■ ABOUT THE GAME

IUPUI (1-3) will head up I-69 on Wednesday (11/23) night to take on Ball State (0-2) in the first of two meetings during the 2011-12 basketball season. Tip time is slated for 7:00 p.m. from inside Worthen Arena in Muncie, Ind.. In the Indianapolis-market, the game can be heard on 1260 WNDE and is also available via WNDE.com and the iHeartRadio free app available on smartphones. Scott McCauley (pxp) will call the game from courtside.

■ LAST TIME OUT

IUPUI dropped a 66-64 home contest to Eastern Michigan on Sunday evening as part of the Auto-Owners Insurance Spartan Classic. The Jaguars missed their first 12 shots of the game and finished up shooting just 31.1 percent overall and 17.4 percent from three in the loss. Senior **Alex Young** had a game-high 21 points and career-high 14 boards for his seventh career double-double, but was just 7-of-22 from the floor. The second half featured 11 ties and 12 lead changes, but EMU used a 7-2 mini-run after the score was tied at 59 all with 1:50 to play.

Darrell Lampley led four Eagles in double-digits with 16 points and Antonio Green added 14 points and seven boards as the guests hit 51.2 percent from the field. Sophomore **Ian Chiles** scored 17 points off the bench for the Jags and freshman **Lyonell Gaines** chipped in 10 points and a season-high seven rebounds.

■ LAST MEETING/SERIES INFORMATION

Ball State leads the all-time series with IUPUI 5-0 with the Jaguars having had to vacate a 2003 win. BSU has won the last two meetings in the series including a 53-50 win in Indianapolis on Dec. 7, 2005 and an 80-73 win in Muncie on Dec. 11, 2004. IUPUI is 0-3 all-time inside Worthen Arena, losing those games by an average of 10.3 per contest.

■ SHOOTING WHOAS!

IUPUI's 30.0 percent shooting from the floor in last Friday's (11/18) loss at Milwaukee was the lowest in a game since hitting just 29.2 percent (14-of-48)

against Oral Roberts in The Summit League Tournament semifinals on Mar. 7, 2007, a span of 133 total games. The Jaguars nearly replicated the effort on Sunday (11/20) against Eastern Michigan, hitting just 19-of-61 (31.1 percent) from the floor. Had **Ian Chiles'** 28-footer at the buzzer not gone in, IUPUI would have ended the night at 29.5 percent.

The current two-game shooting percentage of 30.6 percent is the lowest in IUPUI's Division I era, dating back to 1998.

■ **ALEX GOES DUB-DUB**

Senior **Alex Young** recorded his first double-double of the season against EMU on Sunday, tallying a game-high 21 points to accompany a career-high 14 boards. The double-double was the seventh of his career, tying him with **Christian Siakam** for the active career lead.

■ **7UP**

Senior **Stephen Thomas** handed out a career-high seven assists in the loss to EMU on Sunday as the Jaguars had 15 assists on 19 baskets against the Eagles' 2-3 zone.

■ **ALEX'S STREAK SNAPPED**

Senior **Alex Young** had scored in double-figures 26 straight times until he was held to just five points (in 13 minutes) at Milwaukee on Nov. 18. Young was hit with four first half fouls and never got in a rhythm in the loss. The five points were his fewest since Feb. 21 of his freshman season. For his career, he's scored in double-figures 84 times in 102 career games and in 38 of IUPUI's last 40 games.

■ **TECHNICAL DIFFICULTIES / FOUL DIFFICULTIES**

Young has a recent disturbing trend going, having received a technical foul in each of IUPUI's past two games. Through four games, AY has been whistled for a foul every 8.2 minutes. Last season, that number was a foul every 13.7 minutes and he was only disqualified once all year.

■ **SPREADING THE WEALTH**

Through four games, eight different IUPUI players have scored in double-figures (Young, Rice, Gibbs, Thomas, Siakam, Chiles, Gaines, Barksdale), however no Jag has scored in double-digits in every game. Last season, nine different IUPUI players had at least one game scoring in double-digits.

