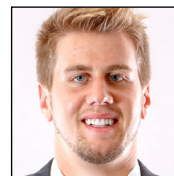
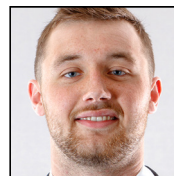
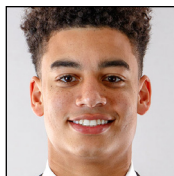

QUICK HITTERS

- IUPUI will open the postseason as the No. 5 seed in the Horizon League Tournament and face No. 4 Oakland in the opening round. IUPUI and Oakland met in conference tournament play four times as members of The Summit League with the Jaguars winning three of the four meetings. IUPUI eliminated the Golden Grizzlies in 2002, 2006 and 2008 and Oakland defeated the Jaguars for The Summit League title in Sioux Falls in 2010.
- While IUPUI was shutout of the league's postseason honors, it was announced on Thursday that **Aaron Brennan** and **D.J. McCall** were voted All-Academic Horizon League by the faculty athletic representatives.
- IUPUI completed a clean sweep of the Wisconsin portion of the Horizon League schedule, going 2-0 against both Green Bay and Wisconsin. The Jags were swept by Northern Kentucky, UIC and Youngstown State and split with Cleveland State, Detroit Mercy, Oakland and Wright State.
- The Jaguars are ranked 60th in the country in turnovers forced (14.9 to/gm) and 85th nationally in steals (7/gm). Junior **D.J. McCall** is second in the Horizon League at 1.59 steals/game.
- In league play, senior **Aaron Brennan** (12.7 ppg) led a balanced attack and was joined in double-digits by **T.J. Henderson** (10.6) and **Ron Patterson** (10.1). Seven players average at least 6 points per game as **Evan Hall** (7.7), **D.J. McCall** (7.2), **Jaylen Minnett** (7.0) and **Nick Rogers** (5.7) make up the Jags' top seven. All seven of those individuals average between 19-29 minutes per game in Horizon League play.
- Aaron Brennan** is the lone IUPUI player to have started all 29 games this season. Gardner has used seven different combinations with nine different players having made at least one start. IUPUI used the group of Brennan, **Evan Hall**, **Nick Rogers**, **D.J. McCall** and **Ron Patterson** for 15 straight games before inserting redshirt freshman **Evan Borgman** for Patterson at Oakland on Feb. 4.
- IUPUI has opened the season 2-2 in all four years since Gardner took over and never gotten back to .500 at any point in the seasons. All four years, the Jags have begun at 2-2 and dropped the fifth and sixth games of the season.
- IUPUI made the move to the Horizon League in the offseason after spending 19 years at the Division I level as a member of The Summit League. The Jaguars were picked to finish tenth in the league according to the preseason polls and no member of the Jaguars' roster earned preseason plaudits.

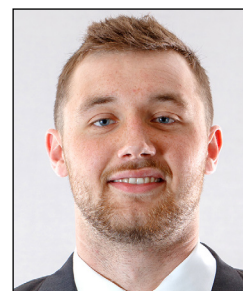

LAST TIME OUT

IUPUI closed the regular season with a 75-56 home loss to Northern Kentucky as the Norse clinched the outright regular season title on the Jaguars' home floor. NKU surged out to a double-digit lead in the opening eight minutes and never looked back in the win.

IUPUI shot just 30.2 percent from the floor while NKU connected on 51 percent for the game. **Ron Patterson** and **T.J. Henderson** scored a team-high 14 points each in the loss while Lavone Holland II had 17 points and Drew McDonald added 15 points and 11 boards.

OLD FOE

Despite the move to the new league, IUPUI will face a familiar foe in the opening round of the Horizon League Tournament on Sunday night (Mar. 4) when the Jaguars take on No. 4 Oakland. The two teams hooked up four different times in the postseason as Summit League foes with IUPUI winning three of the four matchups.

NO. 5

IUPUI has been the No. 5 seed in a postseason tournament exactly one time in program history - that being 2001 in the program's first season of postseason eligibility. That year, the Jaguars upset No. 4 UMKC in the opening round before falling to top-seeded Valparaiso in the Mid-Continent Conference Tournament, held in Fort Wayne.

AB & DJ

Aaron Brennan and **D.J. McCall** were voted All-Academic Horizon League by the league's faculty athletic representatives. The two were picked to the five-man team, along with Drew McDonald and Carson Williams from NKU and Parker Ernsthansen of Wright State.

