana University Indianapolis (1916). The merger was completed in 1969 and athletics began in 1972.

The university offers more than 200 degree programs and boasts an enrollment over 30,000 (22,000 undergrad and 8,000 postgrad). The university also boasts an endowment of more than \$850 million.

The university is ranked among the Top 200 "National Universities" and ranked 7th for "Up and Coming Schools." U.S. News has ranked IUPUI among the nation's elite for 13 straight years.

All total, the campus covers 509 acres and is located along Indy's Cultural Trail.

IUPUI includes the nation's largest nursing school, the second largest medical school in the country, the only dental school in the state, and the country's oldest school of physical education. IUPUI is among the top 20 campuses in the nation for graduate professional degrees conferred

ATHLETIC PROWESS

IUPUI was a primary beneficiary of the 1987 Pan-American Games in Indianapolis and continues to boast some world renowned facilities.

The IU Natatorium is located on the IUPUI campus and is among the best swimming & diving facilities in the world. It has hosted the U.S. Olympic Team Trials four different times and 12 NCAA National Championship meets. In addition, the 2017 World Juniors were held at IUPUI and 16 world records have been set in the Natatorium water.

Adjacent west is the Michael A. Carroll Track & Soccer Stadium which has hosted several USA Outdoor Track & Field Championships and NCAA Championships, along with the 1988 US Olympic Trials. Florence Griffith-Joyner set the 100m world record of 10.49 on the track.

In basketball circles, IUPUI is best known as the long-time host of the Nike All-American Camp, which was held on campus for two decades. The nation's top prep players and coaches from every level converged on campus for two weeks each summer in what was considered the elite college recruiting event of the year. Alum included LeBron James, Chris Webber, Allen Iverson, Kevin Garnett, Jason Kidd and Paul Pierce, among many others.

GEORGE HILL

IUPUI's best known basketball alum is current NBAer George Hill, who is in his 14th year in the league this season. Hill was originally drafted by the San Antonio Spurs (1st rd., 26th overall) in 2008.

He's played for the Spurs (2008-11), Indiana Pacers (2011-16), Utah Jazz (2016-17), Sacramento Kings (2017-18), Cleveland Cavaliers (2018), Milwaukee Bucks (2018-20), Oklahoma City Thunder (2020) and Philadelphia 76ers (2021) before returning to Milwaukee this season. He's played in 825 regular season games, making nearly 500 career starts and averaging 11.0 points and 3.2 assists per game in his NBA career. He led the league in three-point percentage 2019-20 at 46 percent and is a career 38.4 percent shooter.

Entering this season, he's played in 139 career playoff games, starting 91 times and averaging 11.4 points per game.

FRESH FACES

Hired in April, head coach Matt Crenshaw had to build out his roster for this season in short order. He added five scholarship additions in graduate transfers Zach Gunn (Ball State) and B.J. Maxwell (St. Edward's University) and three freshmen in Chuks Isitua, KJ Pruitt and Boston Stanton III.

Gunn, who will miss the season due to an injury suffered in the preseason, played in 69 games and averaged 4.7 points per game during his four-year Ball State career. Maxwell, who played last season at Division II SEU in Austin, Texas, was the Lone Star Conference (LSC) Newcomer of the Year after averaging 18.6 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game last season.

Isitua, a 6-foot-11 forward/center, was considered among the top recruits from the state of Texas and was named to the 2021 All-VYPE Houston Boys Public School Basketball Team.

Pruitt, a 6-foot-4 guard, was originally in the Class of 2020 before attending Sunrise Christian Academy last season and reclassifying to the 2021 class. He averaged 14.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game as a senior at Lewisville (Texas) High School before suffering an injury in the season's final game.

Stanton III, the final addition to the program, is a 6-foot-5 guard from Denver East (Colo.) High School. He averaged 21.0 points, 5.6 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game as a junior, but had his senior year derailed by an injury and averaged just 14.2 points, 3.8 rebounds and 2.2 steals per game in five games.

CRAFTY VETERAN

Maxwell is an interesting case study in today's new world of college basketball as he's entering his seventh year of college this season. After redshirting his opening season (2015-16) at Abilene Christian, he played three full seasons at ACU before transferring out for a fifth season. He played just two games at Detroit Mercy in 2019-20 before suffering a season ending injury and receiving another season of eligibility. He spent all of last season at Saint Edward's University in Austin, Texas, where he averaged 18.6 points and 5.3 boards per game while earning NABC Second Team All-District honors.