■ **BENCH PRODUCTION**

So far this season, IUPUI has gotten tremendous bench production as evidence by the 29 points per game. Sophomore **Ian Chiles** (8.3 ppg) and freshman **Lyonell Gaines** (7.8 ppg) have been the primary force behind that production, while **Marcellus Barksdale** (4.8 ppg) and sophomore **Mitchell Patton** (4.0 ppg) have also played well as reserves.

IUPUI already has six double-figure efforts off the bench this season and had at least one double-figure reserve in each of the first four games.

■ YOUNG TABBED SUMMIT LEAGUE PRESEASON POTY

IUPUI senior swingman **Alex Young** was voted The Summit League's Preseason Player of the Year by the league's coaches, media and sports information personnel. The 6-foot-6 lefty averaged a team-high 19.7 points and 6.4 rebounds per game as a junior, earning his second straight First Team All-Summit ballot. He was joined on the First Team by Michael Craion (Oral Roberts), Frank Gaines (IPFW), Reggie Hamilton (Oakland), Dominique Morrison (Oral Roberts) and Nate Wolters (South Dakota State).

He became the second player in school history to earn the league's preseason player of the year honor, joining current NBAer **George Hill**, who was honored in 2007-08.

■ ANOTHER HONOR FOR ALEX

Young picked up another preseason honor just prior to the start of the year, being selected to the 2011-12 Lou Henson Preseason All-America Team by CollegeInsider.com, which recognized the top Mid-Major players in Division I basketball.

■ ALEX ON TOP

■ MILESTONES

Young became the 13th player in school history to reach 500 rebounds on Sunday and the seventh in school history to have hit 150 career threes. AY and **Brandon Cole** are the only two in school history to have grabbed 500 boards AND hit 150 career threes.

■ GOOD START

The **Todd Howard**-era got off to a good start on Nov. 7 as the Jaguars ripped Anderson, 101-68. In doing so, Howard joined **Mel Garland** and **Kirby Overman** as the only IUPUI coaches to win their first career games on the sidelines.

Howard spent the last 16 years on Hunter's staff including the last 10 as Associate Head Coach and the recruiting coordinator. Howard has had two opportunities to lead the Jaguars in the past though, including taking over the reins with 11:41 left in a loss to Oakland on Feb. 21, 2009 after Hunter was ejected. Howard also commanded the Jaguars in a 109-82 pasting of Indiana Tech on Nov. 28, 2001 as Hunter missed the game due to a one-game suspension.

■ GUARDING THE THREE

So far this season, IUPUI's opponents have hit just 23.1 percent from behind the three-point line, 12-of-52 overall.

■ CUPBOARD CHECK

Howard inherits a roster long on experience and production, headlined by the senior trio of Young, **Stephen Thomas** and **Christian Siakam**. Two key seniors from a year ago moved on in 1,000 point scorer **Leroy Nobles** and lead guard **John Ashworth**.

67.4% of the team's scoring (Young 649, Thomas 363, Siakam 306, Esposito 90)

71.9% of the team's rebounding (Siakam 227, Young 211, Thomas 108, Gibbs 67)

■ **SCHEDULE NOTES**

-The 16 regular season home games are the most in IUPUI's Division I era and the most since the 1988-89 season

-IUPUI will be taking part in the Sears BracketBusters, presented by ESPN for the first time in school history. The Jaguars will be assigned a road game to be played on Feb. 18

-The Jaguars will be hosting games at Conseco Fieldhouse for the fourth straight season, this year hosting Ball State (Dec. 19) and Valparaiso (Dec. 23). It will be the first-time IUPUI has played BSU at Conseco, while the Jags are 0-1 against the Crusaders at the home of the Indiana Pacers.