FOUR GRADS

The IUPUI roster boasts four graduates this season as **Maurice Kirby** completed his degree at Loyola (Ill.) and is pursuing his master's in sports journalism. In addition, junior guard **D.J. McCall** completed his undergraduate work in three years and is now pursuing his master's degree at IUPUI. **Aaron Brennan** and **Ron Patterson** completed their degree requirements during the fall semester.

ONE HALL OF A NIGHT LEADS TO HL POTW

Junior **Evan Hall** had one of the best games of his career at Milwaukee, finishing with 20 points (10-of-15 FG), 10 rebounds and a career-high four blocked shots in the victory. It was Hall's fourth career double-double and he closed one point shy of his career-high in the scoring column. It was his eighth career game with at least 10 rebounds and the first time this season he's led the Jaguars in scoring.

Hall was later named Horizon League Player of the Week, becoming the first IUPUI player to ever earn the award.

HALL GOES BACK-TO-BACK

Junior **Evan Hall** recently posted back-to-back double-doubles for the first time in his career and became the first IUPUI player to post back-to-back double-doubles since **Marcellus Barksdale** had three-in-a-row from Dec. 18-23, 2013 (Nicholls State, at Indiana State, at SEMO).

BENCH NOTES

The IUPUI bench has been especially strong, averaging 25.1 points per game, including a season-high 43 at Oakland on Feb. 4. The past four years, the IUPUI bench has outscored opponents in 85 of 124 (68.5 percent) of its games, going 42-43 in those contests. Coming into today, the IUPUI bench has outscored the opponents' in eight straight games.

BENCH NOTES, PART II

For the year, IUPUI is getting 36.6 percent of its points from reserves, primarily keyed by **T.J. Henderson** and **Jaylen Minnett**. The Jags bench has hit for 40-or-more points in a game six times this season.

SINCE OAKLAND

Since the second half of the Oakland game (Feb. 4), junior **T.J. Henderson** has been on a tear. He scored 14 points in the second half at Oakland and followed with back-to-back career-high efforts of 19 against Cleveland State (Feb. 8) and 22 against Youngstown State (Feb. 10). The past seven games, Henderson is averaging 14.7 points and shooting 48 percent (30-of-62) from the field and 88.9 percent (32-of-36) from the foul line.

FREE MONEY?

IUPUI is shooting just 65.9 percent from the foul line this season, which would threaten the program's lowest mark in the Division I-era. The current lowest mark is 65.4 percent from 2008-09. The lowest single-season on record was a 62.7 percent mark in 1976-77.

NO. 1 FOR 6TH

Henderson made a compelling case for Horizon League Sixth Man of the Year honors, leading the league in scoring (10.6 ppg) among those who didn't start a game in league play. However, UIC's Godwin Boahen was voted the award winner.

THEFT ALERT

Junior **D.J. McCall** is currently second in the Horizon League with 1.54 steals per game. The junior guard has 43 steals this season, surpassing his career total of 41 entering this season in 63 games.

ROSTER CHANGES

The IUPUI program had a few roster changes at the turn of the semester as one player departed the program and two others joined the Jaguars. Little used sophomore **Noah Thomas** left the program after having appeared in just two games in the first semester. Thomas, a 6-foot-9 center, totaled four points and four rebounds in eight total minutes.

On the flip side, the Jaguars brought in a pair of transfers as **Mike Sagay** (Boston College) and **Trevor Johnson** (Mesa [Ariz.] C.C.) joined the program. Sagay, a 6-foot-7 forward, comes to IUPUI with two-and-a-half years of eligibility, after having played 15 games at Boston College last season. A 3-star recruit, Sagay was ranked among Connecticut's top players as a senior at St. Thomas More High School.

Johnson, a 6-foot-2 guard, comes to IUPUI with two years of eligibility remaining. Johnson was an All-State performer while at Flagstaff [Ariz.] High School before attending Mesa Community College.

Both are able to begin practice with the team immediately.

STARTER NOTES

In the early portion of the season, head coach **Jason Gardner** continued to tweak the Jaguars' starting five, using six different quintets. For the year, senior **Aaron Brennan** is the lone Jag to have started all 29 games and **Evan Hall** is next with 28 starts. Nine of the Jaguars' 11 players have one start this season with freshman **Evan Borgman** getting the nod at Oakland.

The group of Brennan, Hall, **Ron Patterson**, **D.J. McCall** and **Nick Rogers** started 15 straight games (5-10) before Gardner inserted Borgman for Patterson at Oakland on Feb. 4.