After all NCAA student-athletes were granted an additional year of eligibility due to COVID-19 issues, Maxwell opted to join the IUPUI program for a seventh season of schooling. He enters this season having played 94 collegiate basketball games and having scored 758 points across both NCAA Division I and II levels.

SMALL WONDERS

IUPUI will most likely be undersized in each and every game this season as the average height on the IUPUI roster is just 6' 4 3/4" this season. The IUPUI roster boasts just three players taller than 6-foot-9 in Isitua (6-11), Pandev (6-10) and Carrasco (6-9).

Pandev played just 60 minutes last season before missing the final two months due to injury and Carrasco played just 50 minutes last season.

Given the lack of size, it's likely that Crenshaw will deploy a number of four guard and five guard combinations this season.

EXHIBITION NOTES

IUPUI defeated Anderson in its lone exhibition, 74-60 inside Indiana Farmers Coliseum on Nov. 3. Crenshaw played all 13 players with 11 different players getting at least 10 minutes of action.

Azariah Seay (20 points) and B.J. Maxwell (13 points) led the way while KJ Pruitt added nine points. The IUPUI bench outscored Anderson's reserves by a 35-20 margin and the undersized Jags outrebounded Anderson 40-34.

Crenshaw utilized a five guard lineup for much of the game with only three bigs - Isitua (16 minutes), Carrasco (12 minutes) and Pandev (10 minutes) - seeing time in the rotation.

IUPUI Hall of Famer **Matt Crenshaw** was named the tenth head coach of the Jaguars' men's basketball program in April 2021. Crenshaw, the program's all-time leader in assists and longtime assistant coach, was selected following a national search, facilitated by an IUPUI campus-wide search committee and assisted by Parker Executive Search. He brings 15 years of collegiate coaching experience to the Jaguar program.

Before his return to IUPUI, Crenshaw spent three seasons as an assistant at Ball State, serving as the Cardinals' co-defensive coordinator. In addition, he was instrumental in BSU's guard development, recruiting efforts and advance scouting. Under his tutelage, Ball State boasted All-Mid-American Conference performers Tayler Persons, Ishmael El-Amin, K.J. Walton and 2019-20 MAC Freshman of the Year Jarron Coleman. In addition, Ball State had the MAC's best scoring defense during the 2019-2020 season and captured a West Division championship before the season was halted due to COVID-19.

Crenshaw previously spent 12 seasons on the IUPUI bench, including his final seven years as the program's associate head coach. He was on the IUPUI coaching staff when the Jaguars notched a 26-7 mark in 2007-2008, led by the program's first NBA Draft pick, George Hill. While at IUPUI, he coached 15 all-league performers, two all-district honorees, three Mid-Major All-Americans and one CoSIDA Academic All-American.

His time on the IUPUI sidelines spanned the tenures of three head coaches, starting with his college coach Ron Hunter. Crenshaw was instrumental in a pair of firsts - leading the Jaguars to their first NCAA Tournament as a player and helping the program to its first postseason victory as a coach.

That victory came in the 2010 College Basketball Invitational as part of a 25-win season in which IUPUI fell one win shy of tying the program's single-season record for victories. That season also included one of the Jaguars' two trips to the Summit League championship game during Crenshaw's time on the bench.

In May of 2013, Crenshaw was selected from a competitive field of talented assistant coaches and invited to participate in the NCAA's A.C.E (Achieving Coaching Excellence) Program. The professional development seminar provided an opportunity to focus on training and education in the areas of leadership, communication, campus relations, media, community involvement and program management. He was able to implement much of the training as he has excelled in academic oversight and been active on campus, both at IUPUI and Ball State. He's also helped spearhead community service initiatives in both Indianapolis and Muncie.

As a player, Crenshaw gained national acclaim in March 2003 when his last second jumper sent IUPUI to a thrilling win over Valparaiso in the Mid-Continent Conference championship game and the program's first-ever NCAA Tournament berth.

The Charlottesville, Va.-native capped his collegiate career with an outstanding senior season, earning Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Year honors and Honorable Mention All Mid-Con honors. The 6-foot-2 guard averaged 11.7 points, 5.6 assists

and 4.4 rebounds per game as IUPUI went 21-11 overall. He shot 57.3 percent from the floor from his guard spot, while playing 36.3 minutes per game. He was a Preseason All Mid-Con selection prior to his senior season.