- IUPUI will host six straight games from Dec. 10 to Jan. 3, marking the longest homestand since hosting eight straight games from Dec. 27, 1997-Jan. 19, 1998 (IUPUI went 8-0 on that homestand)

■ **STAFF NOTES**

Head Coach Todd Howard opted to retain both **Matt Crenshaw** and **Matt Whinrey** from last year's staff, including promoting Crenshaw to the Associate Head Coach spot. Whinrey enters year two as a full-time assistant and Howard tapped into his Louisville roots to hire former Cardinal standout **David Padgett** as assistant coach. Padgett began his college career at Kansas before playing at UofL for Rick Pitino his final three seasons.

Padgett played professionally for two years before returning to Louisville's staff as a program coordinator last season.

In addition, Howard opted to add Indiana Hall of Famer **Basil Mawbey** as a senior advisor this season. Mawbey won IHSAA state titles at Connorsville (1983) and Lewis-Cass (2003) during his illustrious career and was added to the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame in 2002.

■ **BLUEGRASS QUARTET**

IUPUI's entire recruiting class for this season came from the state of Kentucky with true freshmen **Marcellus Barksdale**, **Lyonell Gaines** and **Jordan Shanklin** having signed early a year ago. Following Howard's hiring, he inked JUCO guard **Ian Chiles**, who originally played at Louisville Ballard High School - the same high school that Howard attended while growing up in Kentucky. Chiles played last season at Wabash Valley Junior College, the same JC that former IUPUI standout **Robert Glenn** attended.

■ **SECOND SEMESTER REINFORCEMENTS**

Achille (pron uh-SHEEL) comes to IUPUI after playing at Grace College in 2009-10. He came to IUPUI during the spring of 2011 and is fulfilling his residency requirements before becoming eligible at the semester.

While NBAer **George Hill** certainly headlines the group, there's no shortage of Jaguars currently playing basketball professionally. Hill, who was traded to the Indiana Pacers on the night of the NBA Draft last season, recently played with the Texas Fuel of the ABA with the NBA players locked out. IUPUI head coach **Todd Howard** got three to sign on the dotted line on Wednesday (Nov. 9) to become Jaguars beginning next season. The IUPUI signing class consisted of 6-foot-2, 190-pound left-handed point guard **Cortell Busby** (**Chester, S.C./Fishburne [Va.] Military School**), 6-foot-6, 225-pound forward **Elijah Ray** (**Gary, Ind./Bowman Academy**) and 6-foot-4, 185-pound sharpshooter **Linwood Ross, Jr.** (**Miramar, Fla./Westminister Academy**).

Busby is one of 10 Division I signees on a nationally ranked Fishburne Military School squad, while Ray helped Bowman Academy to an IHSAA Class A state title his sophomore year. Ross ranked second in Broward County in scoring a year ago, netting 21.3 points per game at WA. All three will be true freshmen beginning next season.

TODD HOWARD

Head Coach - First Season Louisville, '93

Todd Howard took over as the seventh head coach in the history of the IUPUI Men's Basketball Program on April 21, 2011. He is entering his 17th season on the Jaguars sidelines, serving the last 10 years as the Associate Head Coach to longtime leader Ron Hunter. He was an assistant on Hunter's staff for six years prior to that.

While under Hunter, he surpassed Greg Mingus as the longest tenured assistant/associate coach in the program's history and was also the longest tenured assistant/associate coach in The Summit League. Before being promoted to the head spot, he was recognized by numerous publications, including Hoop Scoop and Fox Sports, among the top assistant/associate coaches in the nation among mid-majors.

Howard has been instrumental in the program's successes - on the court, in the classroom, on the recruiting trail and within the community. The Jaguars won a school record 26 games during the 2007-08 season and nearly equaled that number with 25 wins in 2009-10. In 2010, IUPUI also claimed its first-ever postseason victory at the NCAA Division I level, bettering Hofstra in the opening round of the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) in Hempstead, N.Y.. IUPUI later hosted its first-ever Division I postseason game before falling to Princeton in a double overtime thriller.

Both Robert Glenn and Alex Young were both pegged First Team All-Summit and Mid-Major All-Americans by assorted publications.