WIN/LOSS SPLITS

In IUPUI's 11 wins, the Jags have shot 46.7 percent from the field and held foes to 39.5 percent overall and 28.6 percent from deep. In addition, the Jags have outrebounded opponents by 3.5 boards per game in the 11 wins.

In the Jaguars' 18 losses, IUPUI has shot just 40.2 percent overall and allowed opponents to shoot a robust 52.1 percent from the field and 40.9 percent from beyond the arc. In addition, IUPUI has been outrebounded by 2.4 boards per game in the 18 losses.

WINNING THE ARC

IUPUI defended the three well in Horizon League play, yielding a league-low 31.5 percent from deep. On the flip side, IUPUI shot 37.9 percent from deep in league play, led by Brennan (42.6) and Minnett (42.9). Patterson tops the team with 35 made 3's in league play while Minnett has 33.

IUPUI made as many or more threes than their opponents in 14 of 18 league games.

MAKE SHOTS, WIN GAMES

The most telling number of outcomes of games under head coach **Jason Gardner** has simply been field goal percentages.

IUPUI is 44-8 (.846) in games in which the Jaguars have shot a better percentage than opponents and just 4-68 (.056) when being outshot.

The Jan. 10 Milwaukee win is the only time this season IUPUI has been outshot and won the game.

GETTING LOOKS

Two areas where IUPUI has excelled this season are offensive rebounding (72nd nationally - 12 rpg) and forcing turnovers (60th nationally - 14.8 to/g).

Because of those numbers, IUPUI has *attempted* 110 more shots than their foes for the year, good for 3.8 shot attempts per game.

GRADE CHECK

Ten members of the IUPUI basketball team earned at least a 3.0 grade point average during the fall semester - **Evan Borgman**, **Aaron Brennan**, **Elijah Goss**, **Evan Hall**, **T.J. Henderson**, **Chad Hudson**, **Ahmed Ismail**, **Maurice Kirby**, **D.J. McCall** and **Noah Thomas**.

LEAGUE OPENERS

Head coach **Jason Gardner** is 3-1 in league openers, having won all three of his Summit League openers before losing his Horizon League opener at NKU.

T.J. Henderson has a team-high 18 double-digit scoring games this season while **Aaron Brennan** and **Ron Patterson** are next in line with 15 games in dubs.

SNAPPED AT 13

Senior **Ron Patterson** opened the year making at least one three in 13 straight games - his longest stretch of his college career. His longest streak last season was 10 straight games from Jan. 5-Feb. 8.

DEFENDING THE TREY

TOUGH THREE

IUPUI endured arguably the toughest three-game stretch in program history with road games at No. 21 Purdue (L, 61-86), at Washington State (L, 59-72) and at No. 12 Gonzaga (L, 71-101). The losses at Purdue and Gonzaga dropped IUPUI to 0-17 all-time against nationally ranked foes.

In the non-conference slate, IUPUI had the nation's 50th toughest schedule (hardest in the Horizon League) according to KenPom.com.

FIVE KEY NUMBERS

Below are five key numbers from the Jaguars' loss to NKU.

14: IUPUI had a season-low 14 points in the paint in the loss as NKU outscored the Jags 34-14 inside

AT THE HORN

FRESH STARTS

In the season opener at Bradley, true freshman **Jaylen Minnett** became the first IUPUI true rookie to start his debut since **Alex Young** did so against Northeastern in 2008. Minnett had five points, two boards and an assist in his IUPUI debut.

JAGS LOCK UP RAVENS

While head coach **Jason Gardner** has preached defense in the preseason, the win over Anderson was especially impressive in that IUPUI held the Ravens to just 43 points. The 43 were the fewest by a foe since Gardner took over the program and just the second time an IUPUI opponent tallied less than 50 in the Gardner-era (49 vs. Denver on Jan. 10, 2015).

The 43 points allowed was the lowest total by an IUPUI opponent since holding Western Illinois to 42 on Feb. 6, 2010.

FULL STRENGTH

The Nov. 21 Morehead State game was the first time all season the Jags were at full strength. **Evan Hall**, **D.J. McCall** and **Nick Rogers** all missed time in the season's first three games.

IUPUI has nine scholarship players available this season with three other scholarship student-athletes sitting out as Division I transfers.