He finished his career ranked sixth in school history with 157 steals and led the Mid-Con as a junior and senior in assist-to-turnover ratio. He played in 123 career games, making 98 starts during his four years, totaling 923 points and 422 rebounds to accompany his school record 510 assists. He later had his No. 21 jersey retired by the program, becoming just the third former player to have his number retired to the IUPUI rafters.

After graduating from IUPUI in 2004, Crenshaw spent two years playing professionally both in the U.S. and overseas. He has played professionally in the ABA, Slovakia and Poland. While in Slovakia, he helped his squad to the Slovakian National Championship, while earning Playoff MVP honors. He was pegged by Eurobasket.com as the All-Slovakian League Import Player of the Year and First Team All-League before turning his attention to the coaching ranks.

THE LAST MEETING - EVANSVILLE 70, IUPUI 64 (Nov. 30, 2019 - INDIANAPOLIS)

JAGUARS DROP 70-64 SLUGFEST TO EVANSVILLE

INDIANAPOLIS (Nov. 30, 2019) - Despite a strong defensive effort, the IUPUI basketball team fell victim to some cold shooting of its own as the Jaguars dropped a non-conference contest to Evansville inside Indiana Farmers Coliseum, 70-64. Marcus Burk and Jaylen Minnett led IUPUI with 18 points each and junior Isaiah Williams chipped in with a career-high 15 points, eight rebounds and three assists in the loss.

DeAndre Williams shouldered the load for Evansville (5-3), pumping in 20 points, 15 rebounds and five assists off the Purple Aces' bench, including a bevy of key plays down the stretch. Evansville closed the game with a 15-5 run while holding IUPUI to just two field goals in the final seven minutes of the contest.

Williams helped IUPUI (2-6) build a 59-55 lead with 6:35 remaining as he split a pair of free throws, which was a common theme for the Jaguars. UE's Williams followed with a jumper of his own and then hit a pair of free-bies to tie the score at 59 all with 5:52 left.

Artur Labinowicz put the Aces ahead for good when he swished a pair of foul shots after drawing a foul on a hard drive from the left wing. After IUPUI came up empty on consecutive trips, Williams hit Evan Kuhlman for an uncontested layup to give the Aces a 63-59 lead with 2:45 left. The lead grew to seven when Labinowicz completed a three-point play with 1:55 left.

IUPUI got back within five after Elijah Goss got free for a two-handed dunk, but Evansville essentially closed out the Jags from there.

"They took Burk out of the picture and we didn't do a good of getting him into the right spots. There were times during the second half where we didn't initiate our offense and we kind of played panicked and played hero ball at times. We didn't do a very good job of getting the ball to the right people and we didn't do a very good job of setting screens to get guys open," head coach Byron Rimm II said. "I think (Evansville) gave us a little confidence in that we can play some of the best teams in the country.

"That's a team that just beat Kentucky at Kentucky and we let it slip away and I didn't think we played very well in the second half."

Burk, who came in ranked No. 7 nationally in points per game at nearly 24 a night, was held to just four points and 2-of-8 shooting after halftime in his 18-point performance. Minnett scored 13 of his season-high 18 point in the second half.

IUPUI closed the first half with a 7-0 run to take a 37-27 lead into halftime. Burk began the run with a pair of free throws and Grant Weatherford extended the rally with a tough drive in traffic. Minnett closed the first half with a long three, which sparked him going into the second half.

With the UE defense loaded up to slow Burk, Minnett connected on back-to-back contested treys early in the second half and then fed Burk to build a 47-35 lead at the 16:29 mark. Later, Evansville hit three straight threes, including back-to-back connections from Noah Frederking to turn the Jaguars' 52-44 lead into a 53-52 deficit.

Both teams finished the game shooting under 40 percent from the floor and both struggled from the arc as Evansville hit just 5-of-23 (21.7 percent) and the Jags made just 5-of-18 attempts (27.8 percent). However, IUPUI left 11 key points at the free throw line, making 13-of-24 attempts (54.2 percent).

The teams combined to commit just 15 turnovers and score a combined 16 points off turnovers.

Goss just missed a double-double with eight points and nine rebounds and Weatherford finished with four points and six rebounds. Labinowicz had nine points and six boards for Evansville and Frederking and K.J. Riley closed with eight each.