The 2008 calendar year was a banner campaign for Howard as he traveled to Peru as part of the program's work with Samaritan's Feet to deliver shoes to those less fortunate. That was after he had coached an Athletes in Action team to an 8-1 record during a 10-day tour of East Asia. Later that same offseason, reigning Summit League Player of the Year George Hill was selected by the San Antonio Spurs in the first round of the NBA Draft. He became the first early entrant to be chosen in Summit League history and was just the second-ever first rounder in the league's near 30 year history.

Collectively, IUPUI was coming off its most successful season in program history, having won the aforementioned 26 games behind Hill and fellow guards Gary Patterson and Austin Montgomery. In addition, the Jaguars won a school record 15 Summit League games and were a perfect 15-0 on their home floor.

Since being elevated to the associate post, Howard has been instrumental in IUPUI's success in the conference and on a national level. In six of the past 10 years, IUPUI has either played for or captured a league title. Plus, IUPUI has produced two league Players of the Year, two Newcomers of the Year, a Sixth Man of the Year and a Defensive Player of the Year.

Howard's work with the Jaguars' guards has been evidenced by the program being ranked among the nation's leaders in fewest turnovers per game the past five seasons. In 2008, the Jaguars were the only team in the country to

rank among the top five in field goal, free throw and three-point shooting percentages, leading the nation in the three-point shooting. In 2010, the Jaguars ranked second to only Syracuse in field goal shooting and led The Summit in field goal and three-point percentage and steals. In 2011, IUPUI led The Summit and ranked top five nationally in free throw shooting.

In his role as recruiting coordinator, Howard is always highly visible on the recruiting trail, having strung together numerous marquee classes for the Jags. Most recently, he scoured his home state of Kentucky for prep standouts Marcellus Barksdale, Lyonell Gaines and Jordan Shanklin. Gaines later earned a spot on the prestigious Kentucky All-Star Team, becoming IUPUI's second selection in three years. In 2007 IUPUI inked Indiana All-Stars Larry Stone and Alex Young and Kentucky All-Star Aaron Morris. The class of John Ashworth and Adrian Moss, swingman Leroy Nobles and highly touted big man Christian Siakam was rated tops in The Summit by noted insider Clark Francis, editor of The Hoop Scoop. IUPUI's class ranked No. 93 in the nation with the spring signings of Ashworth, Moss and Siakam.



He helped land Ben Davis standout point guard Greg Rice, keeping the trend going of landing top-notch talent from the city of Indianapolis. In 2010, he returned to his Louisville roots to bring talented forward Donovan Gibbs to the IUPUI program, along with in-state standouts P.J. Hubert and Mitchell Patton.

In 2004, Howard began to further earn acclaim on both the camp and recruiting scene. He spent a week as a clinician at the prestigious Pete Newell Big Man Camp in Hawaii, while also helping secure one of IUPUI's most prolific recruiting classes in recent memory.

In the early signing period, Howard helped ink Indianapolis high school products George Hill (Broad Ripple) and Craig Swoope (Carmel). Over the summer during the late signing period, Howard helped land a pair of junior college standouts in Michal Vavrek (Joliet JC) and Maushae Byles (Kennedy-King CC). Prior to that, Howard had been equally successful in landing in-state talent including 2002 Marion County Player of the Year Brandon Cole and 2003 Indiana All-Star David Barlow.

Hill later became IUPUI's second Indiana All-Star, while Vavrek was the second IUPUI recruit to receive All-America mention from the NJCAA. In all, IUPUI has signed seven former Indiana All-Stars since Howard's promotion to Associate Head Coach, after signing just one in the program's history previously.

Howard also played a vital role in landing a pair of Division I transfers for the third time in program history. Former Indiana All-Stars Gary Patterson and Austin Montgomery were both named to the league's All-Newcomer Team after sitting the previous season. Before that, former Indiana All-Star Brandon Cameron and Lawrence North's Angelo Smith made their mark on the Jags lineup. In 2002-03, the addition's of Wright State's Marcus May and Ball State's Josh Murray in 2002 helped propel the Jags to its most memorable year in program history. That year, Howard was a big part in IUPUI bringing home the Mid-Con Championship and making it's first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance. Under his guidance, the Jaguars posted a 20-14 overall record and a 10-4 mark in conference play.