TRENDING

When head coach **Jason Gardner** took over the IUPUI program prior to the 2014-15 season, he knew it was going to be a lengthy rebuild. The Jags were on the heels of back-to-back 6-26 seasons and 300+ RPI finishes. As expected, Gardner has had IUPUI steadily rising since his takeover:

HOOSIER MADE

IUPUI has the second-most Indiana-natives of any team in the country with nine, trailing only Ball State. Of the nine Indiana natives, four are from the Indianapolis-area in **Aaron Brennan**, **T.J. Henderson**, **Ron Patterson** and **Nick Rogers**.

NEW LEAGUE, OLD RIVALS

Although IUPUI will be in year one of Horizon League play, that doesn't mean there won't be some recognizable foes in league play.

The most recognizable will be longtime Mid-Con/Summit foe Oakland University, which IUPUI played 36 times between 1998 and 2013 as league foes. Oakland leads the all-time series 25-16, which includes five meetings in the mid-/late 70's.

Another former league foe in the Horizon League is Youngstown State, which IUPUI played six times from 1999-2001 before the Penguins moved leagues. YSU is 8-1 all-time against IUPUI, which includes three meetings from the mid-/late 70's.

Another familiar face is Wright State head coach Scott Nagy, who was the longtime leader of the South Dakota State program before taking over the Raiders a couple seasons ago. While at the helm of the SDSU program, Nagy was 13-7 against the Jaguars.

BRING 'EM ON

IUPUI added a new assistant coach in the offseason as **Matt Bringman** joined the Jaguars' staff, replacing Scott Gillespie. Bringman came to IUPUI from South Plains (Texas) College where he helped the Texans to a 2-year record of 53-11 and 28-4 in conference play. South Plains was 3rd at 2017 NJCAA National Championships in Hutchinson, Kan.

Bringman helped a number of players to the D1 ranks, including Jordan Brangers (Western Ky.), Raquan Mitchell (Colorado St.), Shawntrez Davis (Nevada) & Josh Webster (Texas Tech).

OVERSEAS ADVENTURES

IUPUI's top two players from a season ago - seniors **Darell Combs** and **Matt O'Leary** - are both continuing their playing careers overseas this winter.

Combs inked a deal in early September to play for the Roseto Sharks in Italy's second division. Combs had an NBA workout with the Washington Wizards before ultimately seeking employment overseas.

O'Leary signed in late July to continue his career with Penas Huesca in the LEB Gold - Spain. LEB Gold is the 2nd division in Spain and known as one of the top leagues in Europe. In addition, former Jaguars **Alex Young** and **Robert Glenn** are also continuing to play overseas.

NEW SIGNEES

IUPUI inked a pair at the start of the fall signing period, adding size in 6-foot-7 **Jack Hansen** (Noblesville, Ind./Guerin Catholic) and 6-foot-10 **Brandon Kenyon** (Caledonia, Ontario/RISE Prep).

Hansen played AAU with Team Blaze Select and was Gardner's first commitment of the 2018 class and chose IUPUI over interest from Valpo, Indiana State and Wright State. He averaged 19 points and nine rebounds per game as a junior and is among the state's top players heading into this season.

Kenyon played AAU with UPLAY Canada and excelled on the Nike EYBL circuit last summer. His UPLAY squad boasts Florida, Central Arkansas and Loyola signees while The RISE Prep program is expected to be among the best in the Ontario Scholastic Basketball Association (OSBA).

UNIVERSITY NOTES

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

IUPUI is a public research university located in downtown Indianapolis that is the result of a merger of the Purdue Indianapolis Extension Center (1946) and Indiana University Indianapolis (1916). The merger was completed in 1969 and athletics began in 1972.

The university offers more than 200 degree programs and boasts an enrollment over 30,000 (22,000 undergrad and 8,000 postgrad). The university also boasts an endowment of more than \$850 million.

The university is ranked among the Top 200 "National Universities" and ranked 7th for "Up and Coming Schools." U.S. News has ranked IUPUI among the nation's elite for 13 straight years.

ATHLETIC PROWESS

IUPUI was a primary beneficiary of the 1987 Pan-American Games in Indianapolis and continues to boast some world renowned facilities.

The IU Natatorium is located on the IUPUI campus and is among the best swimming & diving facilities in the world. It has hosted the U.S. Olympic Team Trials four different times and 12 NCAA National Championship meets. In addition, the 2017 World Juniors were held at IUPUI and 16 world records have been set in the Natatorium water.

Adjacent west is the Michael A. Carroll Track & Soccer Stadium which has hosted several USA Outdoor Track & Field Championships and NCAA Championships, along with the 1988 US Olympic Trials. Florence Griffith-Joyner set the 100m world record of 10.49 on the track.

In basketball circles, IUPUI is best known as the long-time host of the Nike All-American Camp, which was held on campus for two decades. The nation's top prep players and coaches from every level converged on campus for two weeks each summer in what was considered the elite college recruiting event of the year. Alum included LeBron James, Chris Webber, Allen Iverson, Kevin Garnett, Jason Kidd and Paul Pierce, among many others.

GEORGE HILL

IUPUI's best known basketball alum is current NBAer **George Hill**, who is in his tenth year in the league this season. Hill was originally drafted by the San Antonio Spurs (1st rd., 26th overall) in 2008.

He's played for the Spurs (2008-11), Indiana Pacers (2011-16), Utah Jazz (2016-17) and Sacramento Kings (2017-18) before recently being traded to the Cleveland Cavaliers. Hill has played in more than 600 games and made nearly 400 starts in his NBA career.

HEAD COACH JASON GARDNER



Jason Gardner was named the eighth head coach in IUPUI men's basketball program's history on April 2, 2014. Gardner, the 1999 winner of the Indiana Mr. Basketball Award, spent a year on the University of Memphis bench and two seasons at Loyola prior to that.

In his first season on the Jaguars' bench, he guided IUPUI to 10 wins, more than tripling the program's Division I win total from a year prior. His hiring paid immediate dividends on the recruiting trail, as he immediately inked five Division I transfers, four of whom were former in-state standouts.

In year two, Gardner led the Jags to a 13-win season against one of the nation's stiffest schedules, including a 9-7 mark in league play and a finish in the top half of the league standings. He upped his program's win total to 14 in his third year while coaching the program's first Academic All-American (Matt O'Leary).

Gardner has shown he's a proven recruiter, inking talent, both through high school signees, transfers and graduate transfers.

While at Memphis, Gardner helped the Tigers to a 24-10 record as Shaq Goodwin and Joe Jackson earned All-Conference accolades. In addition, Memphis forward Austin Nichols was a unanimous selection to the American Athletics Conference All-Rookie Team after averaging 9.1 points and 4.2 boards per game. Gardner was a college teammate of current Memphis Head Coach Josh Pastner at Arizona.

Prior to coming to Memphis, Gardner was an assistant under Porter Moser at Loyola, helping the Ramblers to an eight-game improvement from 2011-12 to 2012-13. He coached Ben Averkamp to All-Horizon League accolades for two straight seasons, while Loyola point guard Cully Payne was a Bob Cousy Award nominee. He also helped recruit one of the top signing classes in the Horizon League prior to the 2012-13 season. Gardner's coaching career began in 2010 when he served as an assistant at nearby Cathedral High School.

Gardner's racked up numerous accolades during his prestigious high school, college and professional playing careers. He was a 1999 McDonald's and Parade All-American while at North Central High School, finishing his prep career with a school record 1,669 points. He was a two-time Gatorade Circle of Champions Indiana Player of the Year and was named the 1998-99 Indianapolis County Player of the Year by The Indianapolis Star and Indianapolis News. His senior season, he helped NCHS to the IHSAA 4A state championship and Tournament of Champions title while averaging 22.6 points, 4.7 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 3.0 steals per game.

The 5-foot-10 point guard was recruited to the University of Arizona by legendary Head Coach Lute Olsen, where he was a four-year All-American for the Wildcats. He was the 2002-03 Naismith National Player of the Year and Lowe's Senior CLASS award recipient. He was the 2000 consensus National Freshman of the Year and closed his career as one of four players in Pac-12 history with 1,500 points, 500 assists and 200 steals for a career. He helped lead Arizona to two Pac-12 regular season titles (2000, 2003) and four consecutive NCAA Tournament berths. The Wildcats made three Sweet Sixteens (2001, 2002, 2003), two Elite Eights (2001, 2003) and were the NCAA national runner-up in 2001. All total, Arizona won 107 games during Gardner's four seasons and he still holds school records for games started (135) and minutes played (4,825), while ranking third in school history with 1,984 career points. He also finished second in threes made (318) and fourth in assists (622). He earned his degree from the university in 2011 in disciplinary studies.

Gardner later played professionally overseas for more than eight years, primarily in Germany. In 2009, he was named MVP of German Basketball Bundesliga after helping Oldenburg to the league crown, averaging 13.7 points, 4.0 assists and 3.0 boards per game. He was a two-time Basketball Bundesliga All-Star, including starting the 2007 game.

Gardner is married to the former Jacquelyn Maxberry and the couple has four children, Jasper, Jason Jr., Jacob and Jackson.