In 13 seasons in The Summit League (formerly Mid-Continent Conference), Howard has seen 11 players (Don Carlisle, Sylvester Allen, Antoine Lewis, Odell Bradley, Josh Murray, Akeem Clark, George Hill, Austin Montgomery, Gary Patterson, Robert Glenn and Stephen Thomas) recognized on the All-Newcomer Team in the coaches/media polls. In 2005-06, Montgomery became IUPUI's first-ever Mid-Con Newcomer of the Year in the program's history and Glenn matched the award in 2009.

In 2001-02, Howard's first year as Associate Head Coach, the Jaguars showed promise on the mid-major level as they turned in a 15-15 mark and clawed their way to the Mid-Con Tournament Championship game. The recruiting class around which that team was built, featured six talented JUCO players and 2002 Howard County Player of the Year Blair Crawford.

"Todd certainly has the pedigree, knowledge and work ethic to succeed in this profession," Francis said. "His results at IUPUI have led the Jaguars to unprecedented success. His recruiting prowess has brought quality, impact student-athletes to Indianapolis."

A native of Louisville, Ky., Howard played collegiately at the University of Louisville where he labels his experience in playing for Hall of Fame Coach Denny Crum as one that enabled him to "play for the best, with the best and against the best." While reaching the NCAA Tournament three times, the Cardinals also captured two Metro Conference titles.

Upon completion of his playing career, Howard served as a student assistant under Crum for the 1993-94 season. The Cardinals enjoyed a return trip to the NCAA Sweet 16 that season and boasted a roster that included five future NBA players.

While at IUPUI, more than 20 former Jaguars recruited by Howard have gone on to professional careers, led by George Hill's being drafted and Carlos Knox, Odell Bradley and Matt Crenshaw's stints overseas. Former IUPUI standout Don Carlisle is still among the elite players in France, while Akeem Clark has starred both in the U.S. and overseas. Howard has coached five All-Americans and 14 All-League players.

Howard graduated from Louisville Ballard High School in 1989

after capturing a state championship as a junior in 1988 and finishing as state runner-up in 1987. Ballard was nationally ranked during each of his four seasons as Howard was named All-District and All-Region each season. He was a high school teammate of current New York Knicks star Allan Houston. Throughout his high school and collegiate career, Howard played with eight future NBA players.

The Howard family is rich in basketball tradition. Todd's father, Terry, also played at Louisville while his younger brother, Nathan, played at Murray State. In 1999, Howard was listed by The Hoop Scoop as "One of the Games Top 20 Assistant Coaches" and was recently listed by Indiana Basketball News as one of the state's top assistants.

Howard values the mentorship of Hall of Fame Coach Pete Newell and has served as a camp clinician at his annual 'Big Man Camp' on two occasions. He worked with some of the game's elite post players and learning from the Hall of Fame coach. In 2002, Howard assisted FIBA and USA Basketball in hosting the World Championships in Indianapolis.

The Louisville product prides himself in the development of perimeter players. IUPUI's success has been predicated by strong backcourts and few have been stronger than the 2007-08 trio of Hill, Patterson and Montgomery. In addition, Howard helped the long-term development of Crenshaw, David Barlow, Johnny Miller, Matt Burks, Rodney Thomas, Derek Williams, Taj Hawkins and Carlos Knox, among others.

"Howard has a relationship with the players that all coaches dream about," WISH-TV's Anthony Calhoun said. "The one thing that caught my attention is how much the players love playing for him."

Howard's responsibilities range from recruiting, advance scouting, game and practice preparation, player development, compliance liaison, academic monitoring and scheduling.

He is married to the former Patti Martin, also from Louisville.

The couple have a son, Adam, who turns 12 on Jan. 10 and a daughter, Katie, who turns nine on March 5. The Howard family resides in Fishers, Ind..
